DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the inventive seat or similar article in the form of a chair;


FIG. 2 is a side elevation of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a front elevation of the chair illustrated in FIG. 1;




