The ornamental design for a percussion musical instrument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, bottom and right side perspective view of a percussion musical instrument showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view, the rear being identical; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.

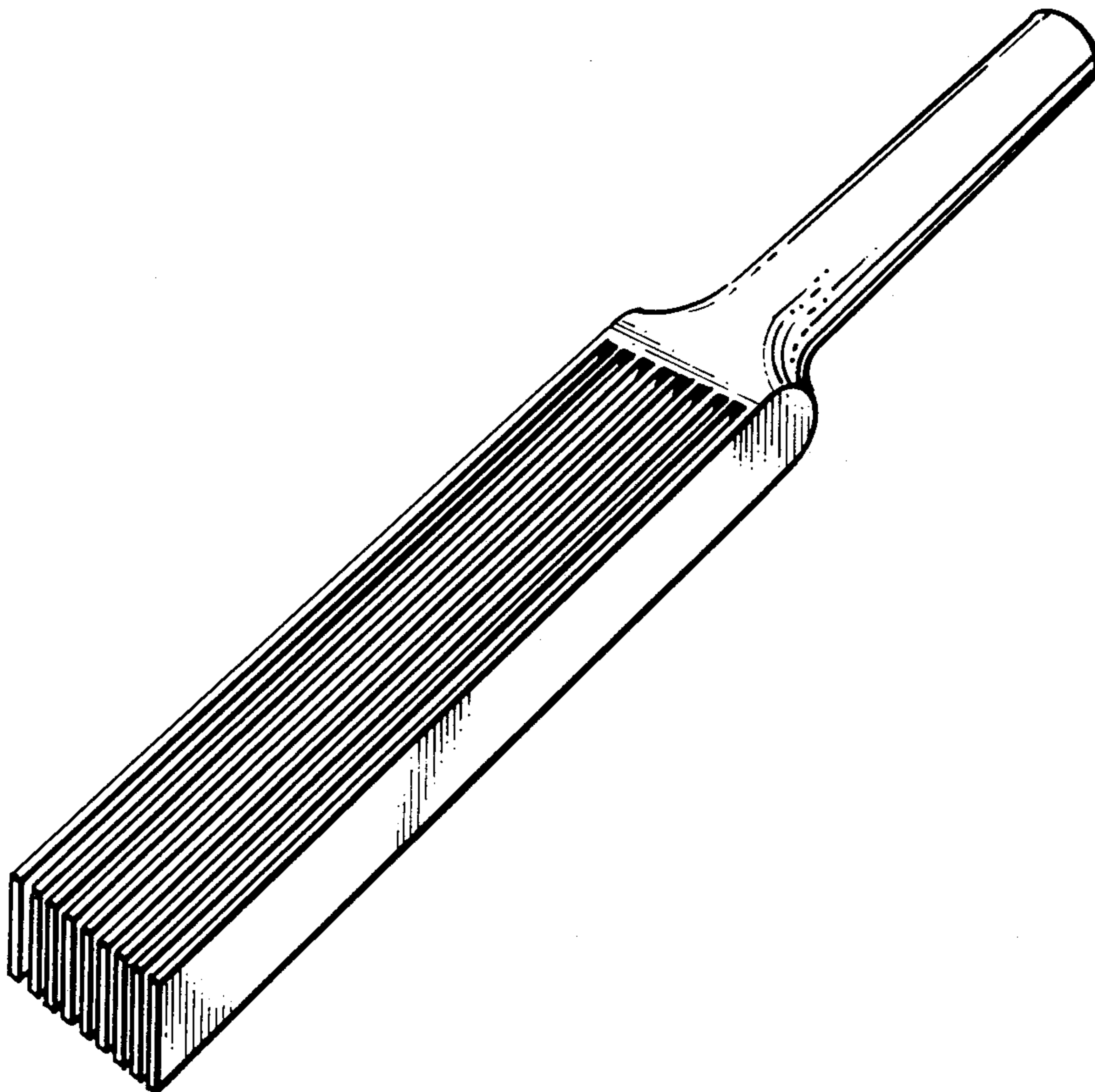

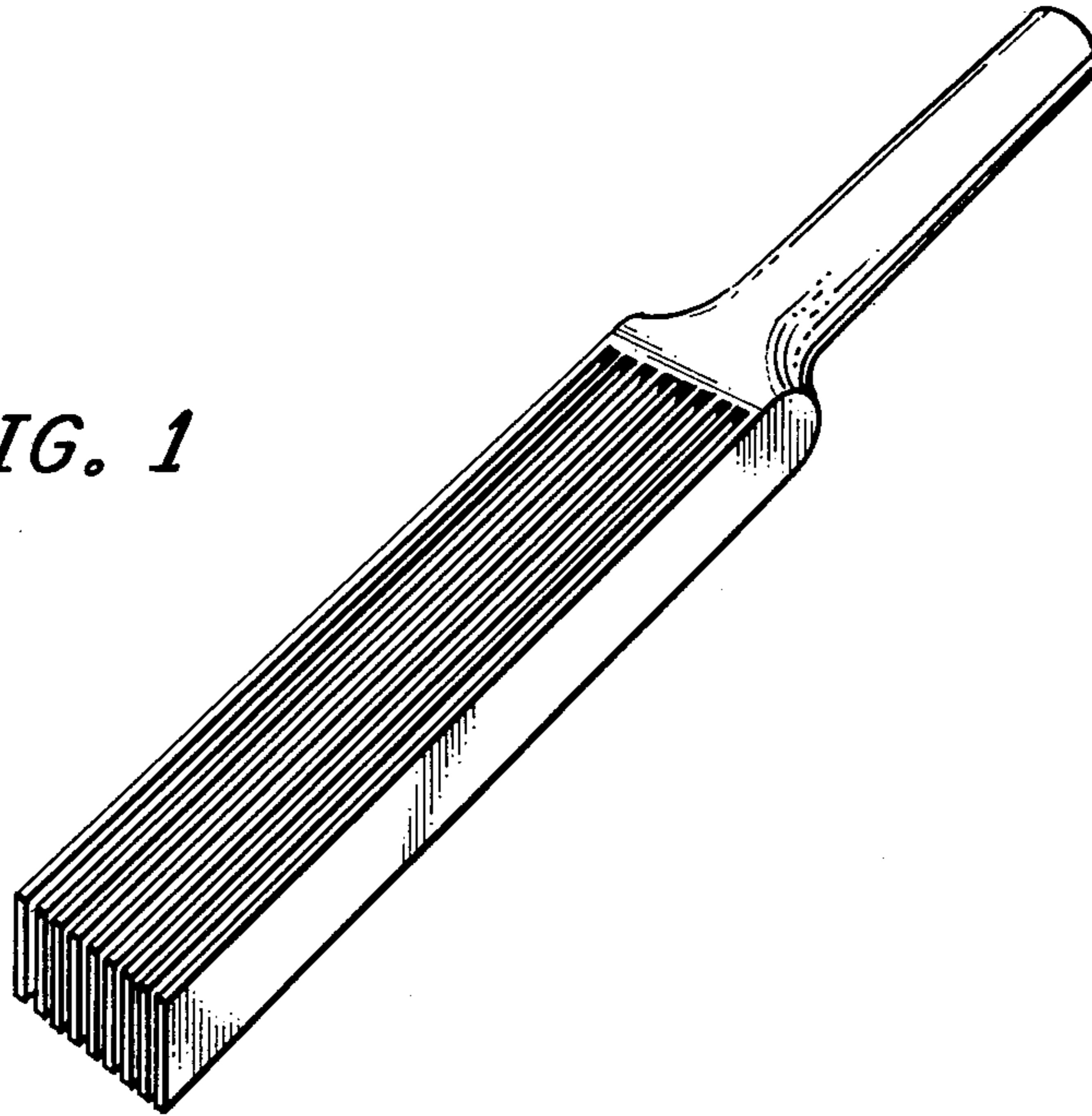

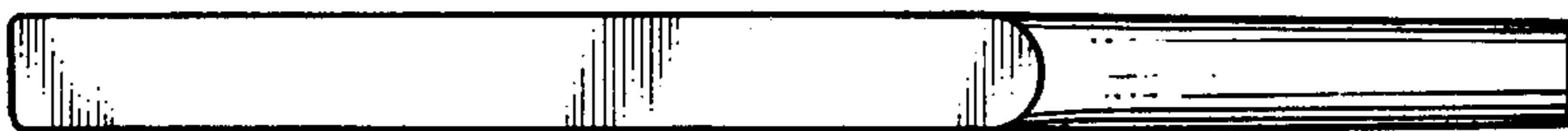

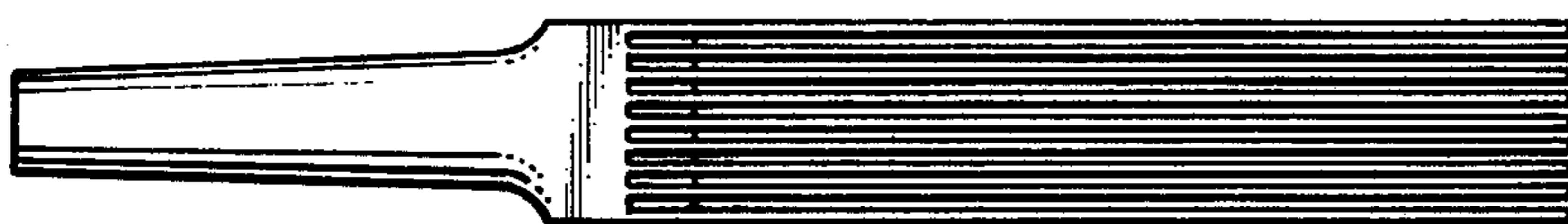
