[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an electrophotographic machine or the like, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, right side and front perspective view of an electrophotographic machine or the like showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a top, left side and rear perspective view thereof.

The bottom of the electrophotographic machine is substantially planar and unornamented.

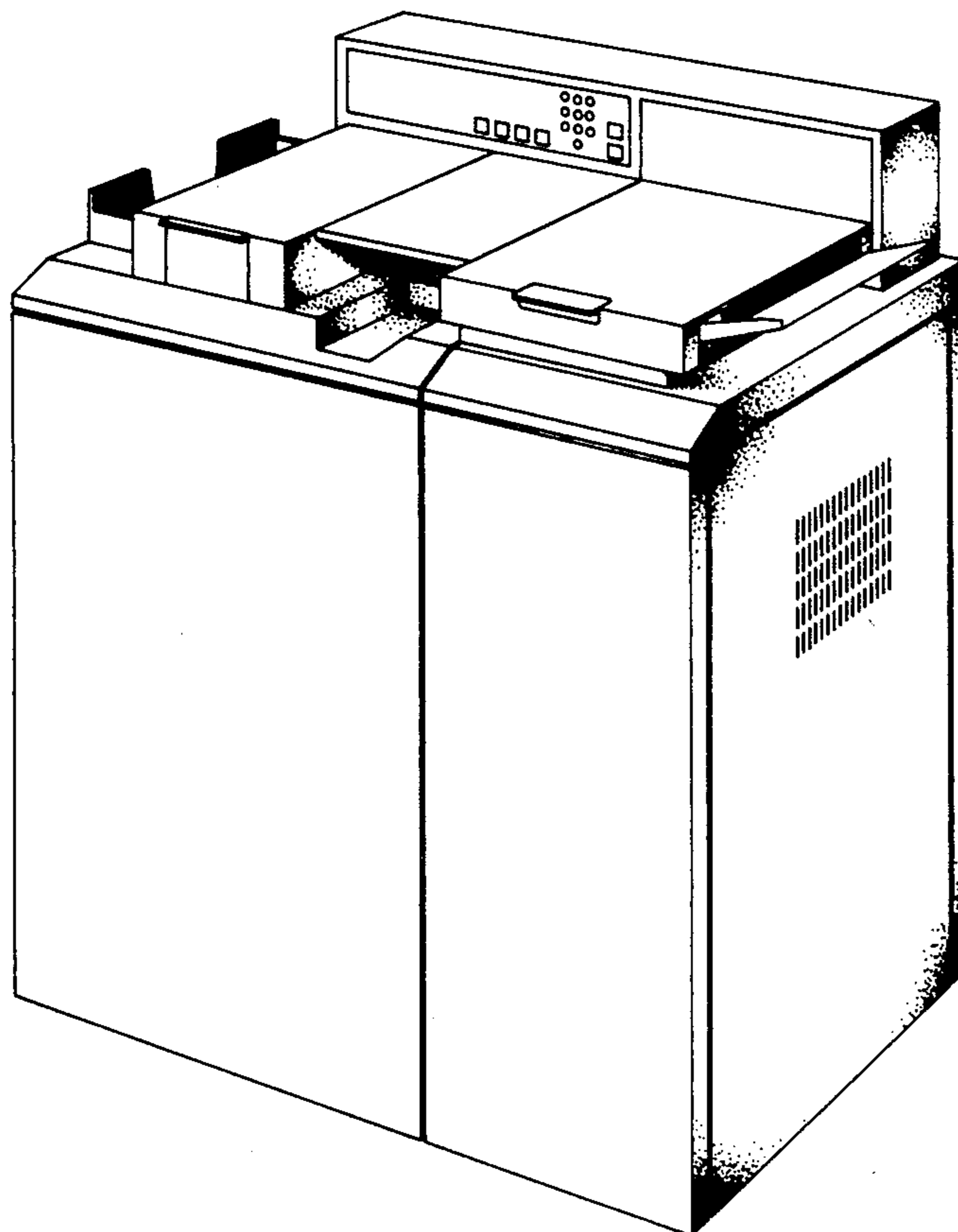

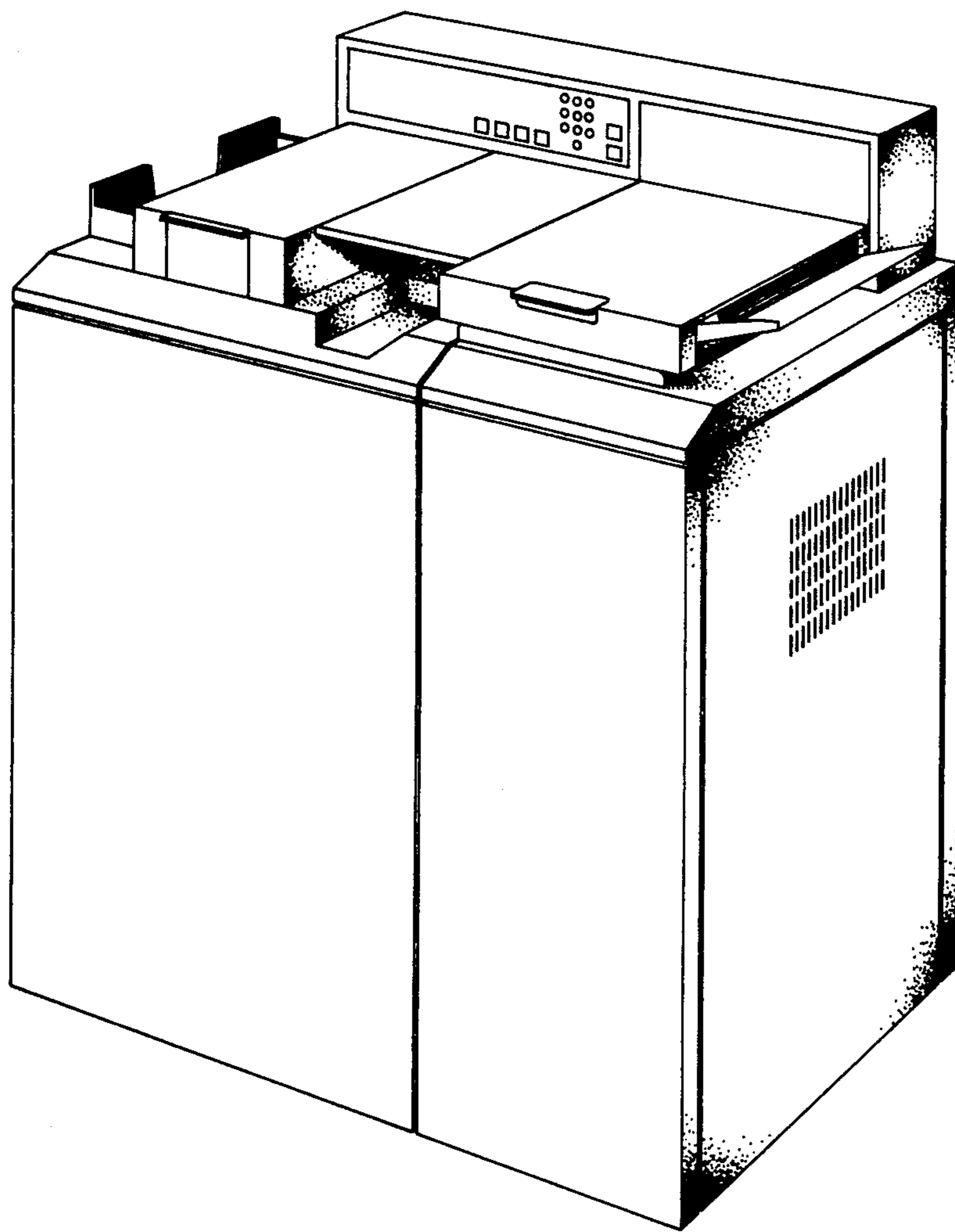
