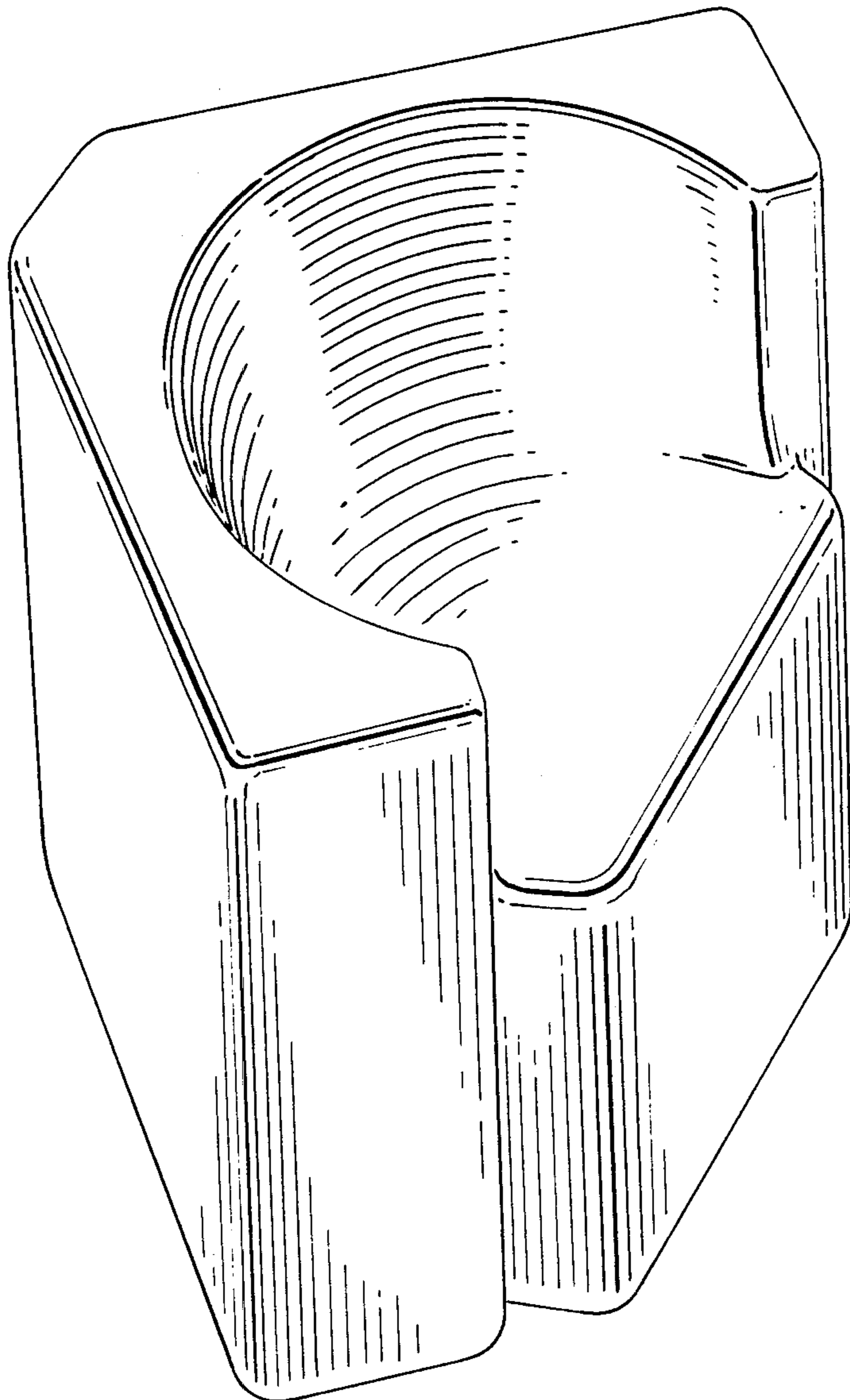

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chair viewed from the front and to one side;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the chair;

FIG. 4 is an underneath plan view of the chair.



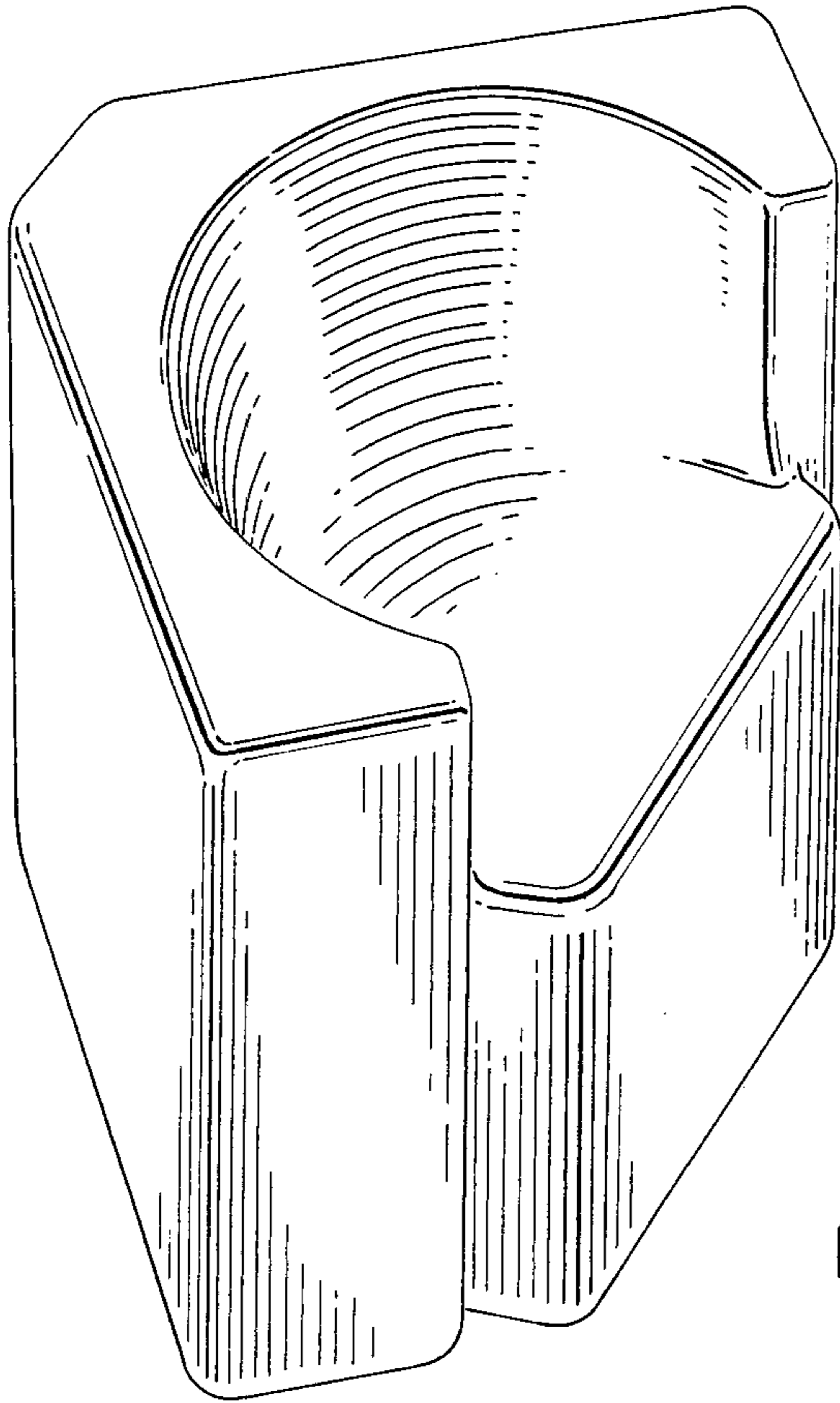

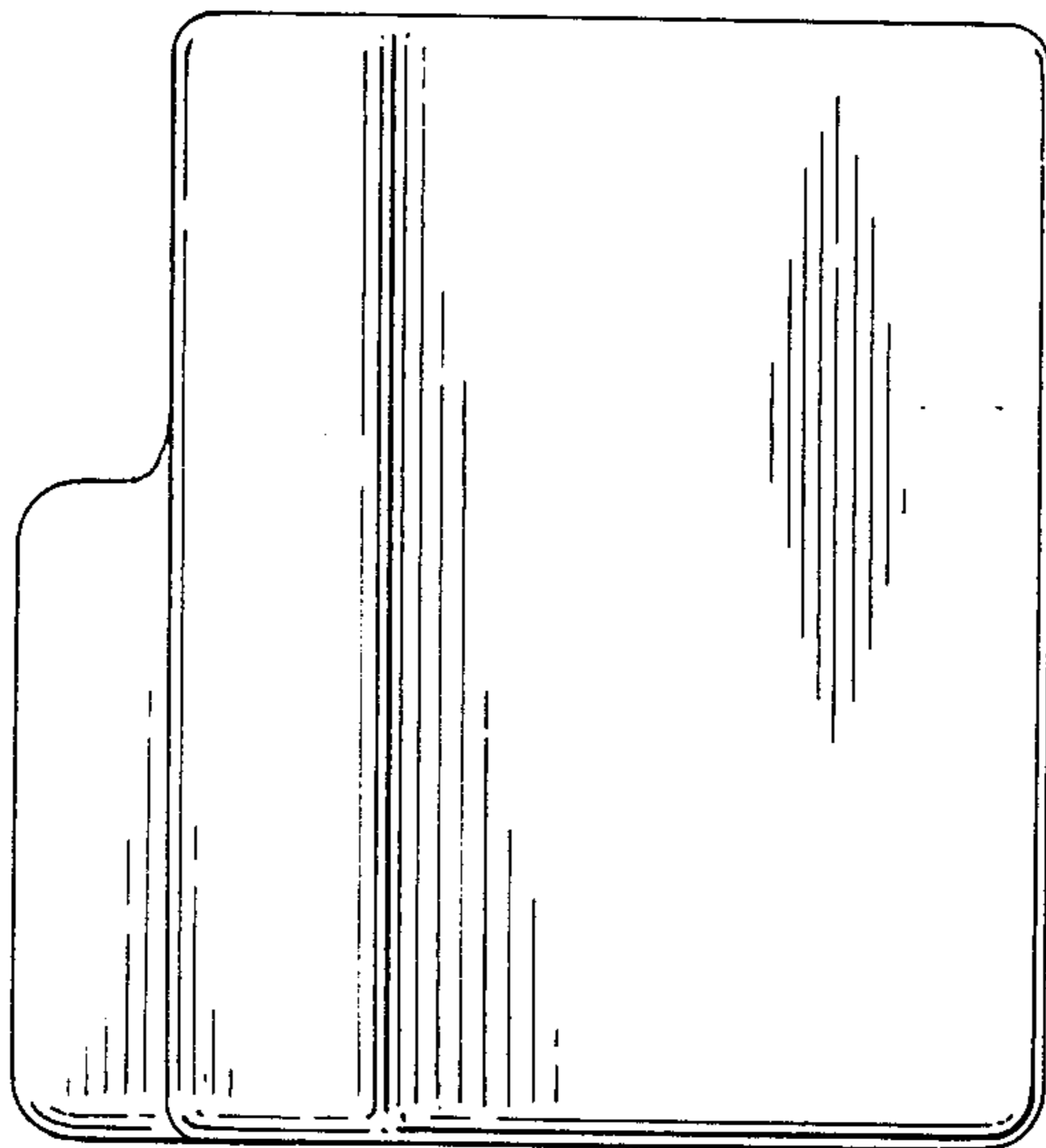

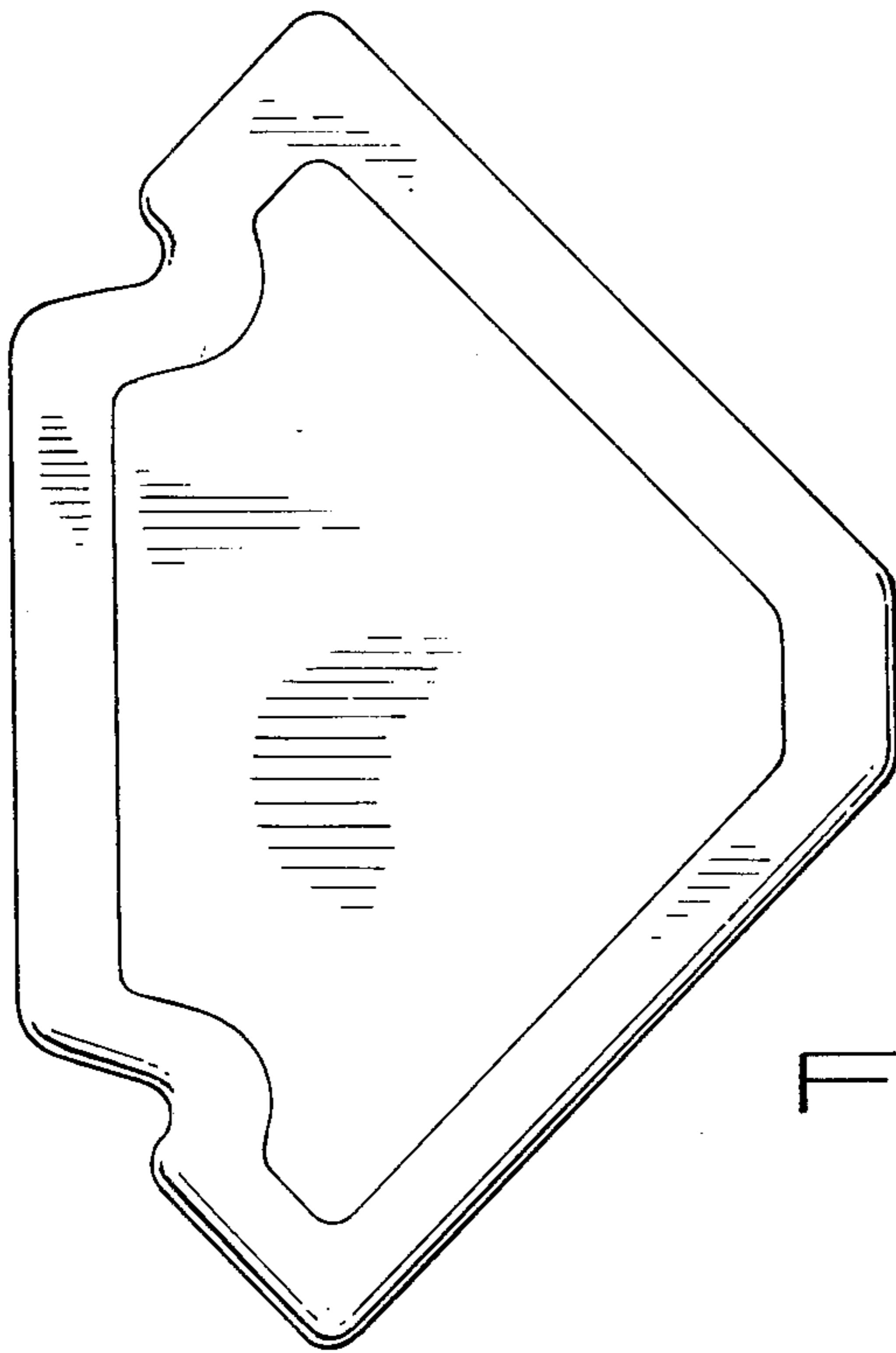
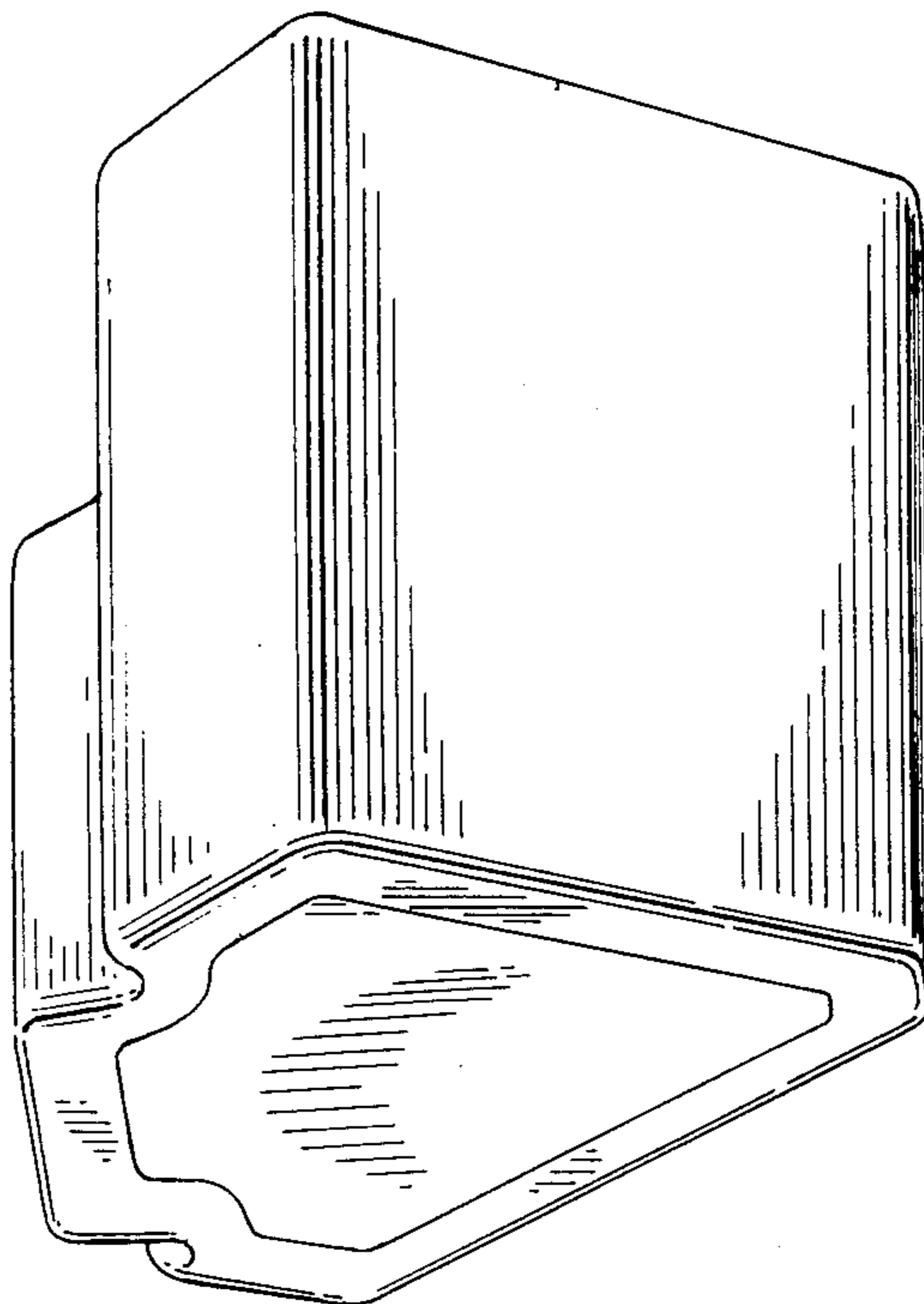
