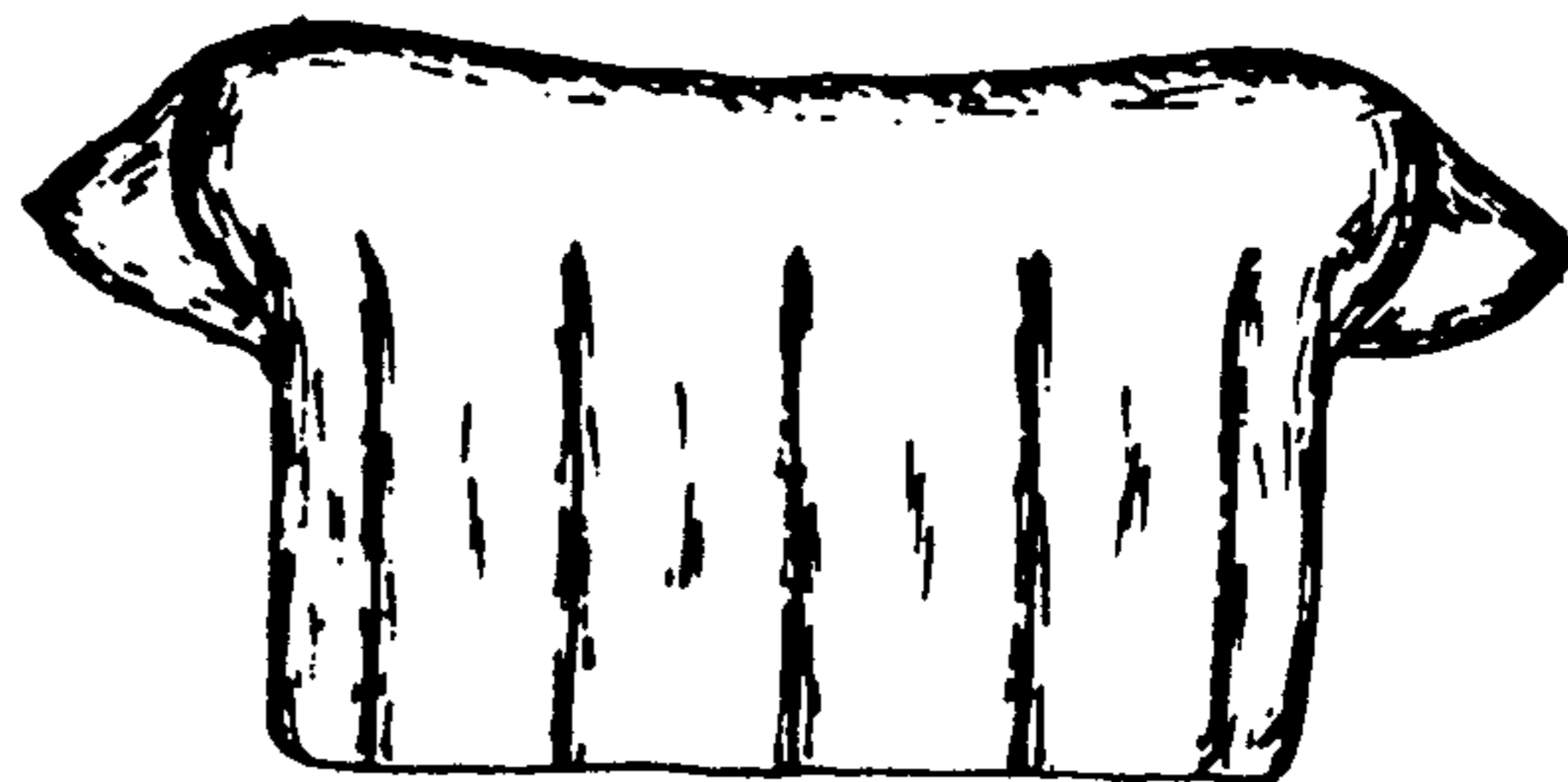
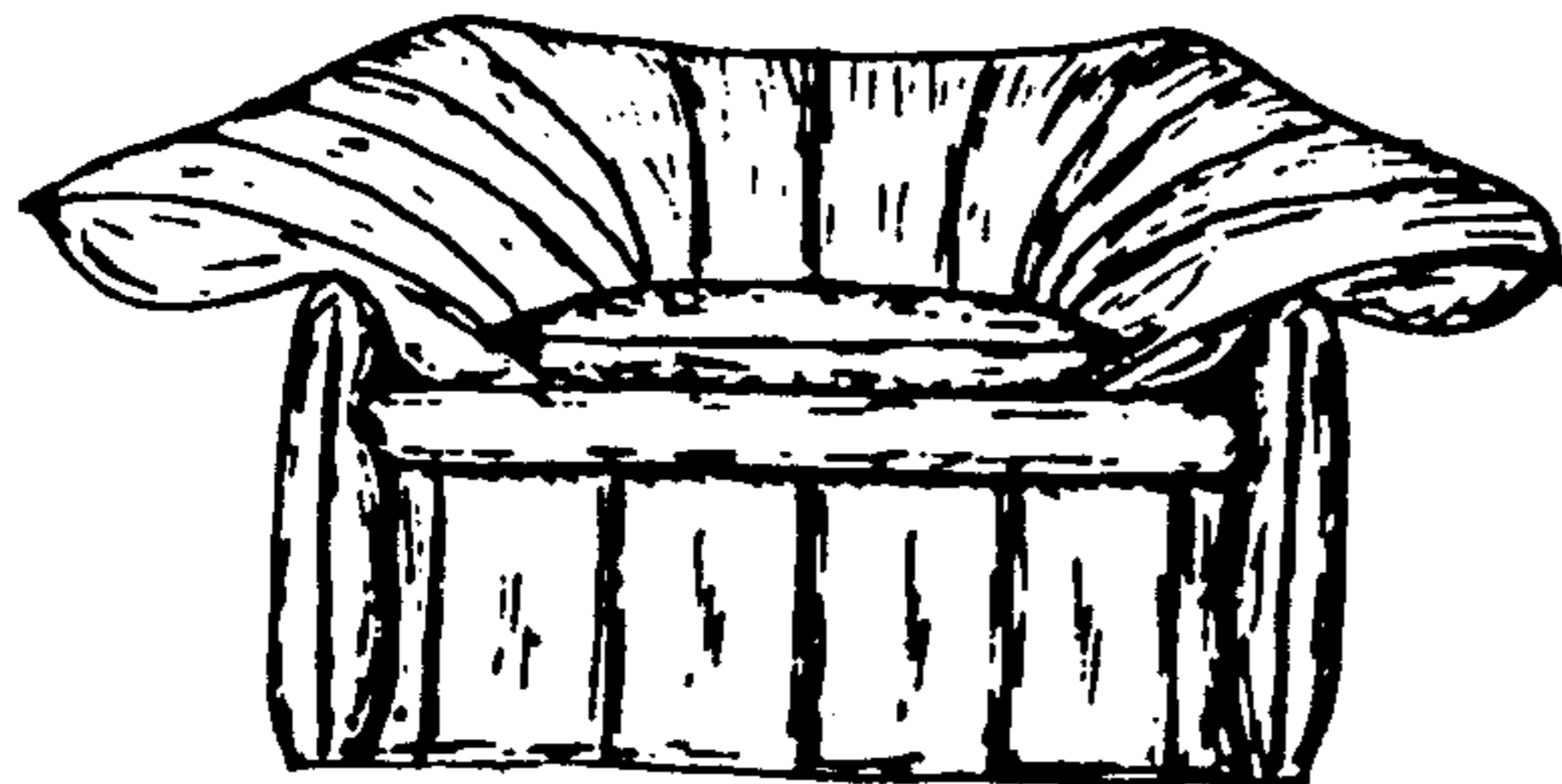

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of one embodiment of the seat of my new design in the form of an arm chair; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is an elevational view taken from either side thereof; FIG. 6 is an elevational sectional view taken from either side thereof; FIG. 7 is a view similar to that of FIG. 1 of another embodiment of my new design in the form of a divan; FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 9 is an elevational view taken from either side thereof; FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 12 is an elevational sectional view taken from either side thereof.



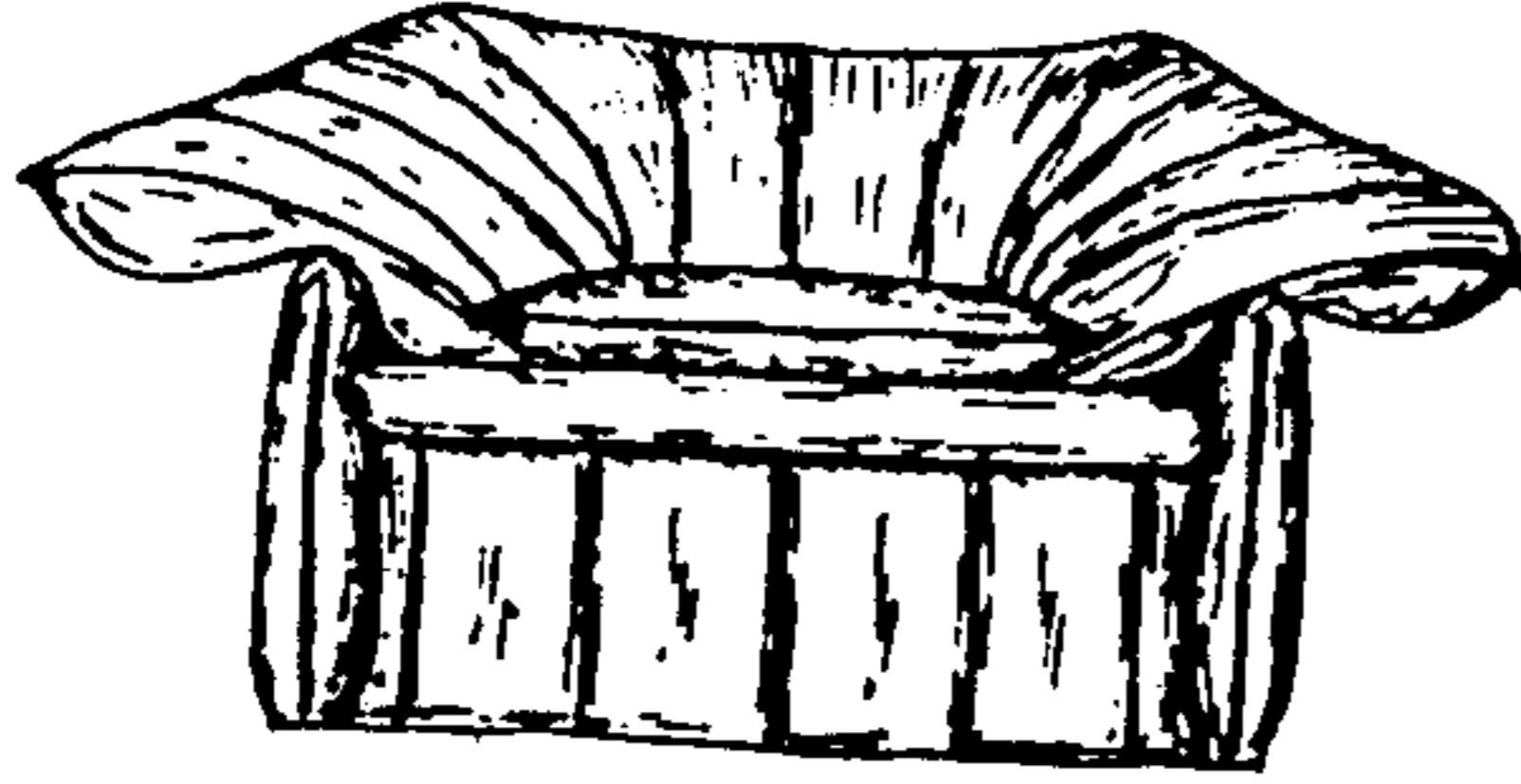

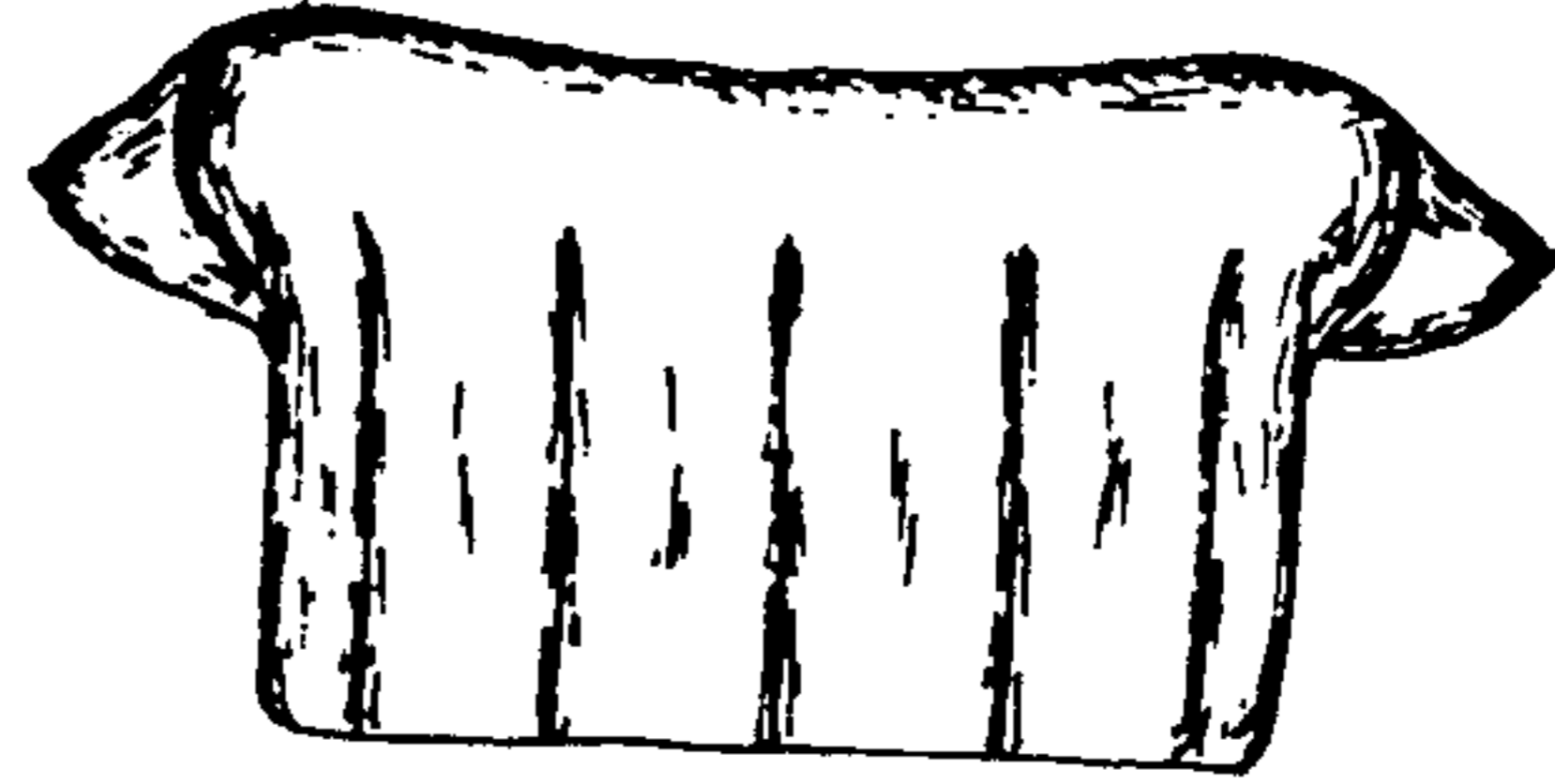

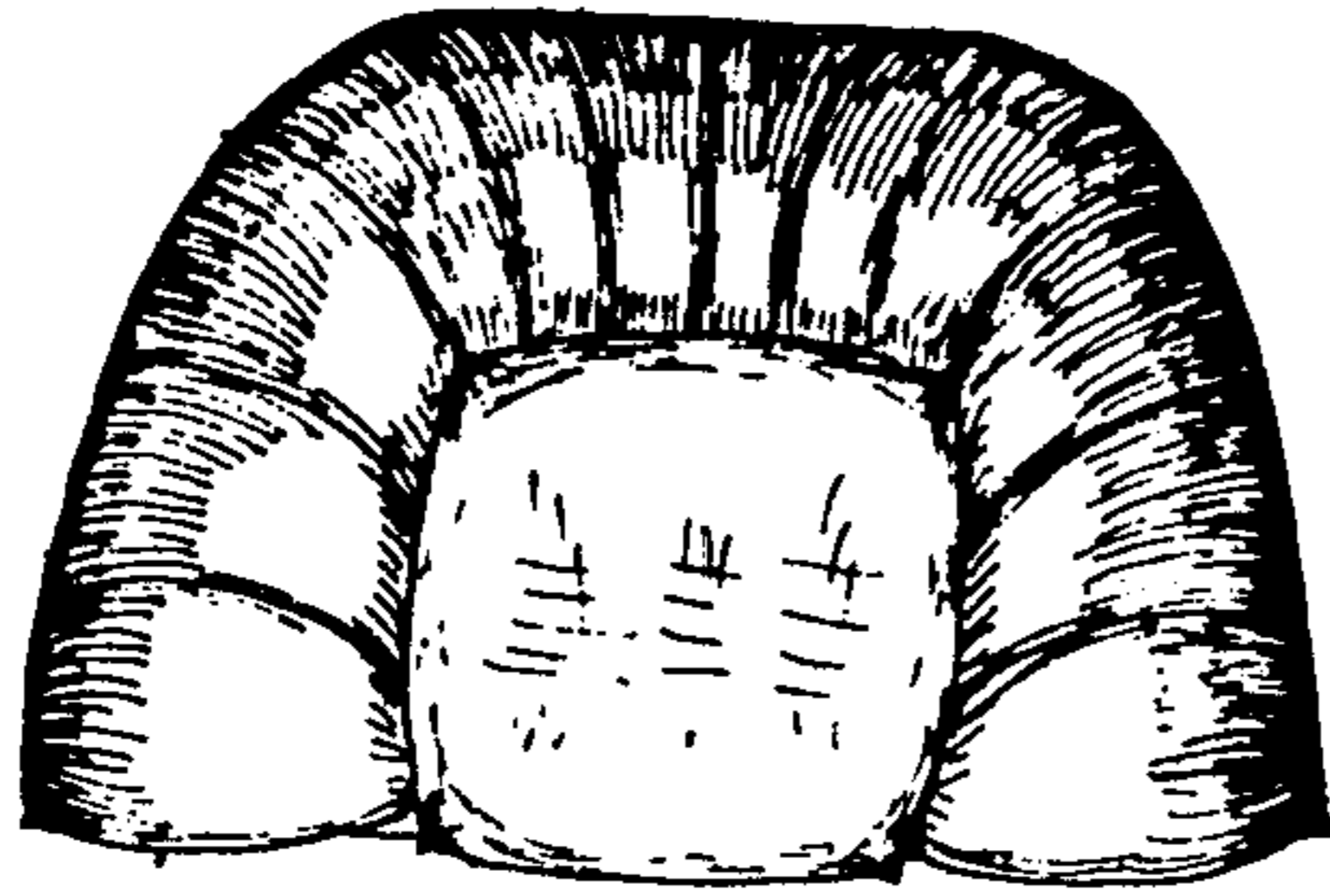

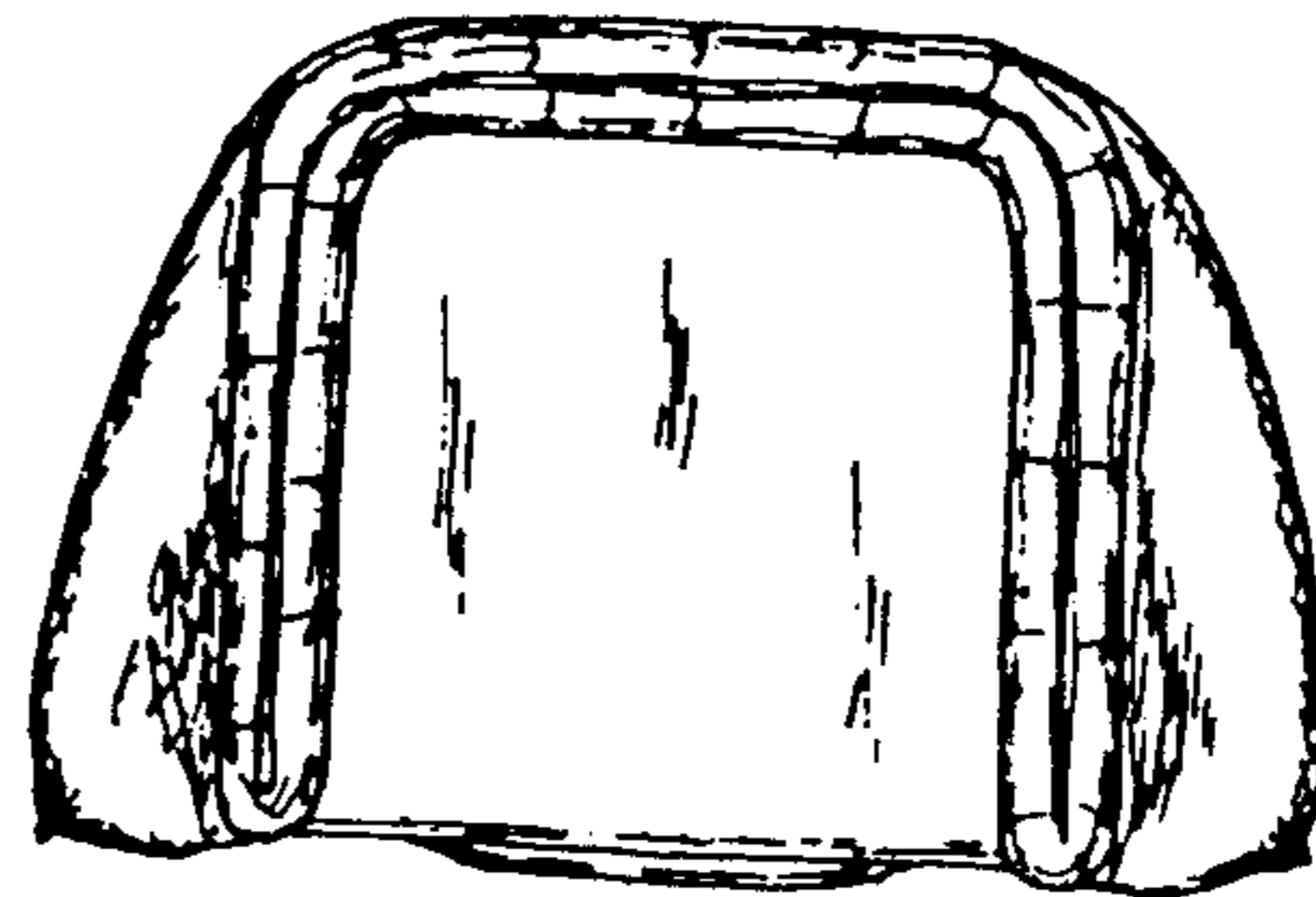

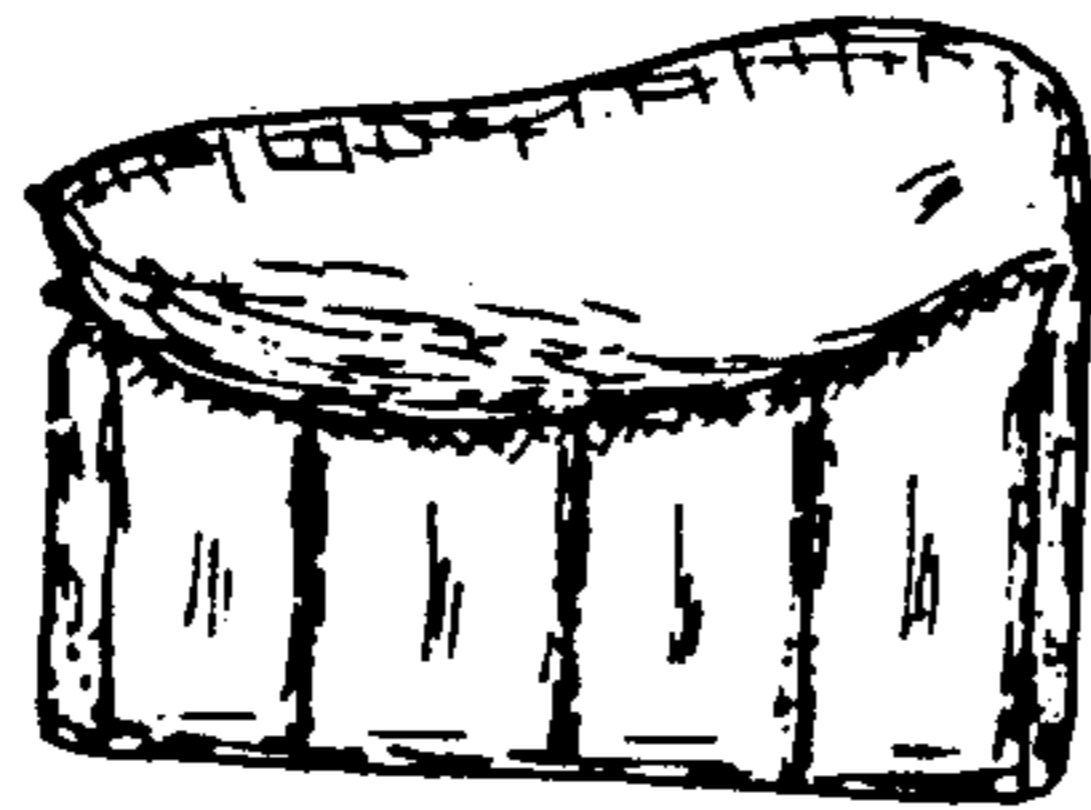

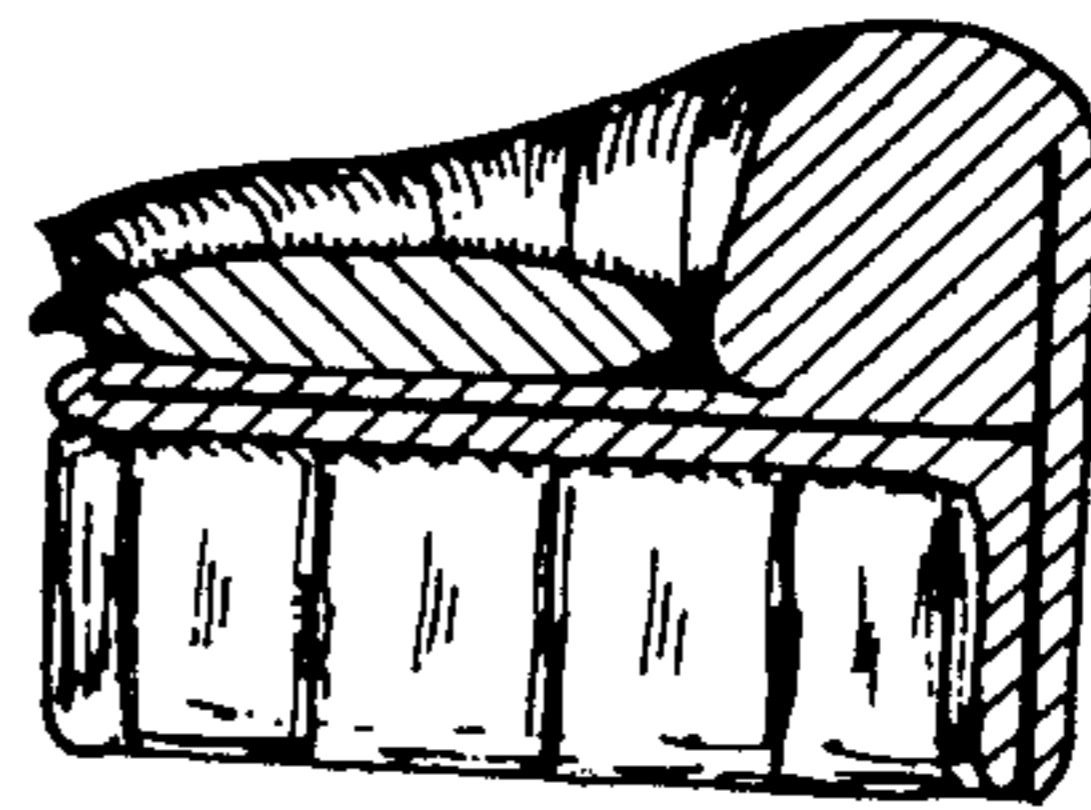

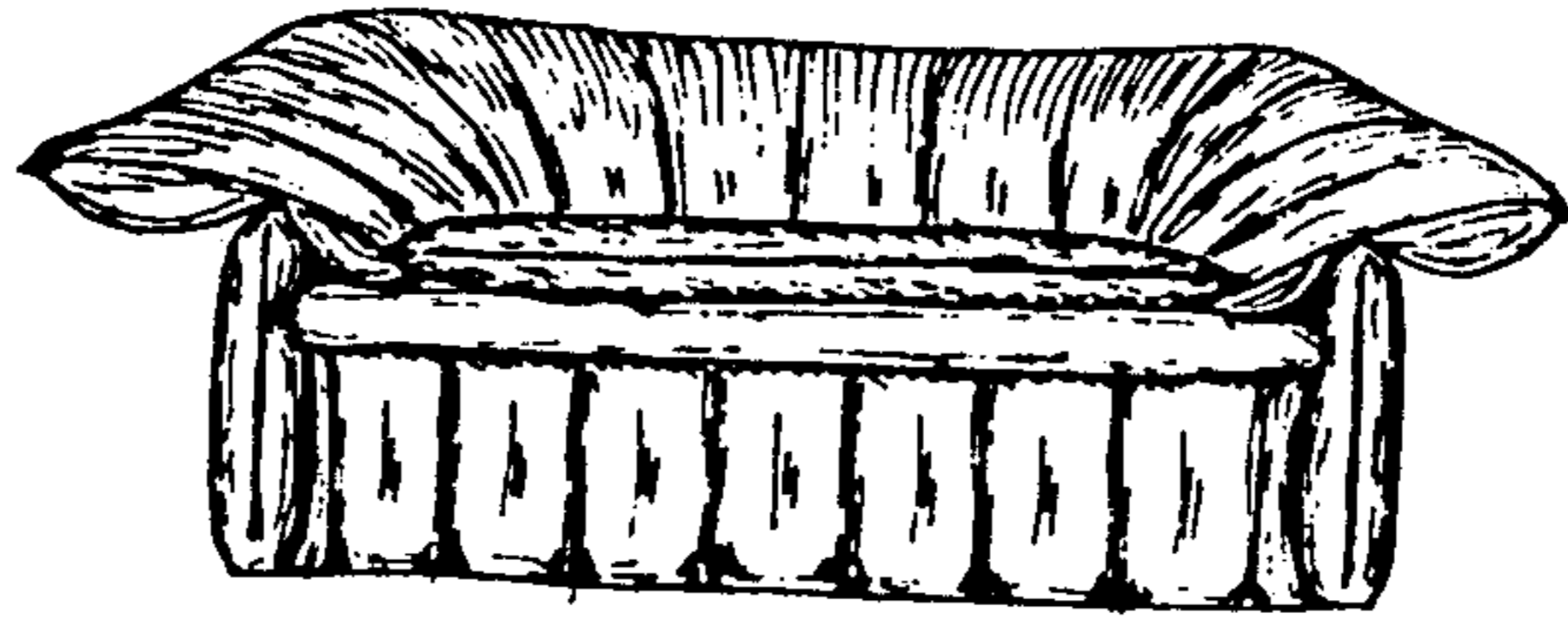

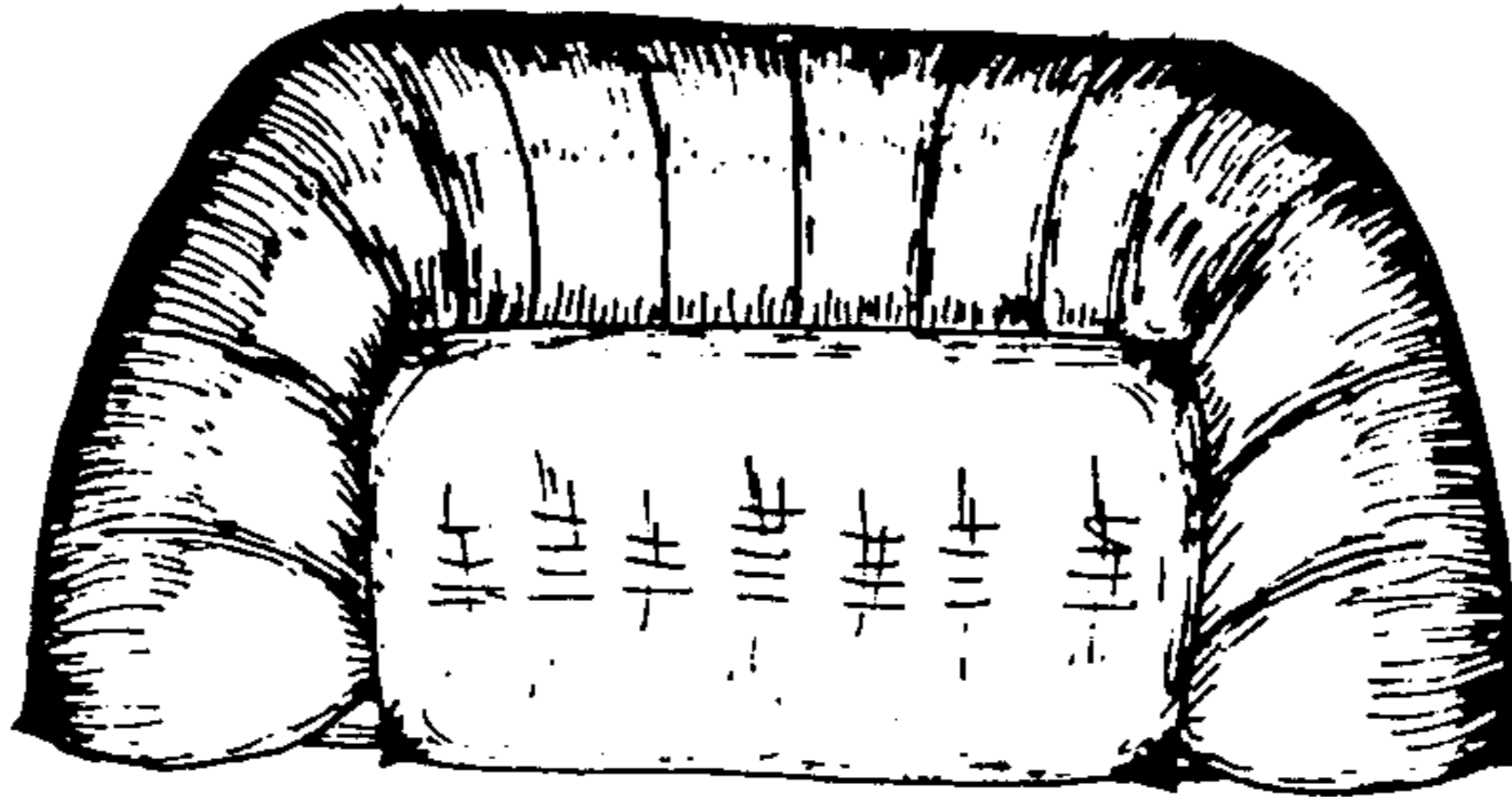

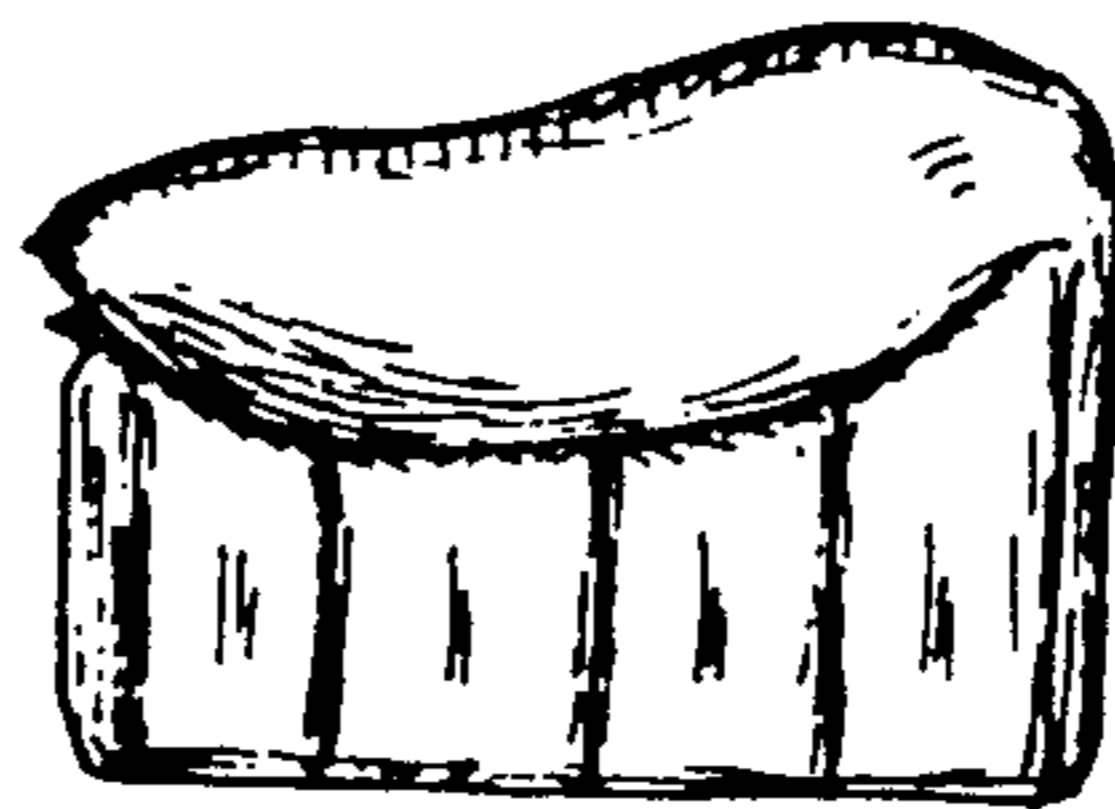

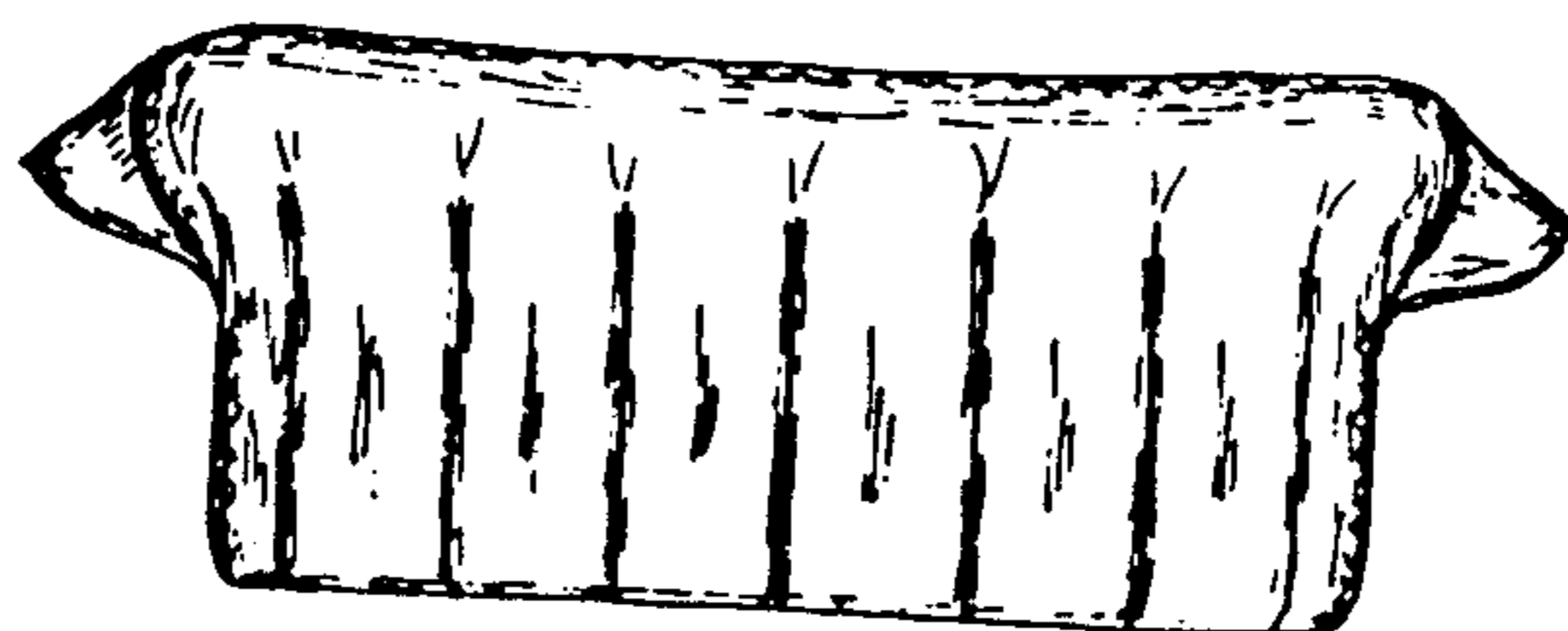

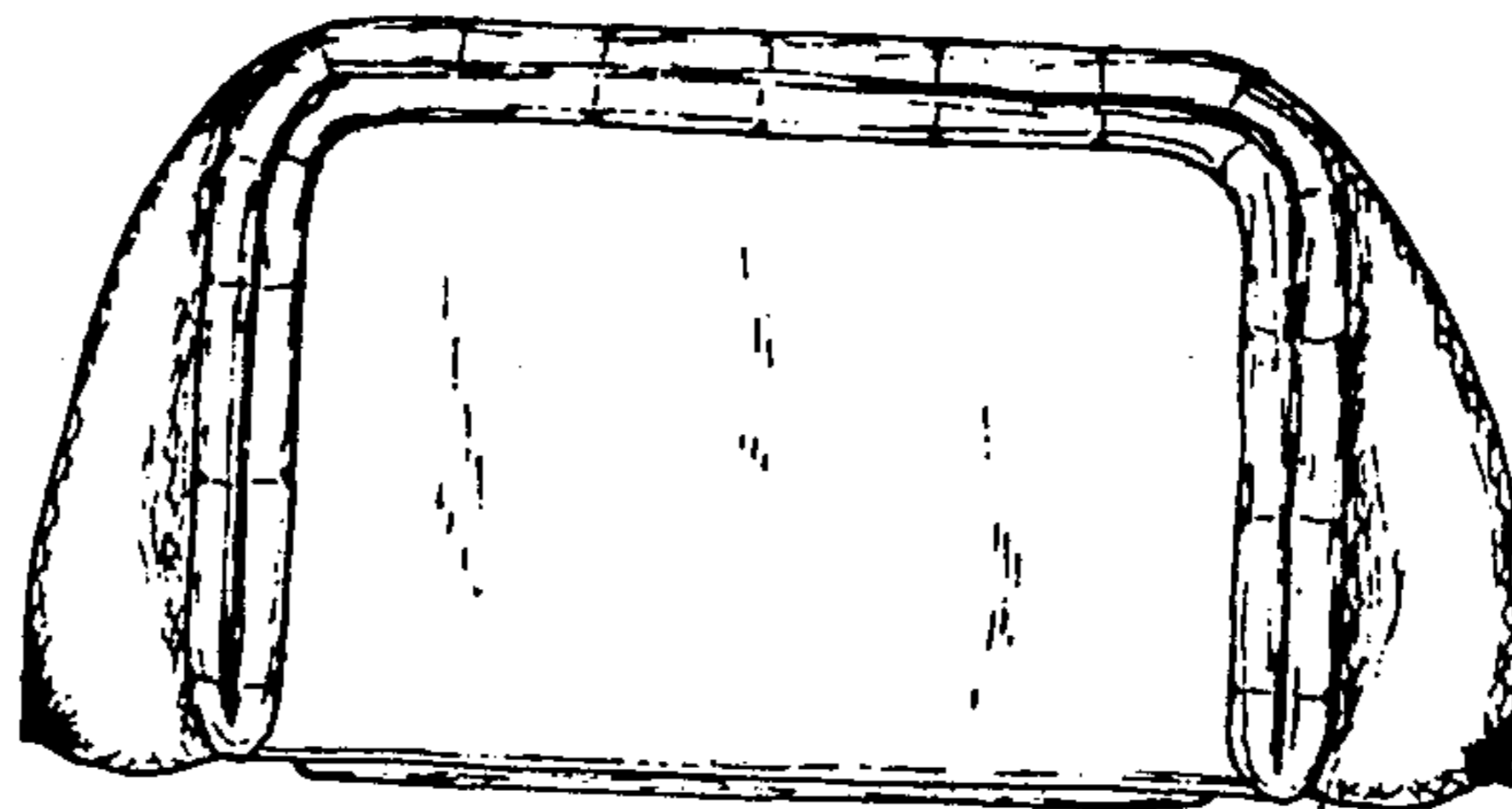
