The ornamental design for a roll bar for retractable awnings, as shown.

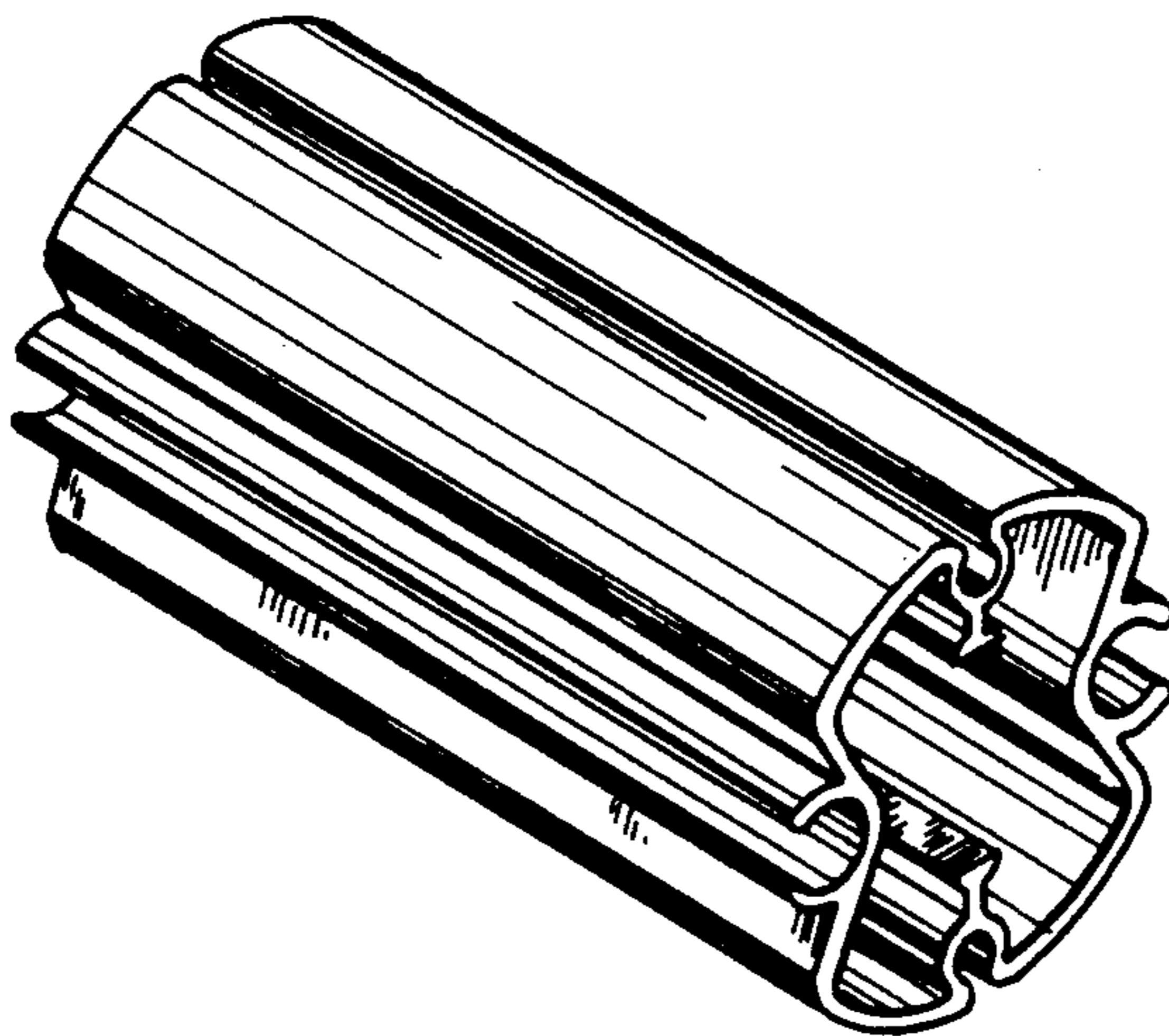
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is an enlarged top plan view of the roll bar.



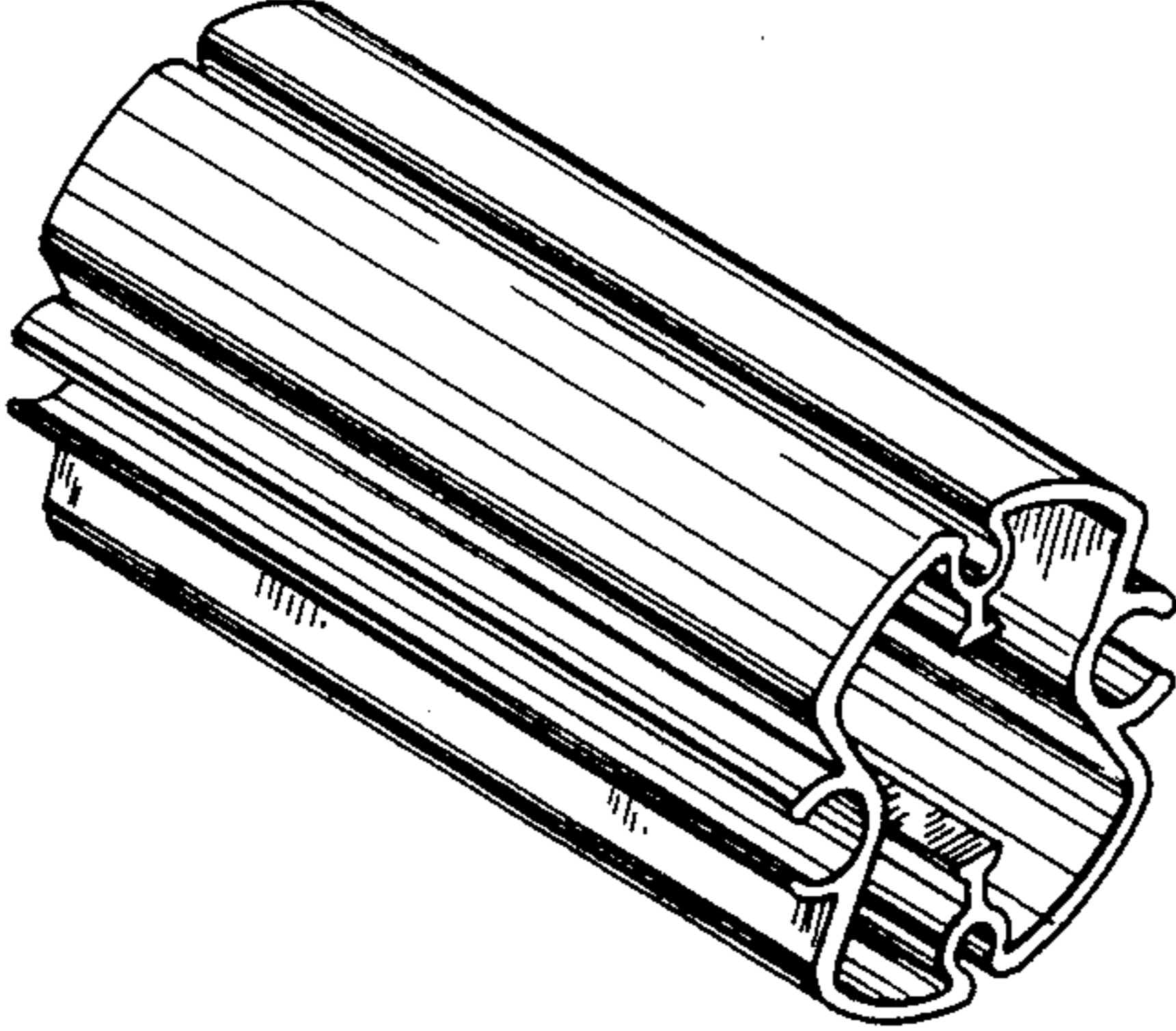

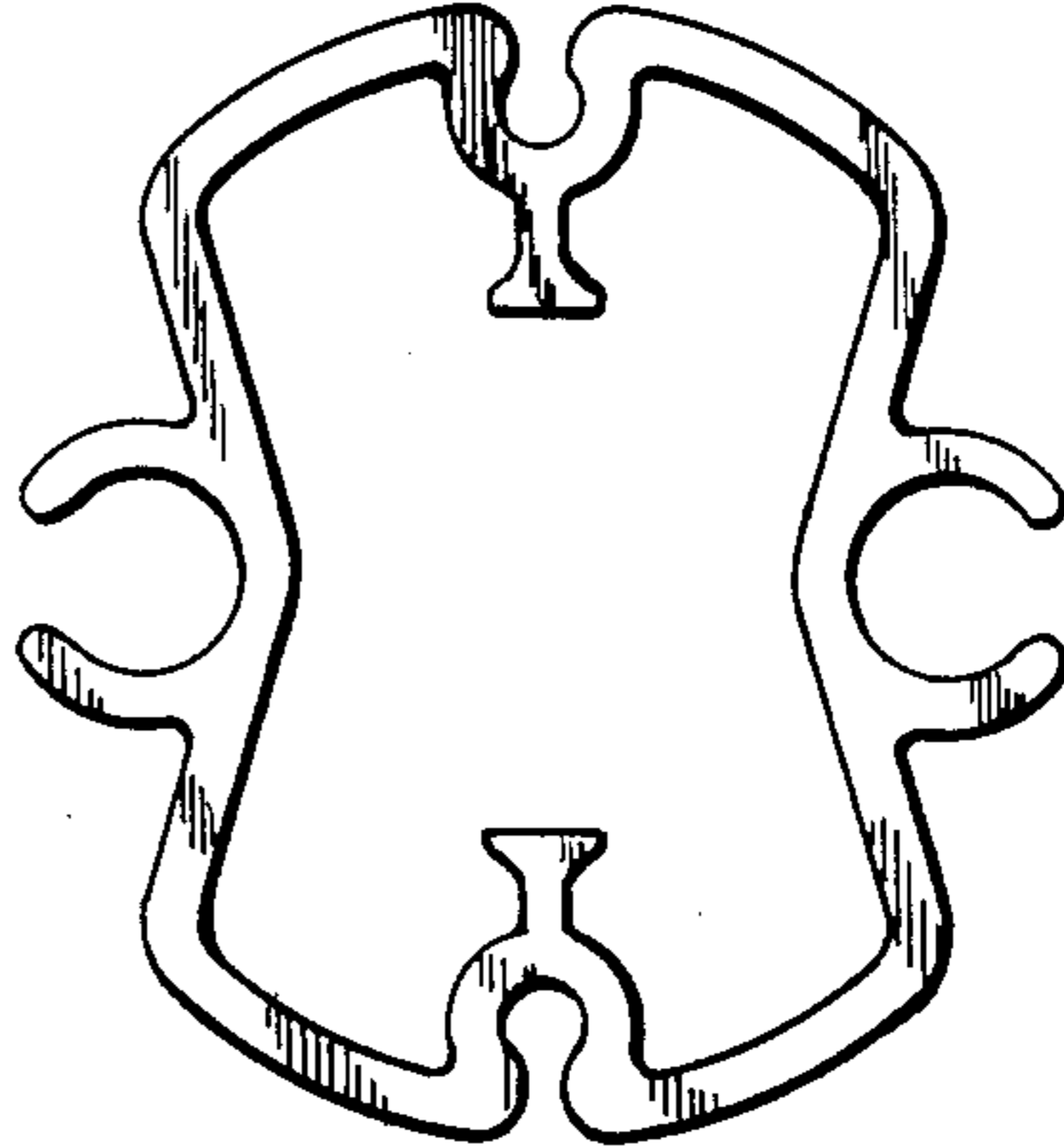

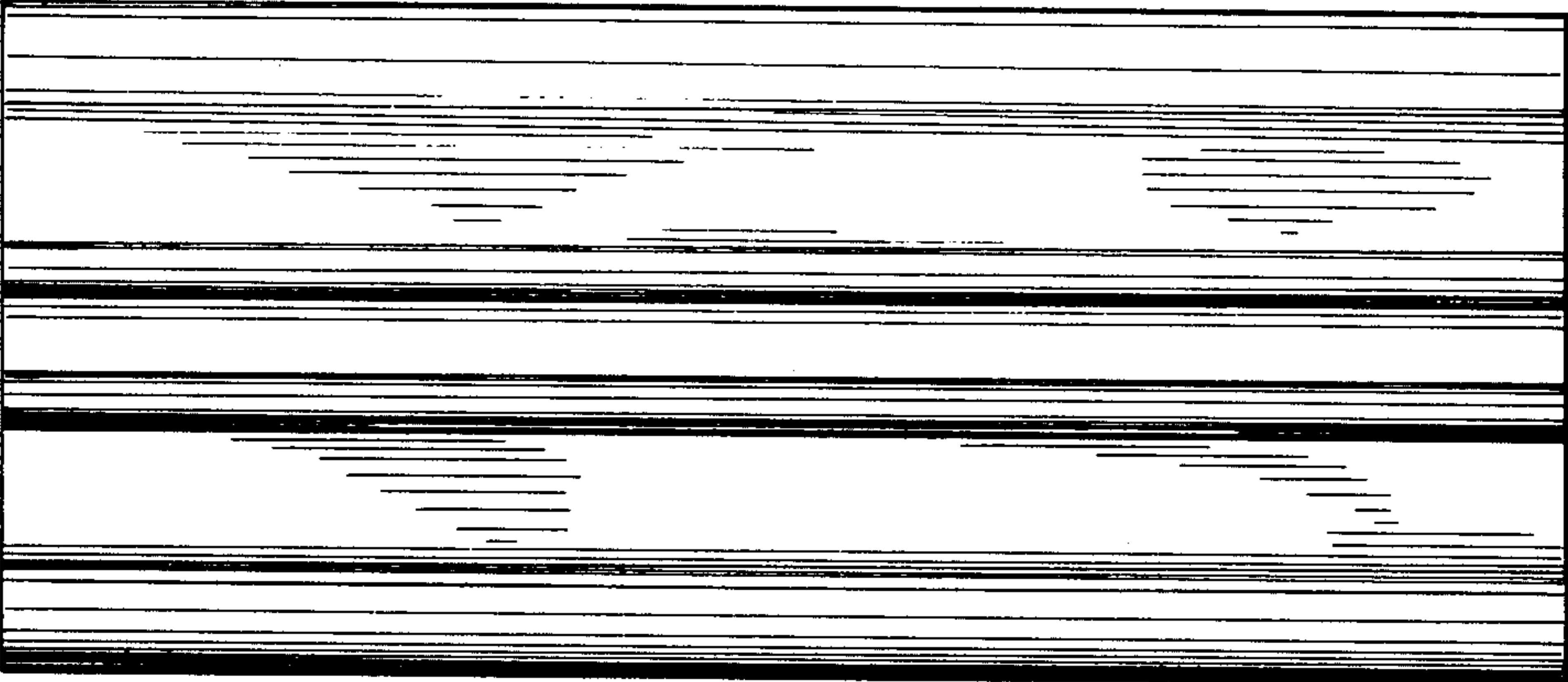

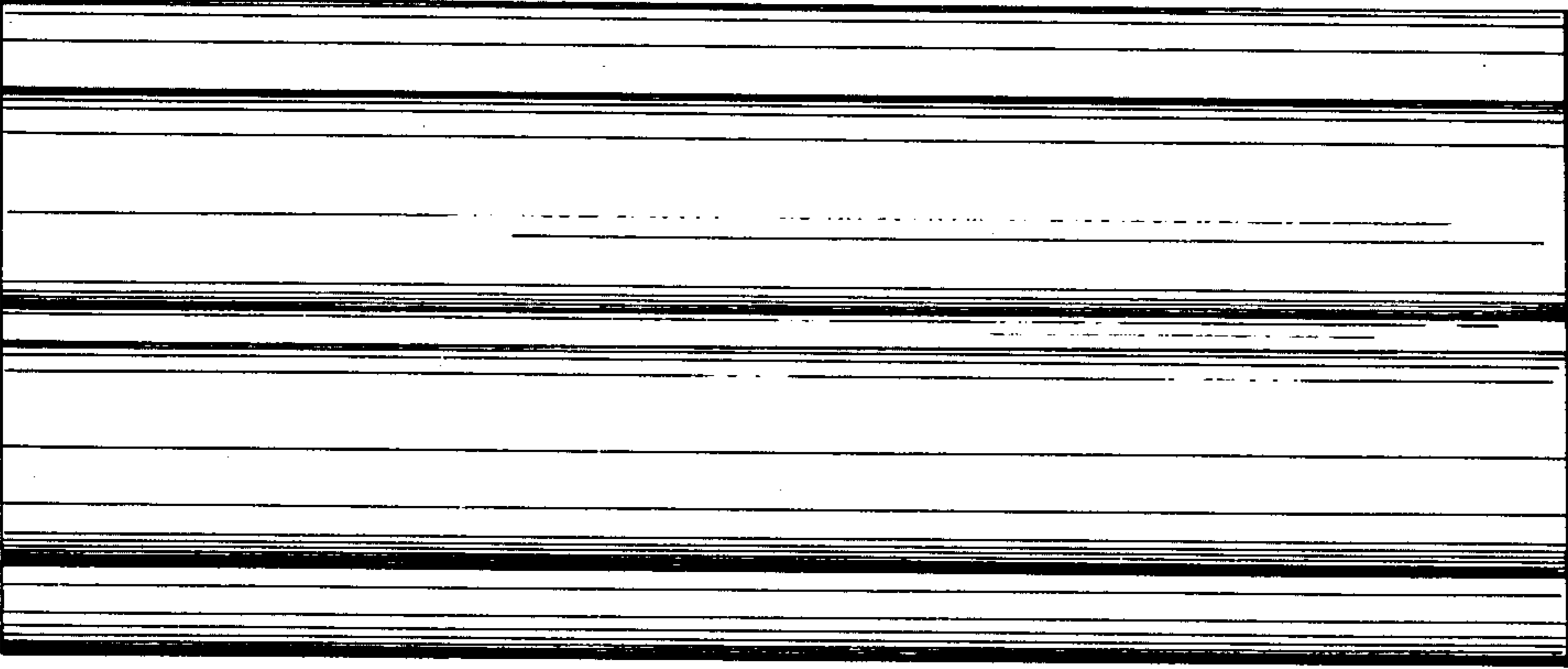
