The ornamental design for a combined bicycle seat and tank, substantially as shown.


#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a combined bicycle seat and tank showing my new design;


FIG. 2 is a top plan view;


FIG. 3 is a front elevational view; and


