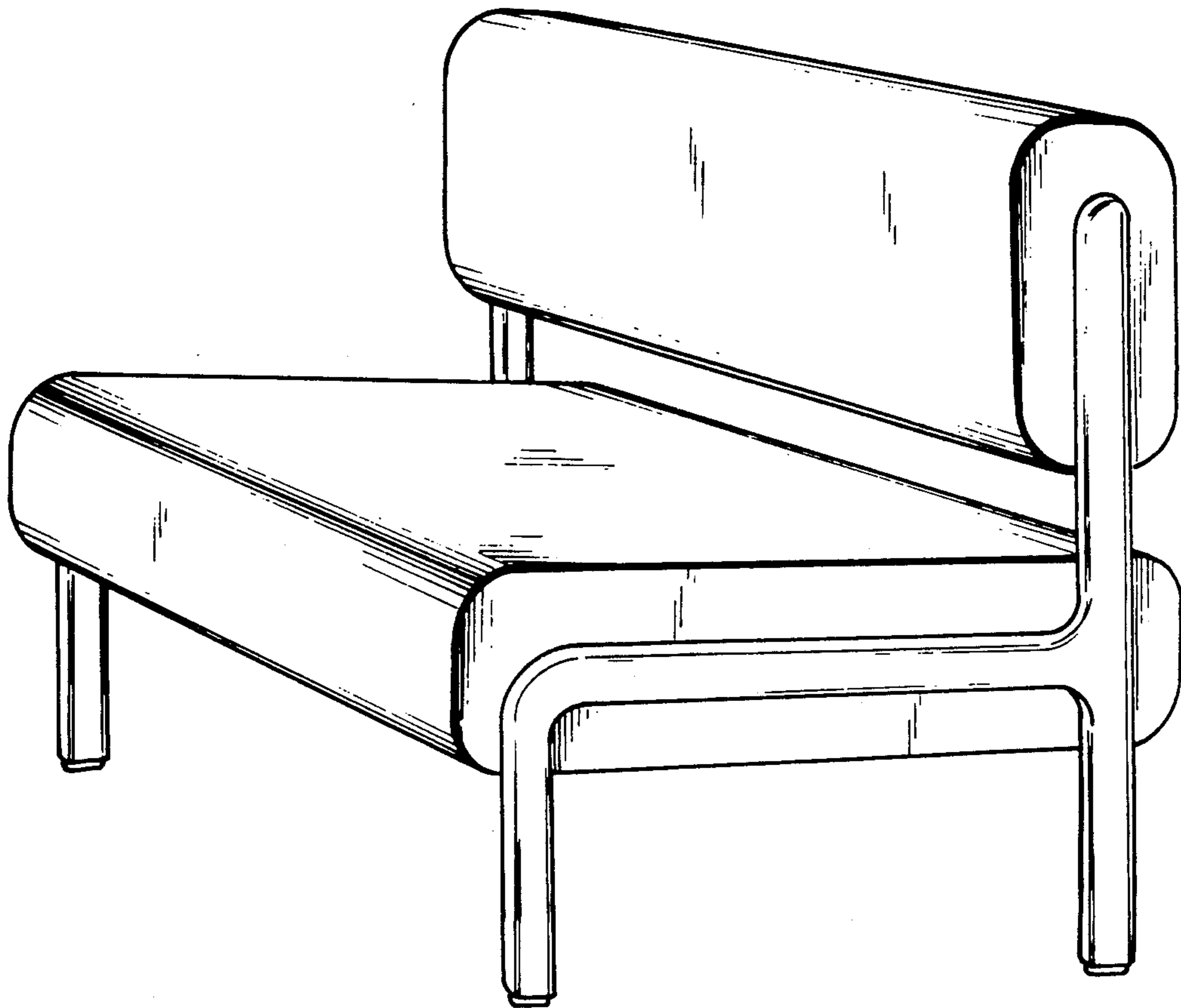
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view of the chair in FIG. 1.



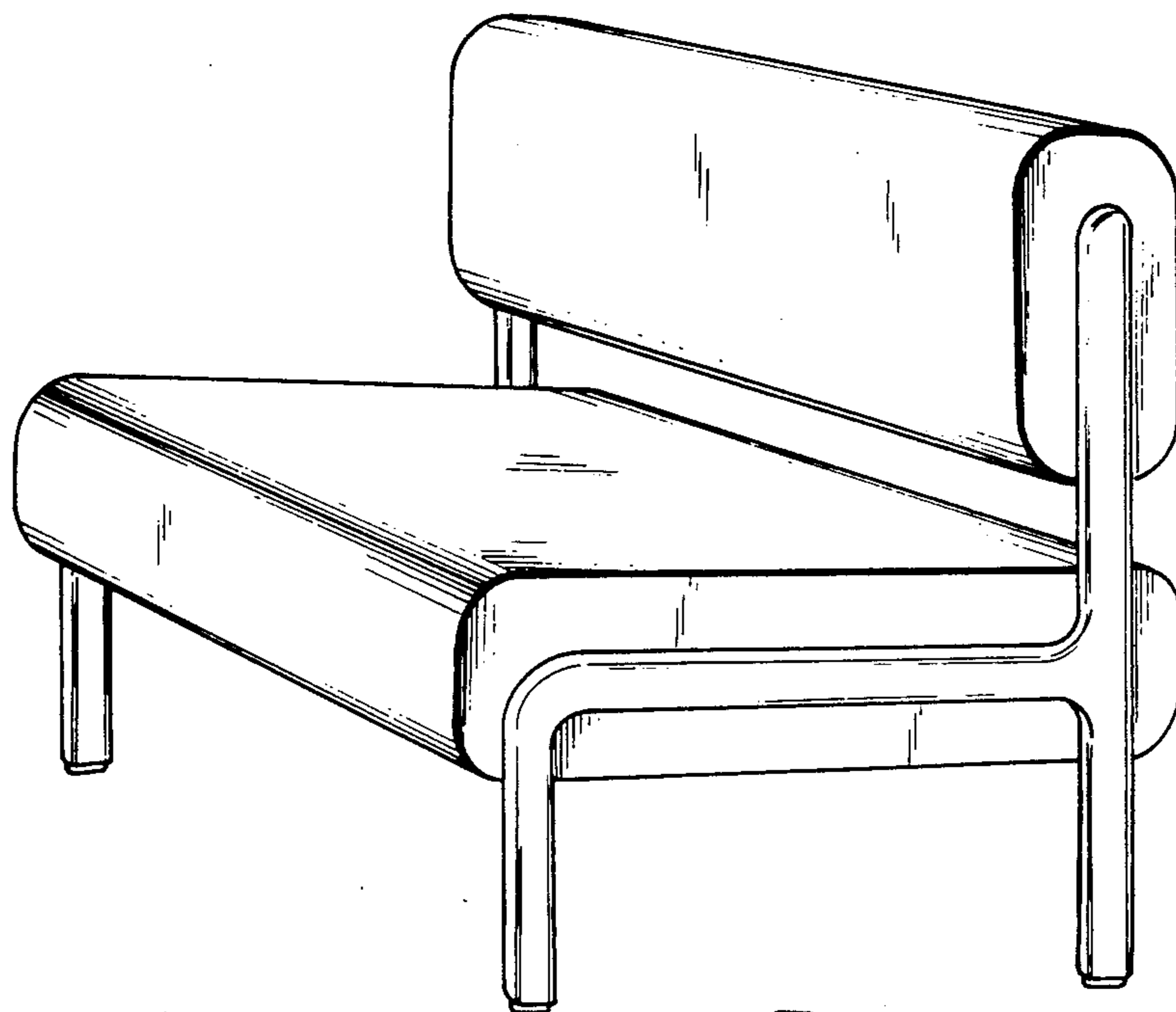

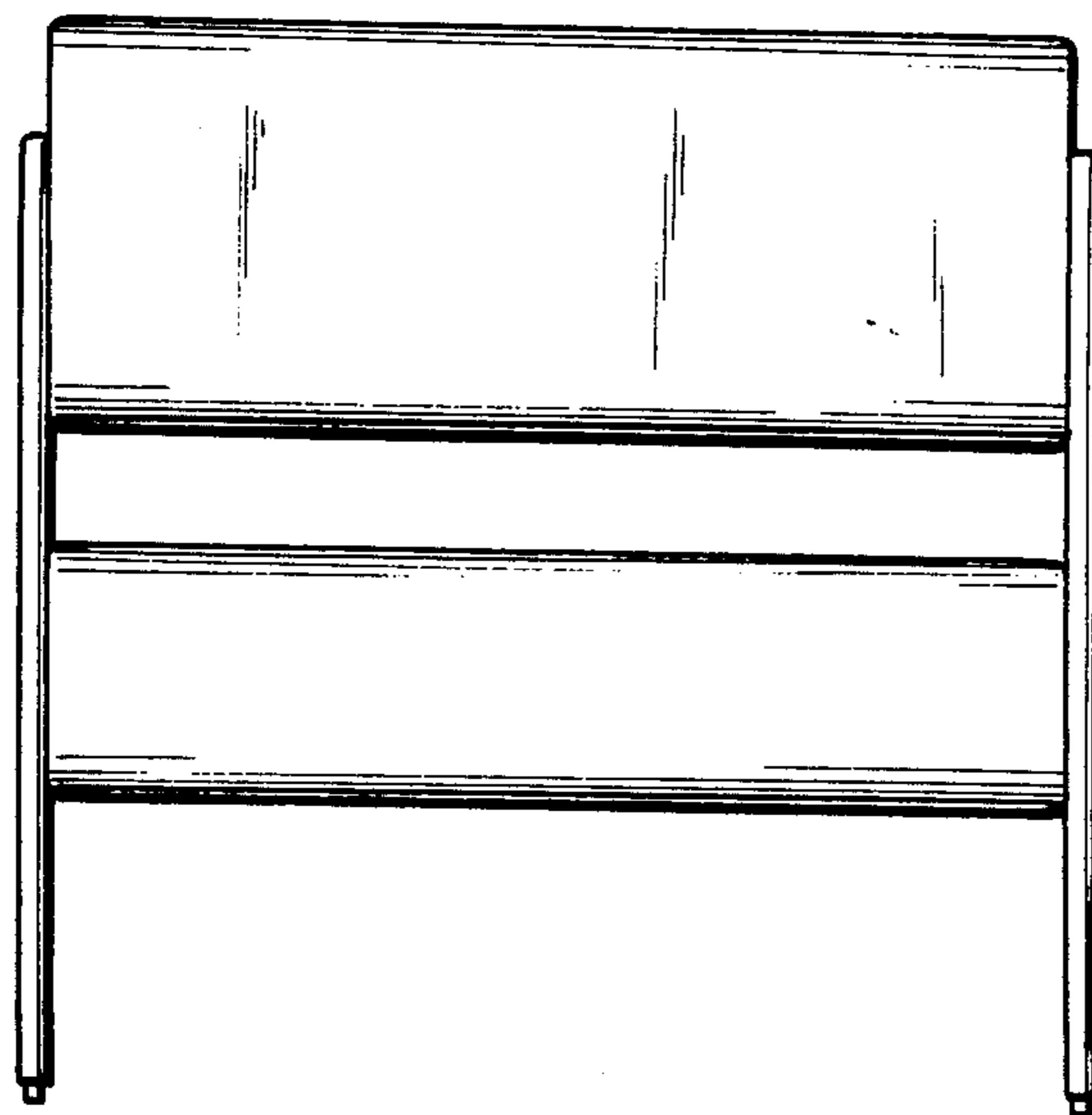
