The ornamental design for a baby bath seat, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a baby bath seat showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view showing the seat in a raised position;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of FIG. 5; and
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 5.

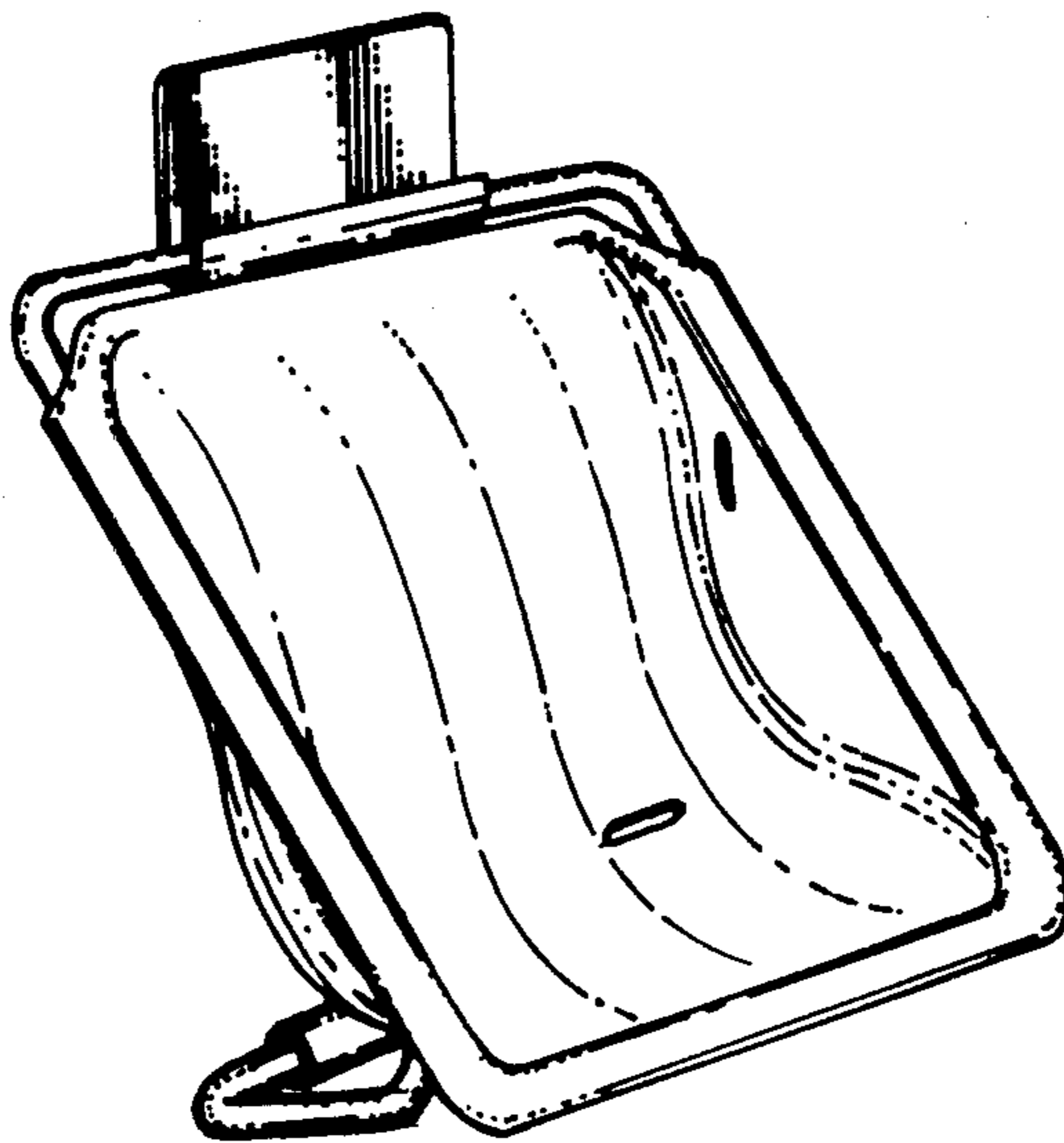

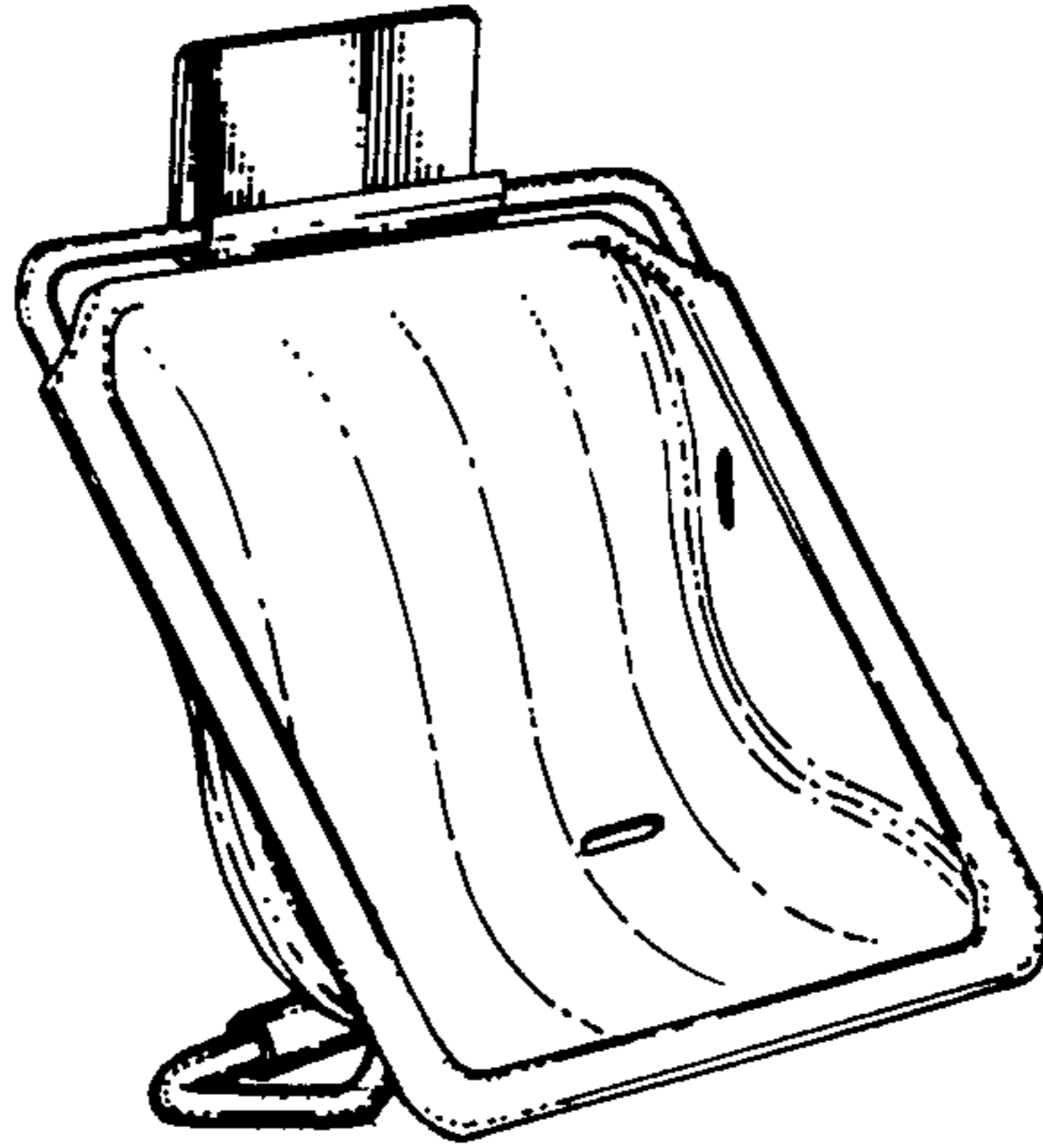

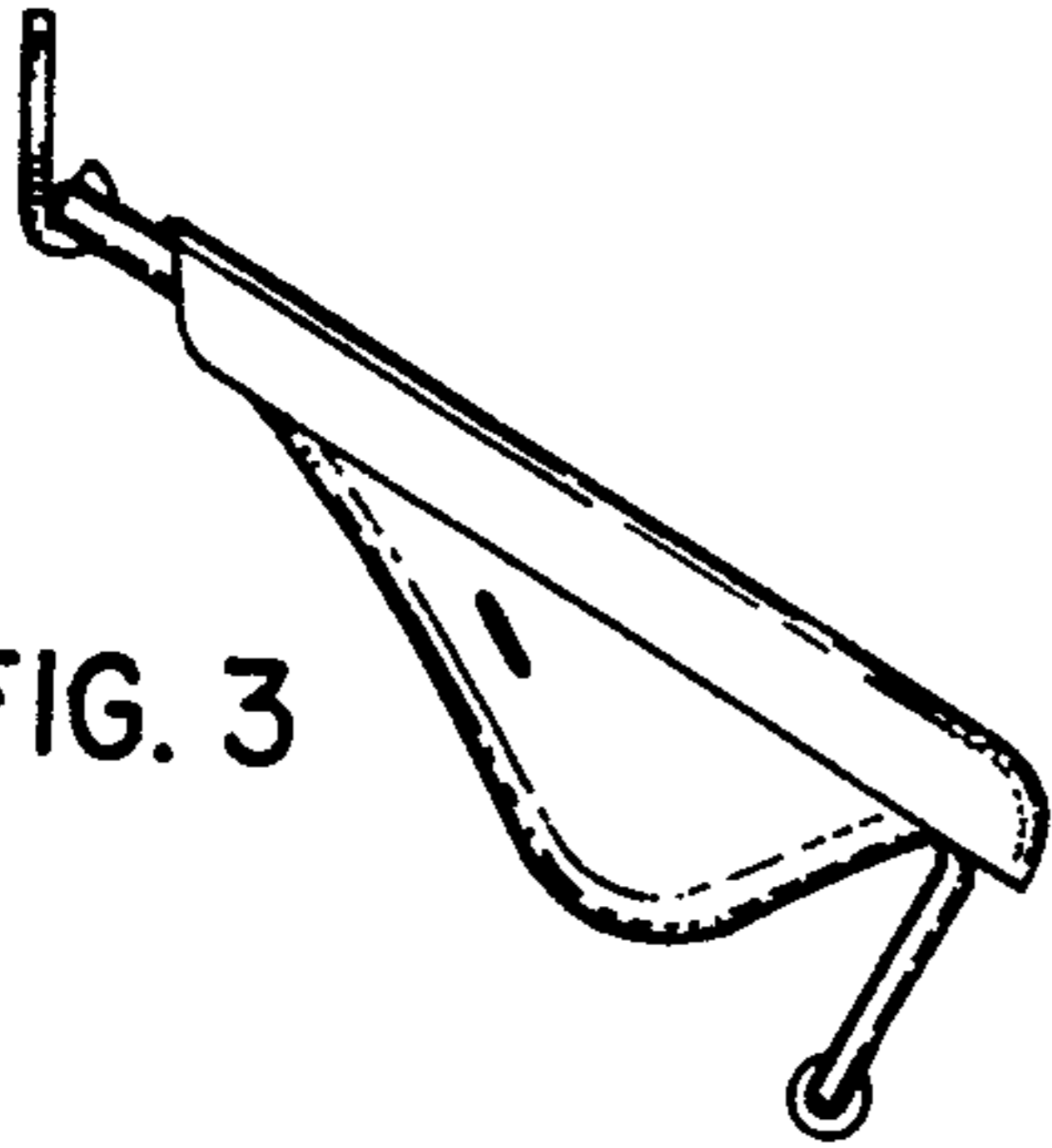

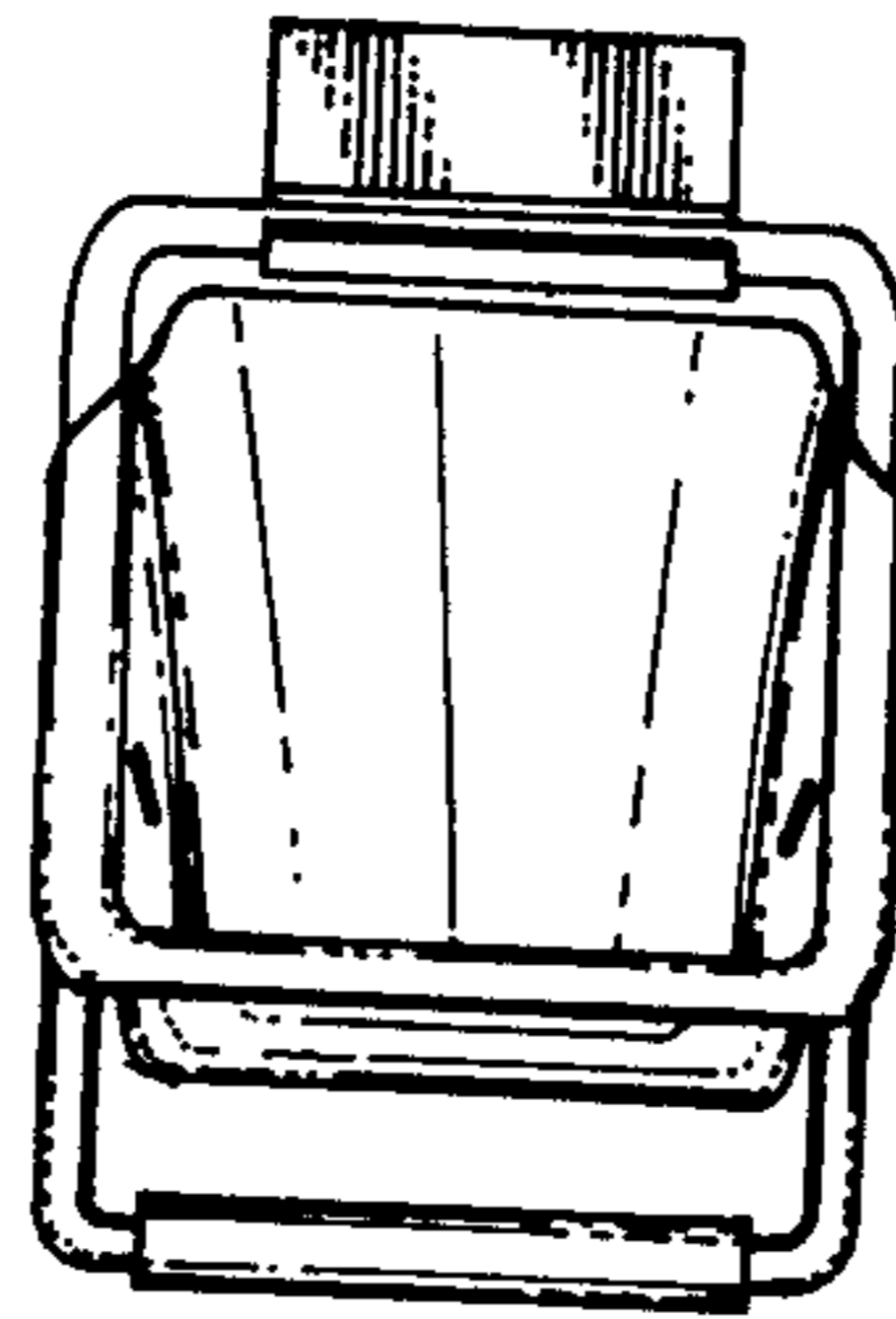

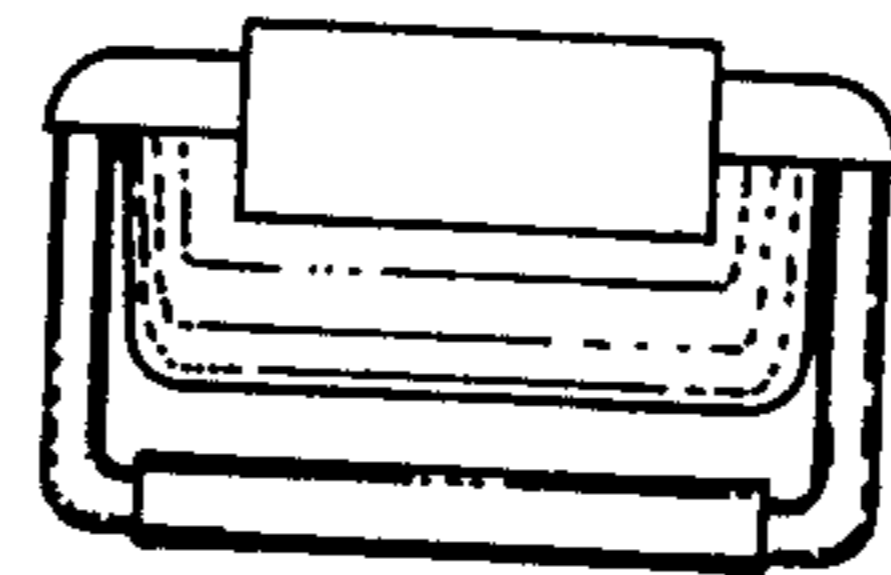
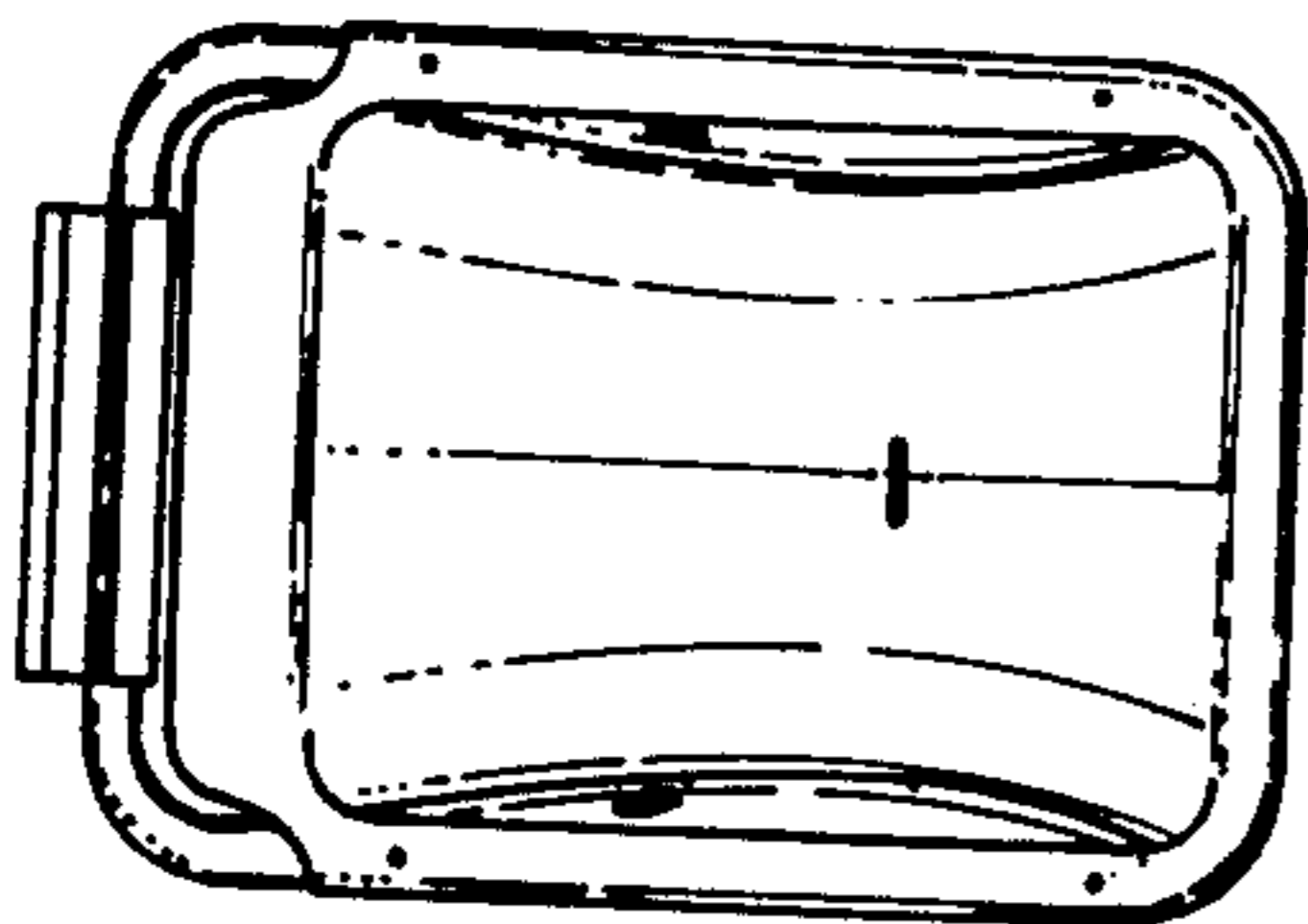

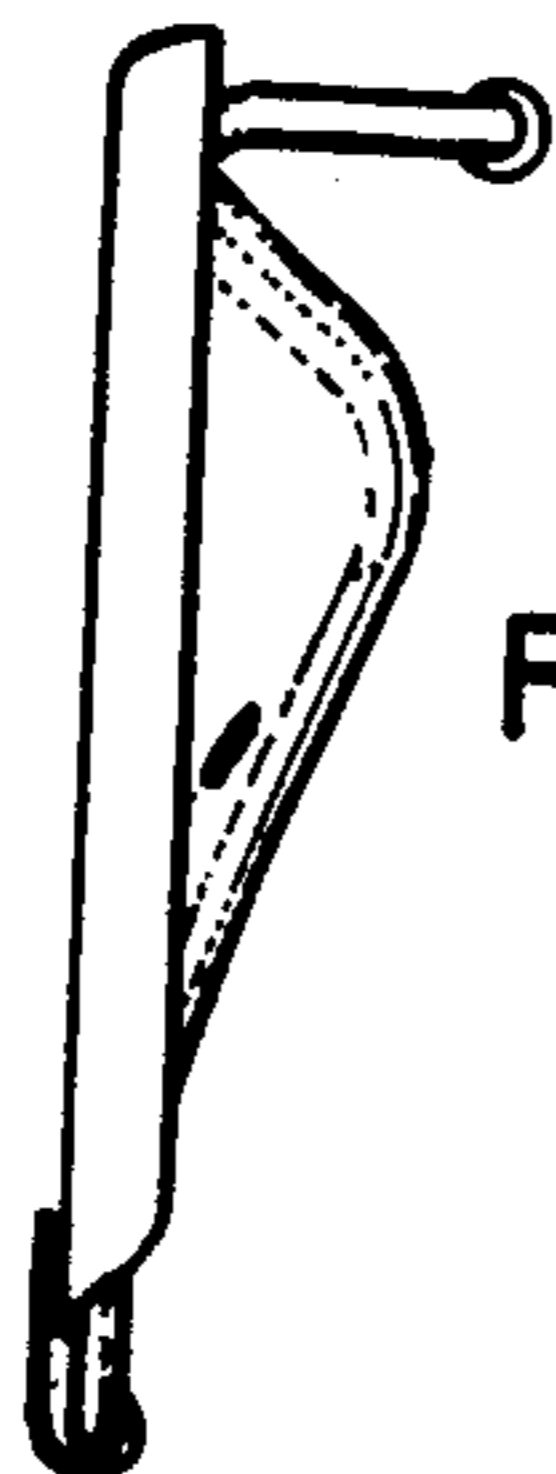
