DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the boy doll embodying my design;

FIG. 4 is a side view thereof as viewed from the right side of FIG. 3.

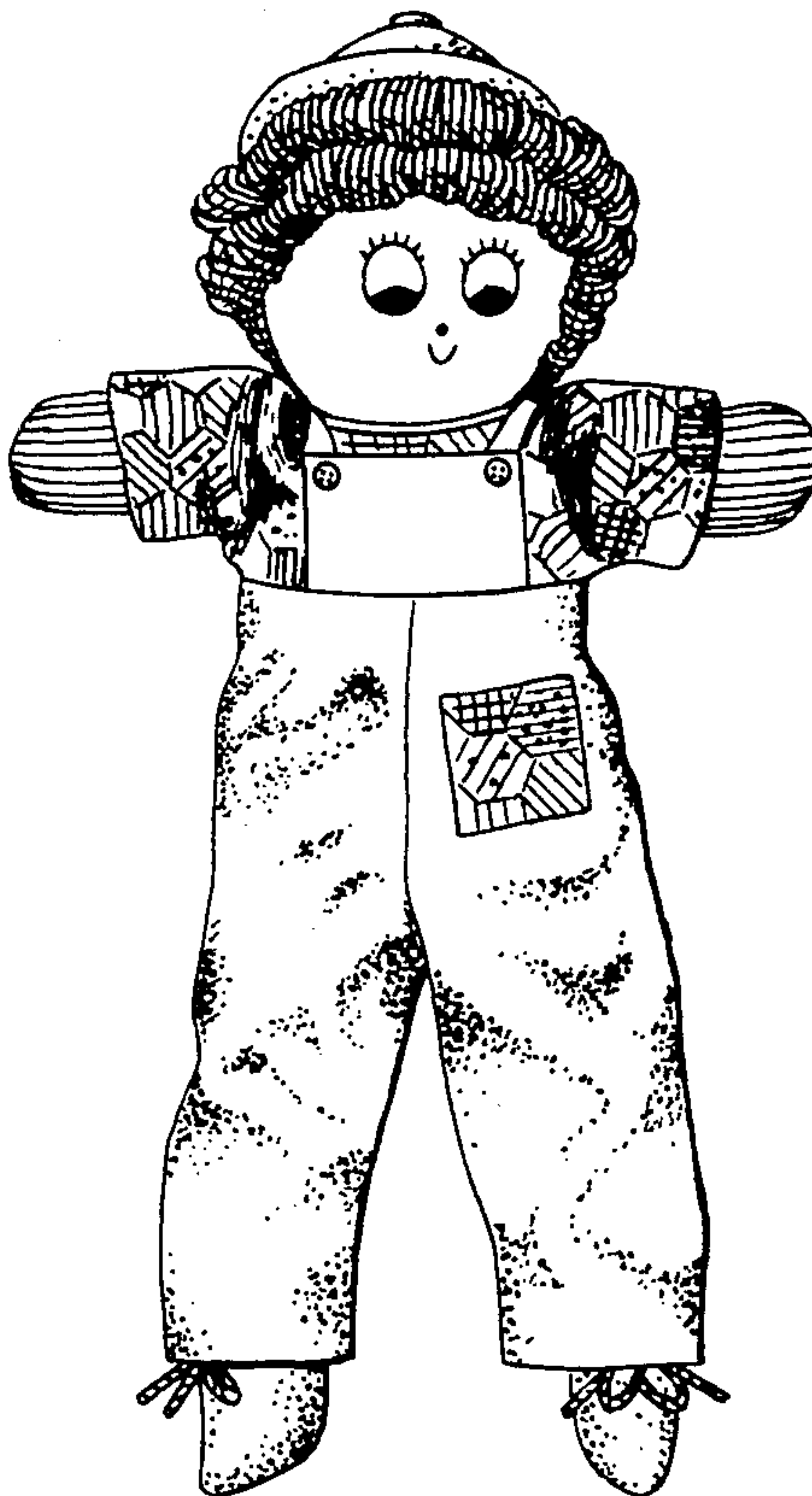

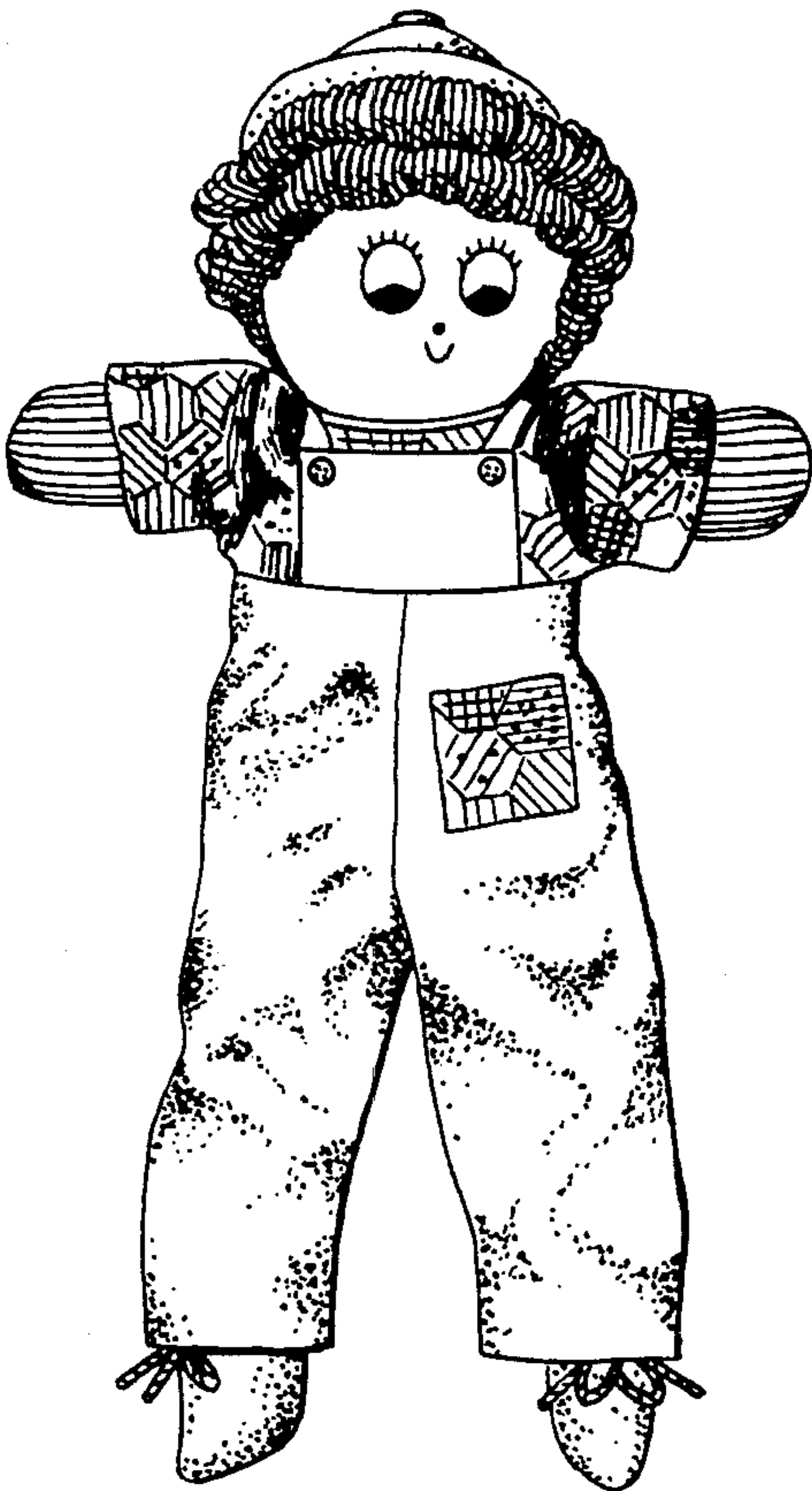

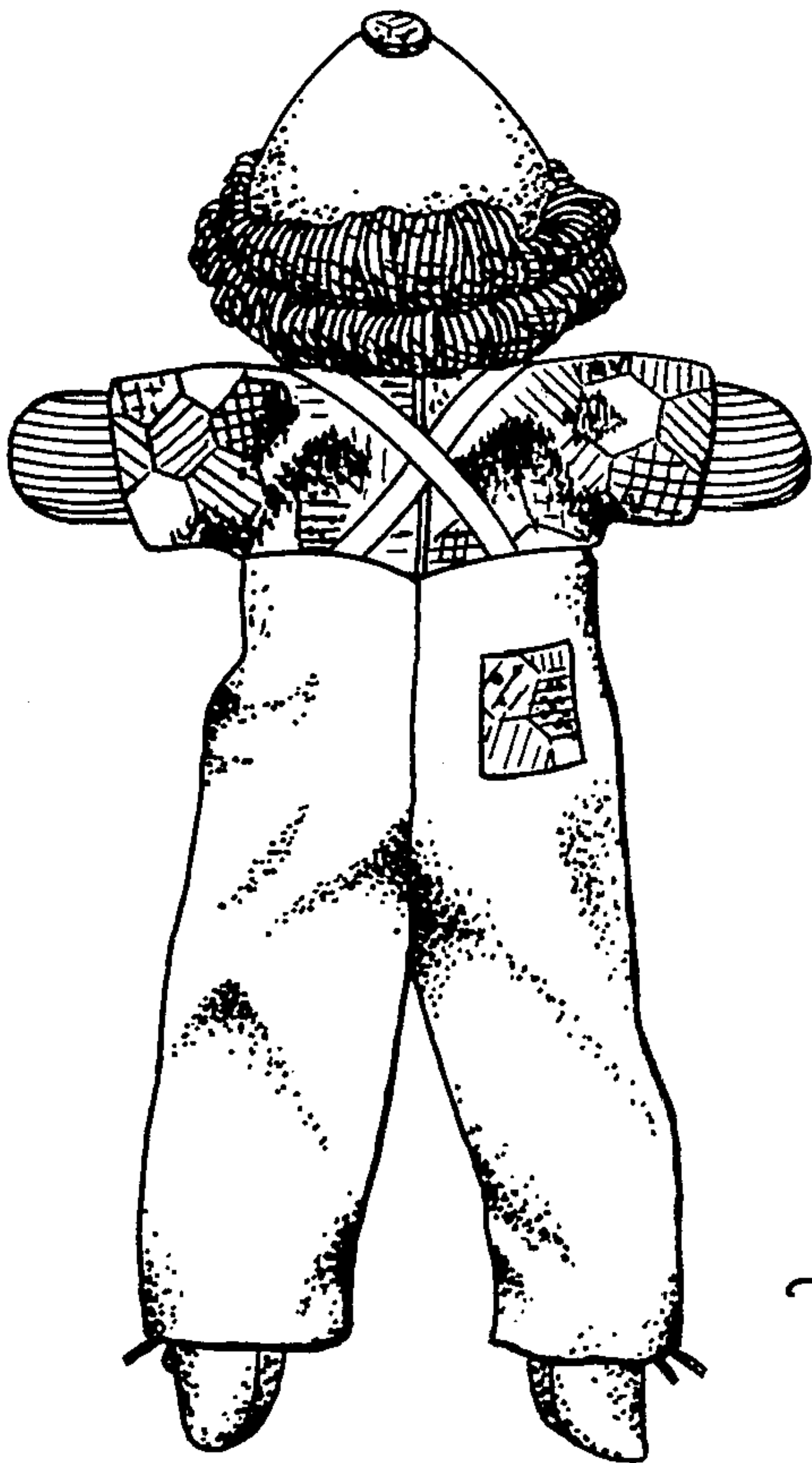
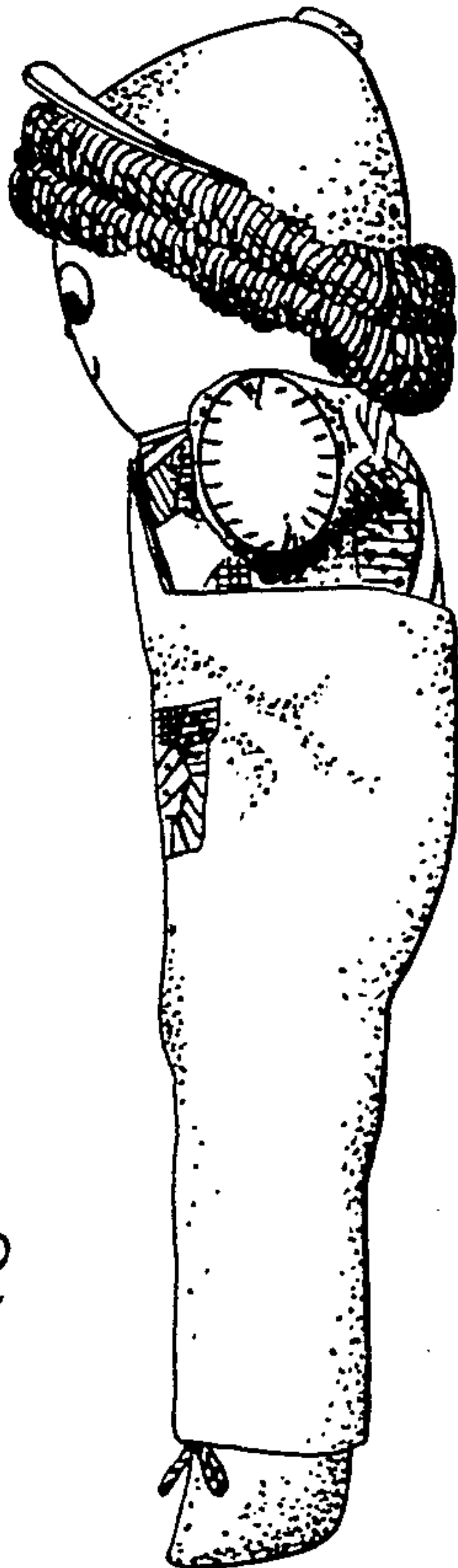

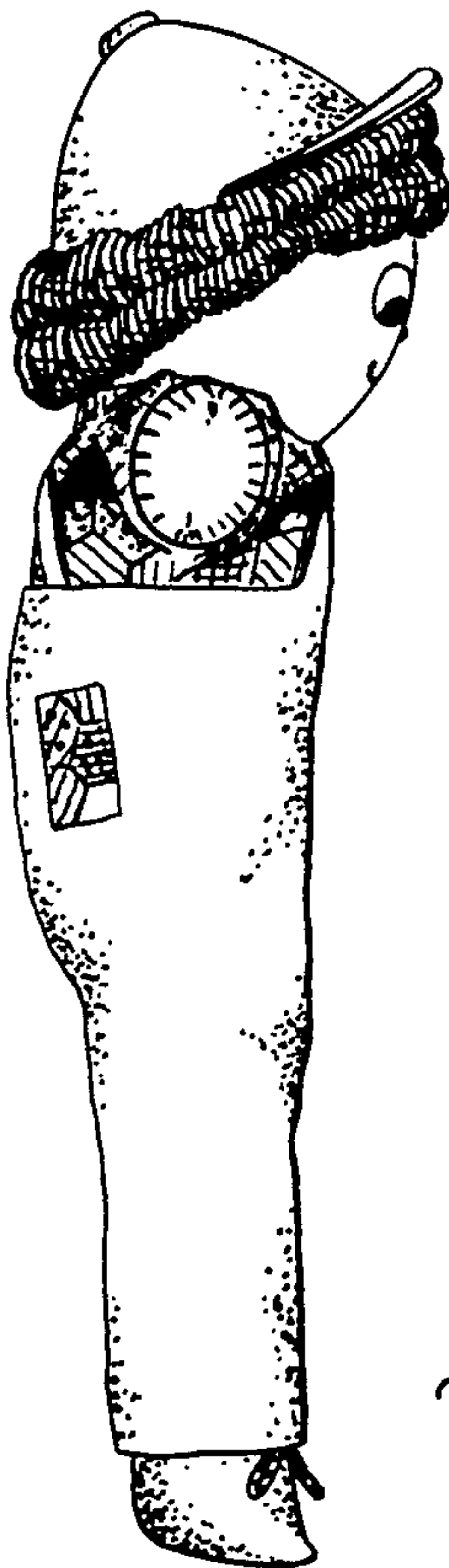
