FIG. 4 is a typical end elevational view thereof;

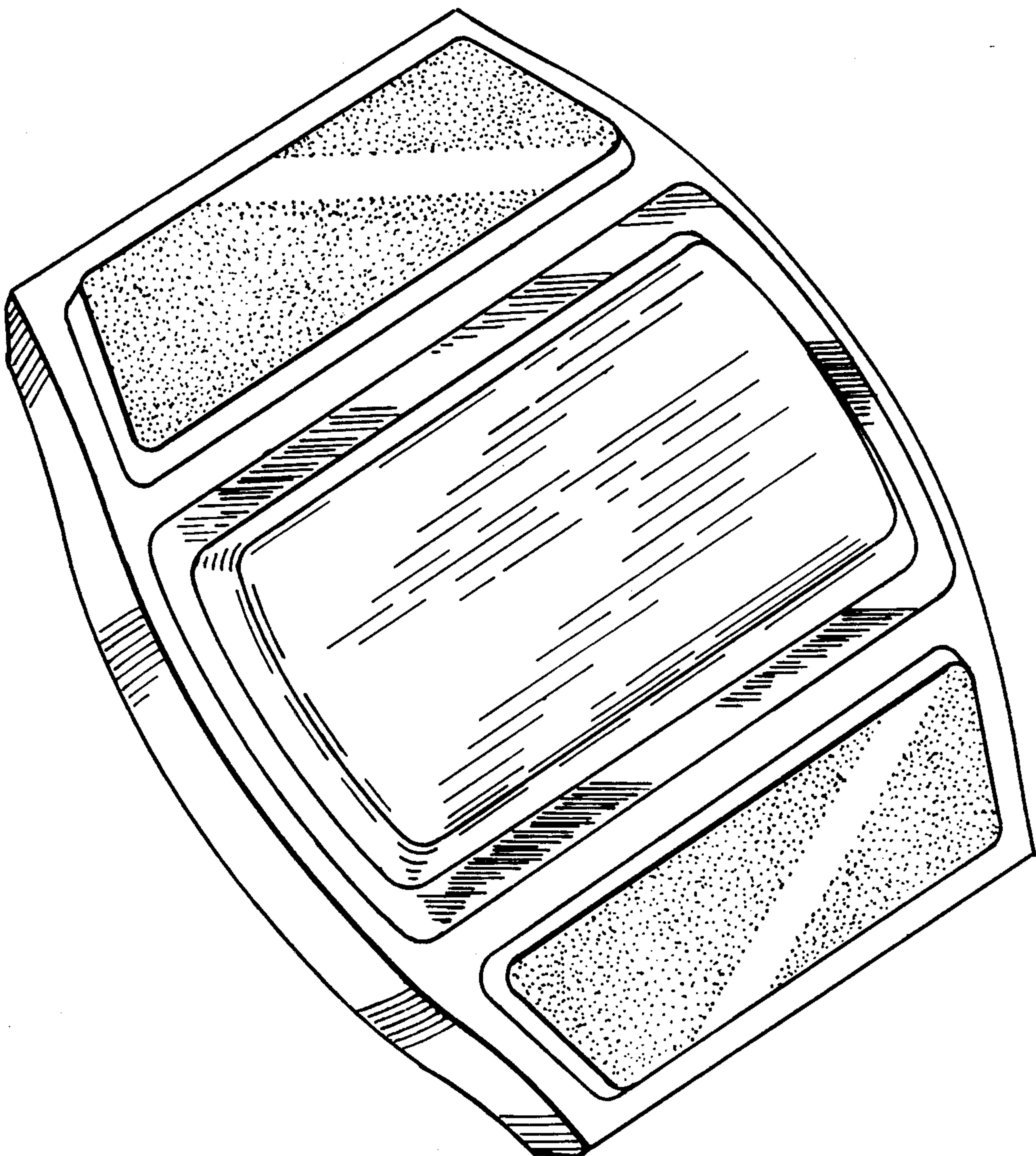
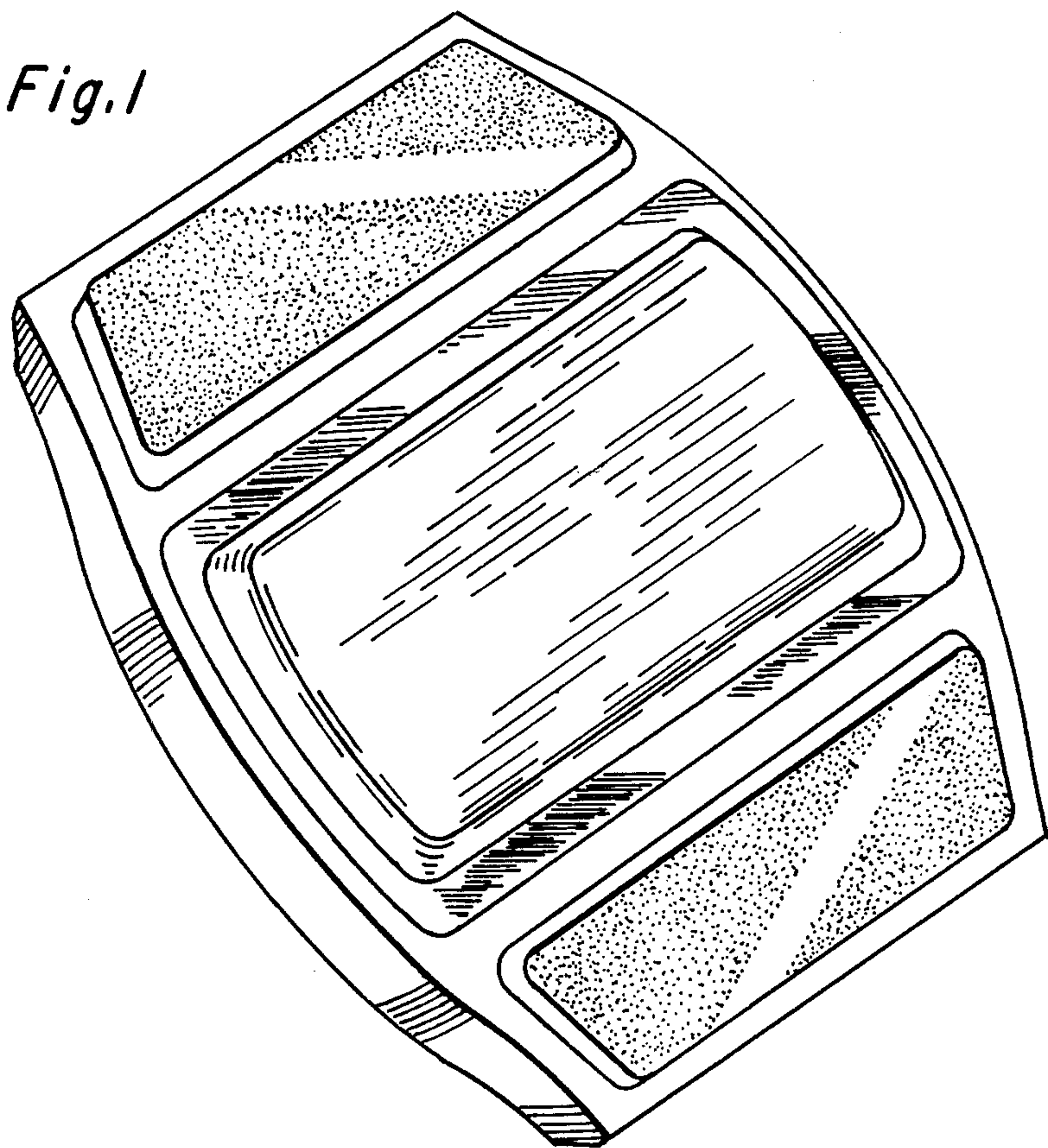

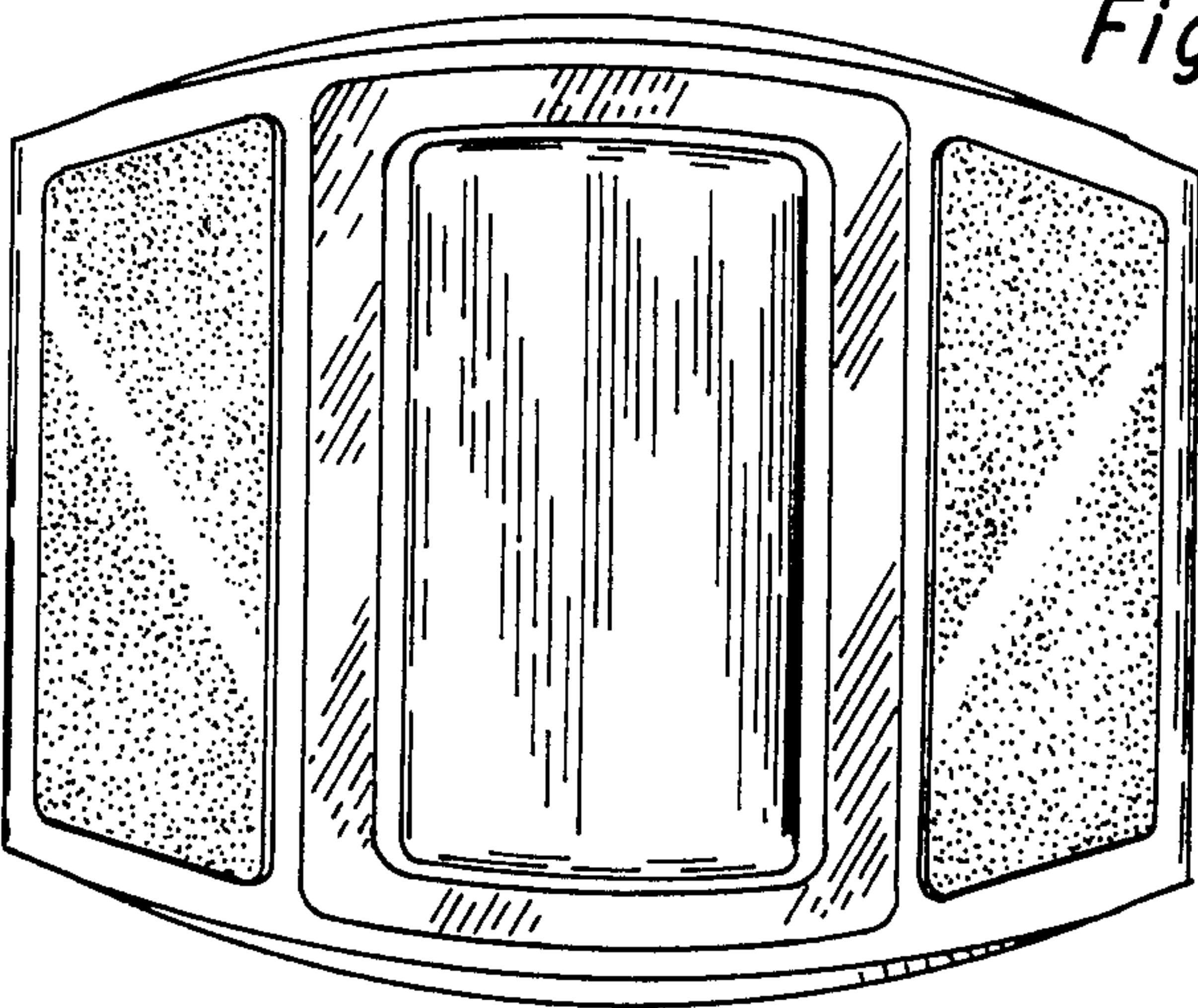

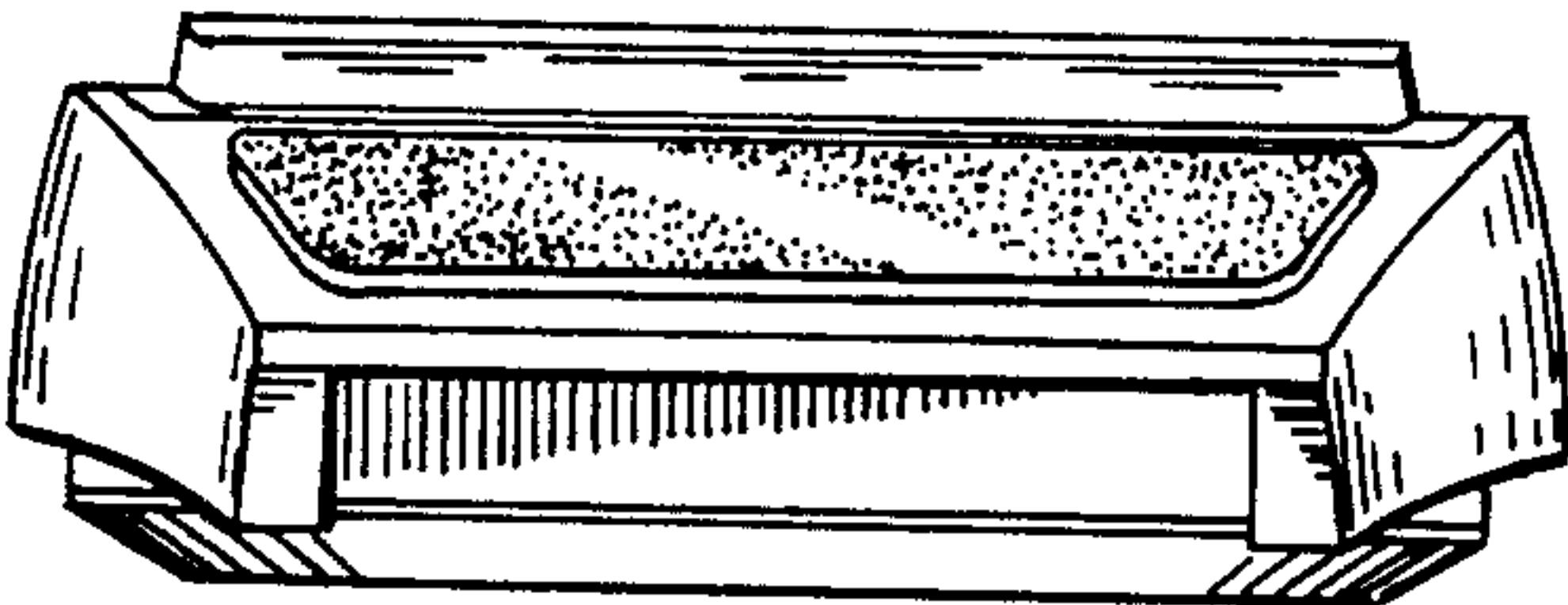
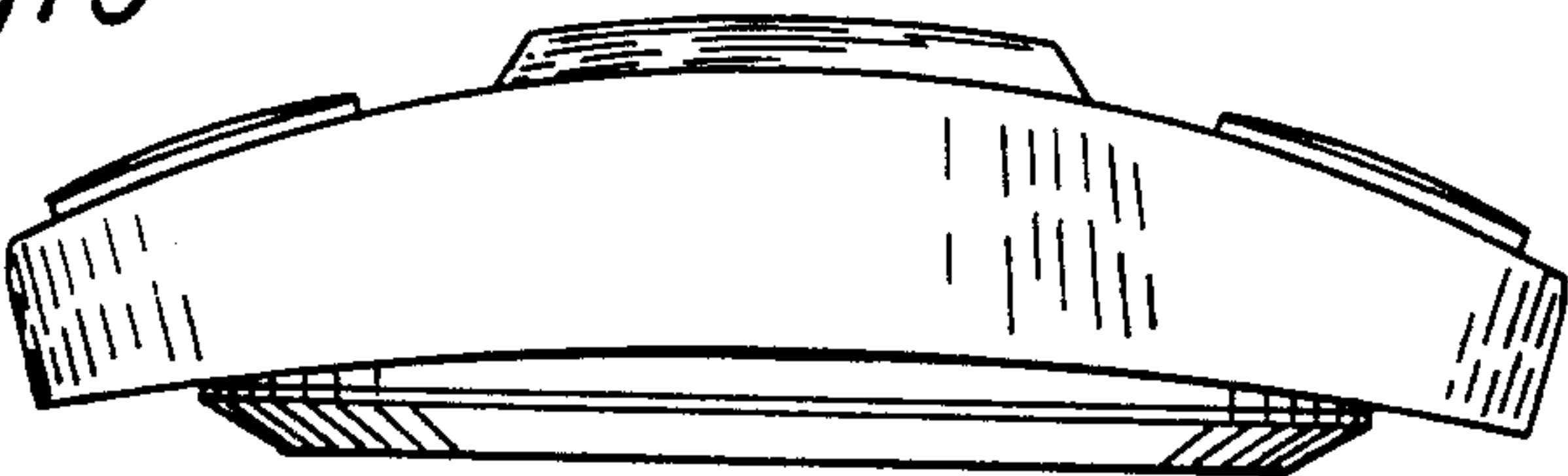
