[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a peanut-shaped fishing lure, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view illustrating my new design for a peanut-shaped fishing lure;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view of the aforesaid peanut-shaped fishing lure;
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevation view of the aforesaid peanut-shaped fishing lure;
FIG. 4 is a top view of the aforesaid peanut-shaped fishing lure;
FIG. 5 is a back elevation view of the aforesaid peanut-shaped fishing lure; and
FIG. 6 is a front elevation view of the aforesaid peanut-shaped fishing lure.

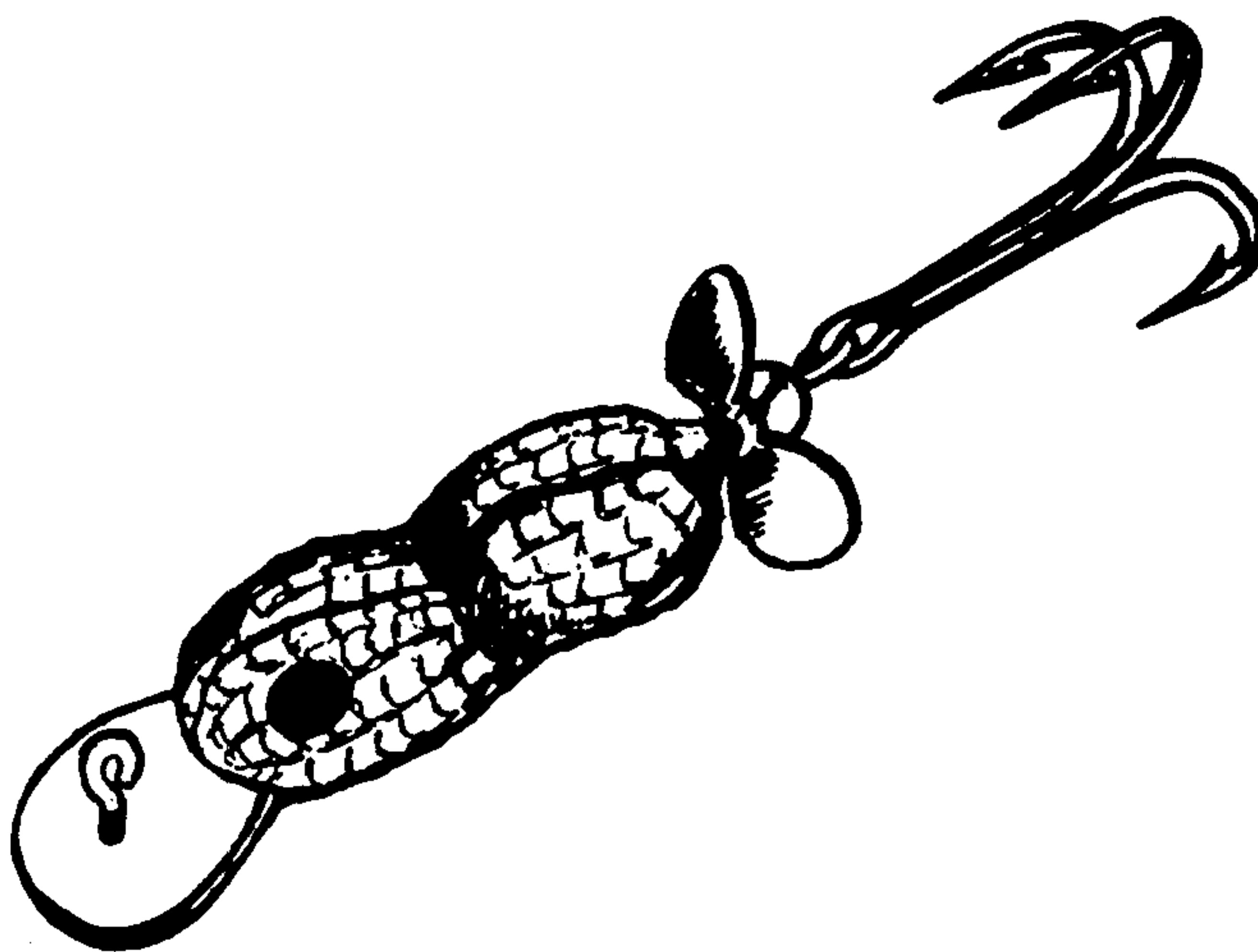

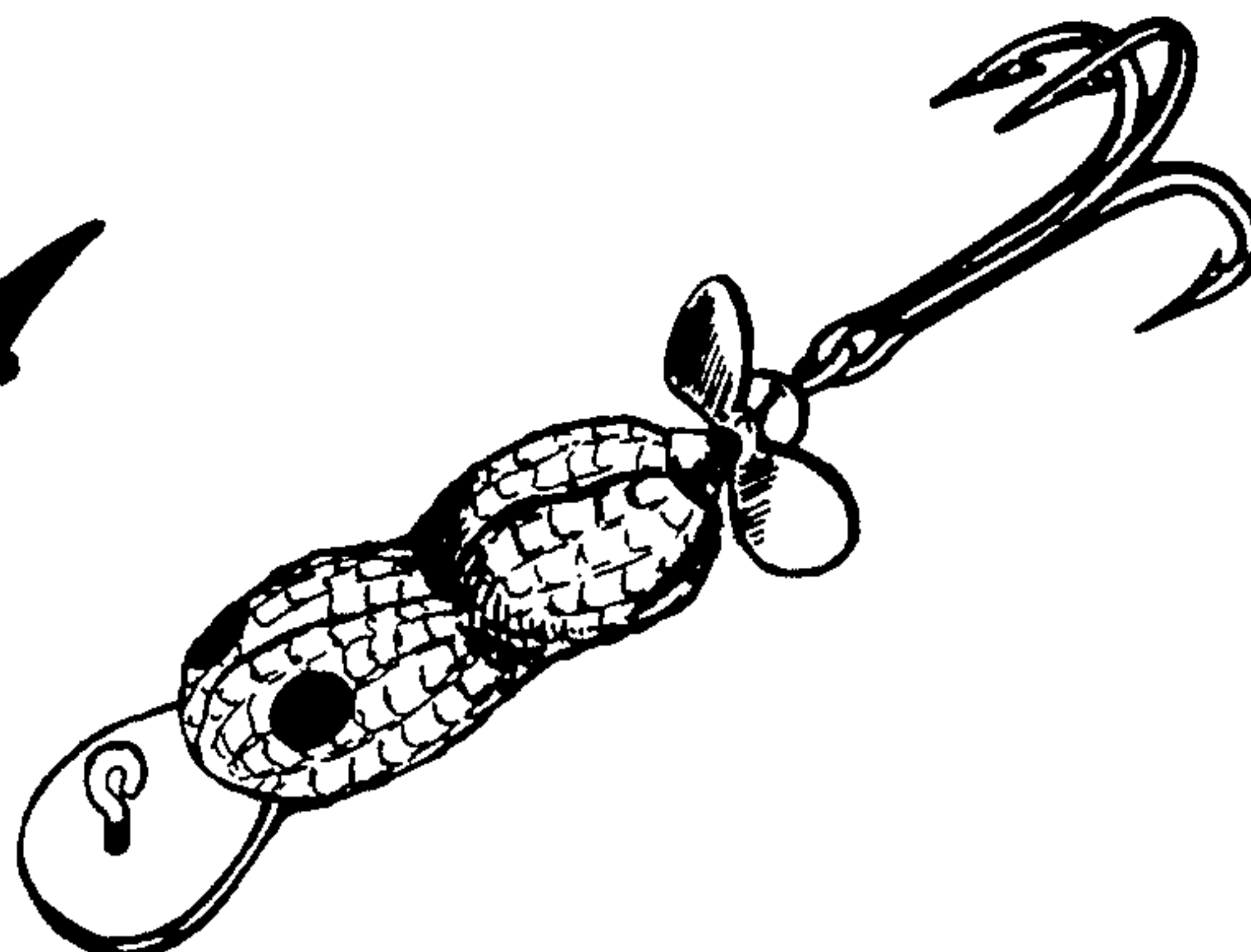

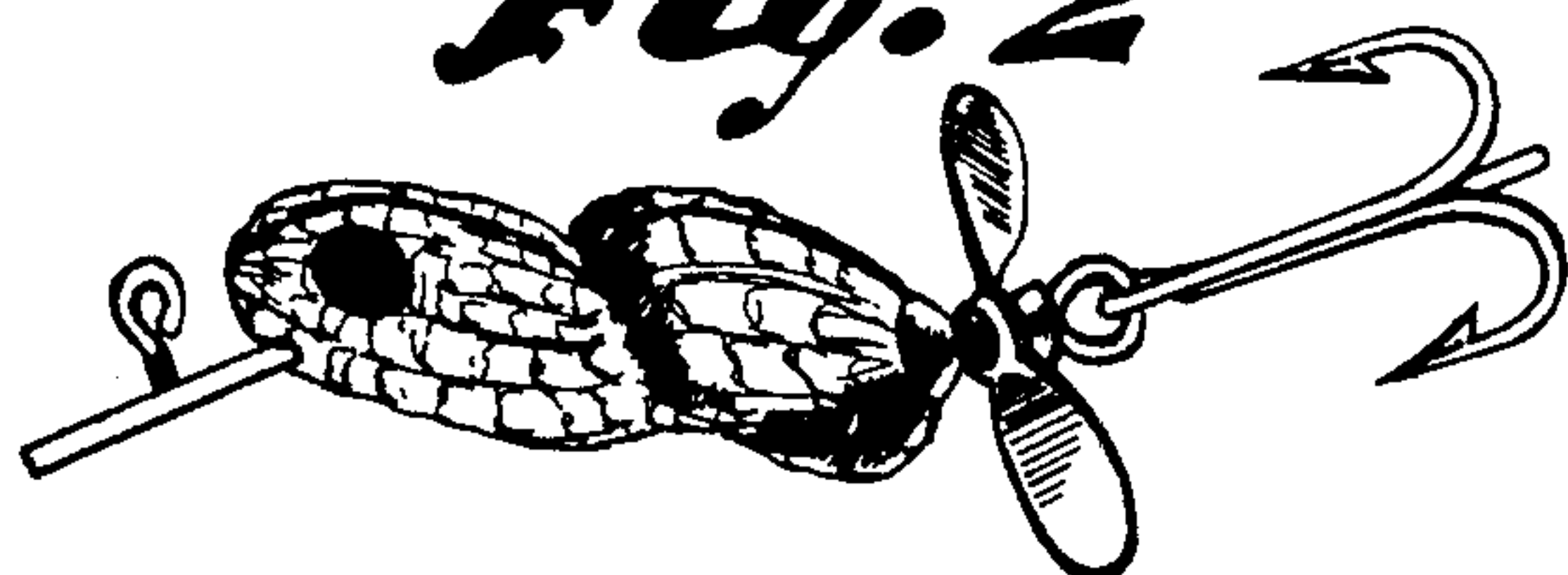

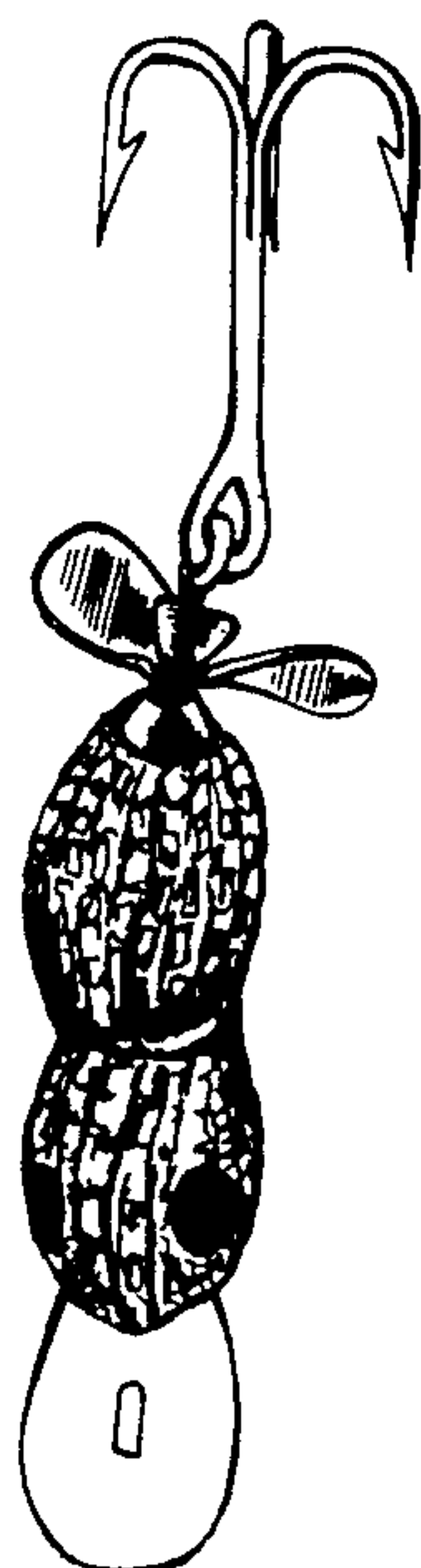

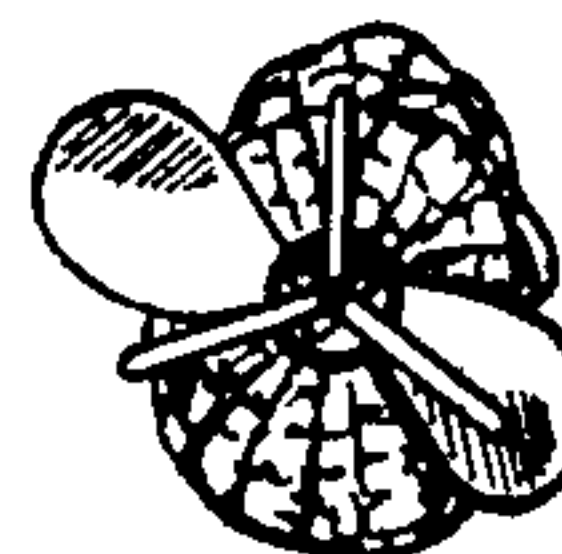
