[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wrist watch, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top right perspective view of a wrist watch showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being conventional;

FIG. 3 is a typical side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a typical end elevational view thereof;

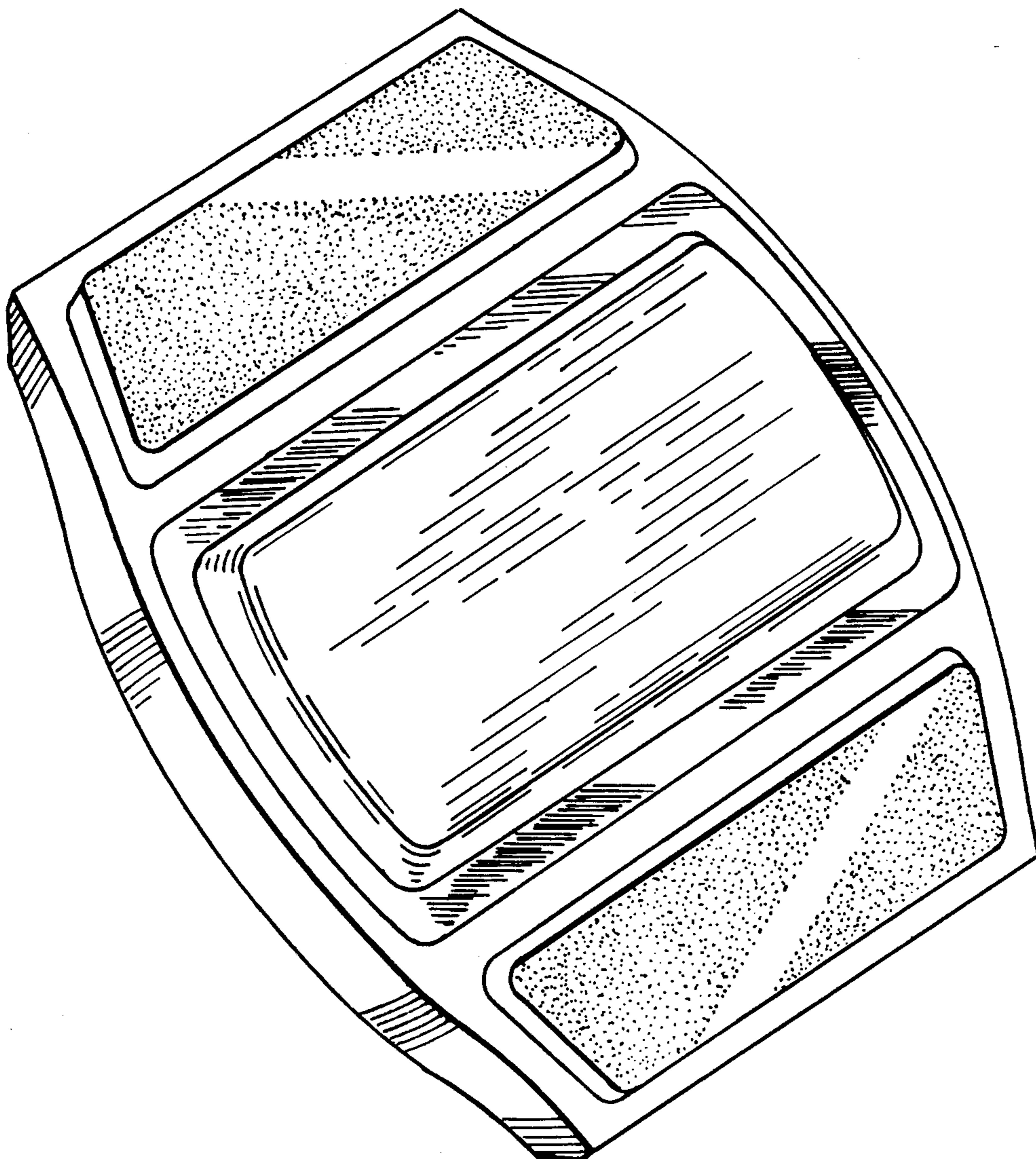
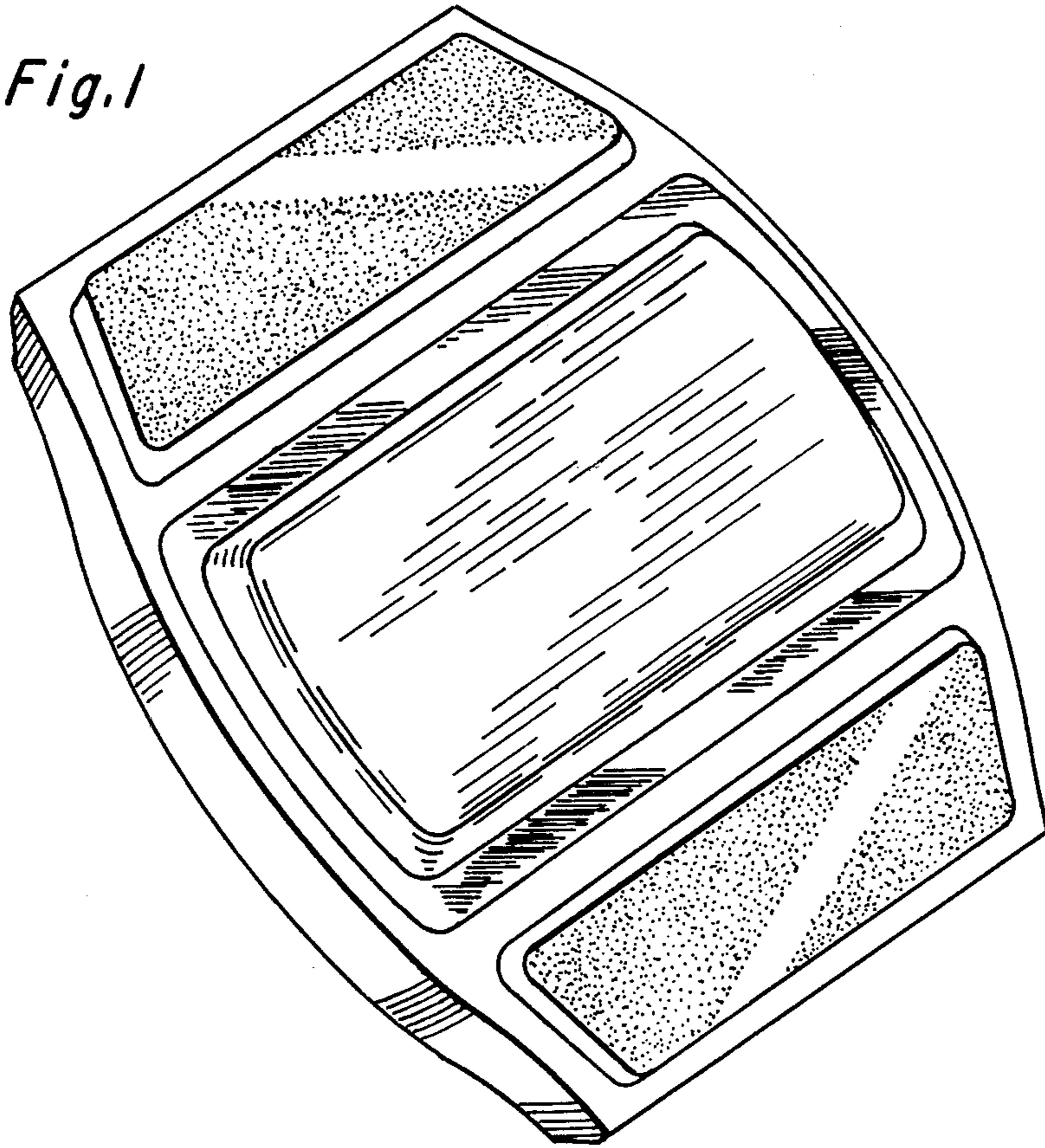

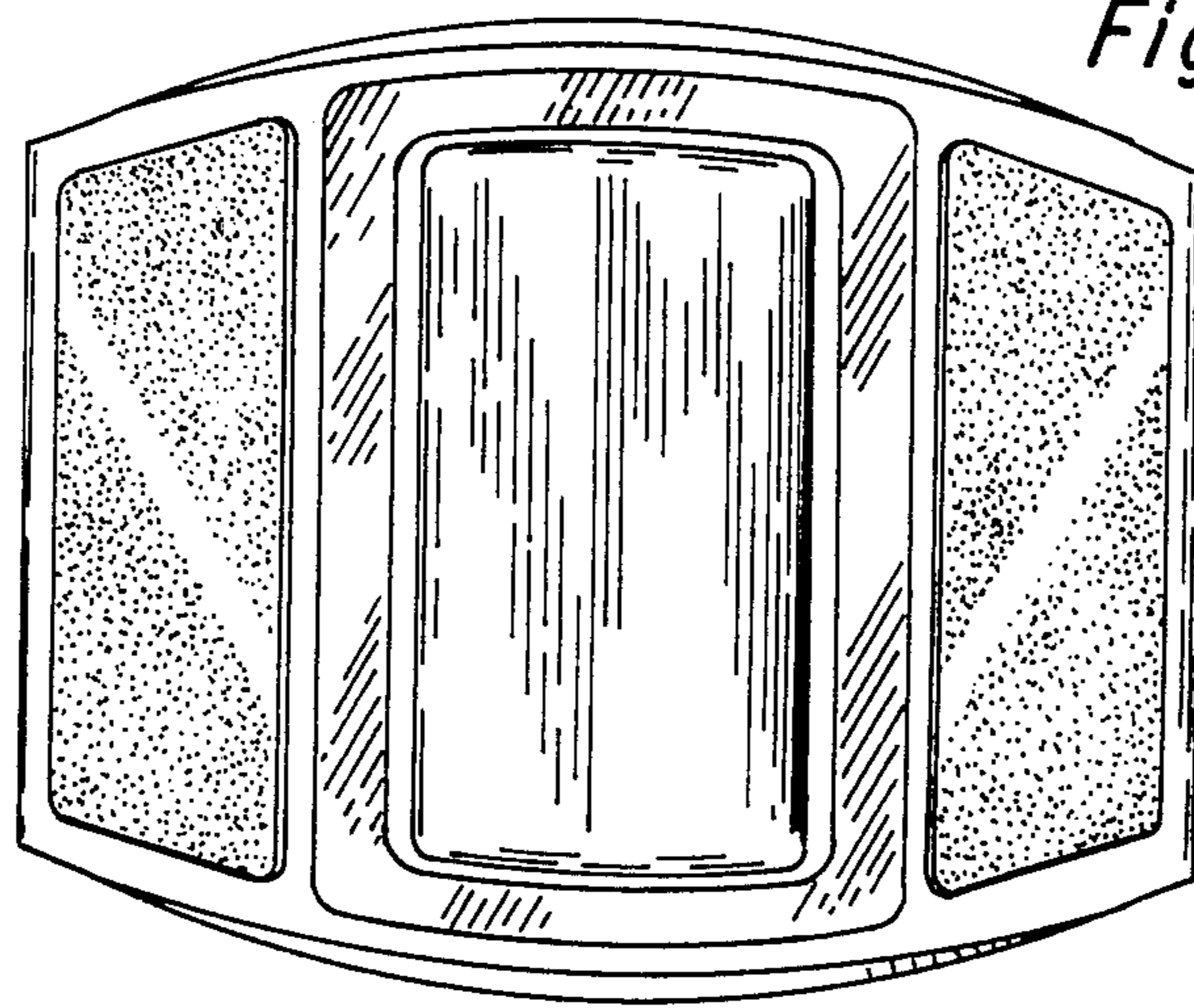

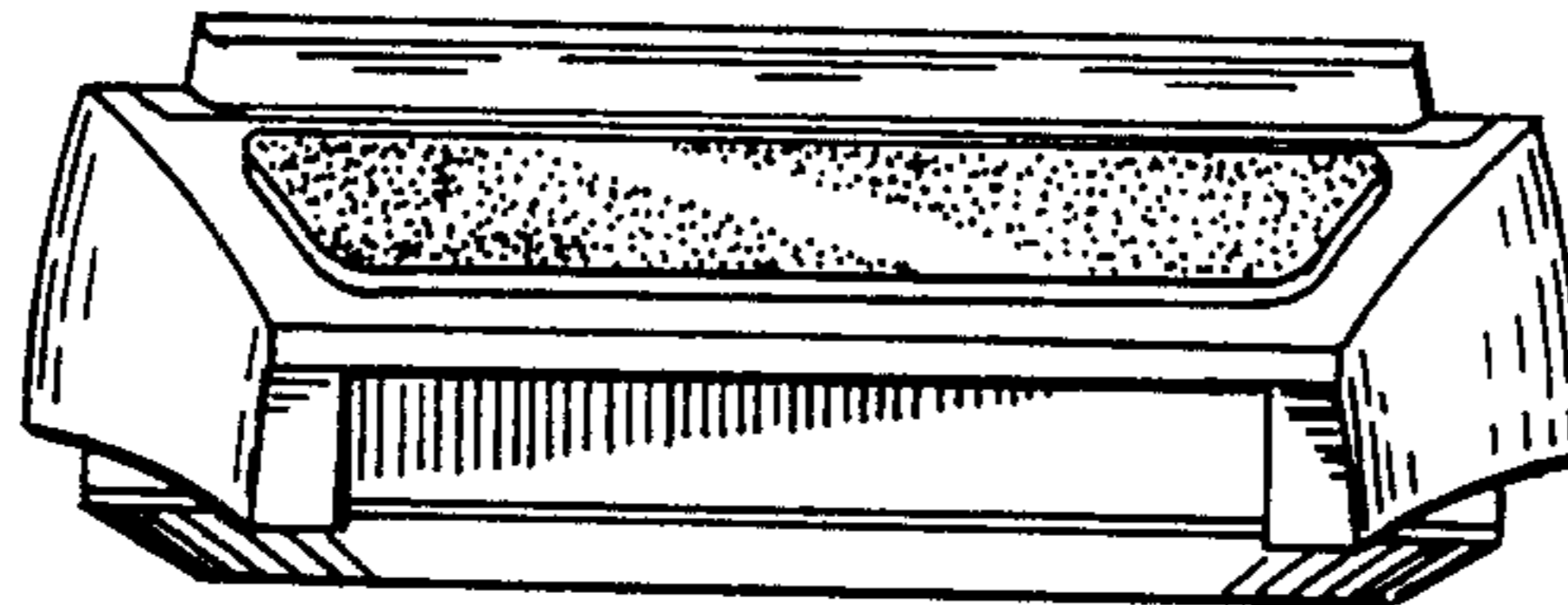
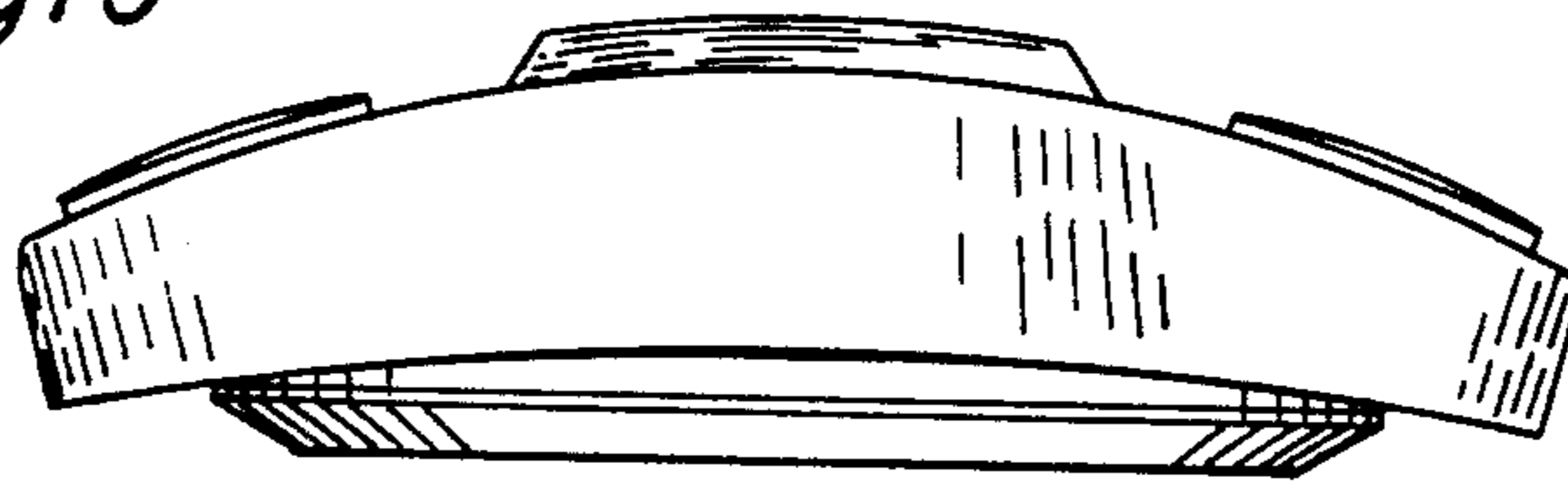
