FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof;

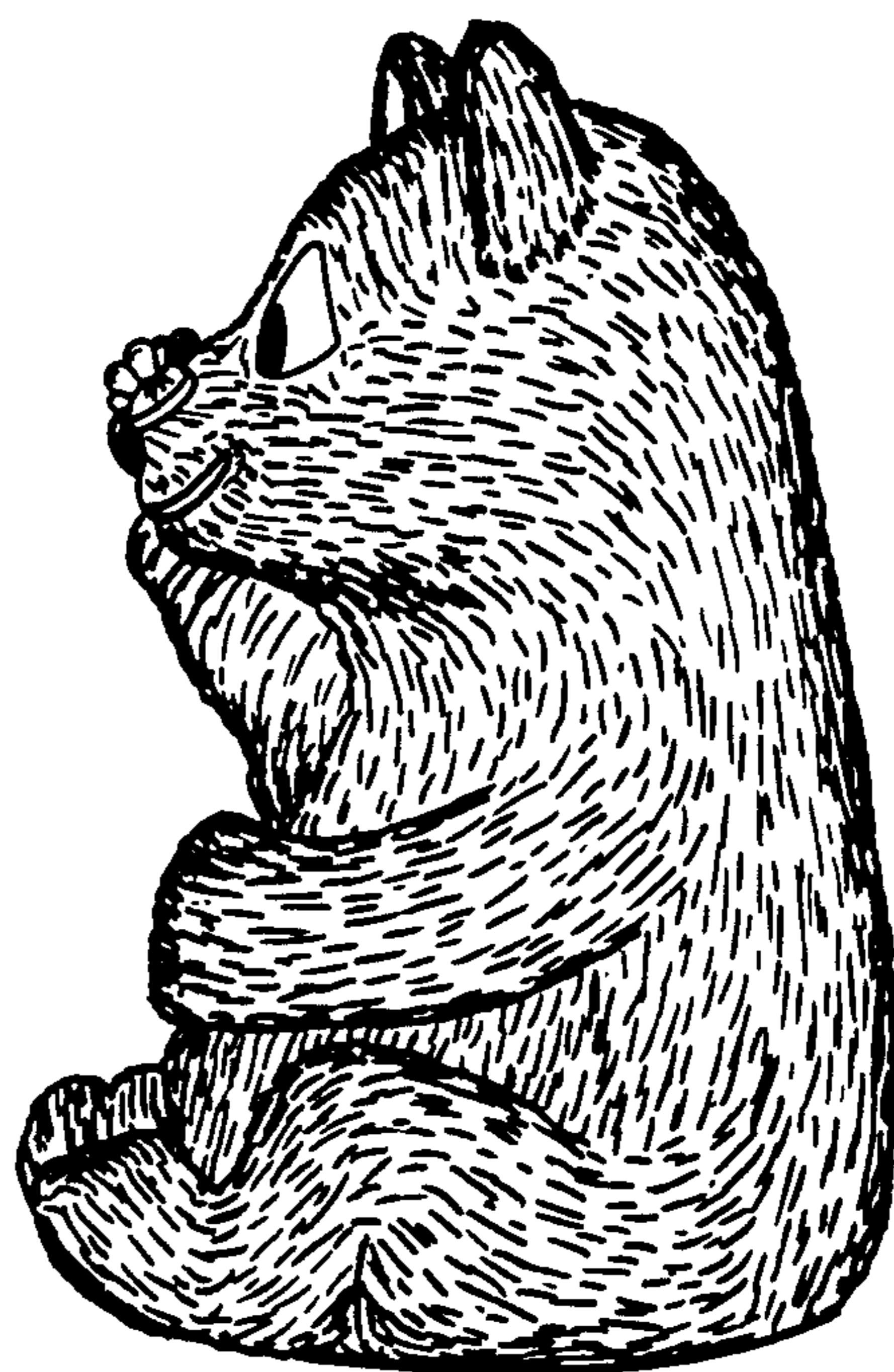
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

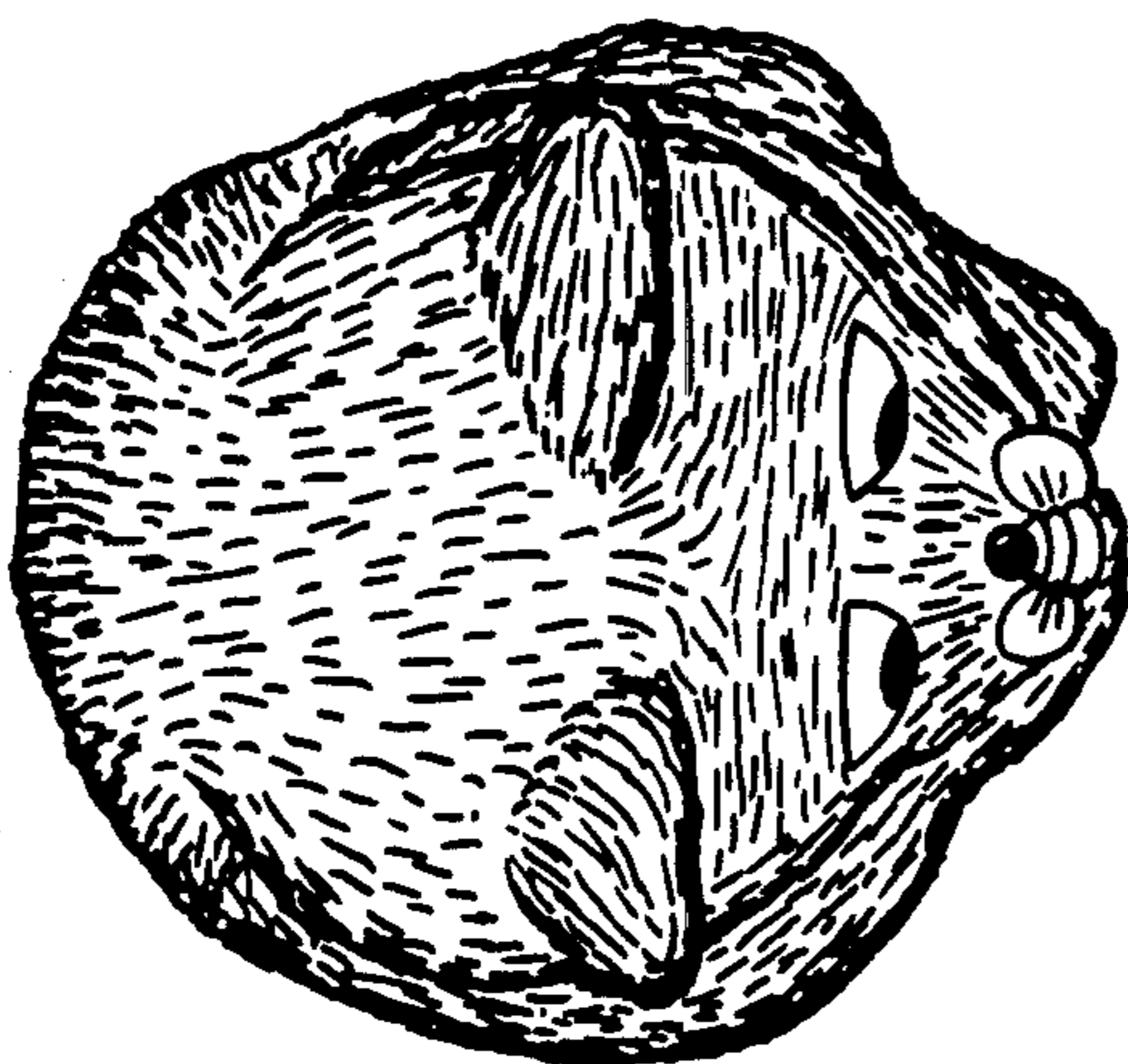




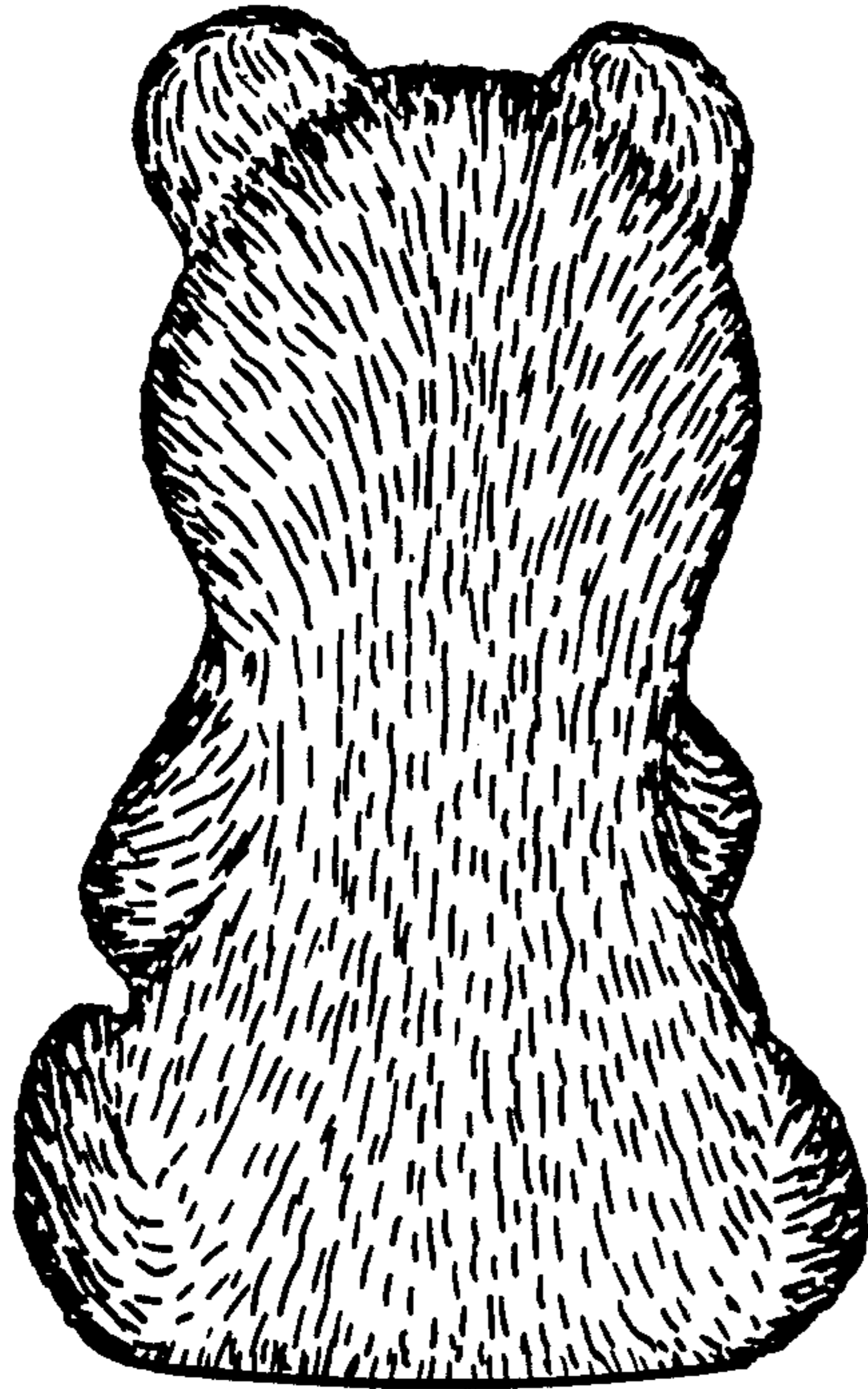

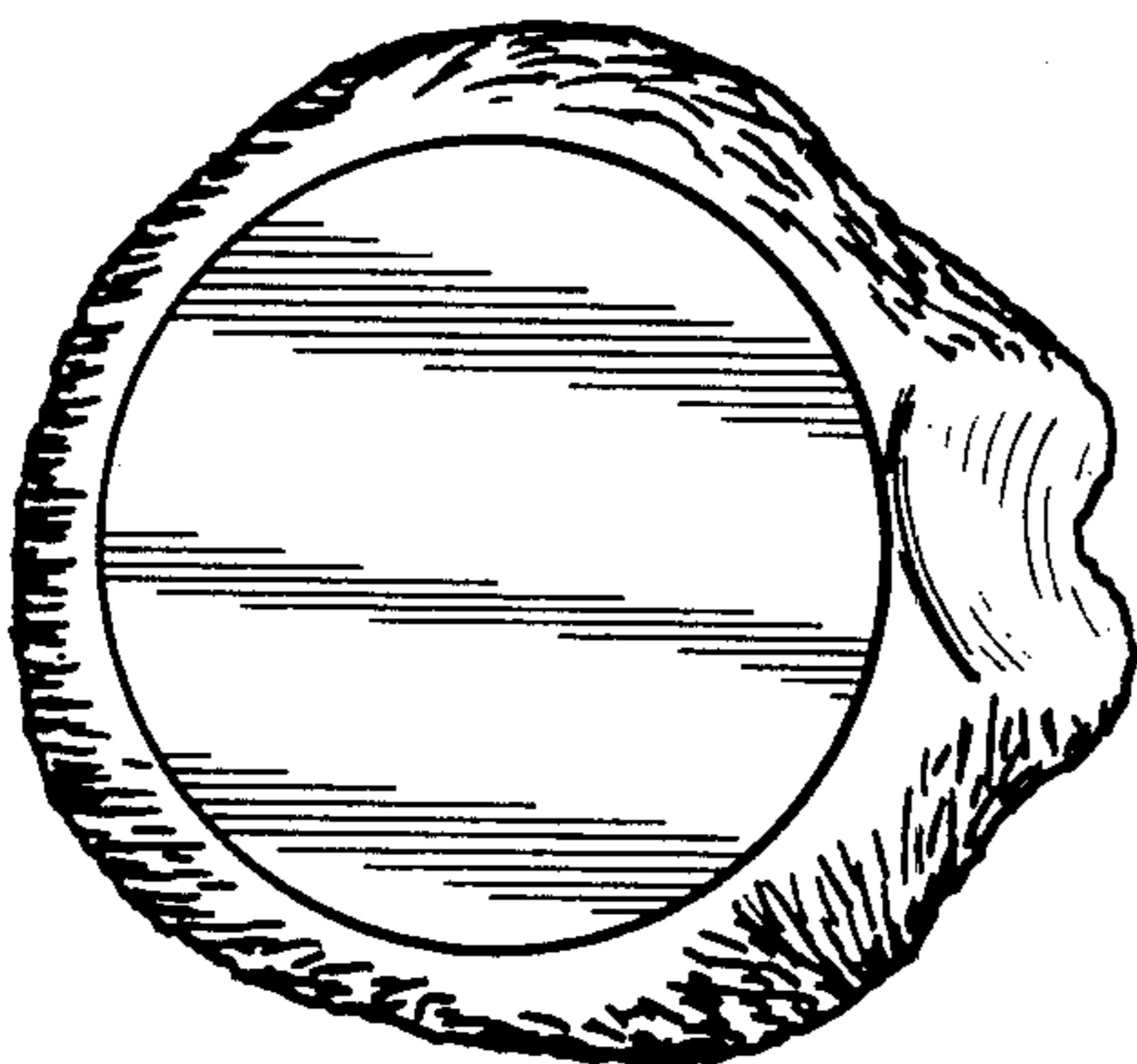
