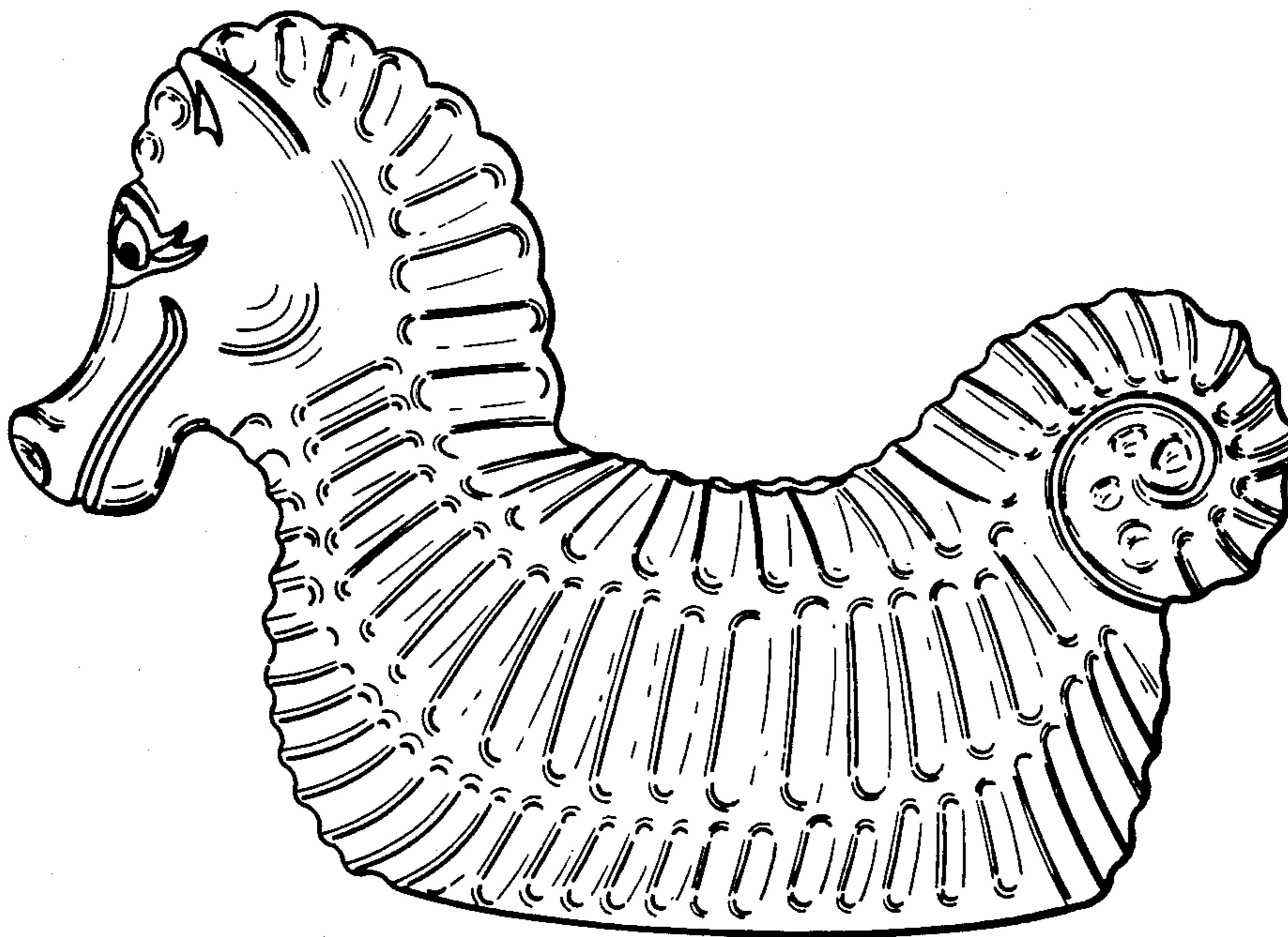

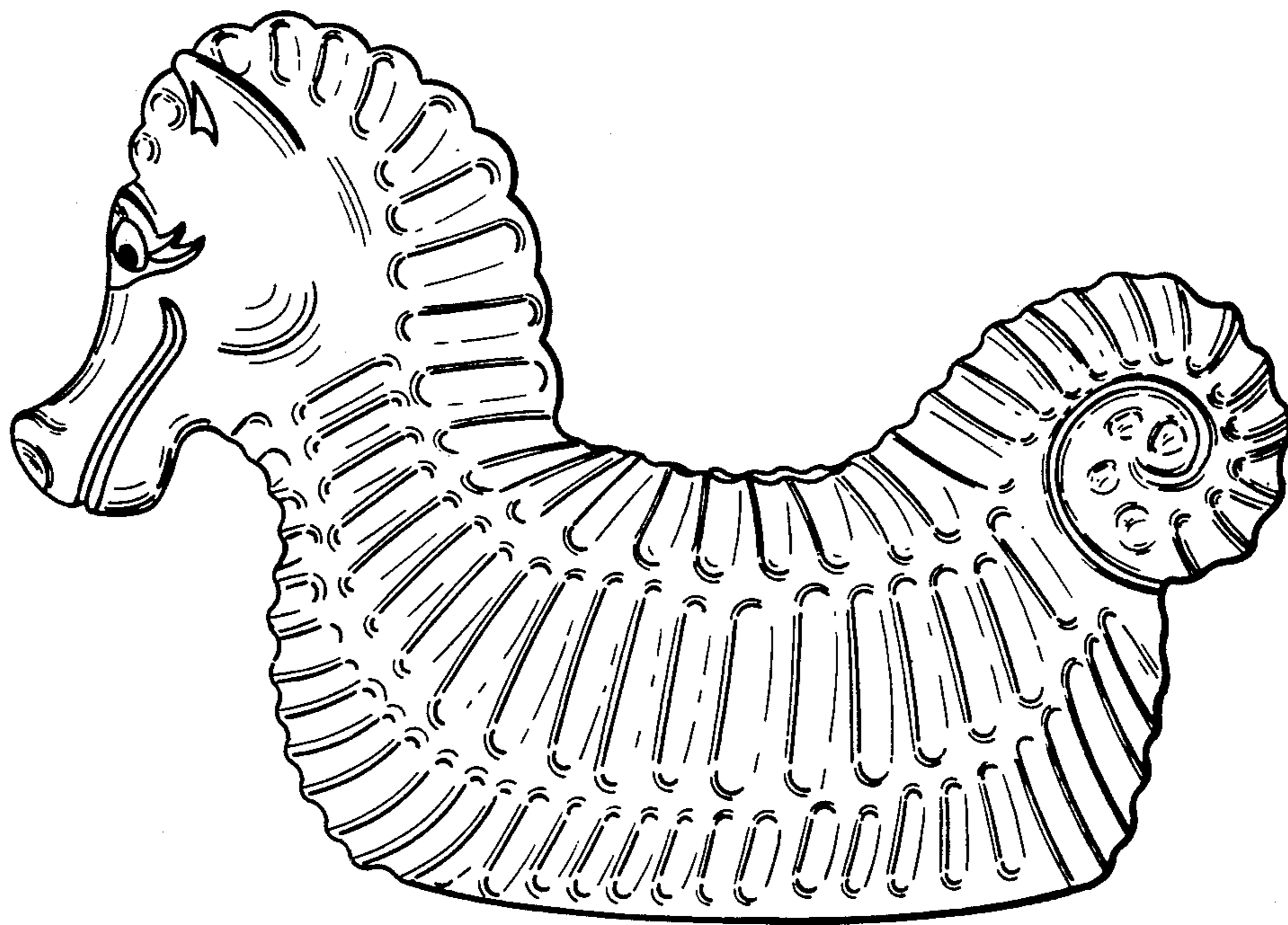
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a toy seahorse, as shown.

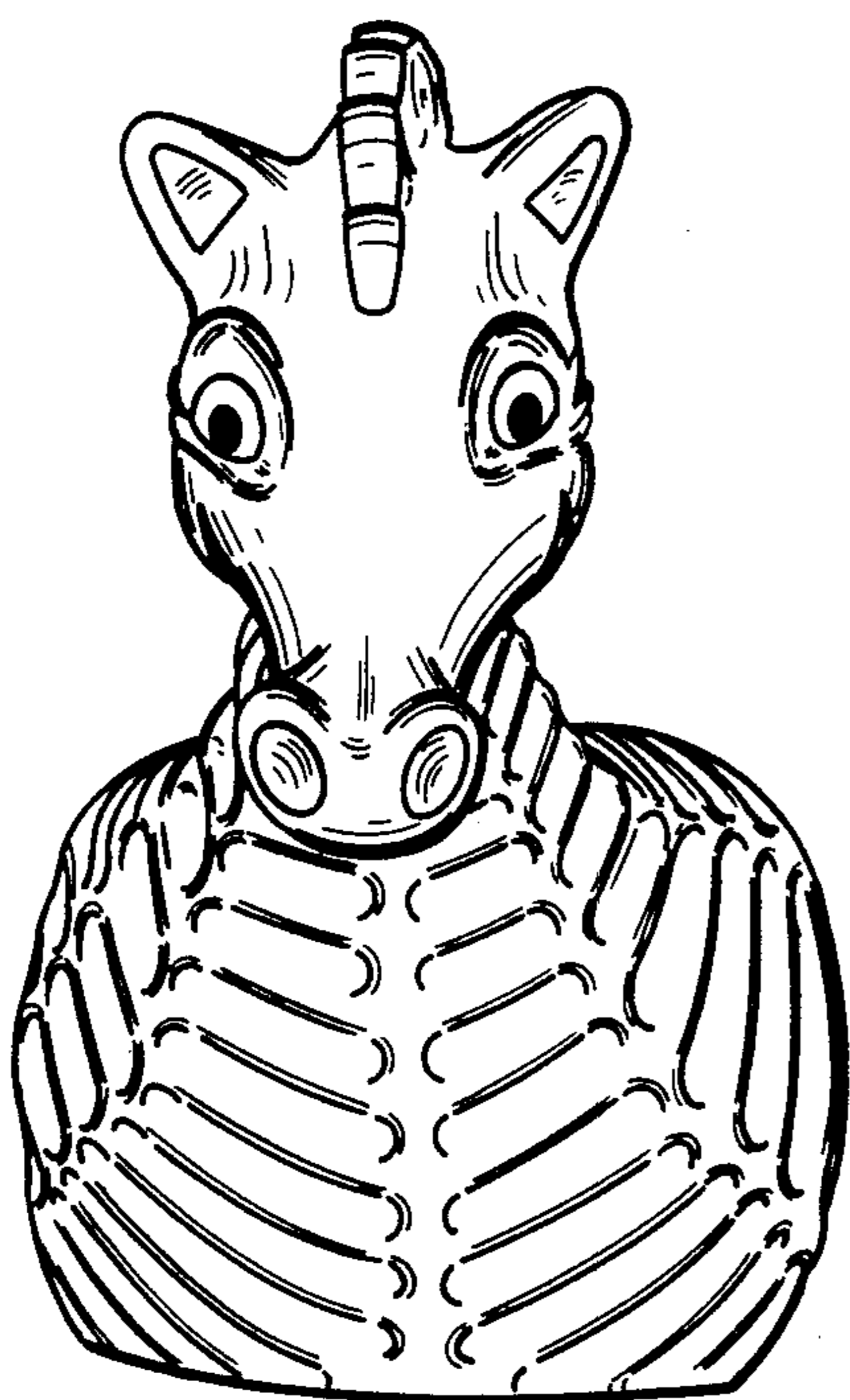
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a toy seahorse showing ny new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

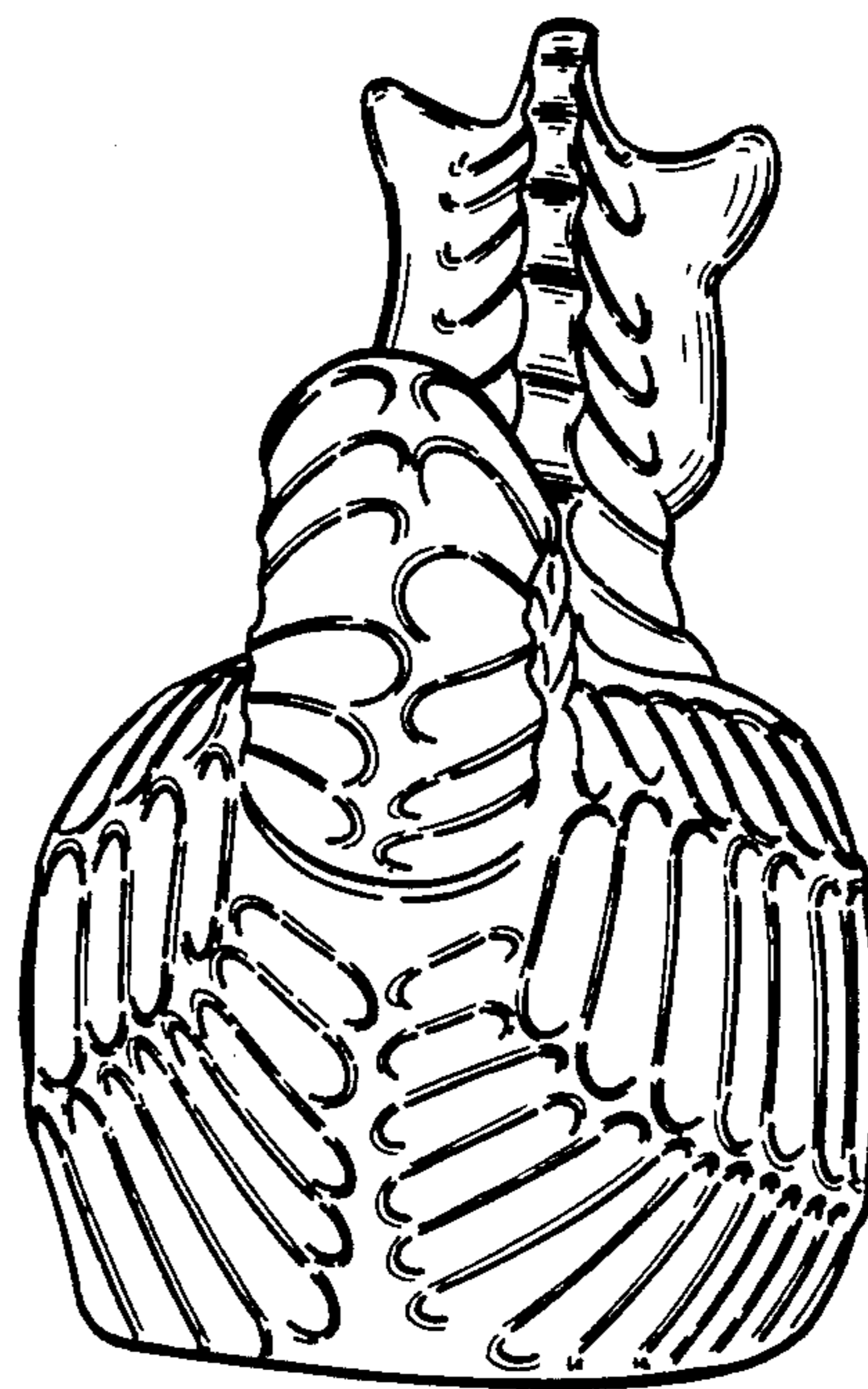

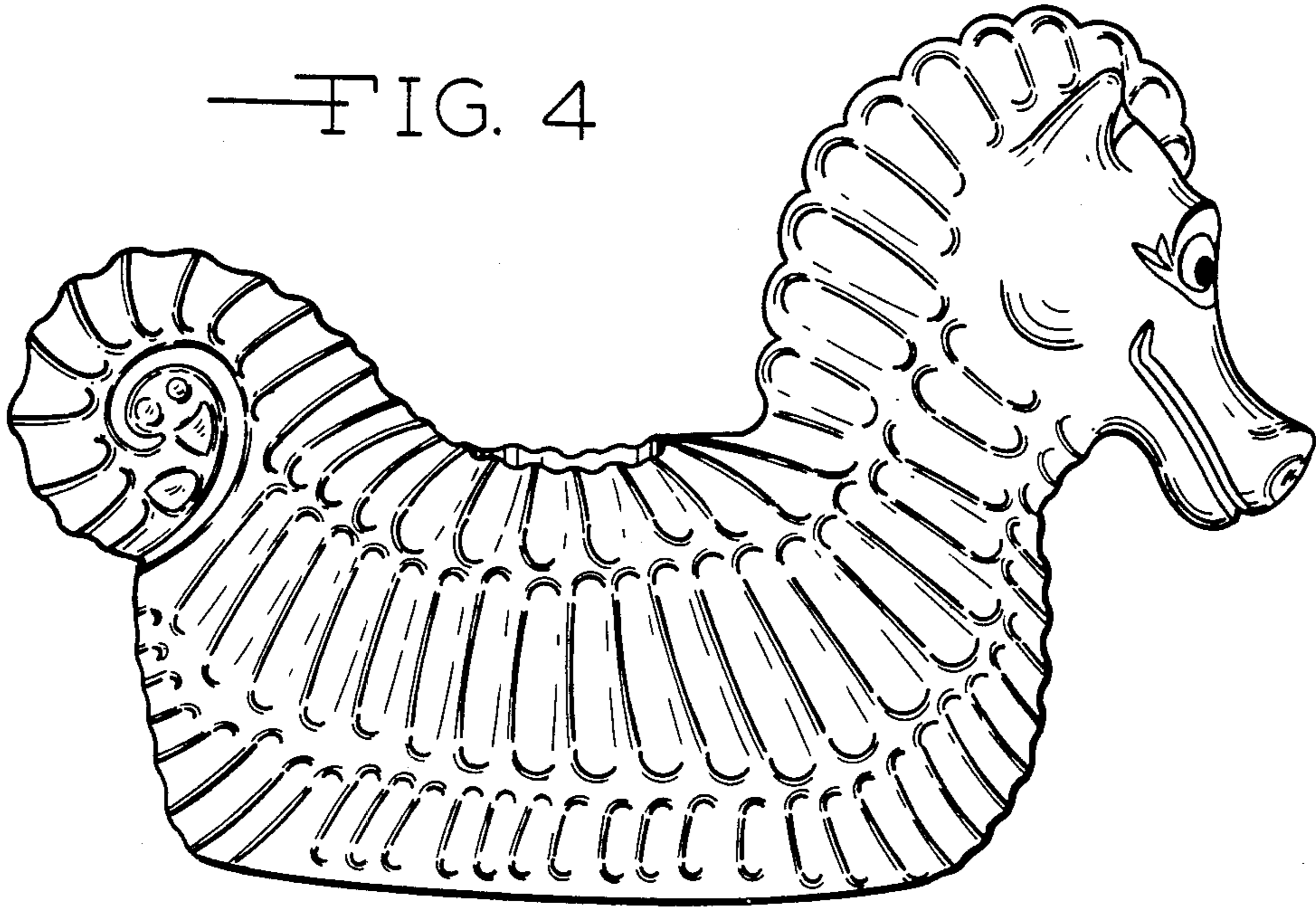

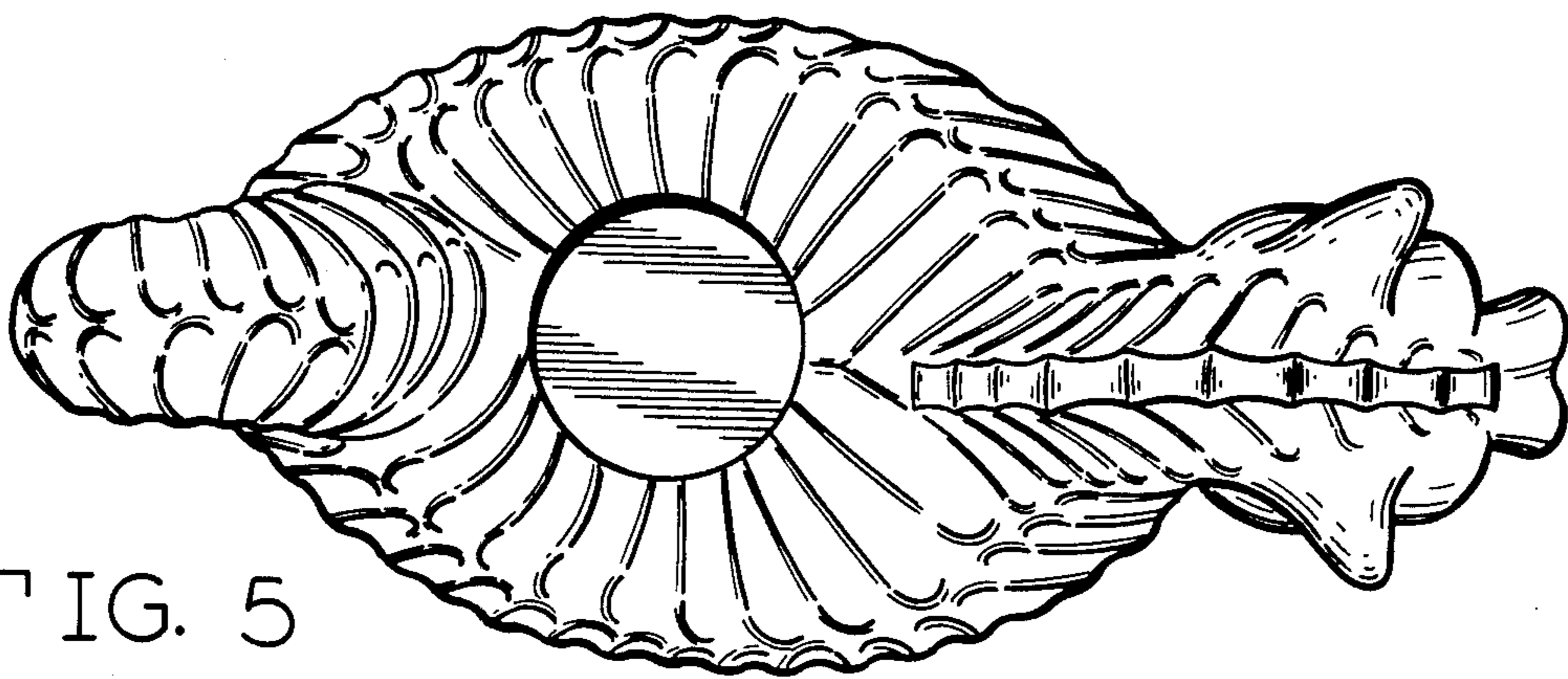
