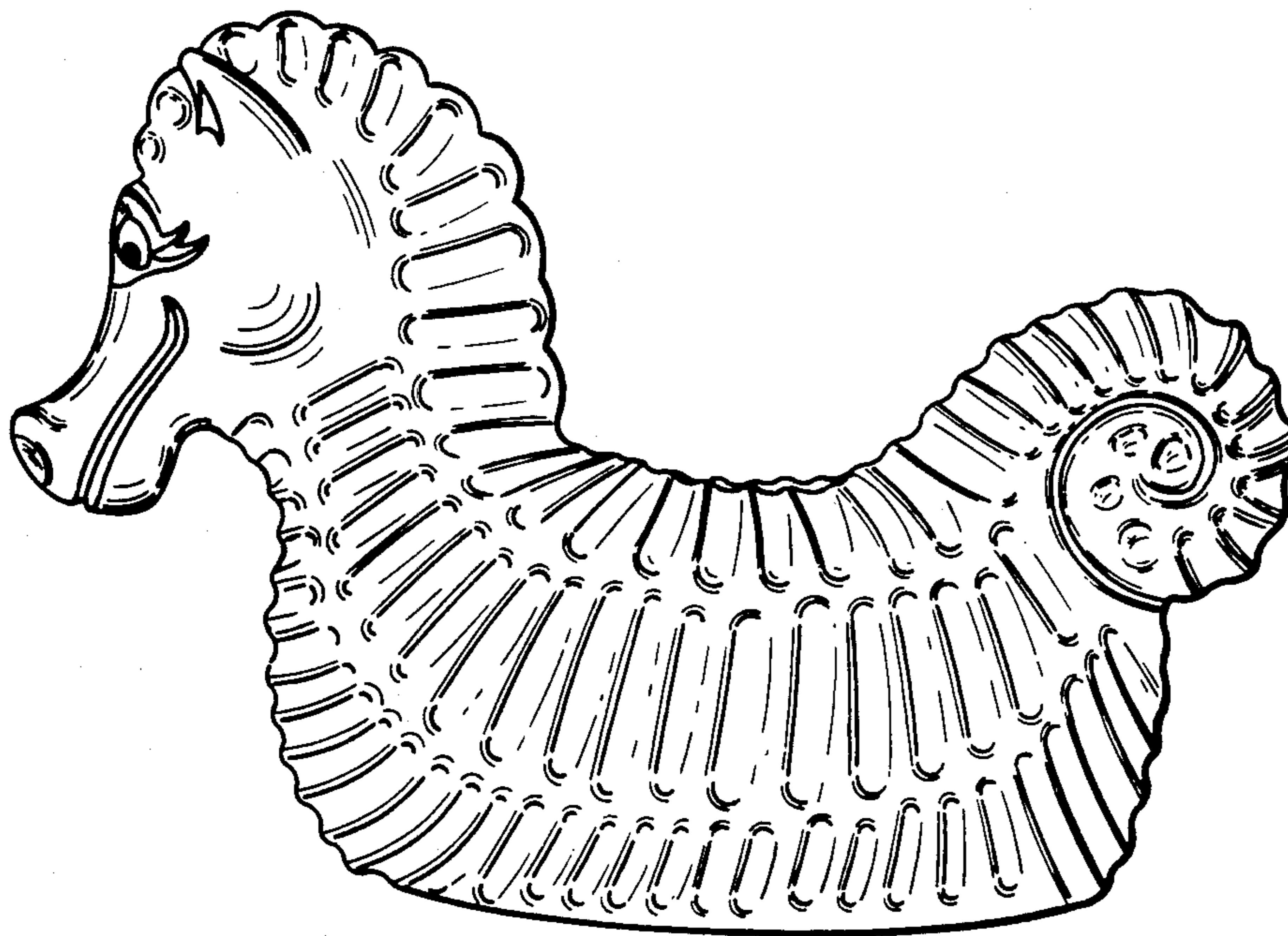

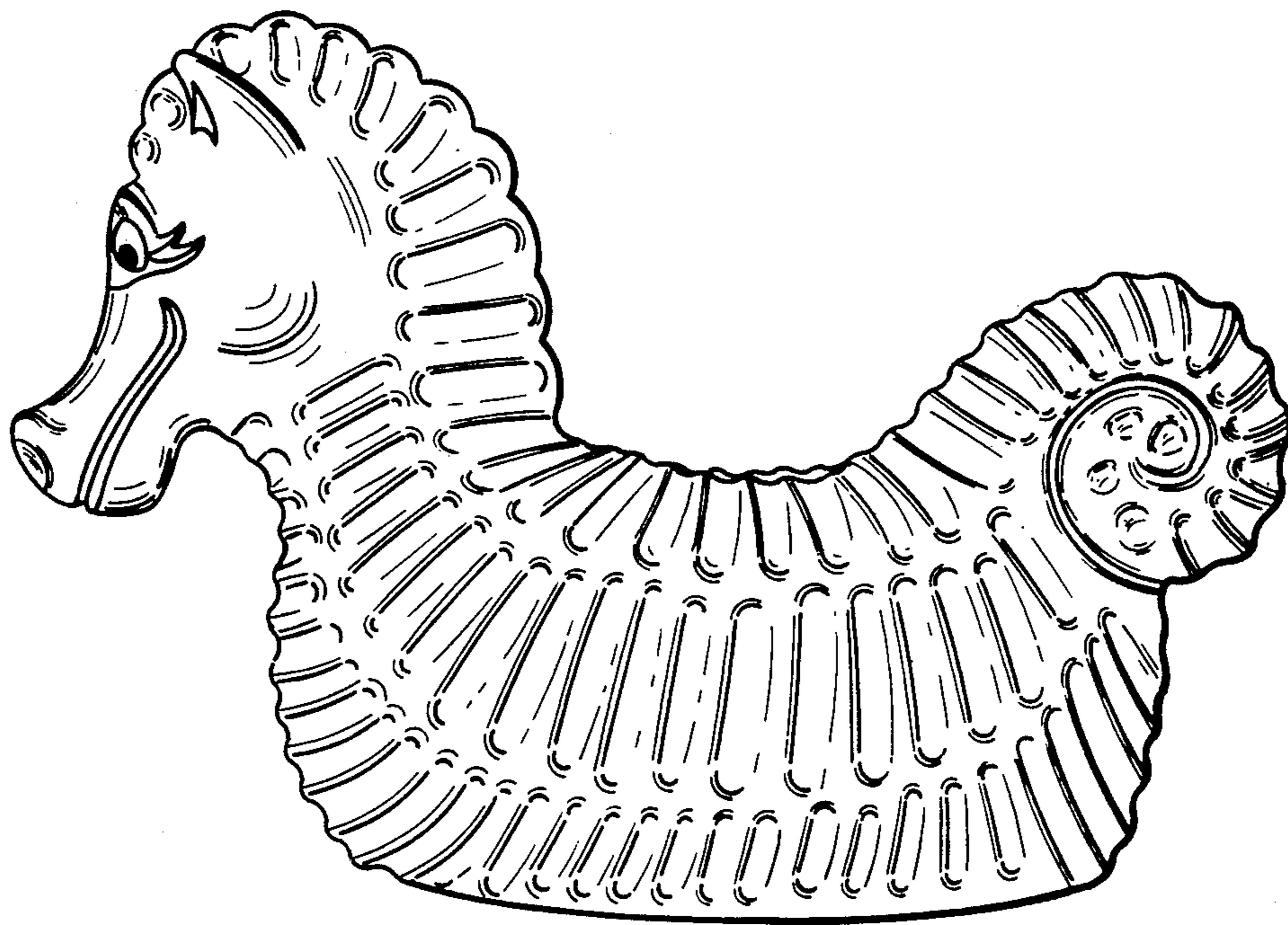

The ornamental design for a toy seahorse, as shown.

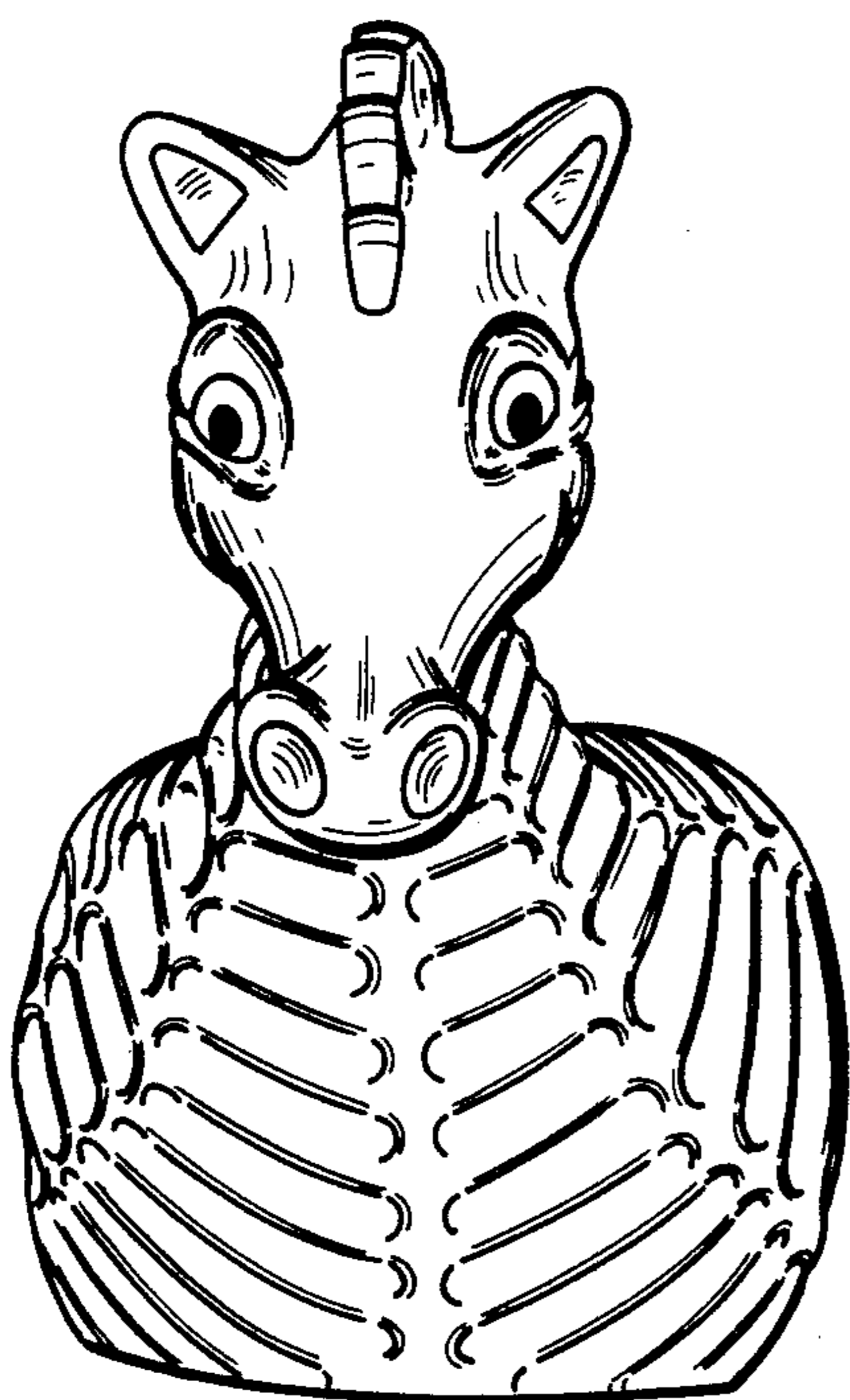
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

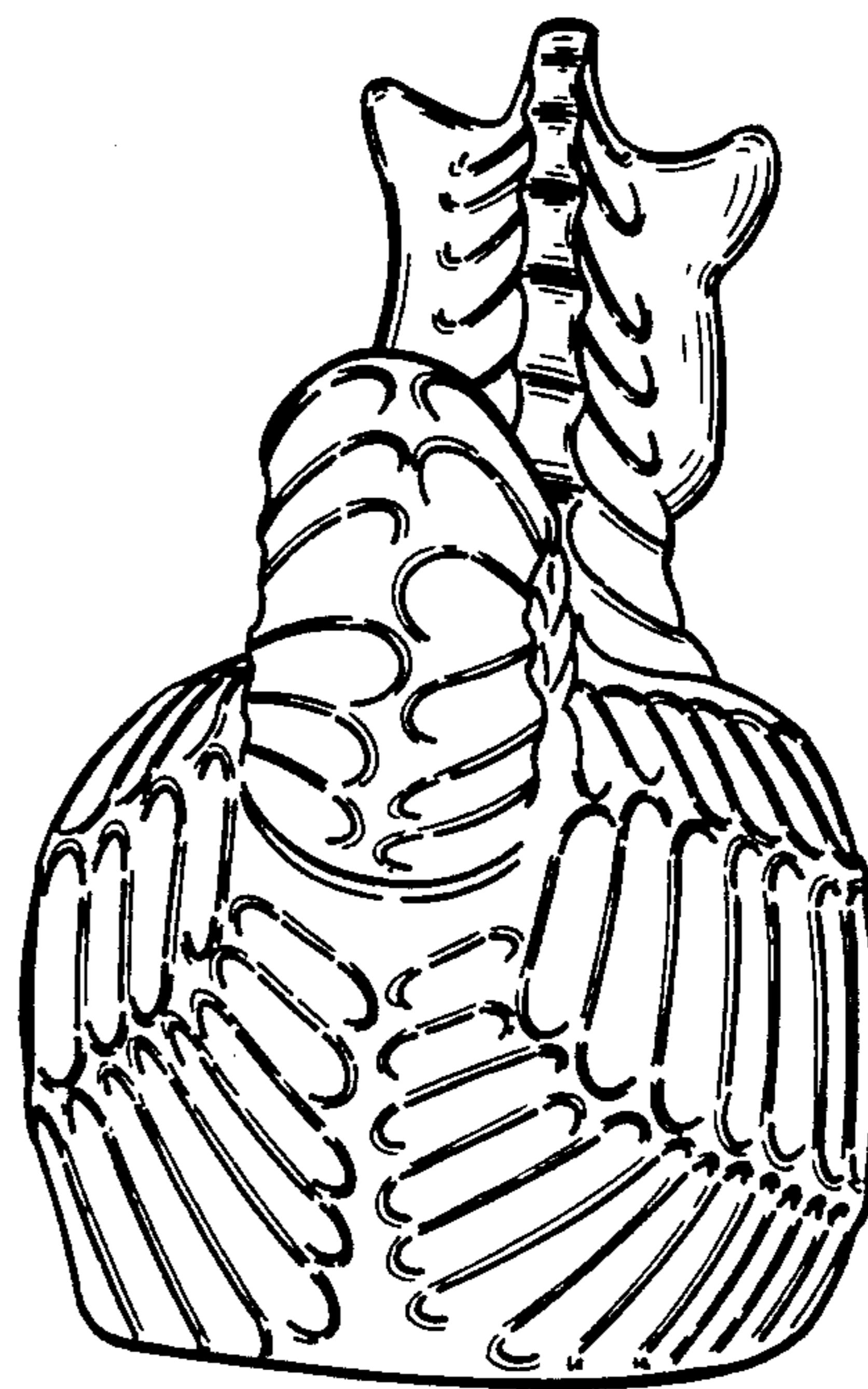

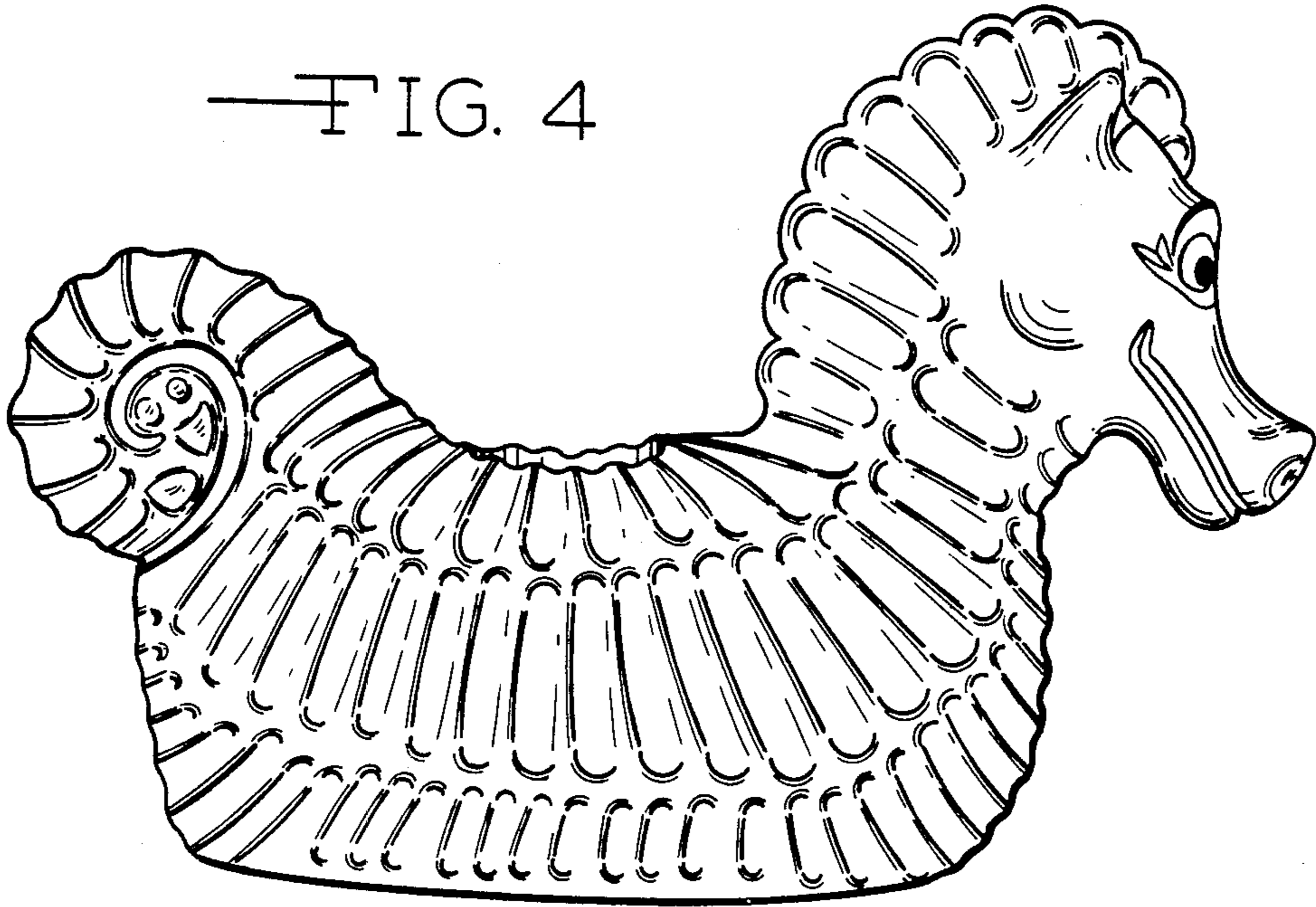

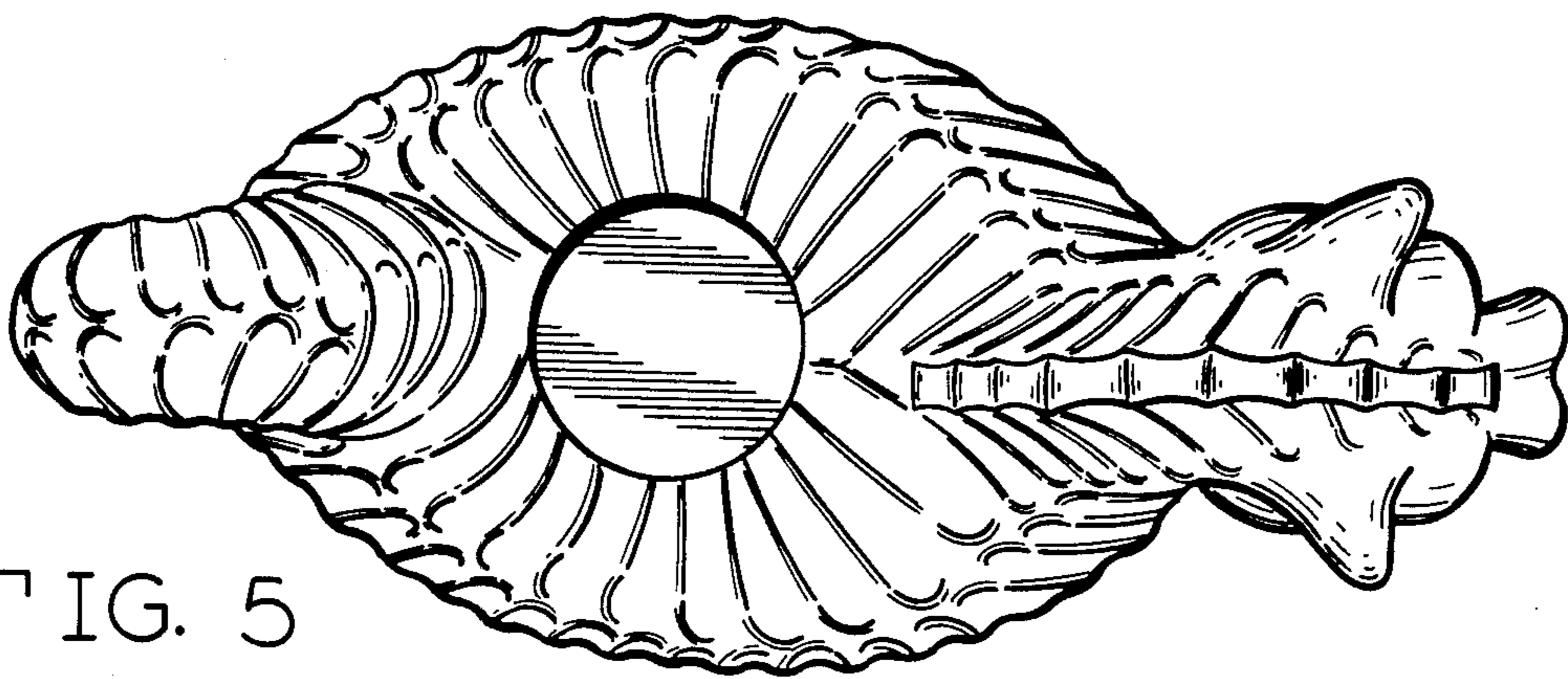
