[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an athletic shoe sole, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of an athletic shoe sole showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an inner side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an outer side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of another embodiment of my new design of FIGS. 1-5;

 FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof.

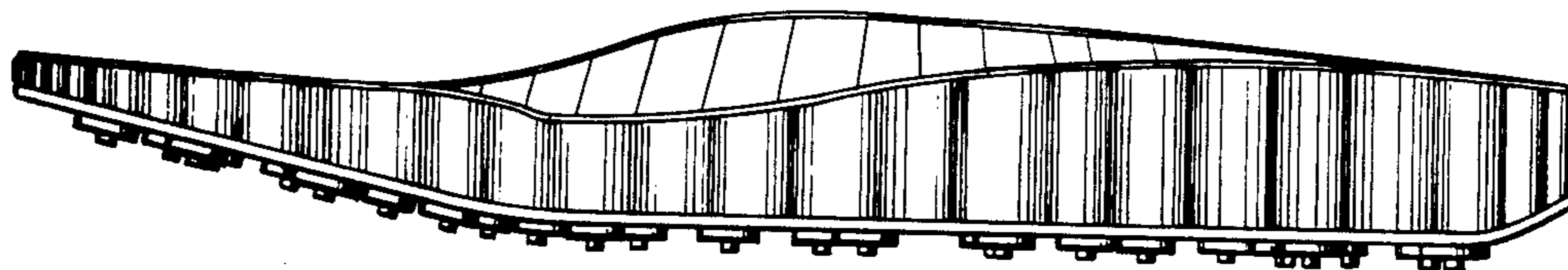

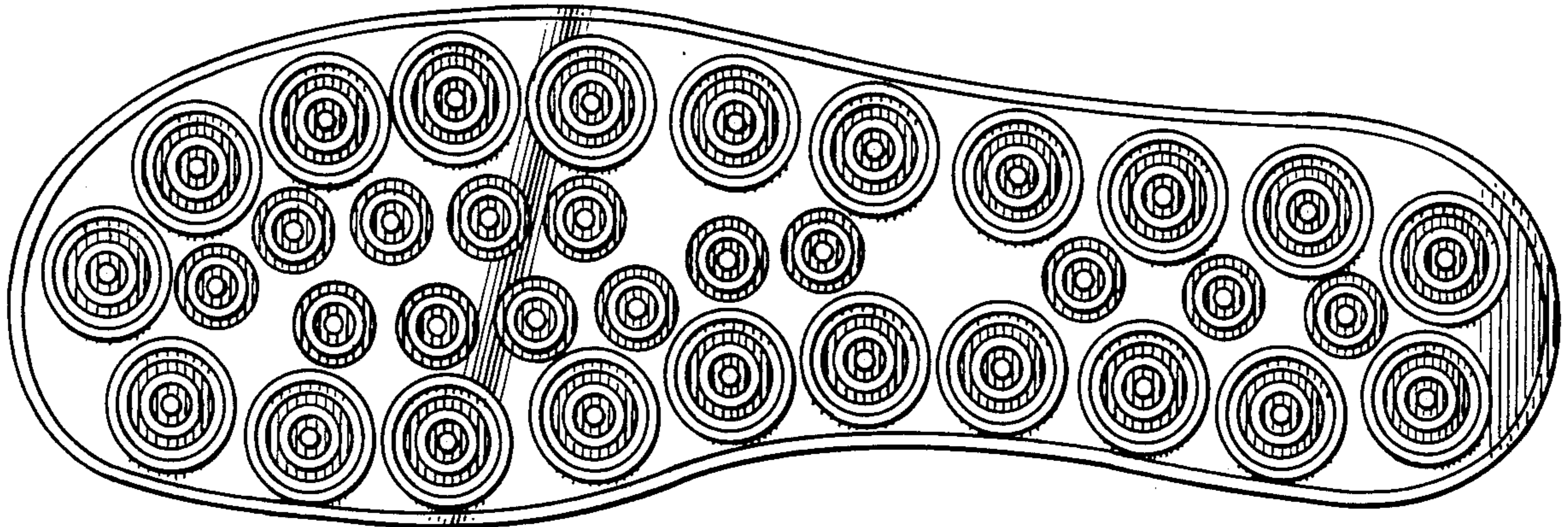

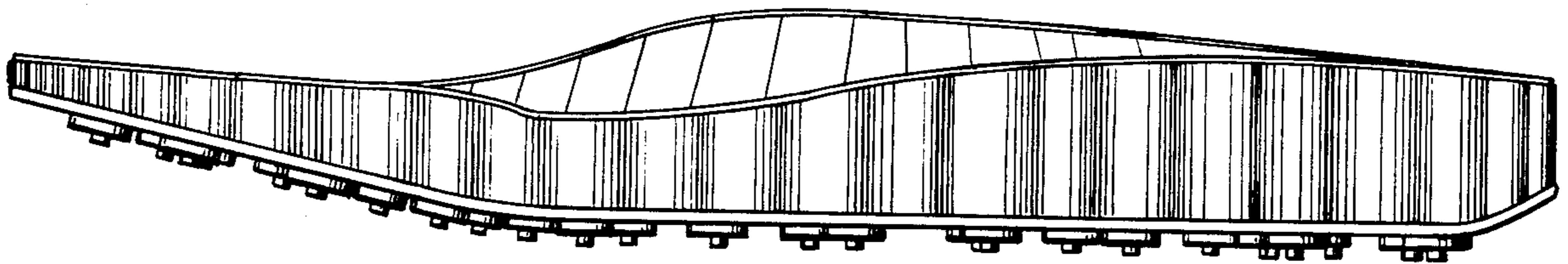

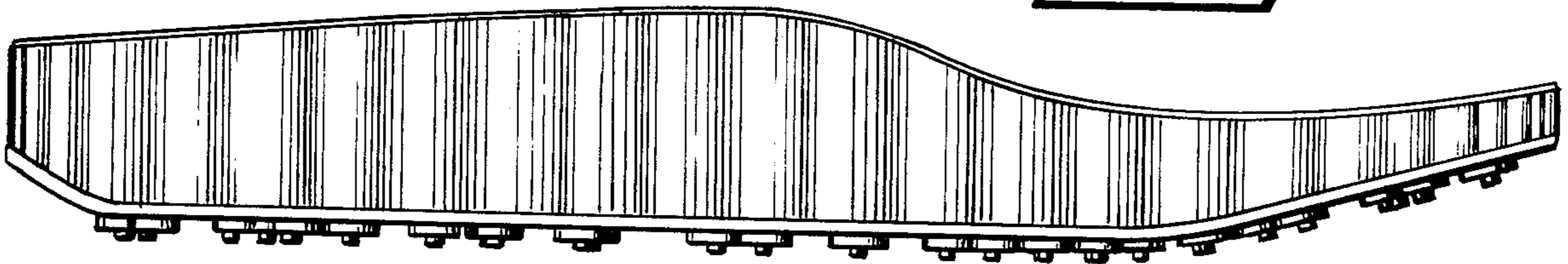

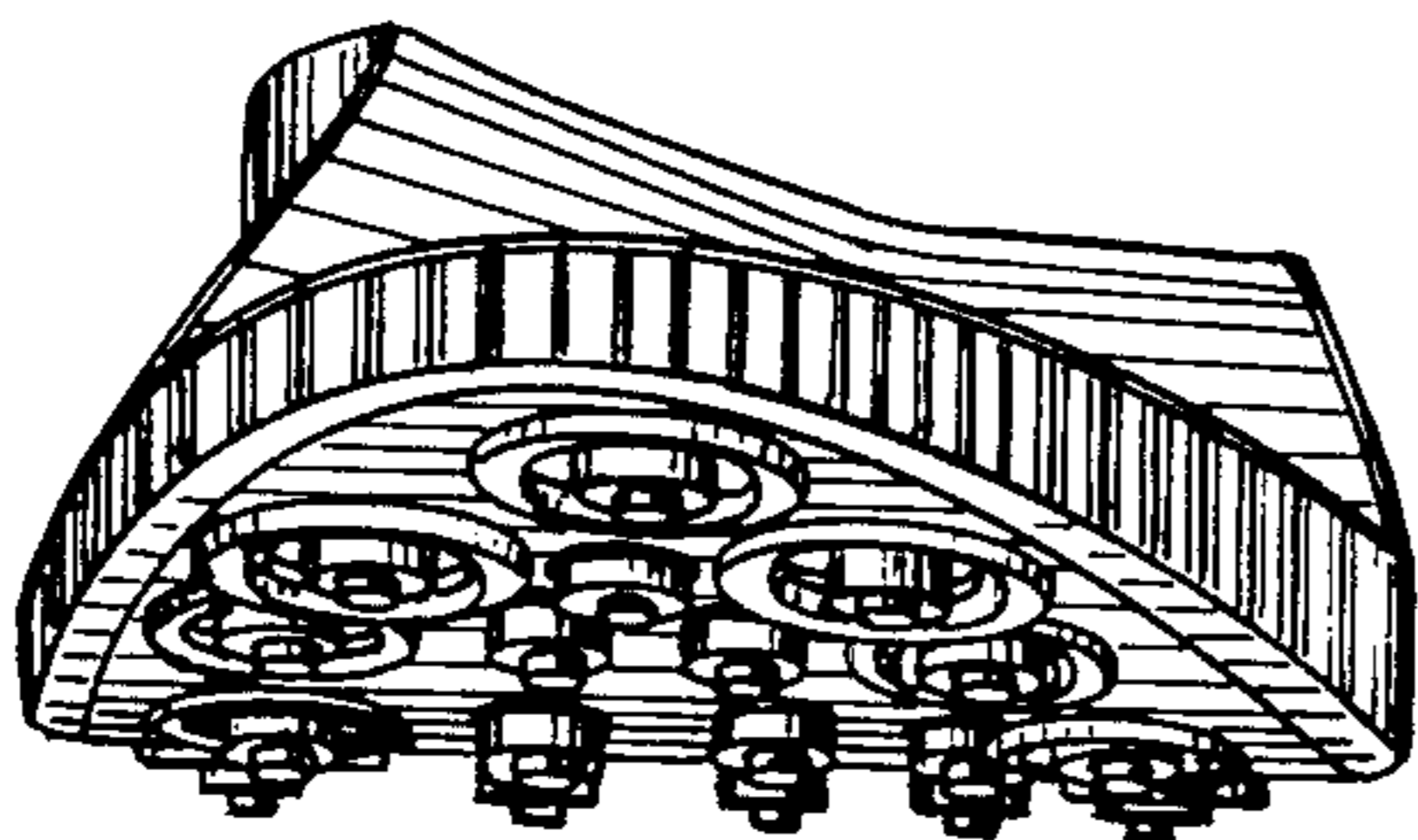

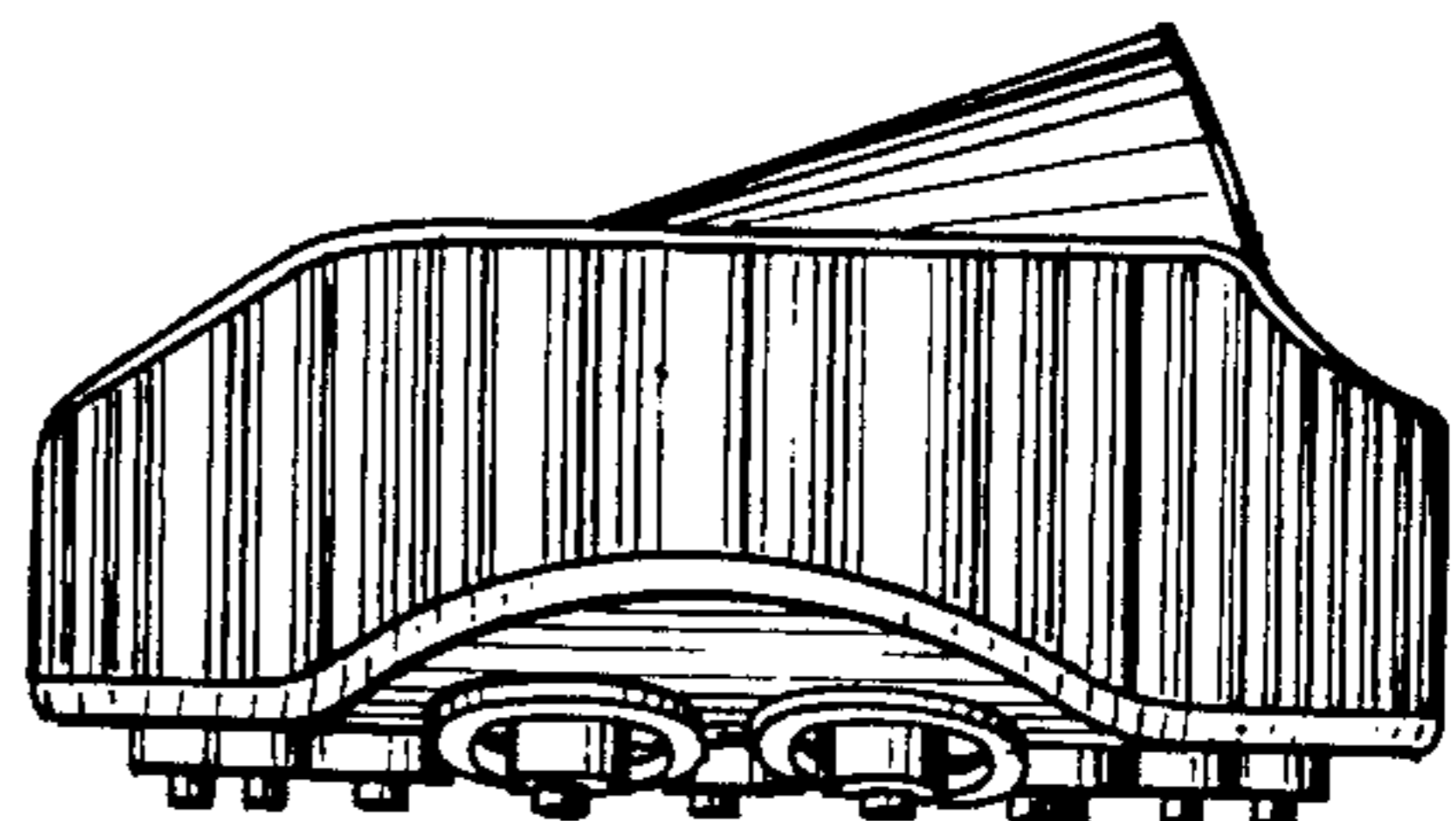

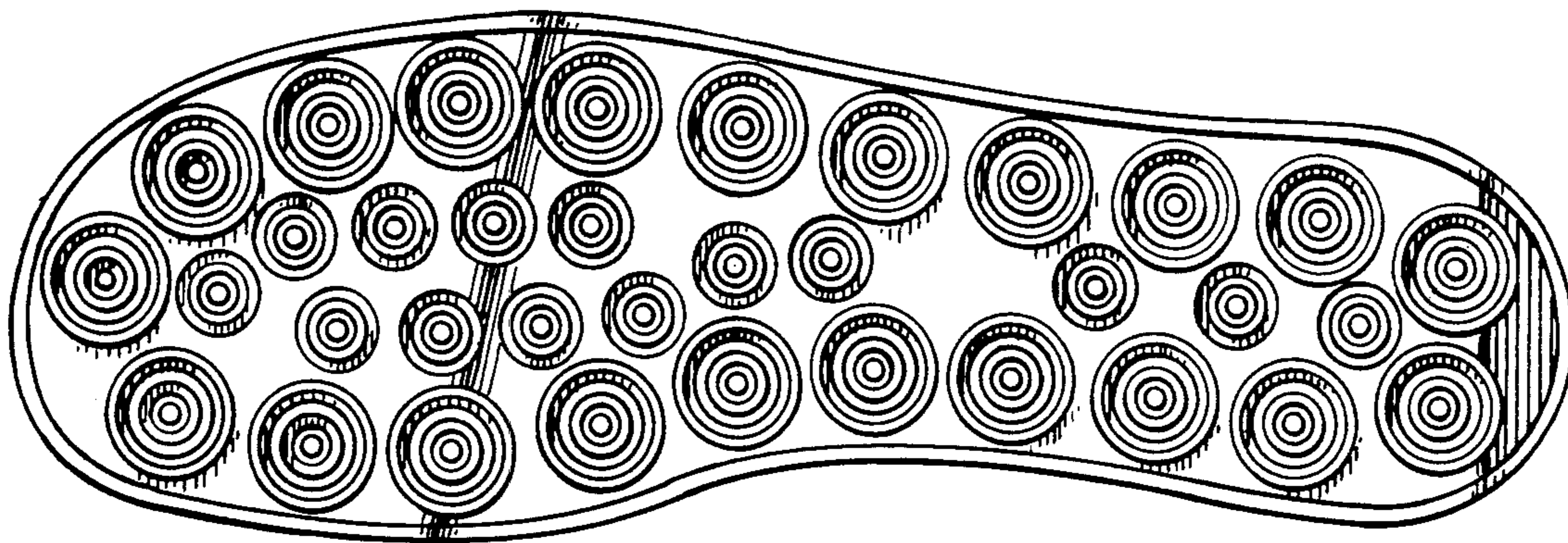

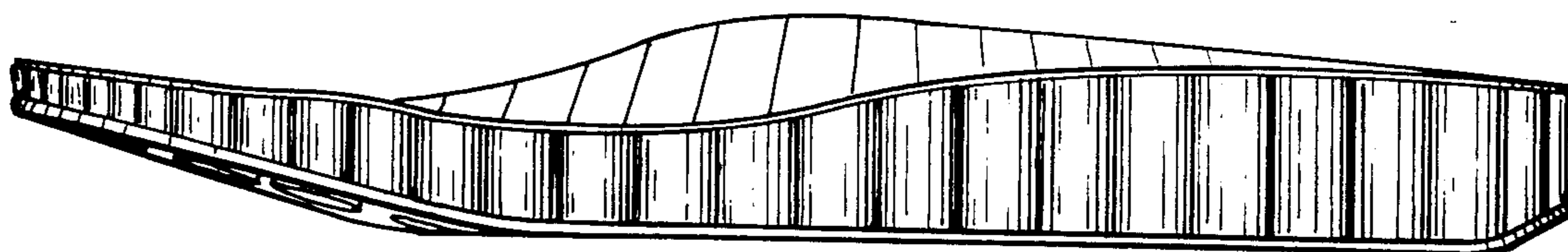

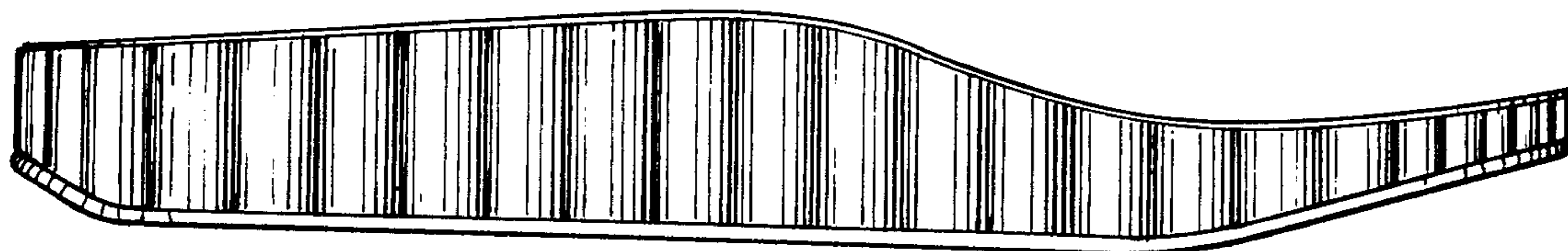

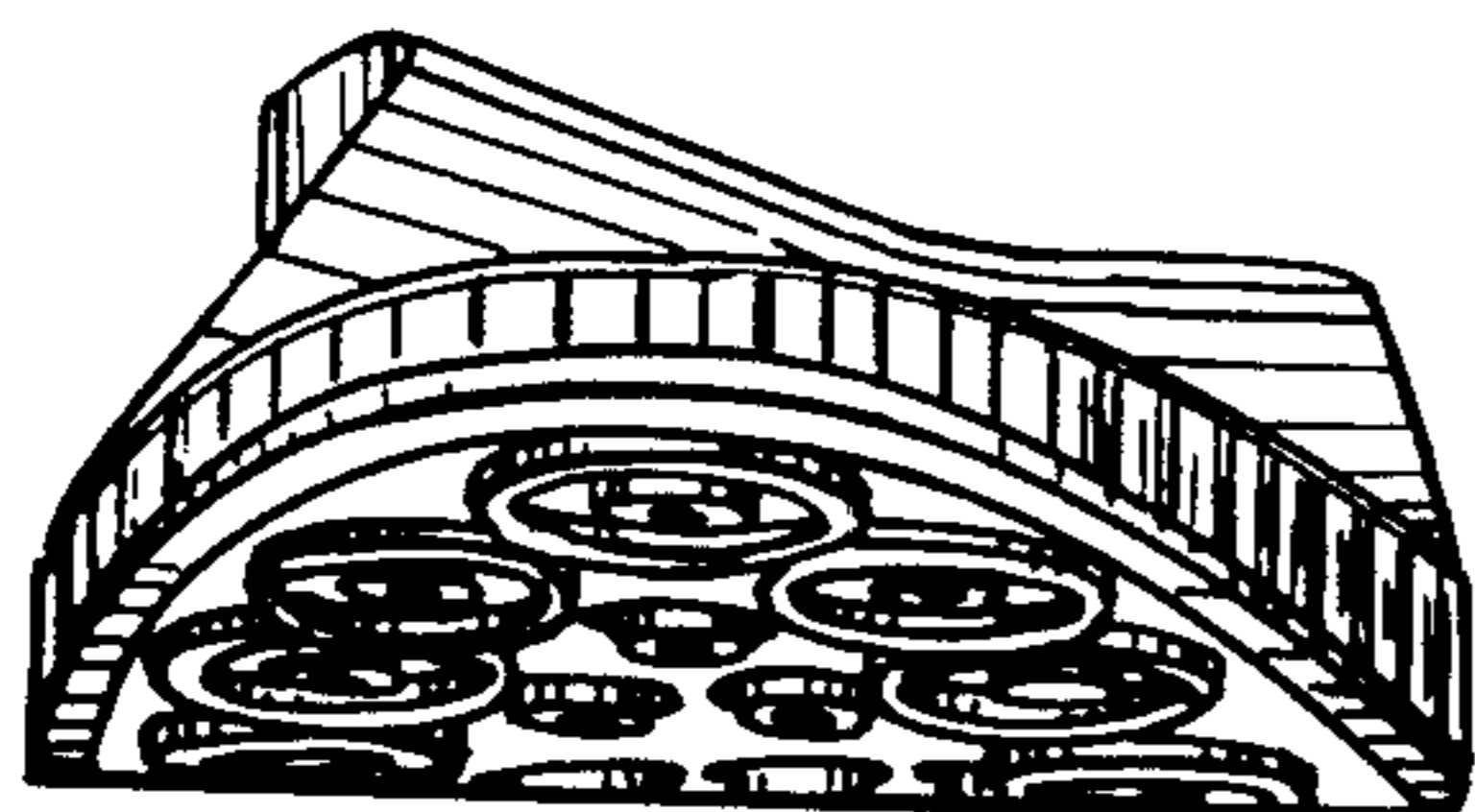
