The ornamental design for a fishing lure, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the fishing lure embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation of the fishing lure shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation of the fishing lure, looking from the left in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a side elevation of the fishing lure, looking from the right in FIG. 2; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the fishing lure.

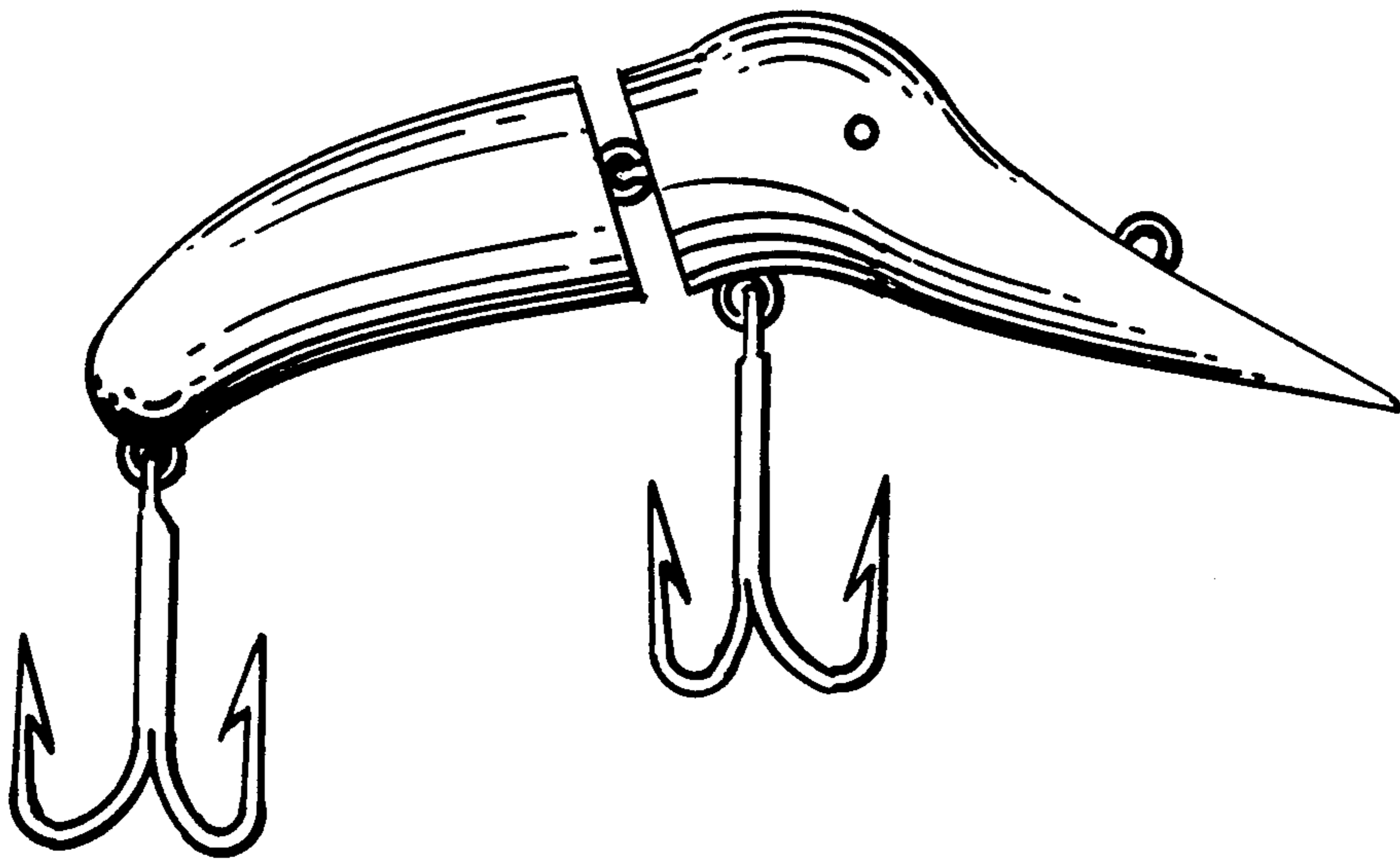

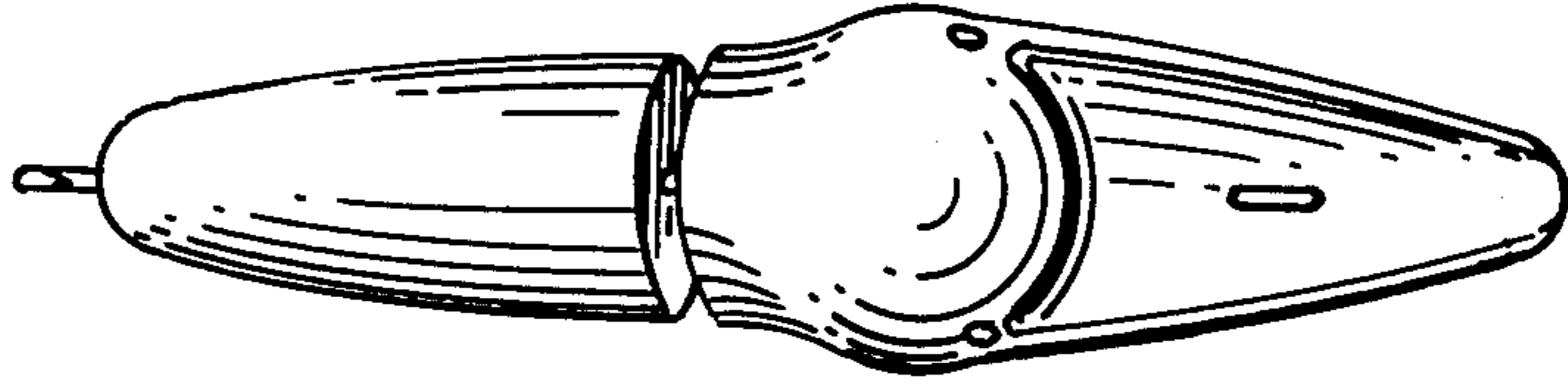

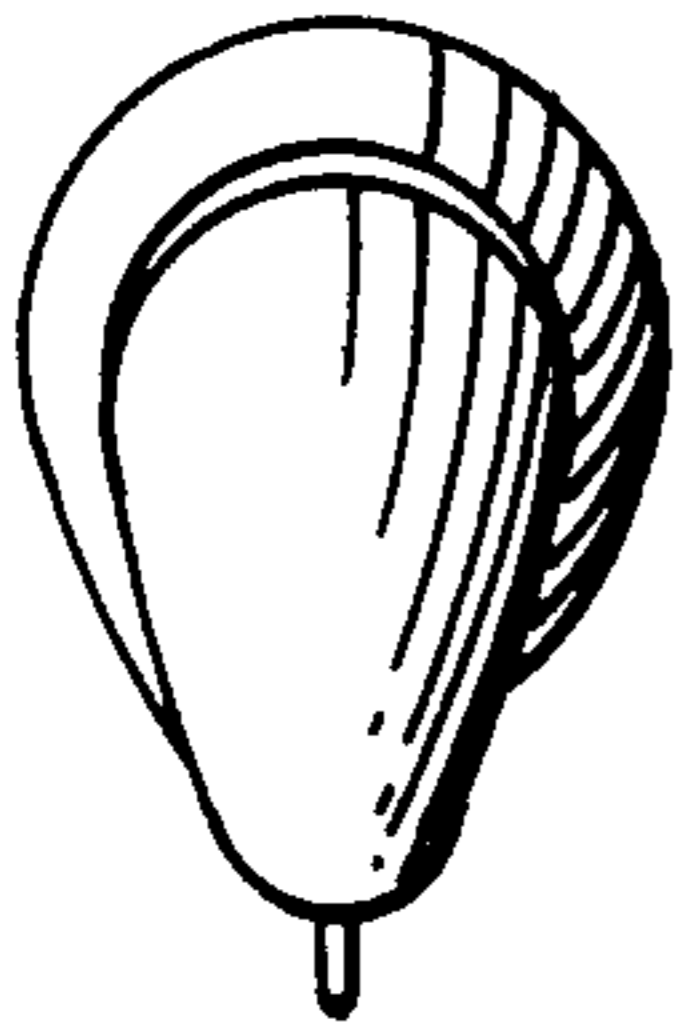

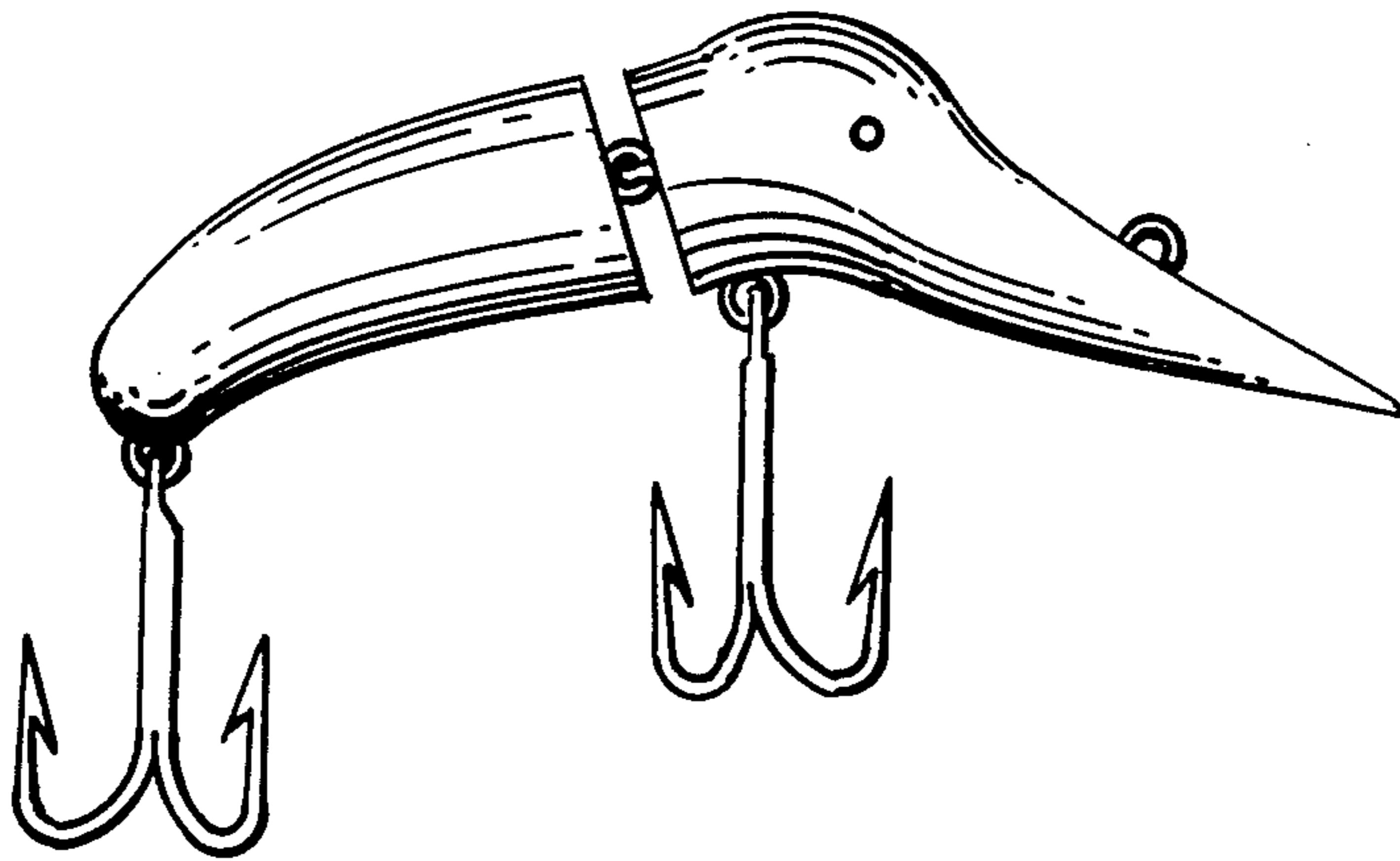

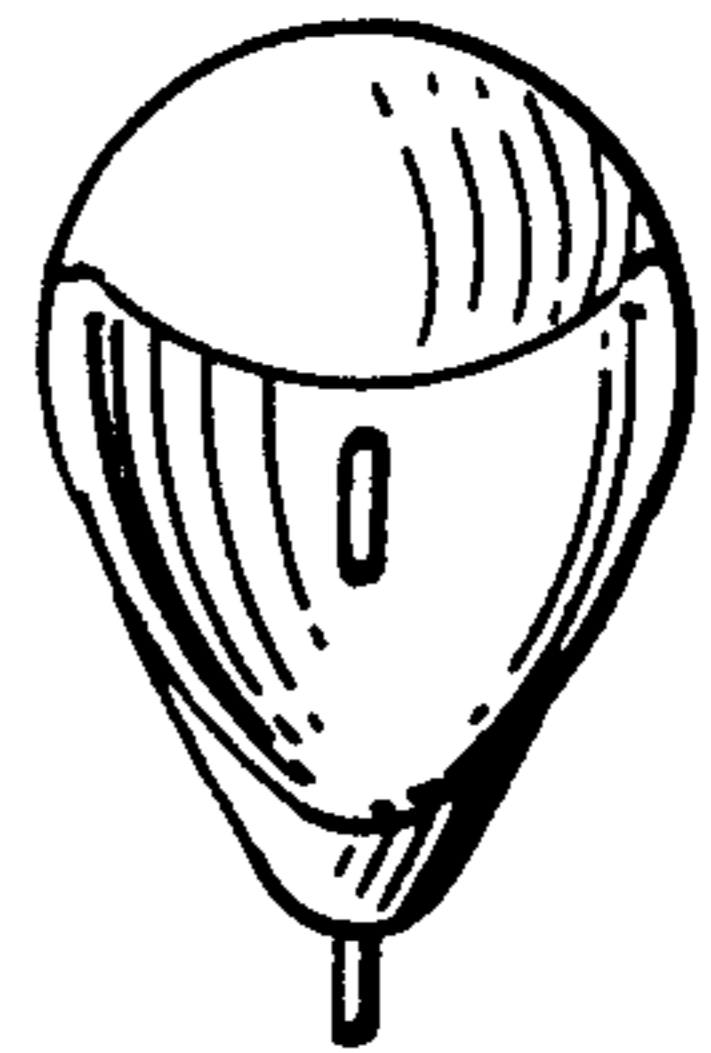
