CLAIM

The ornamental design for a blade guard for hair trimming and clipping apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a blade guard for hair trimming and clipping apparatus showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The bottom, not shown, is unornamented.

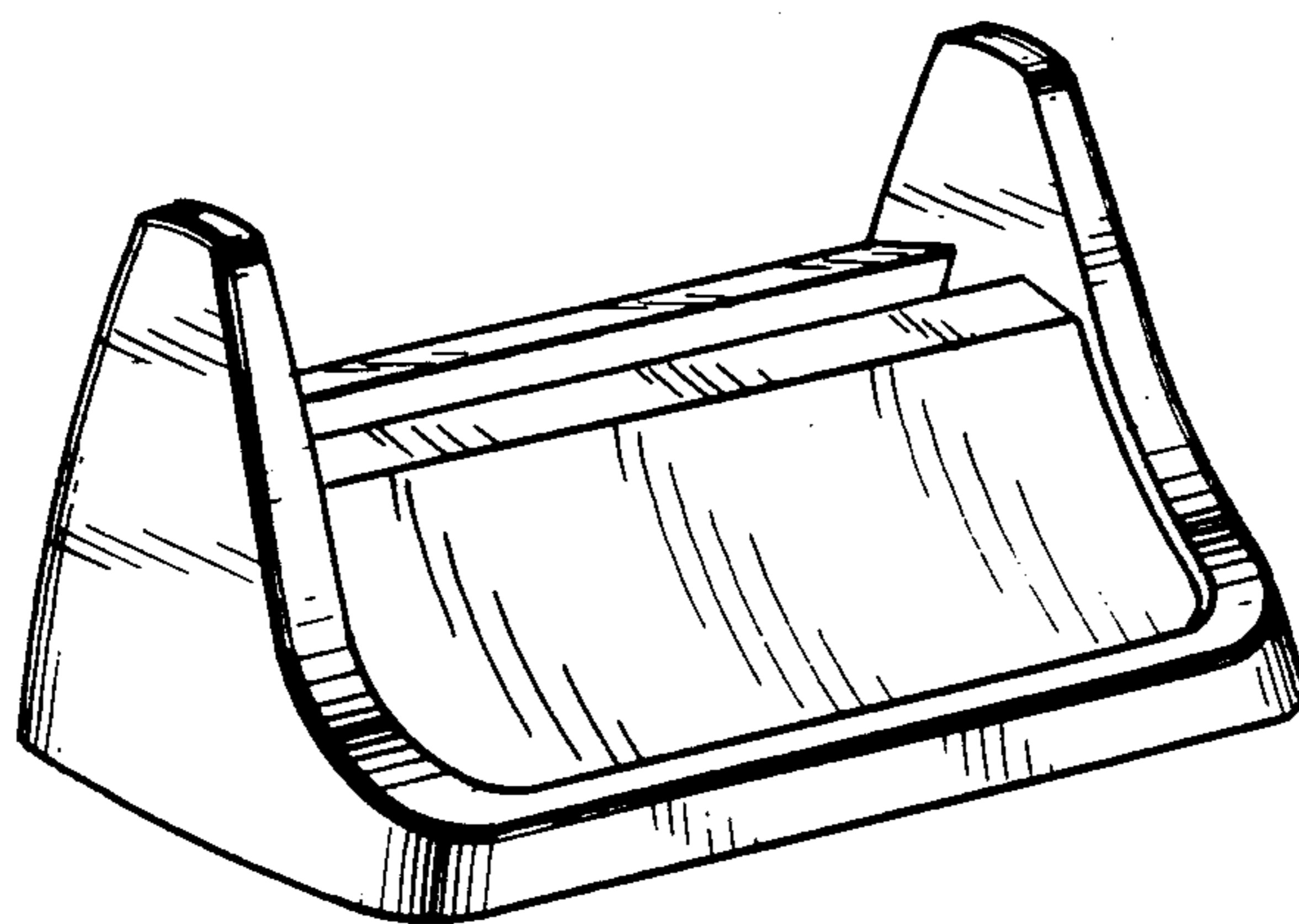

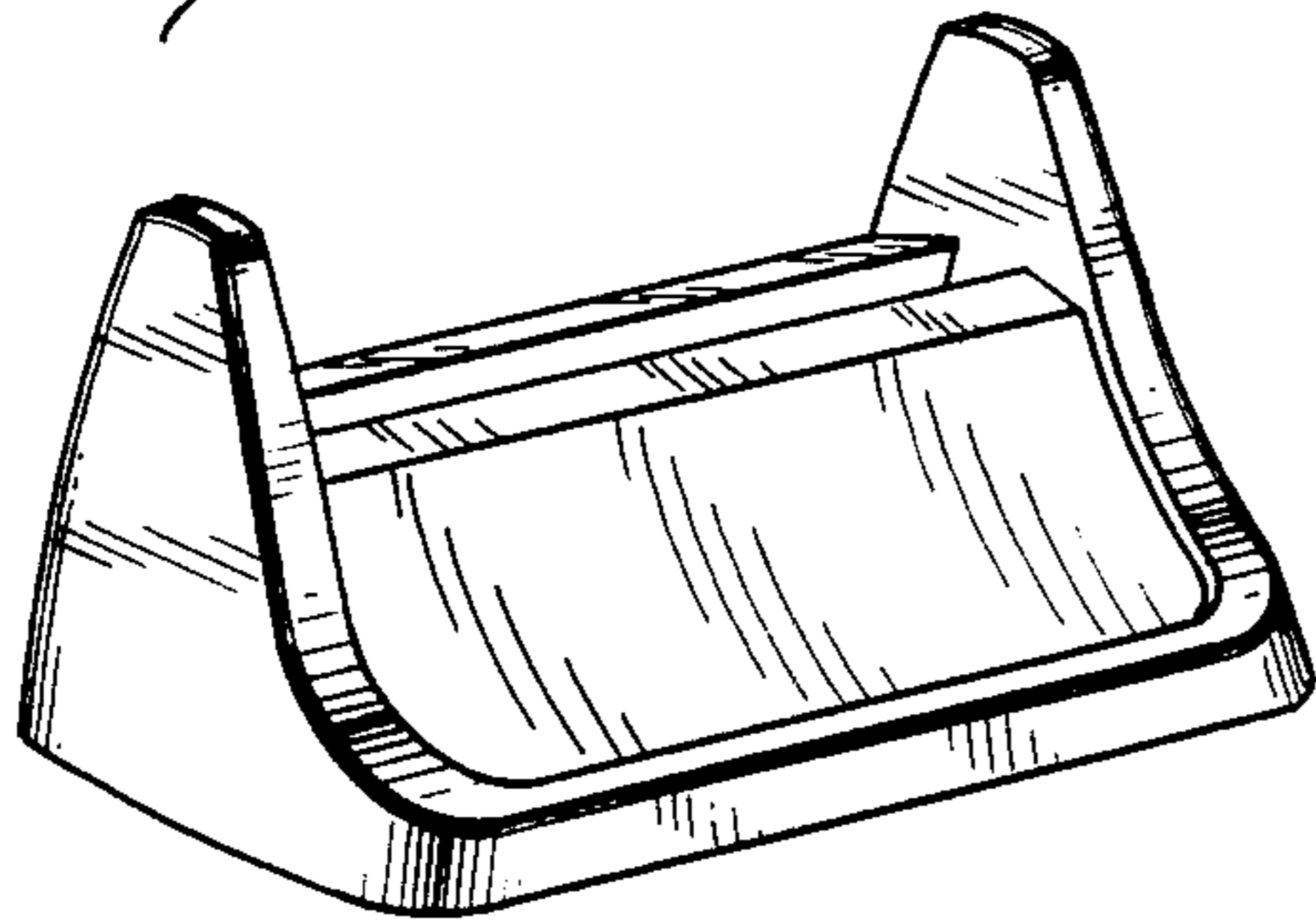

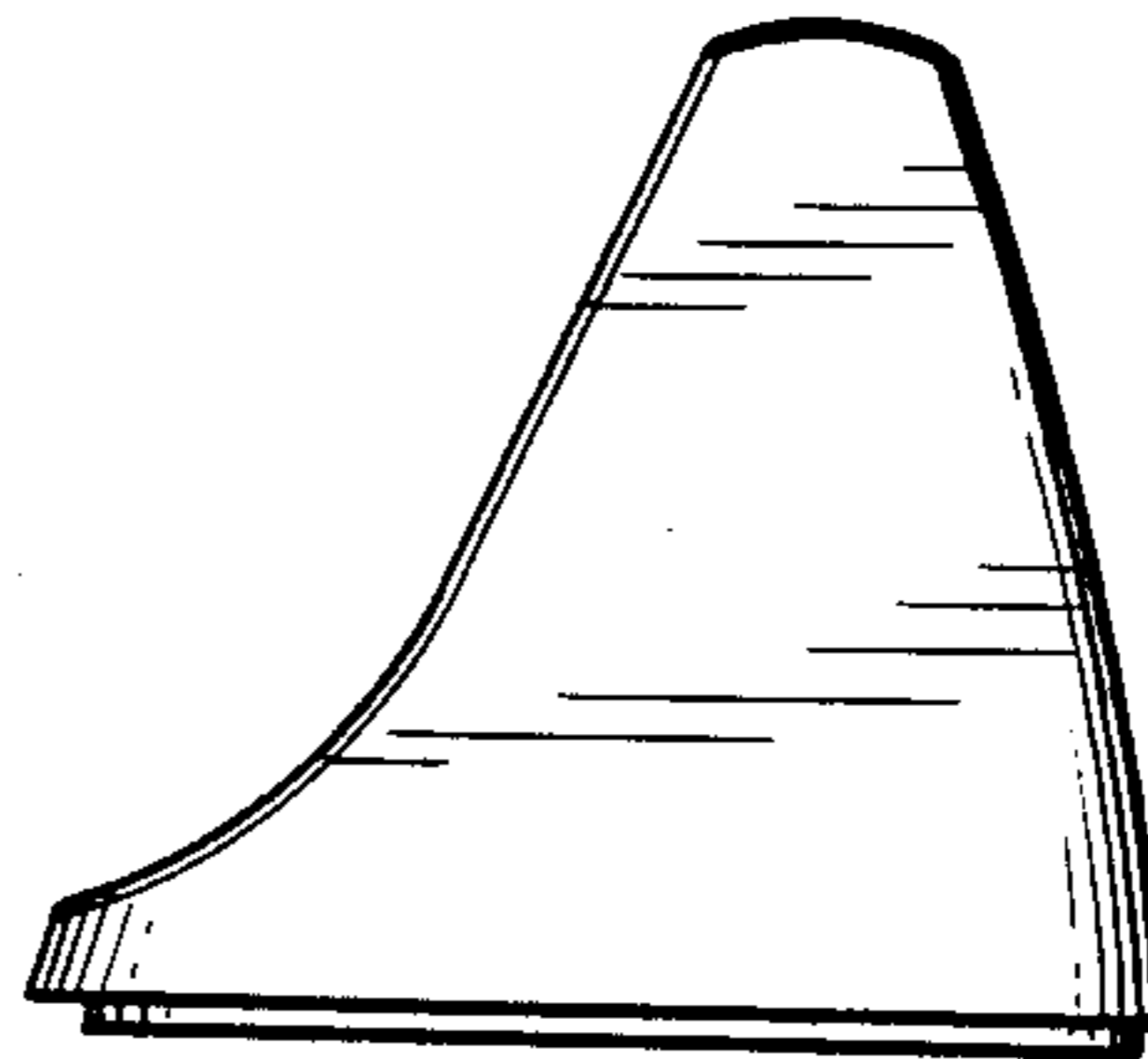

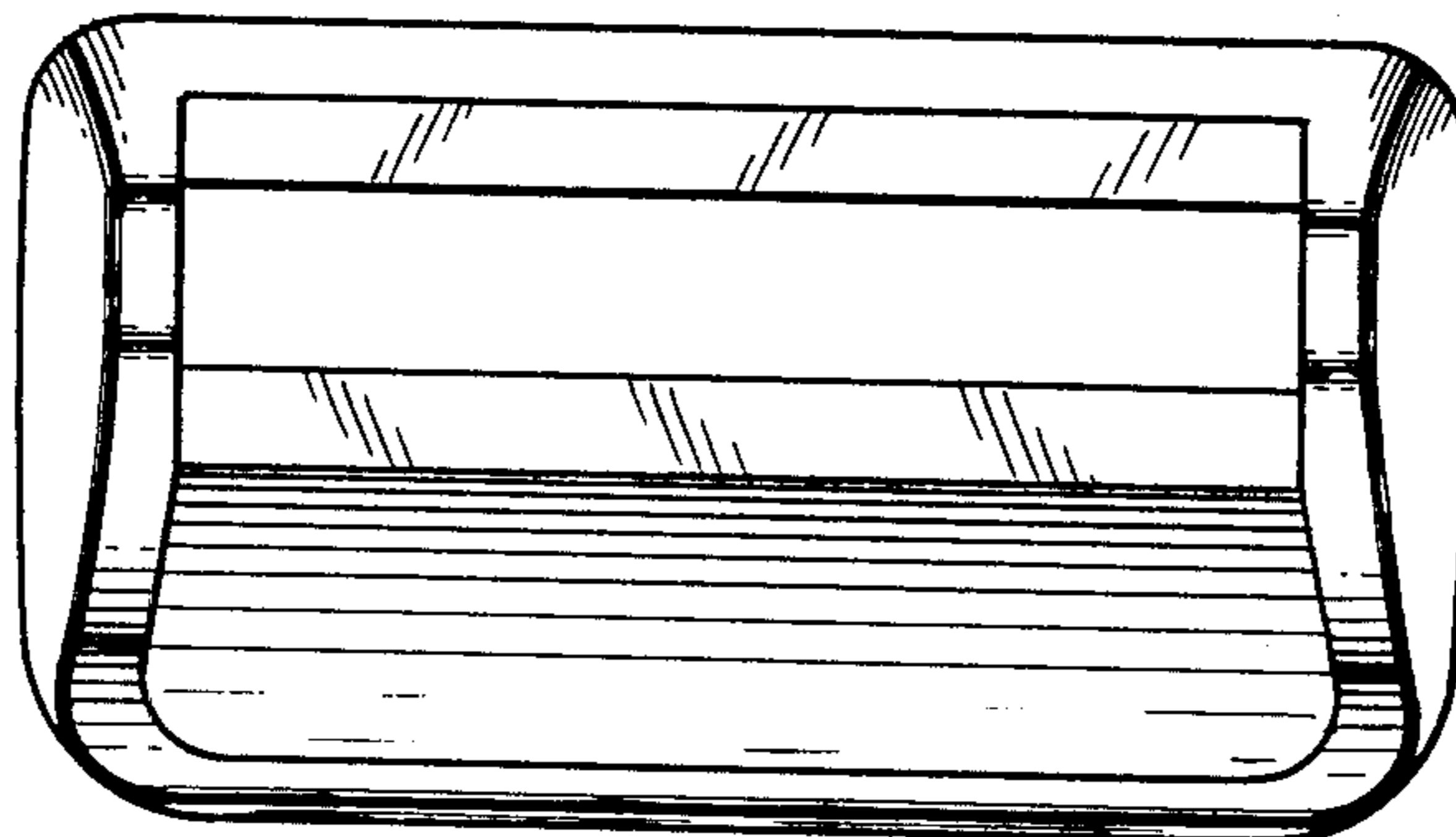
