[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined tennis racquet cover and ball holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined tennis racquet cover and ball holder showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front edge elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a rear edge elevational view;

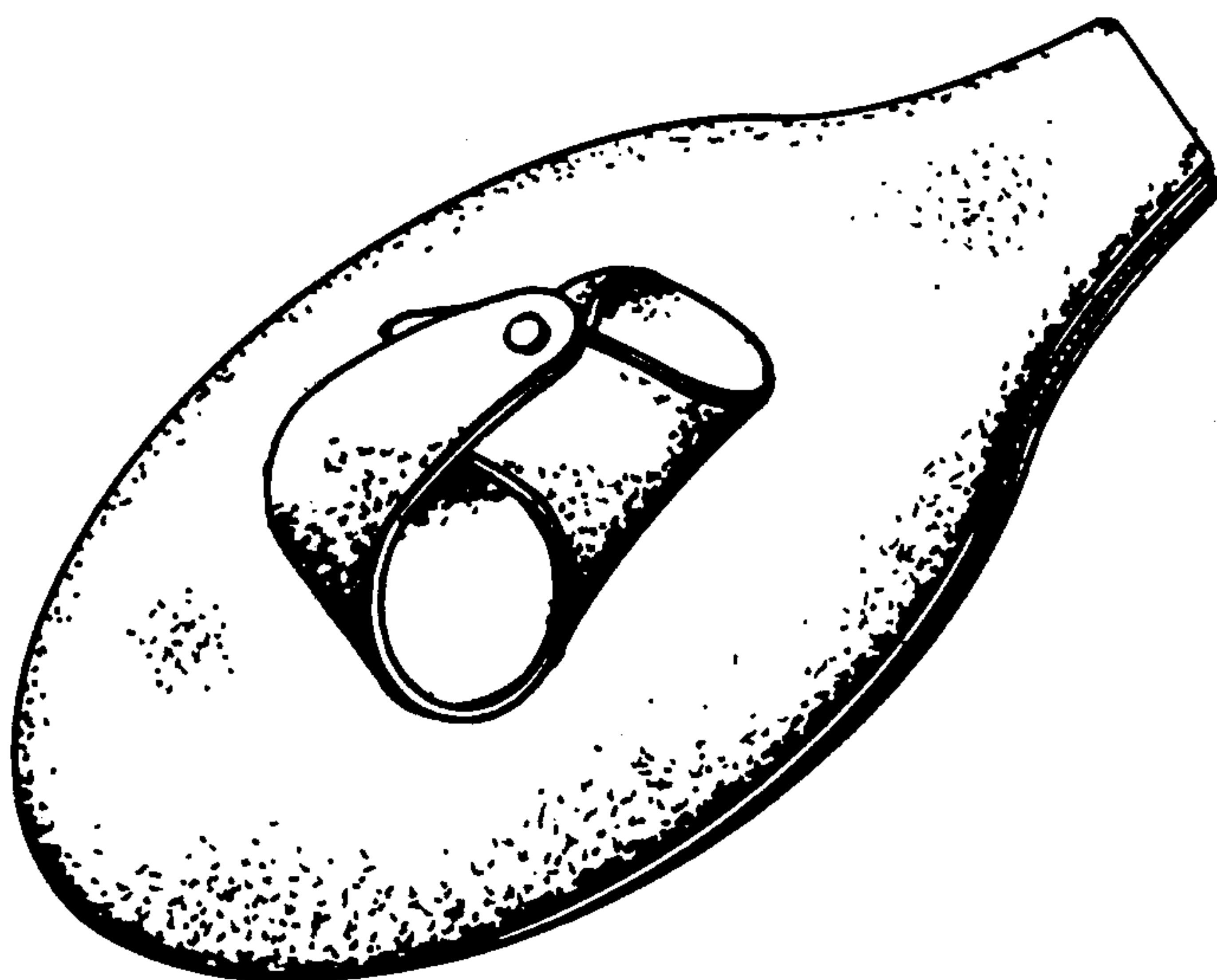
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the combined tennis racquet cover and ball holder with the top flap of the ball holder in an open position;

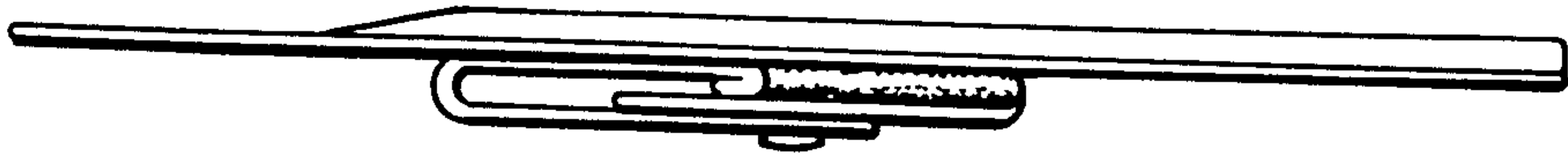
FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a right end elevational view;

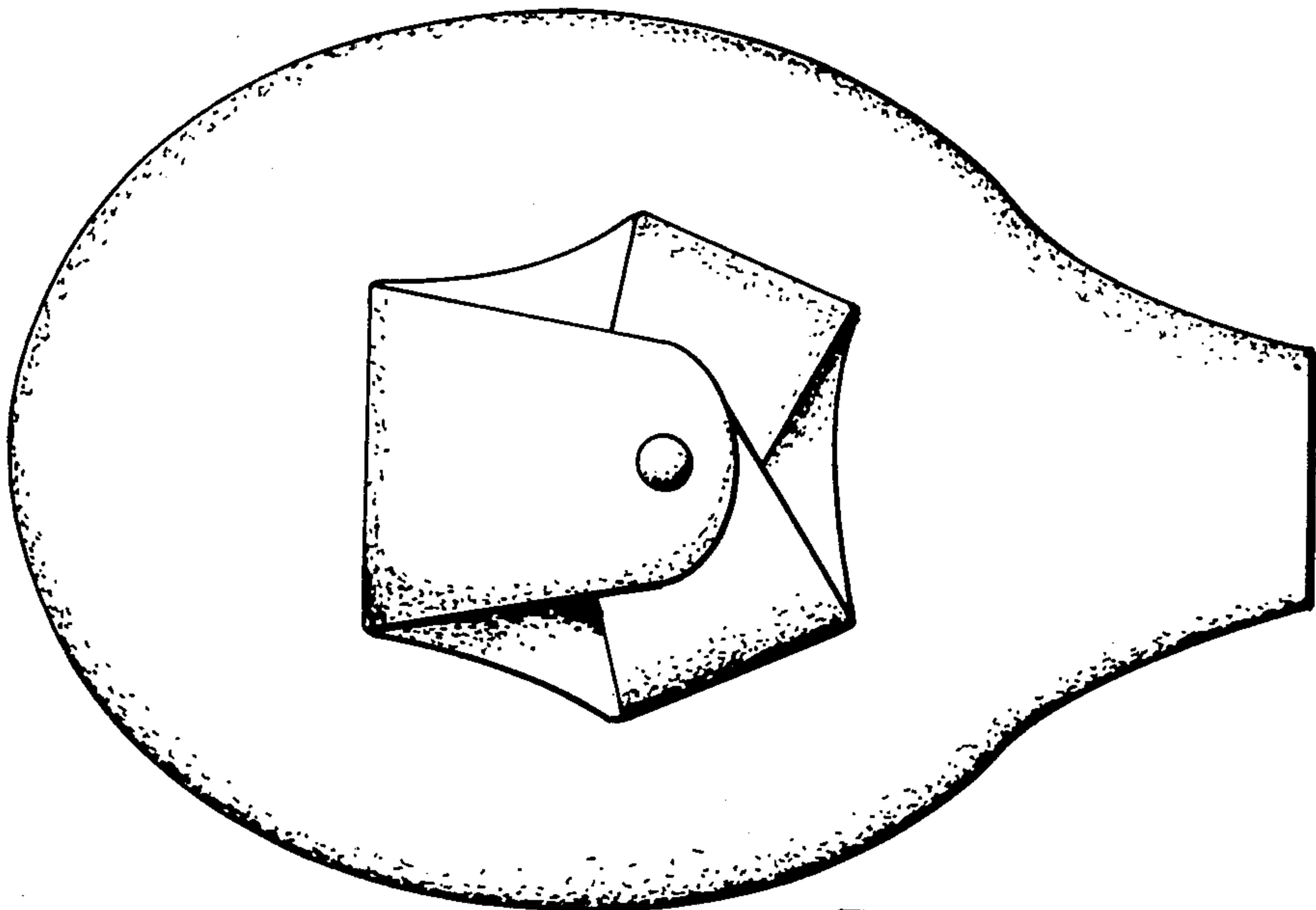
FIG. 7 is a reduced scale bottom plan view; and

FIG. 8 is a perspective view with the ball holder shown in an expanded condition.





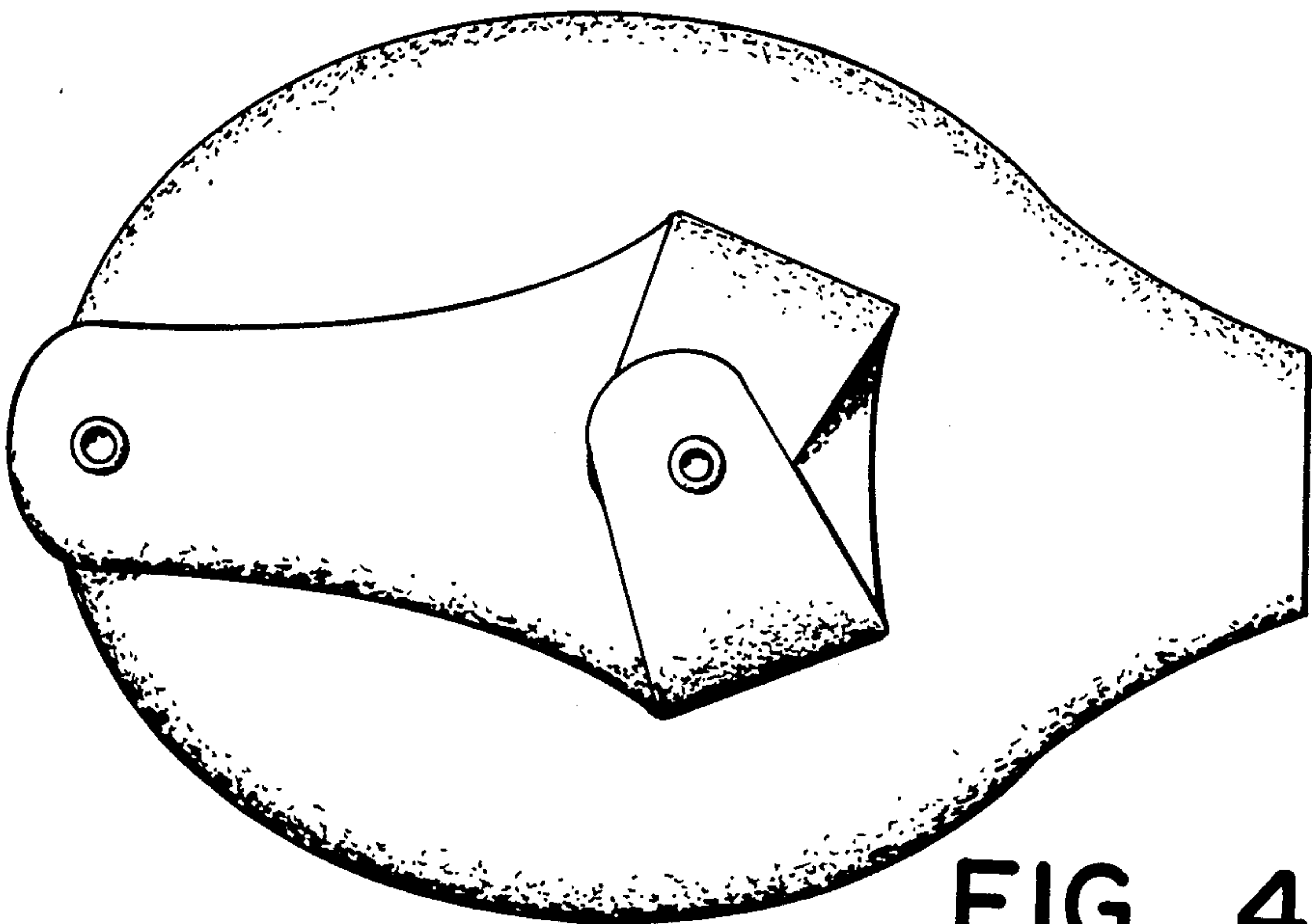

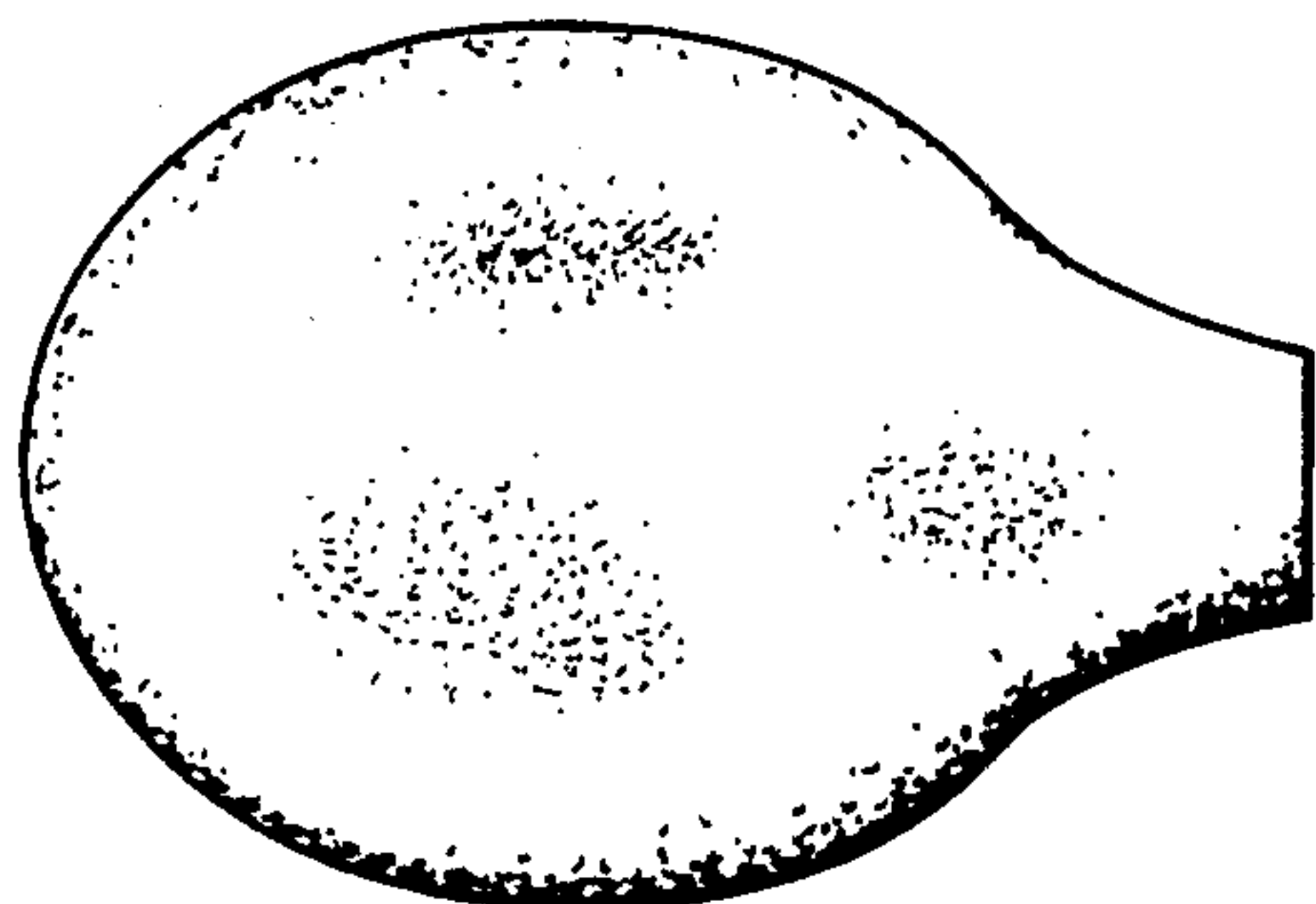

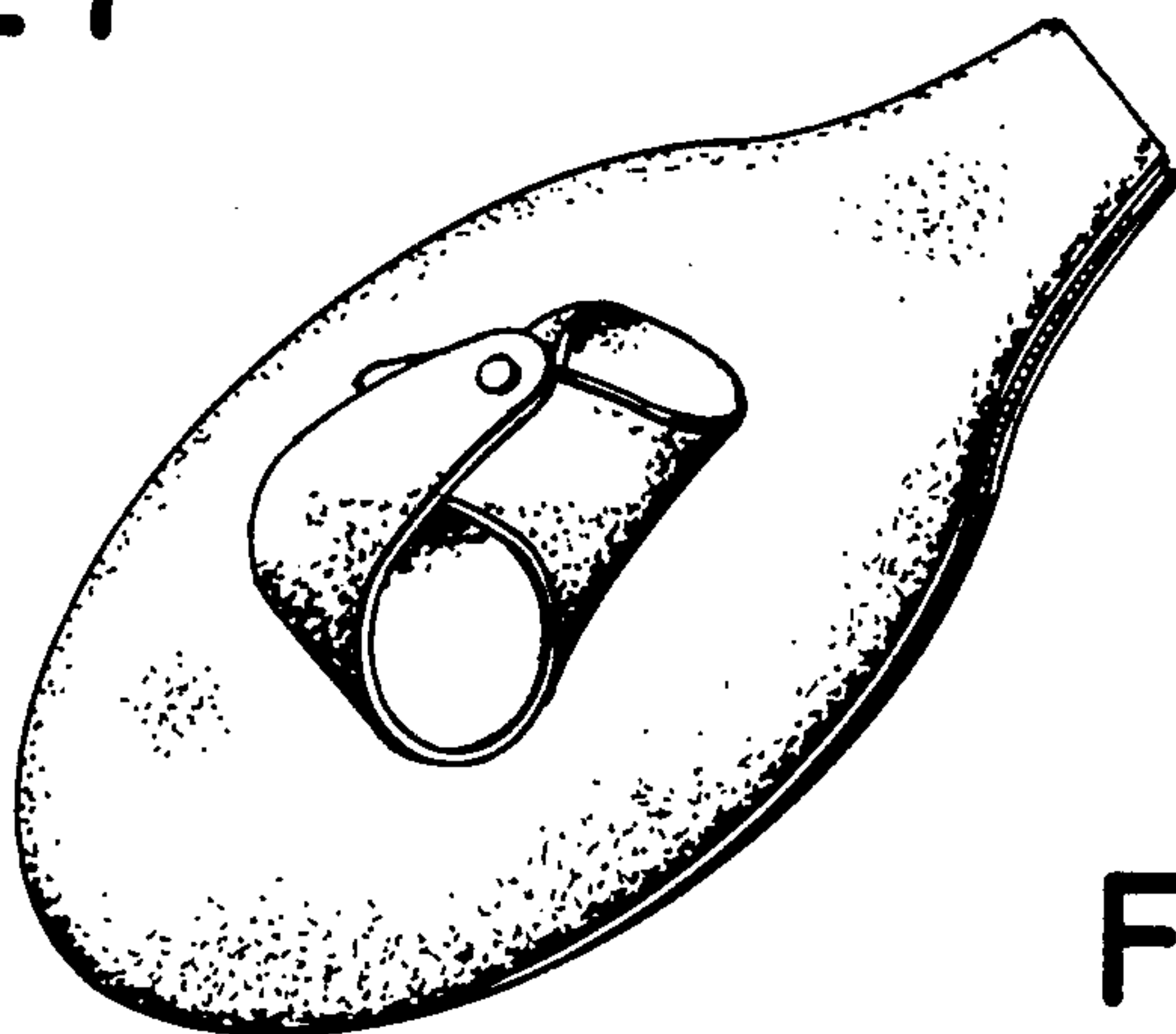
