[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wall sconce for votive
candle holder, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wall sconce for
votive candle holder showing my new design;
FIGS. 2 and 3 are top and bottom plan views, respec-
tively;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view.
The candle cup and medallion are shown in broken lines
for illustrative purposes only.
