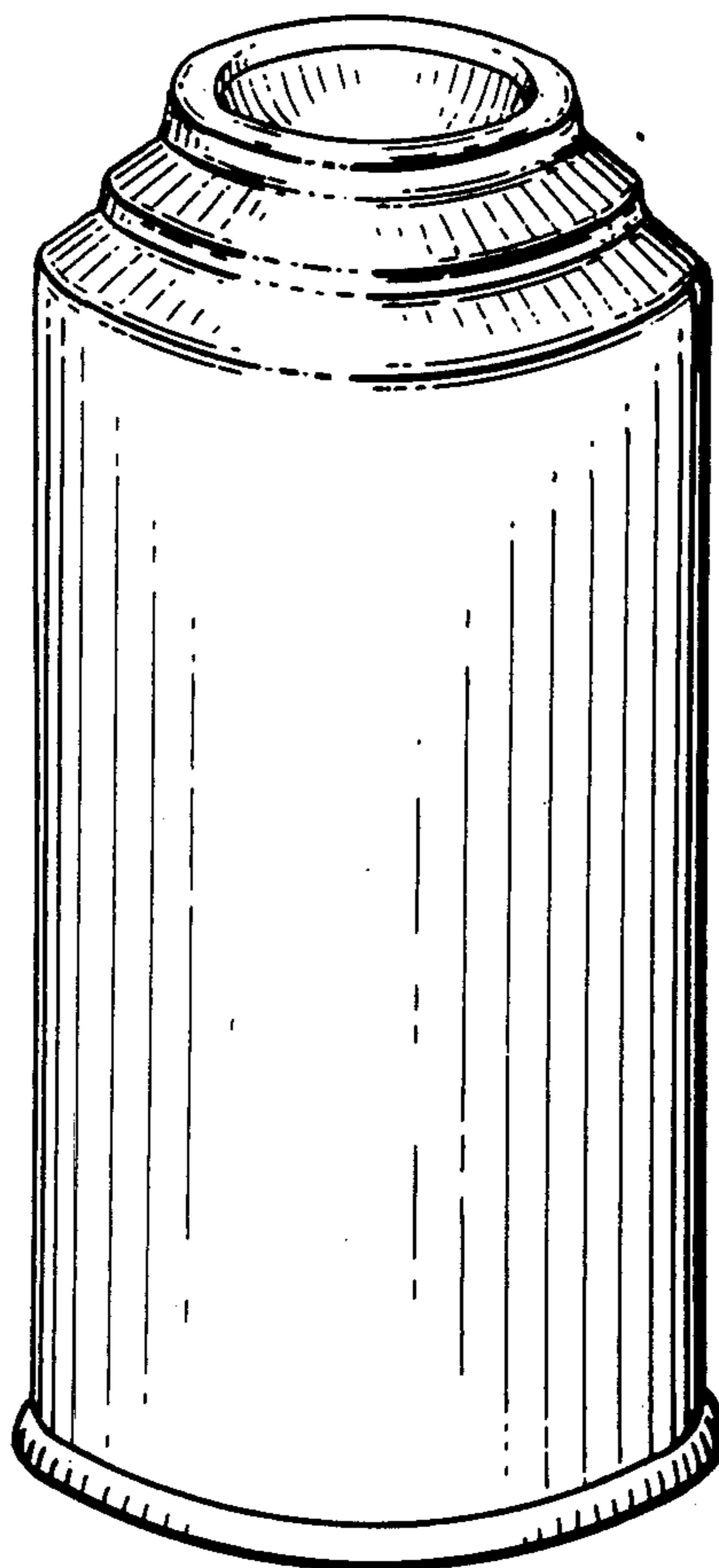

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a can or similar article embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation of the can shown in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 3 is a vertical section through the upper section of the can.



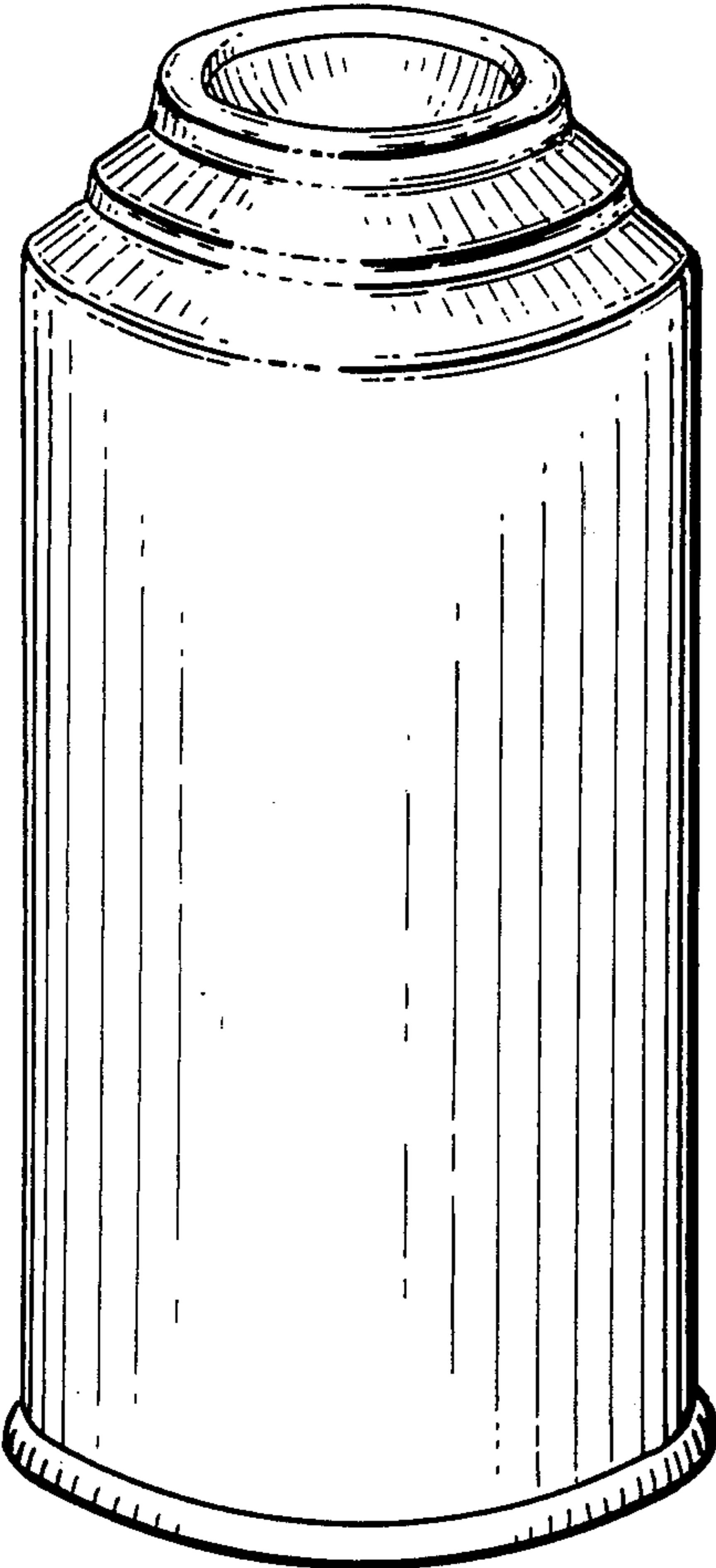

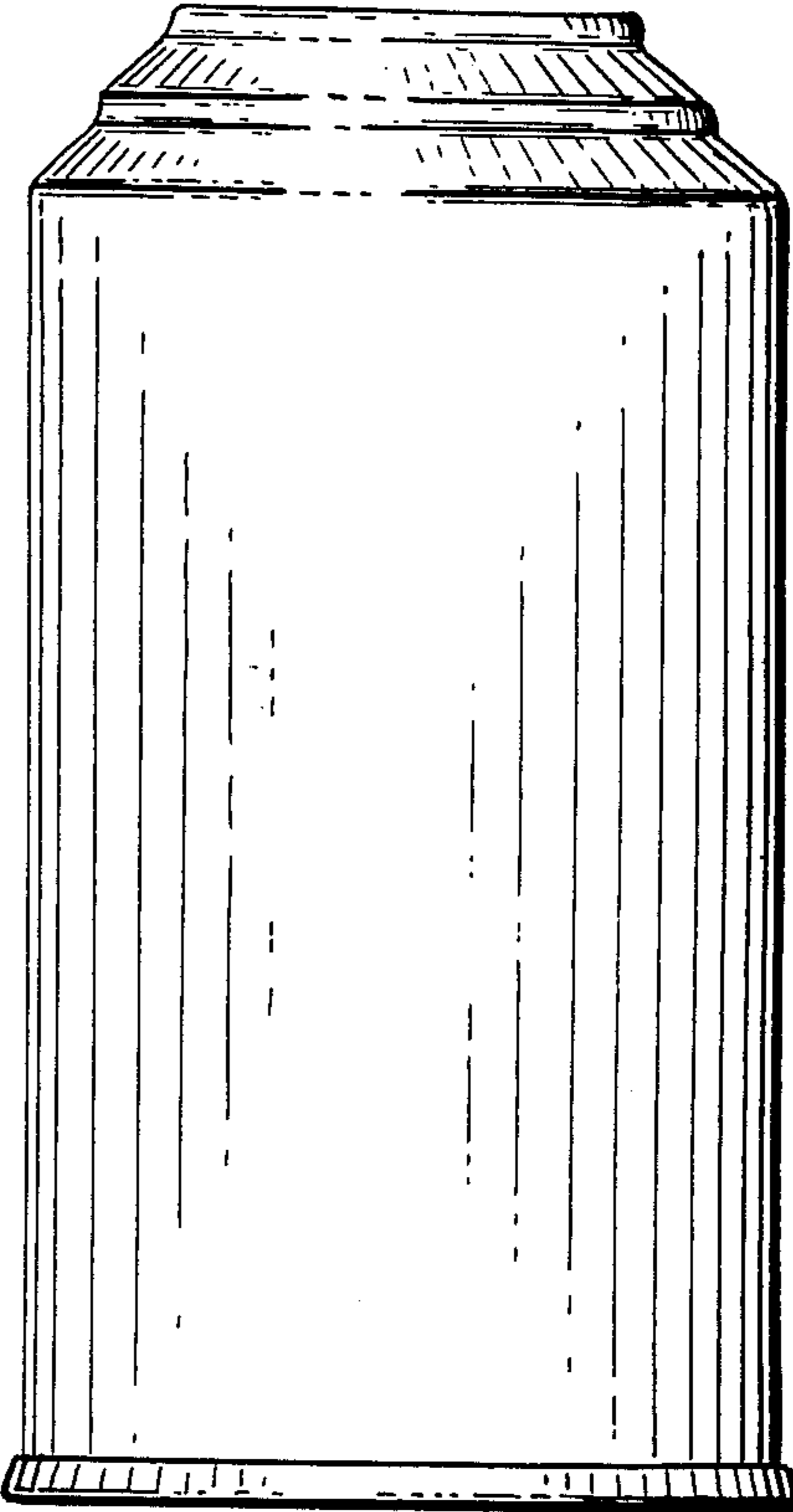

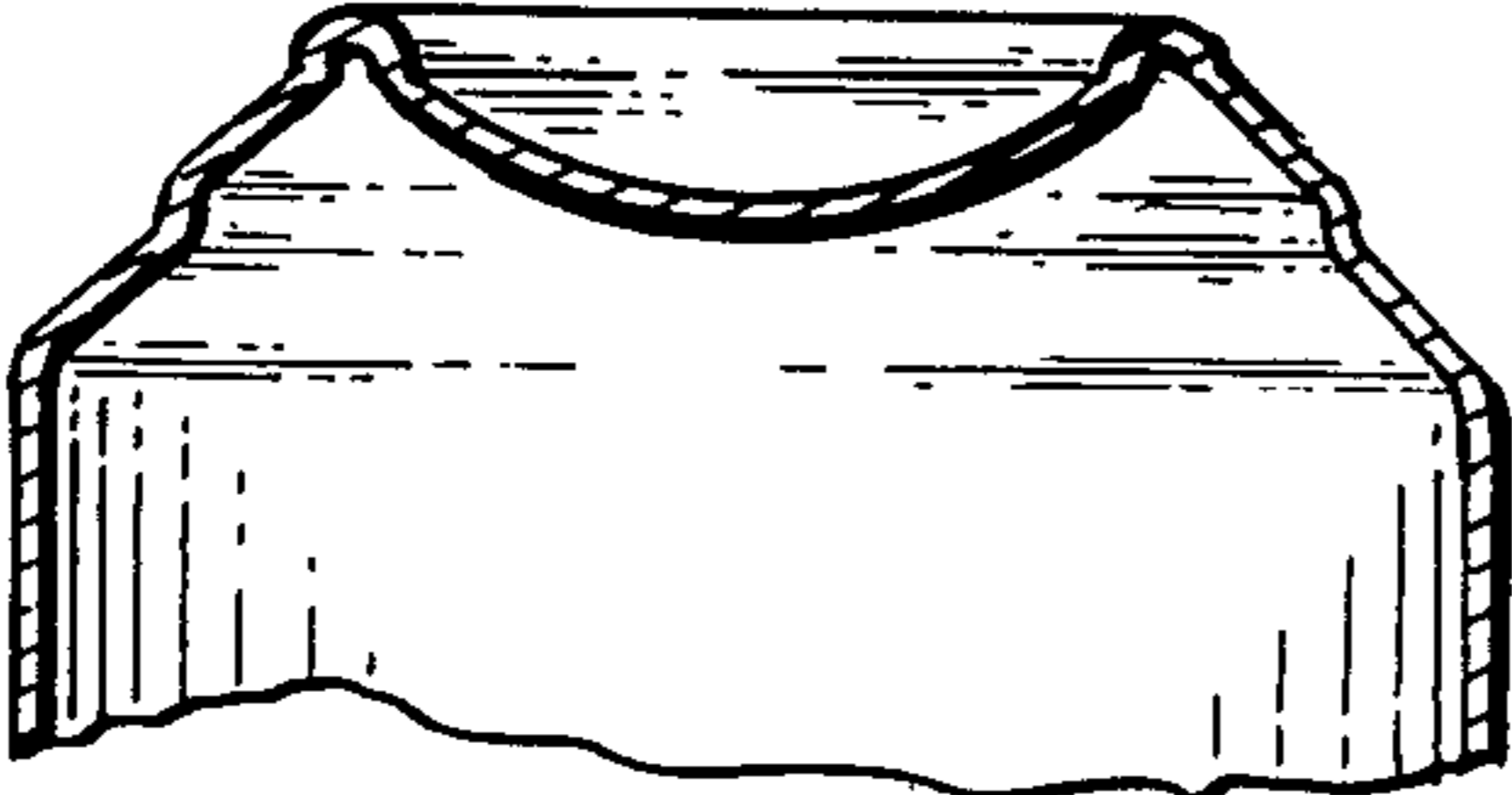
