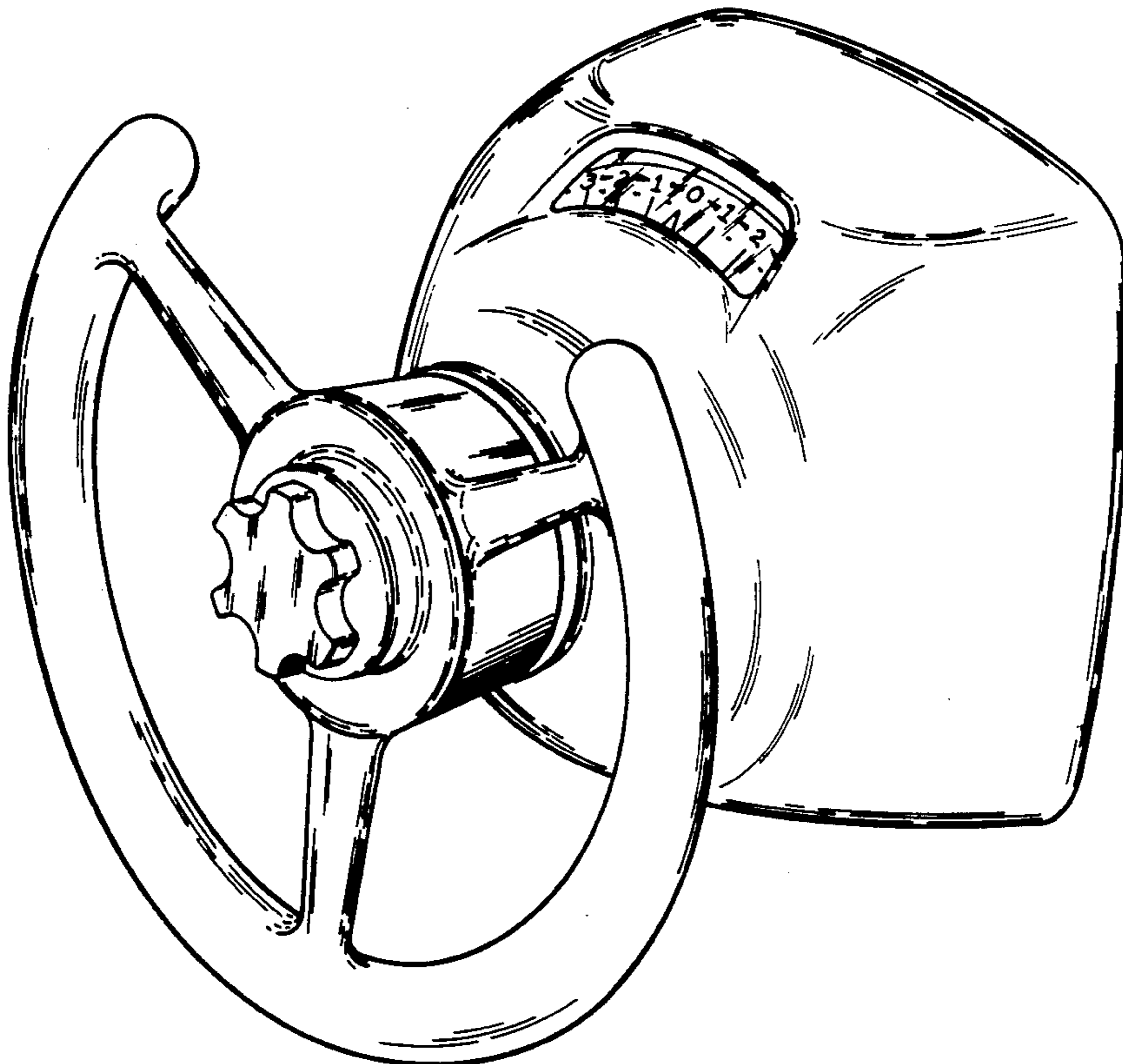

The ornamental design for a ship's helm, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a ship's helm showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a plan view of the same;  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view of the same; and  
FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the same.  
The opposite side of FIG. 3 is a mirror image of the side shown.



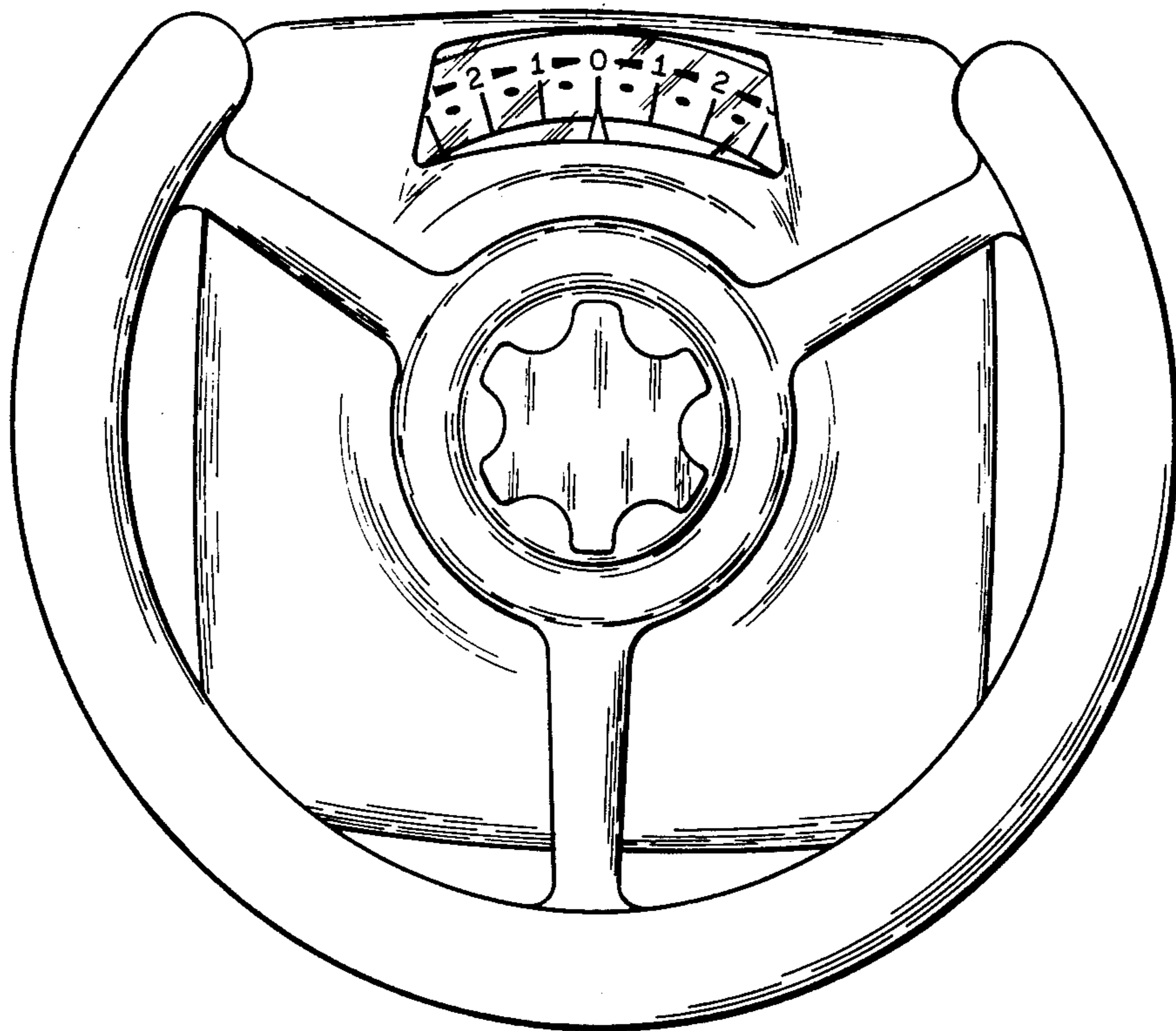

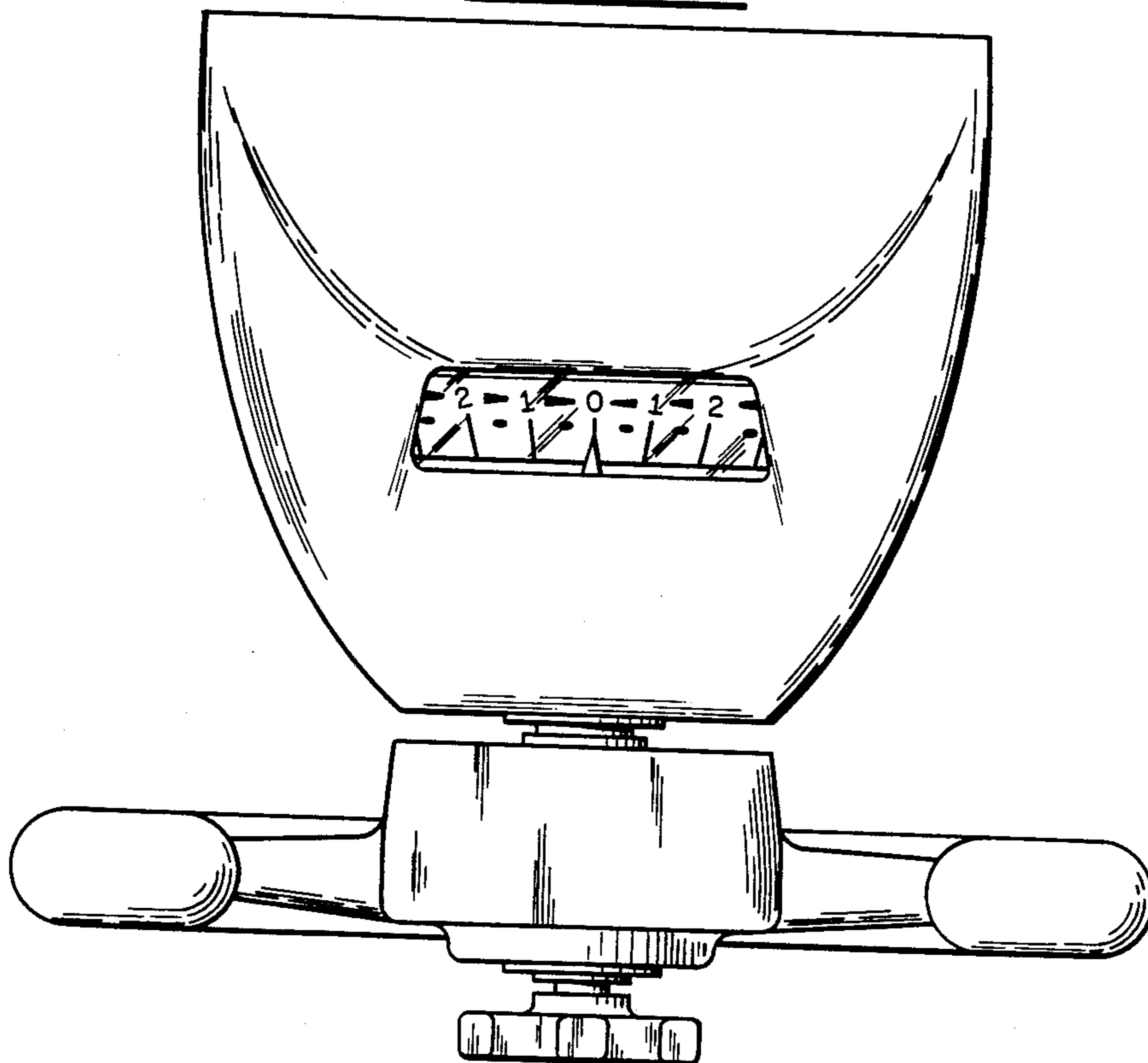

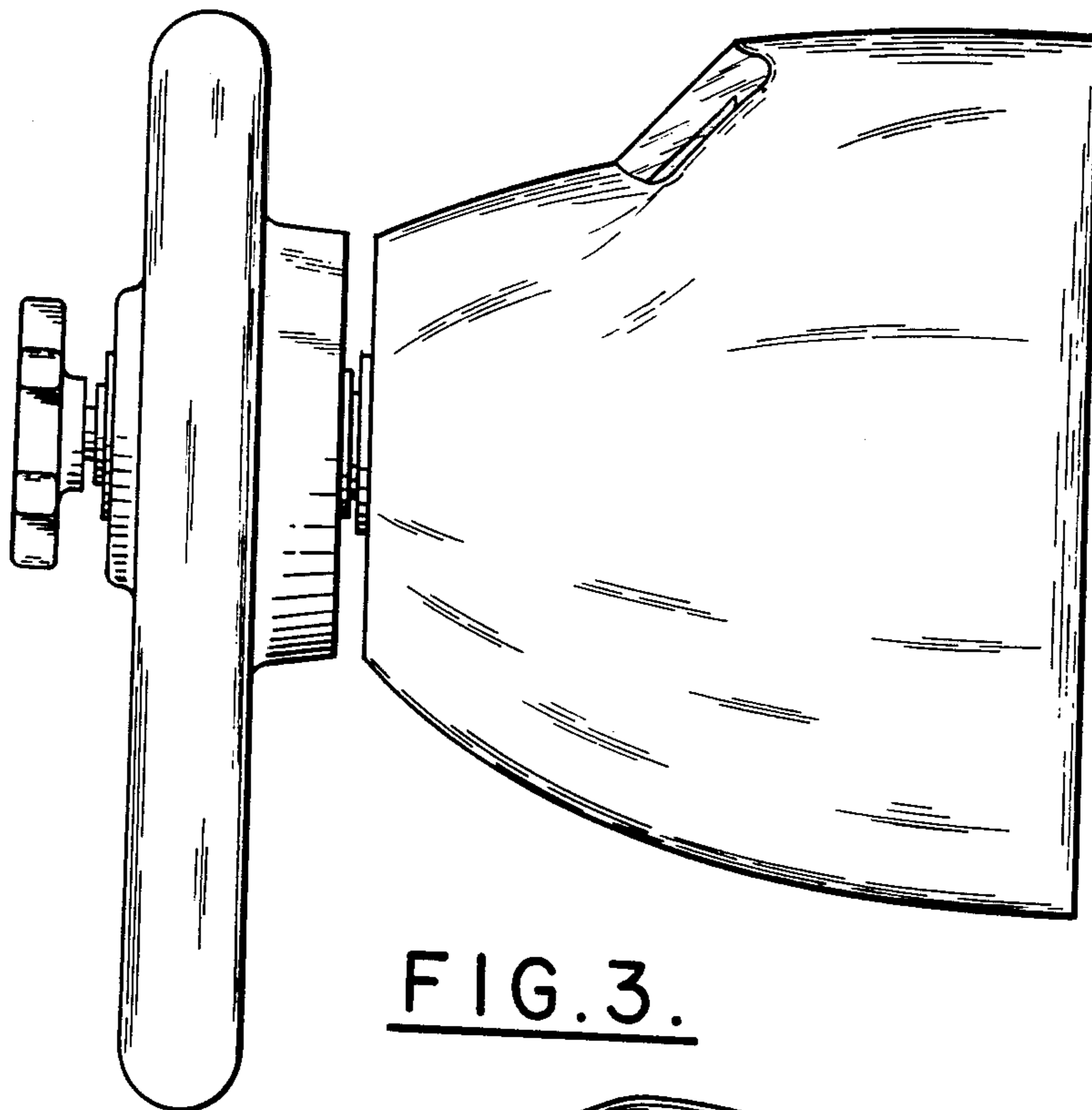

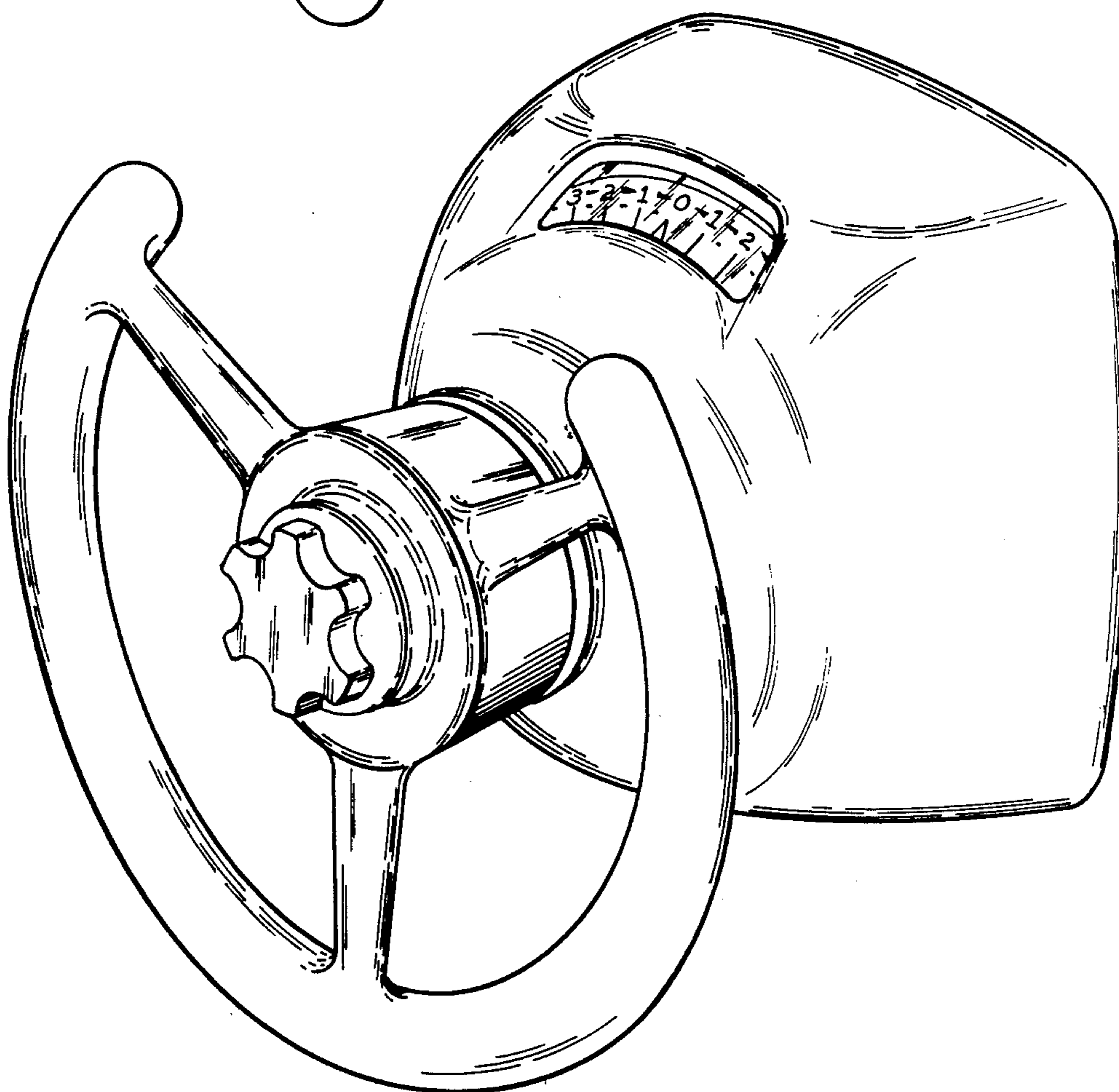
