[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for paneling for a kitchen cabinet or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of one form of panel.
 FIG. 2 is a front view of a similar panel.
 FIG. 3 is a front view of another panel.
 FIG. 4 is a partial and broken away view of the panel shown in FIGS. 1 to 3, and particularly showing a perspective view of the handle.
 FIG. 5 is a partial sectional view of the panel taken along the longitudinal bisecting plane I—I in FIG. 4, and particularly showing a longitudinal bisecting view of the handle.
 The dominant features of the design reside in the portions shown in full line.

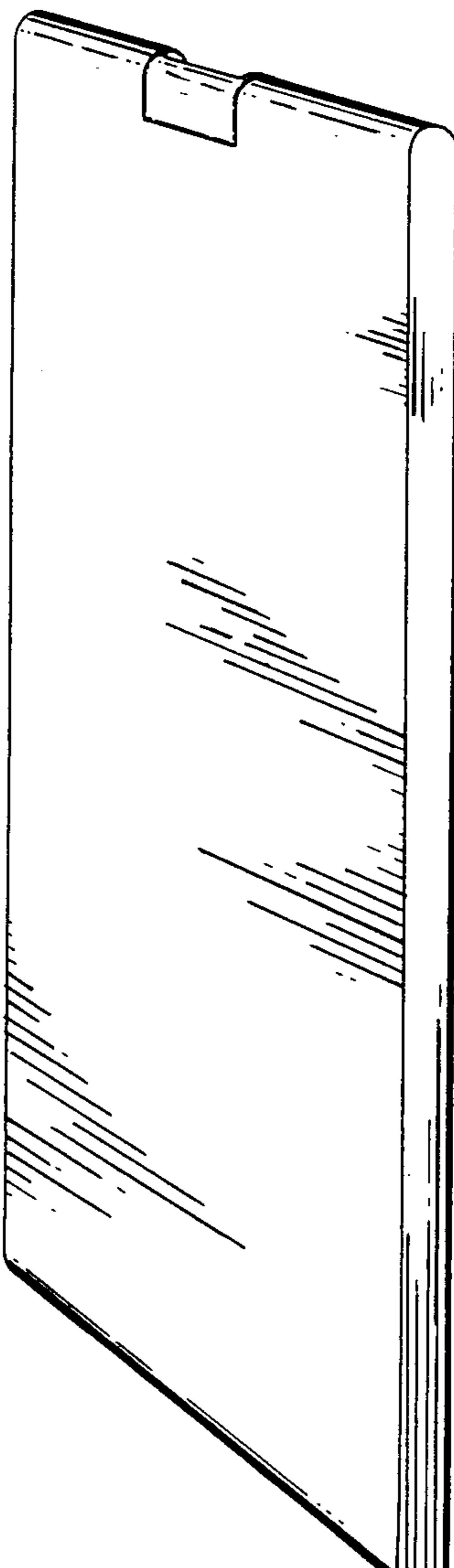

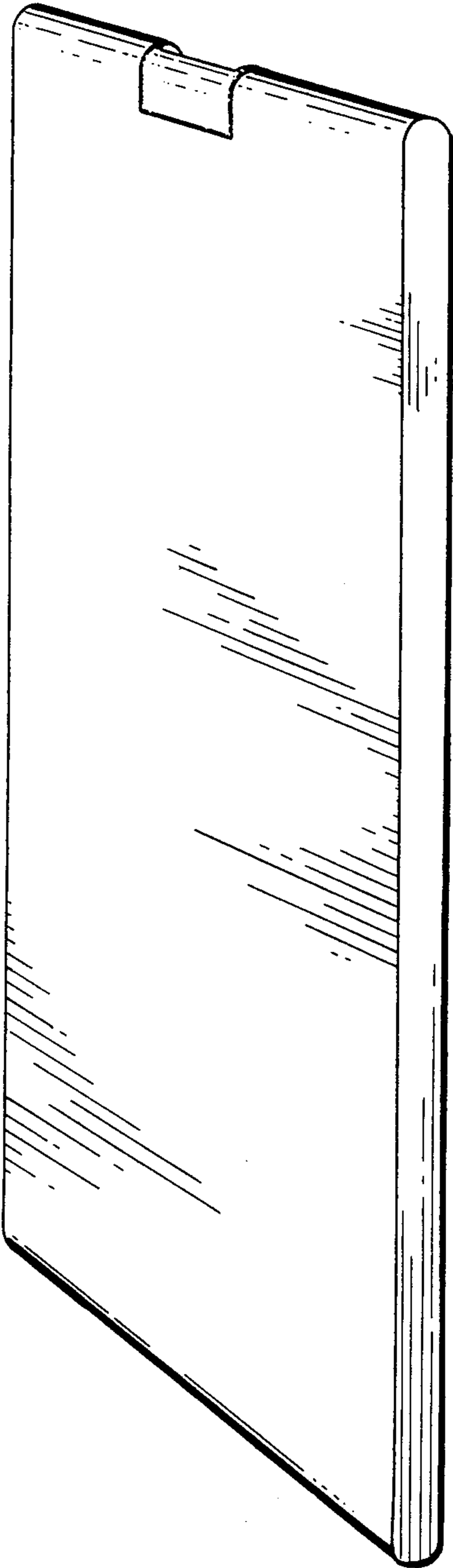

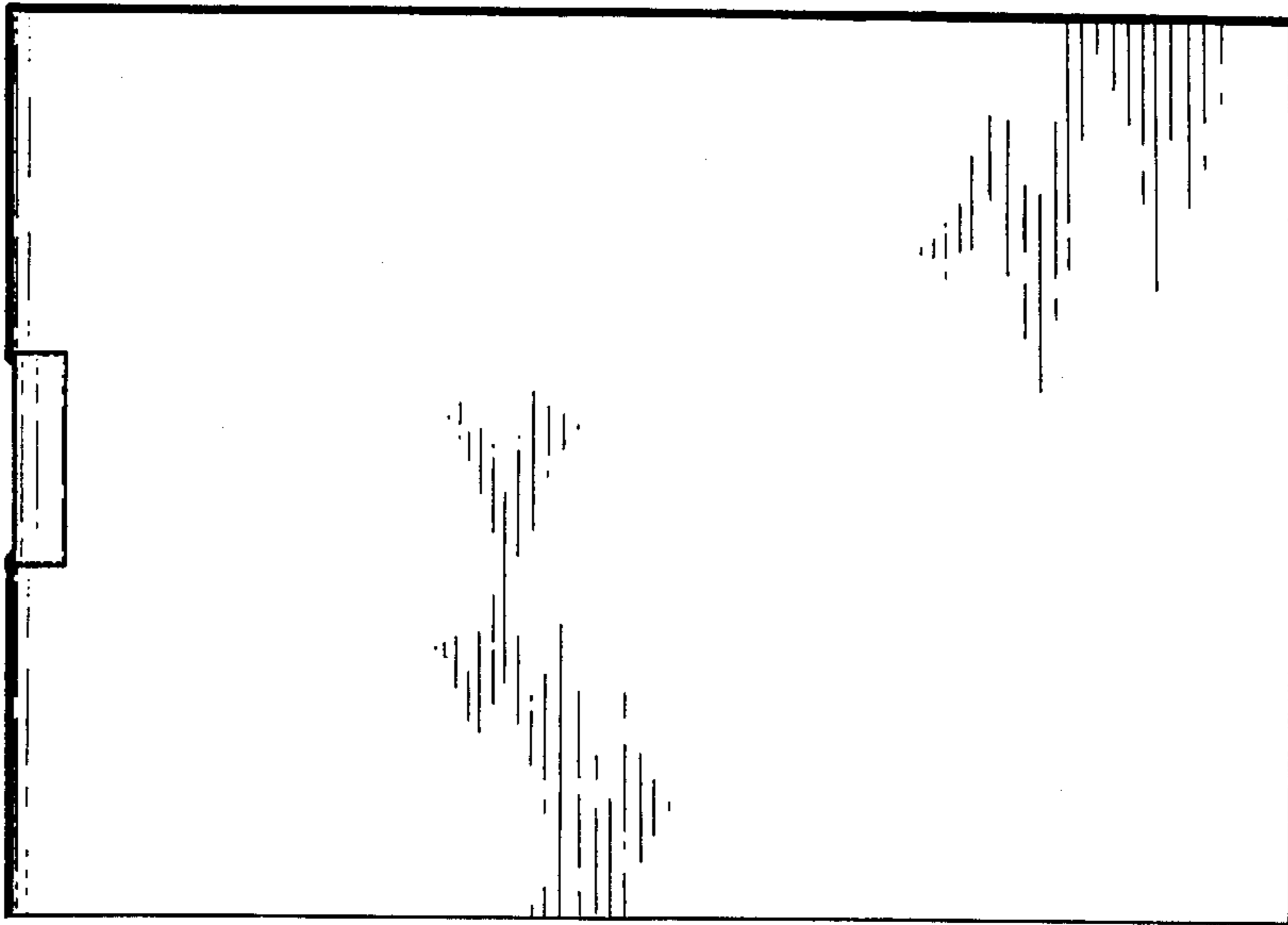
