DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing lure embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the fishing lure;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the fishing lure, being the side opposite that side shown in FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the fishing lure;
FIG. 5 is a front view of the fishing lure;
FIG. 6 is a rear view of the fishing lure; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the fishing lure.

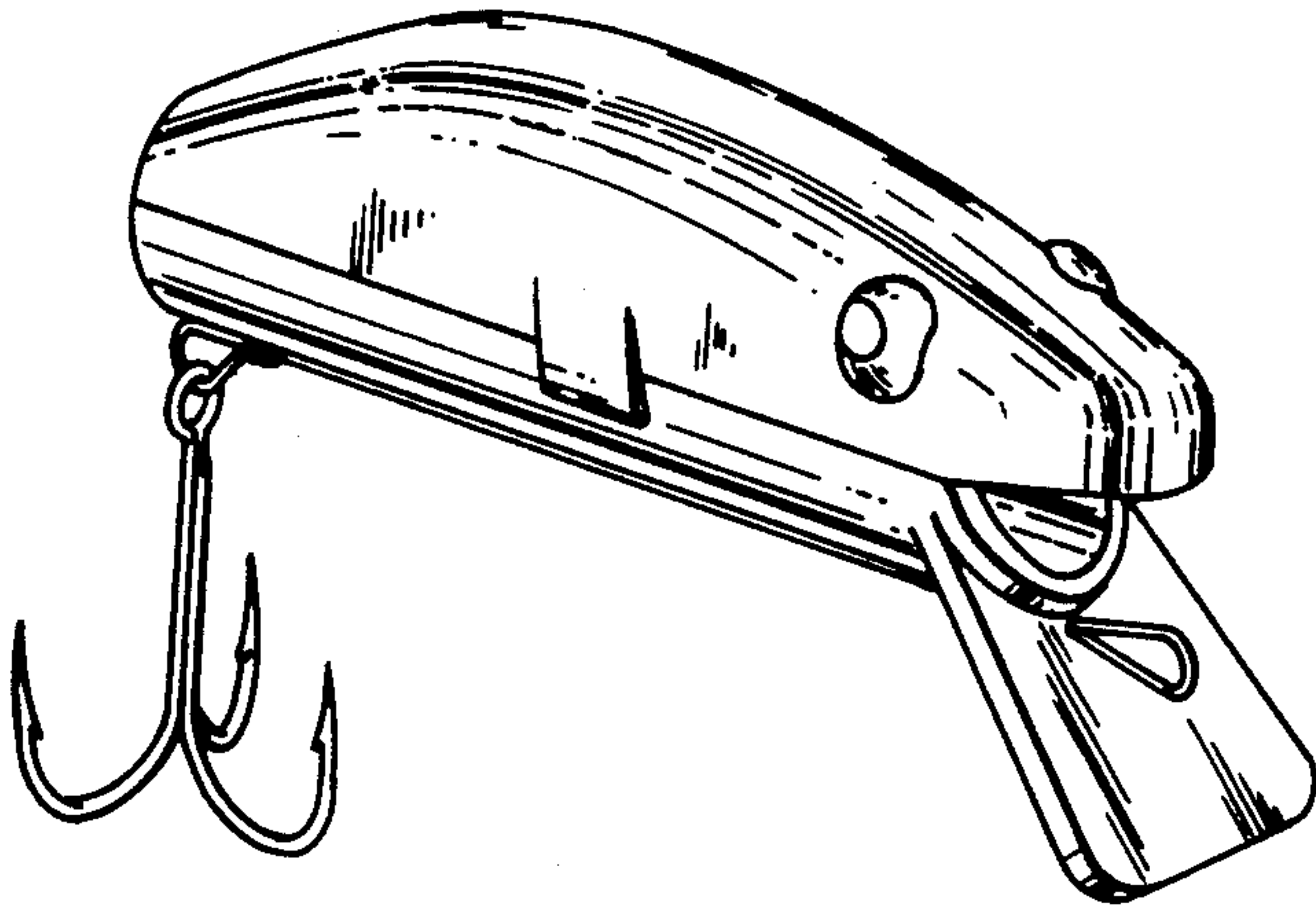

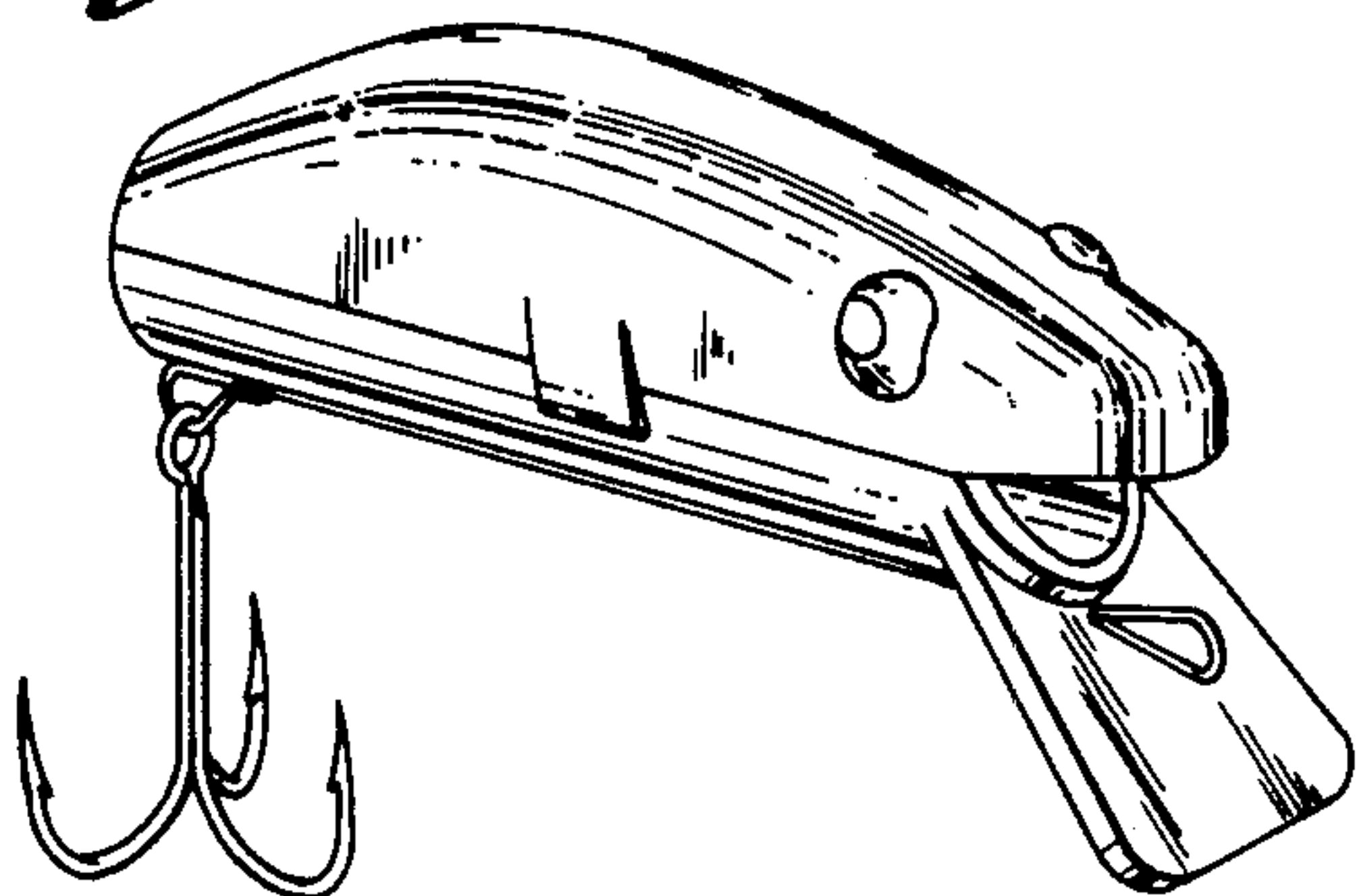

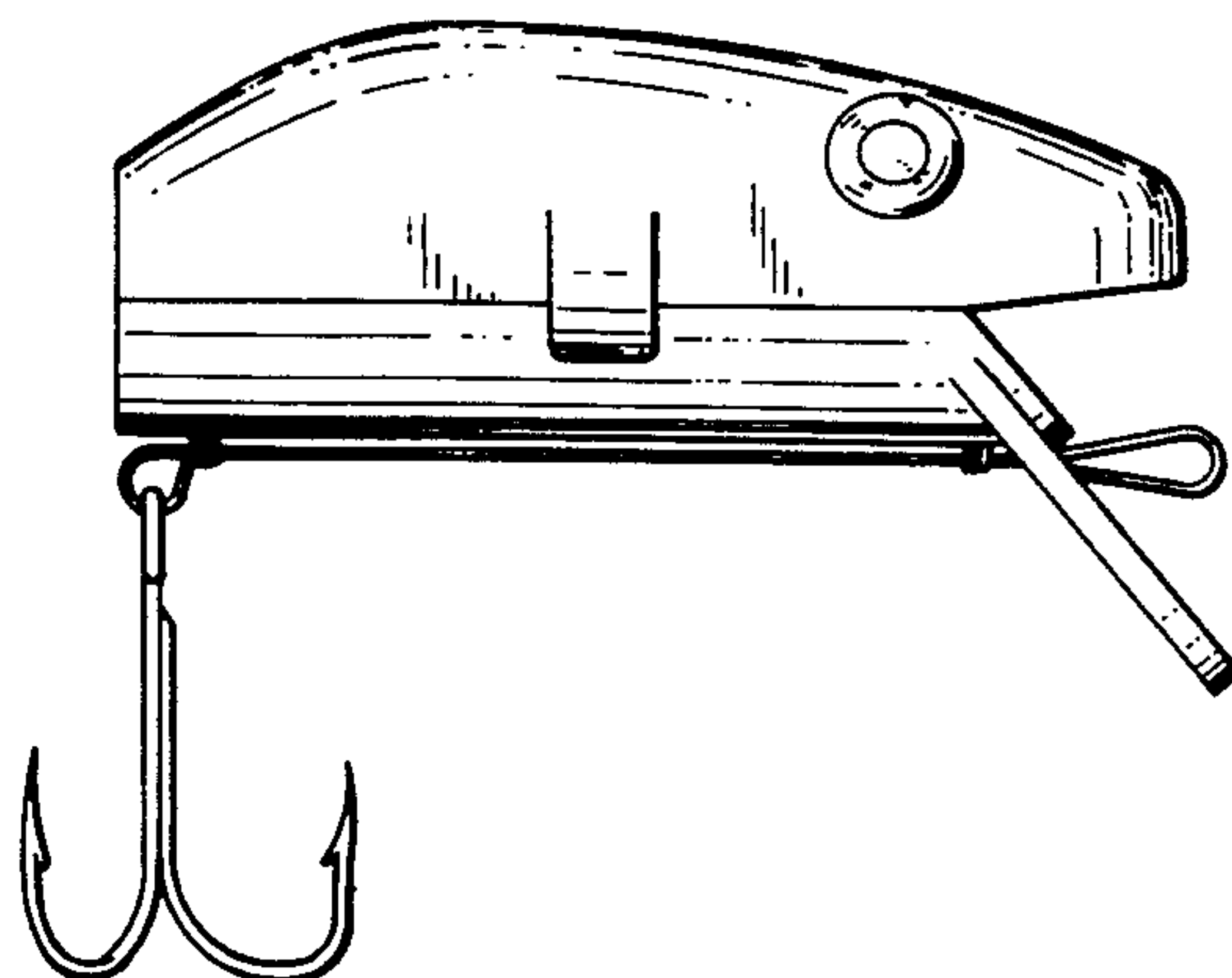

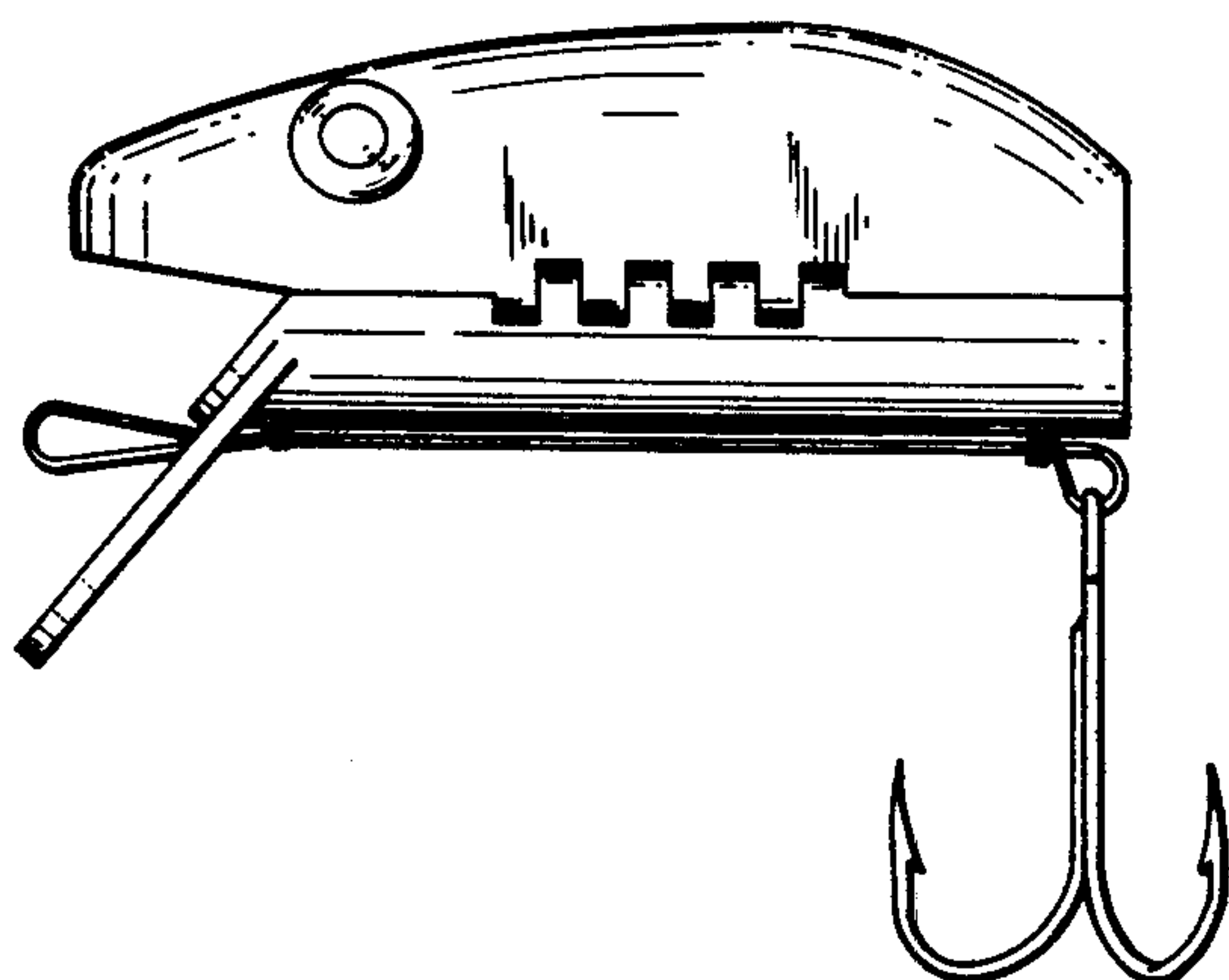

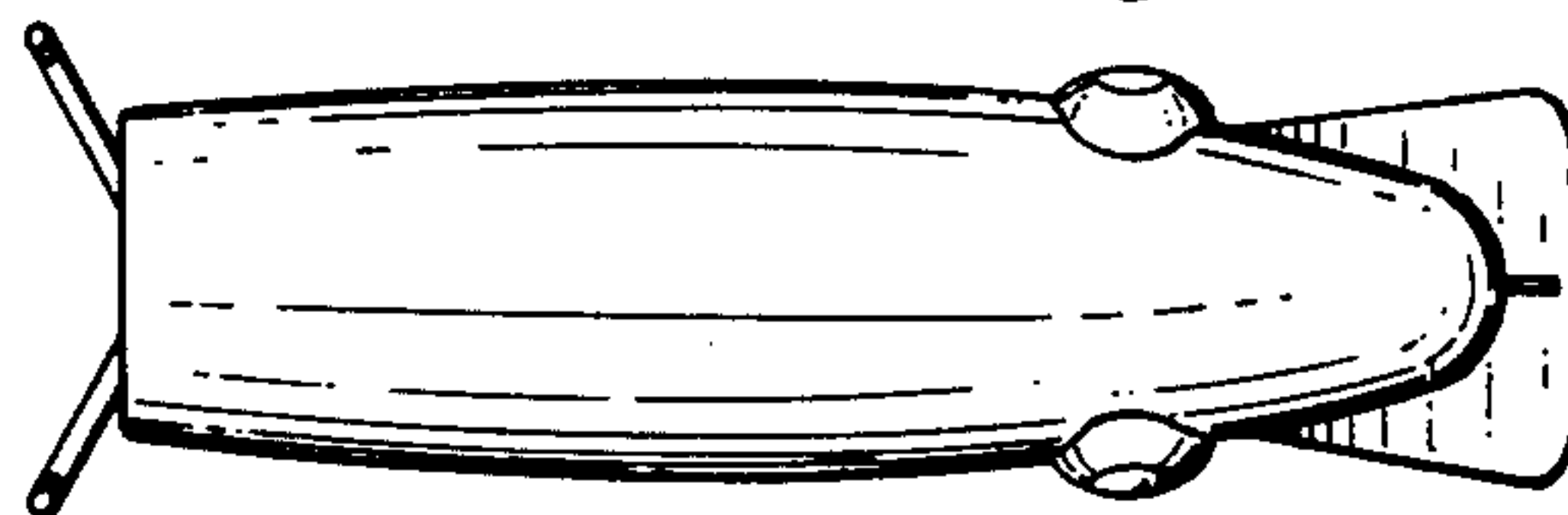

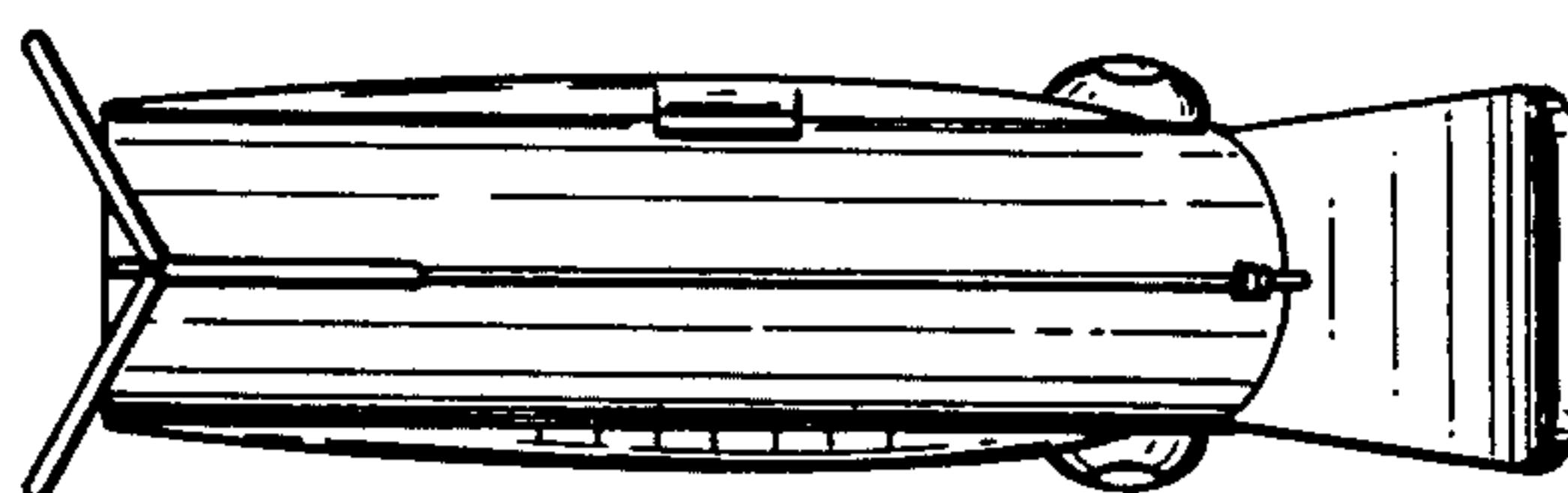

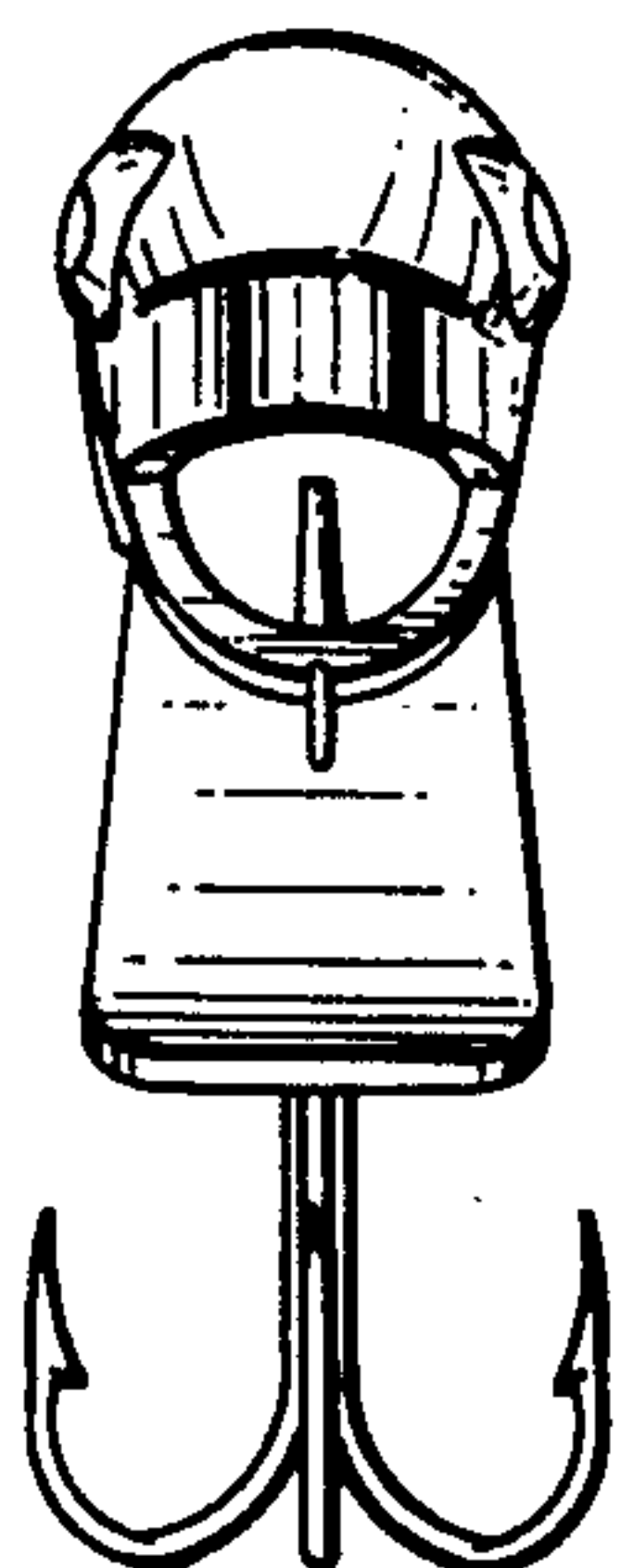
