[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a florist partition structure for the inside of a shopping center complex, substantially as described and shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a florist partition structure for the inside of a shopping center complex showing my new design;

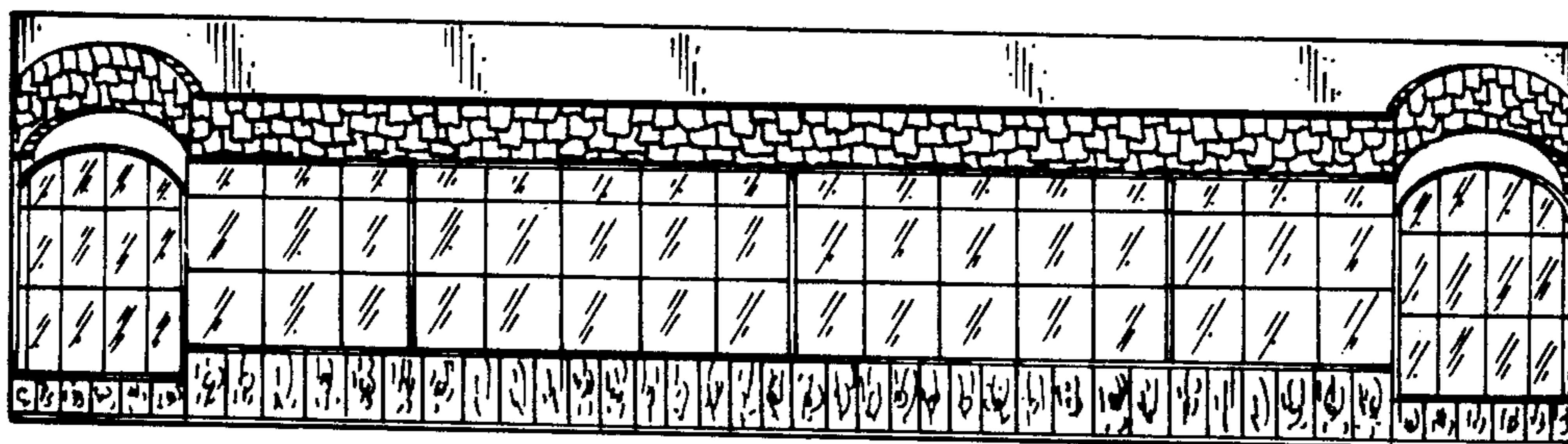
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end elevation thereof as seen from the left of the structure shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an end elevation thereof as seen from the right of the structure shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a corner elevation thereof as seen from the front right-hand corner of the structure shown in FIG. 1 and taken along lines 5—5 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation thereof.



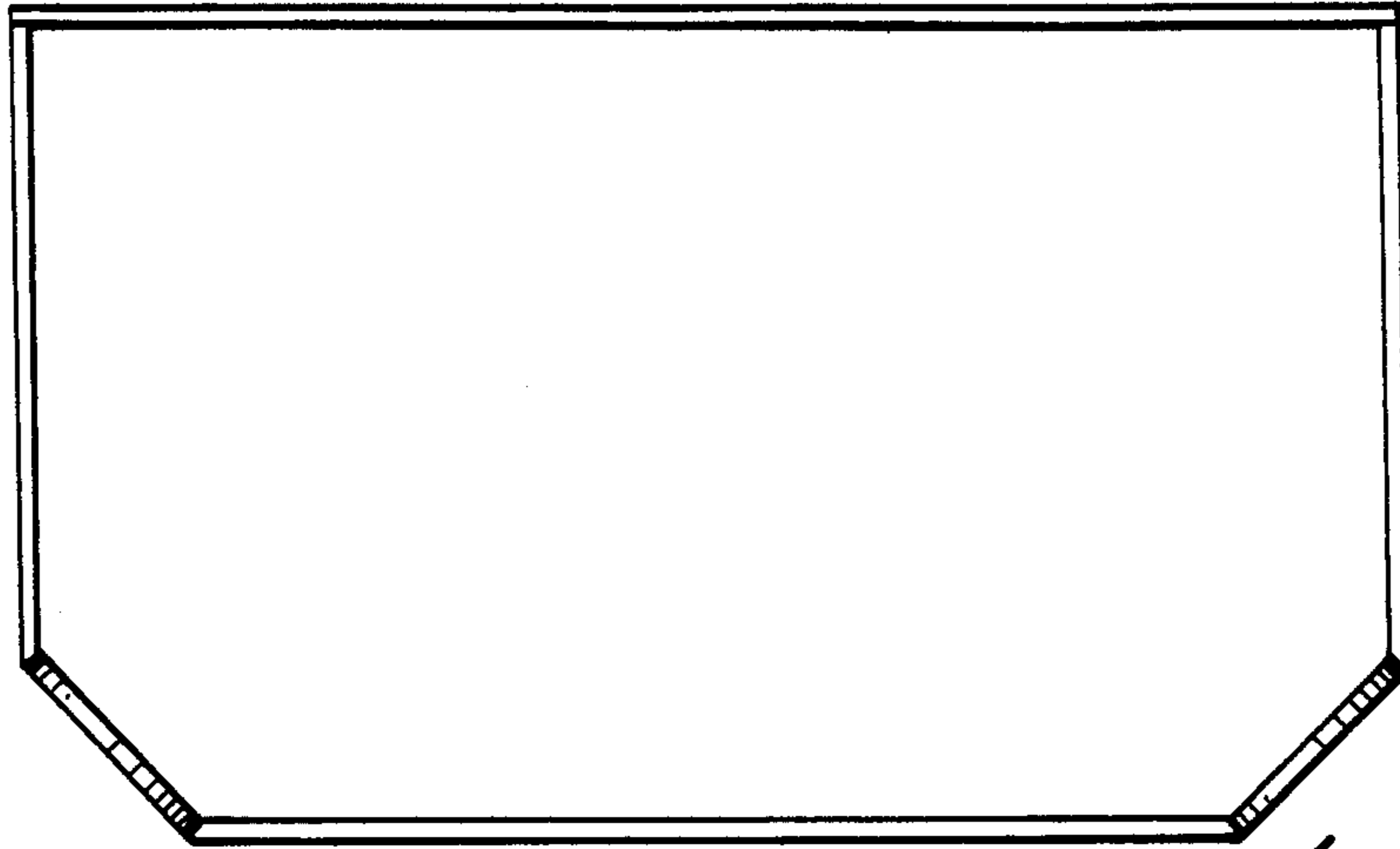

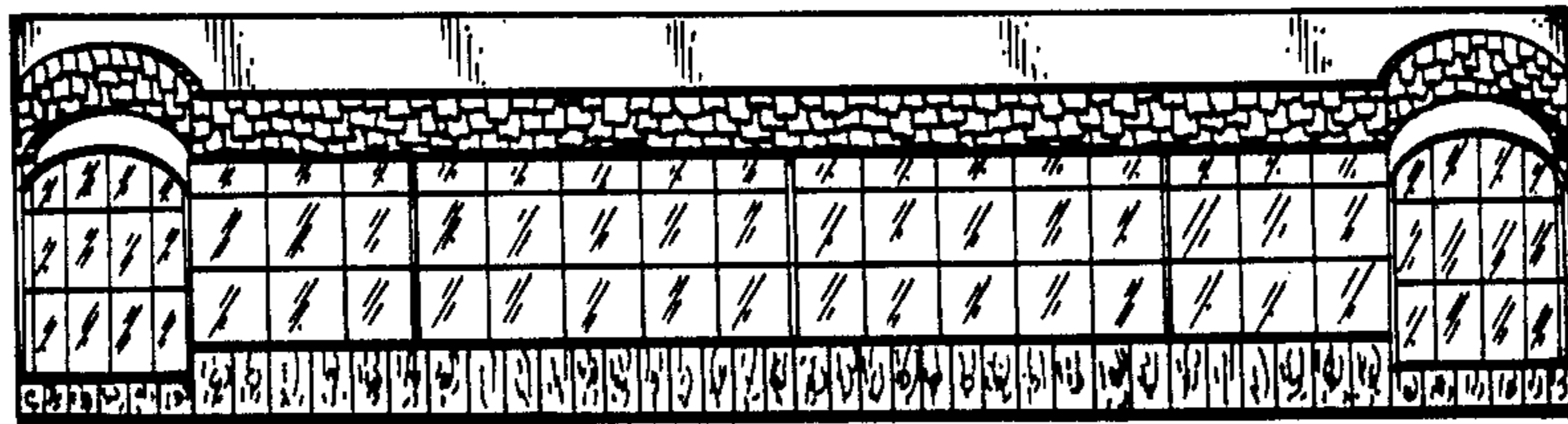

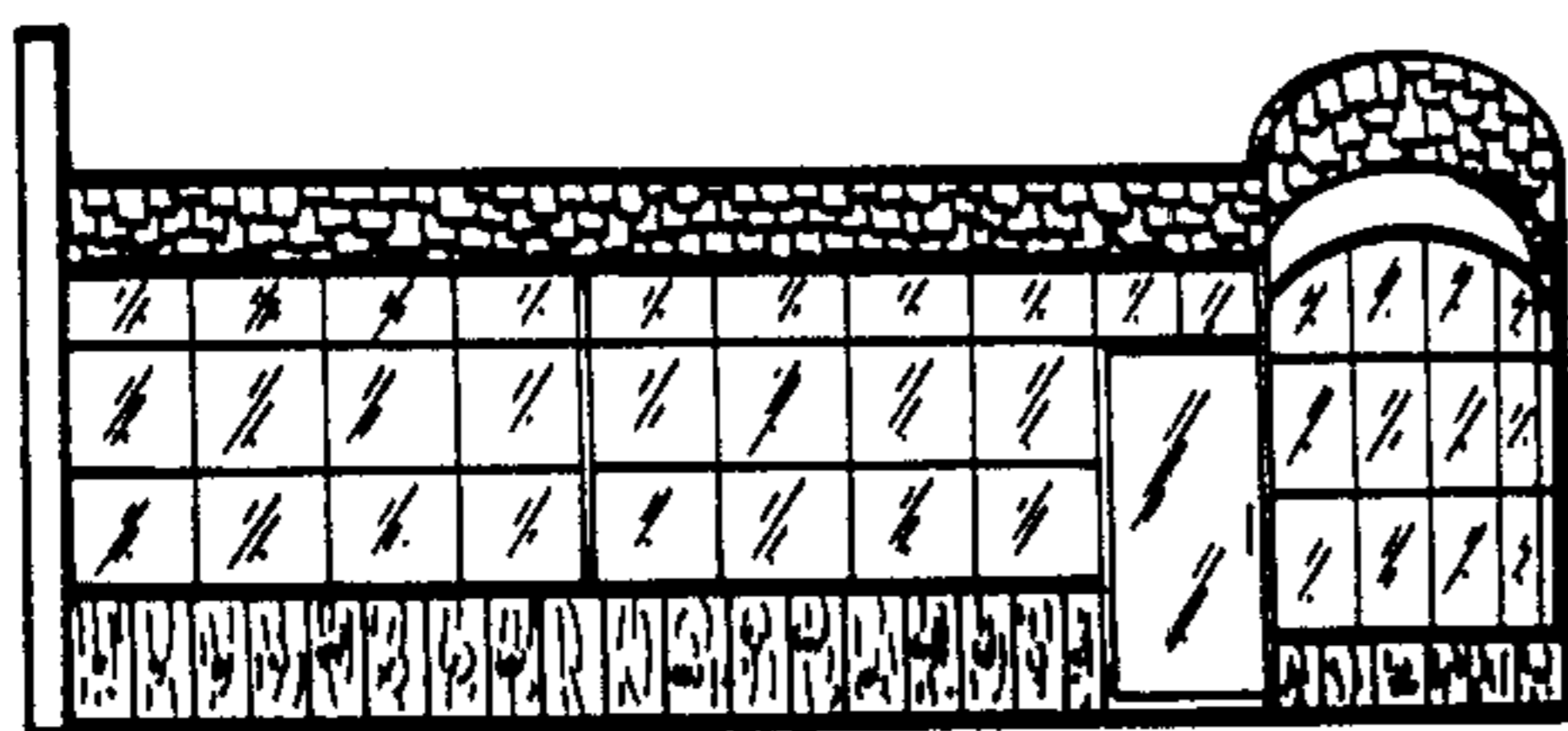

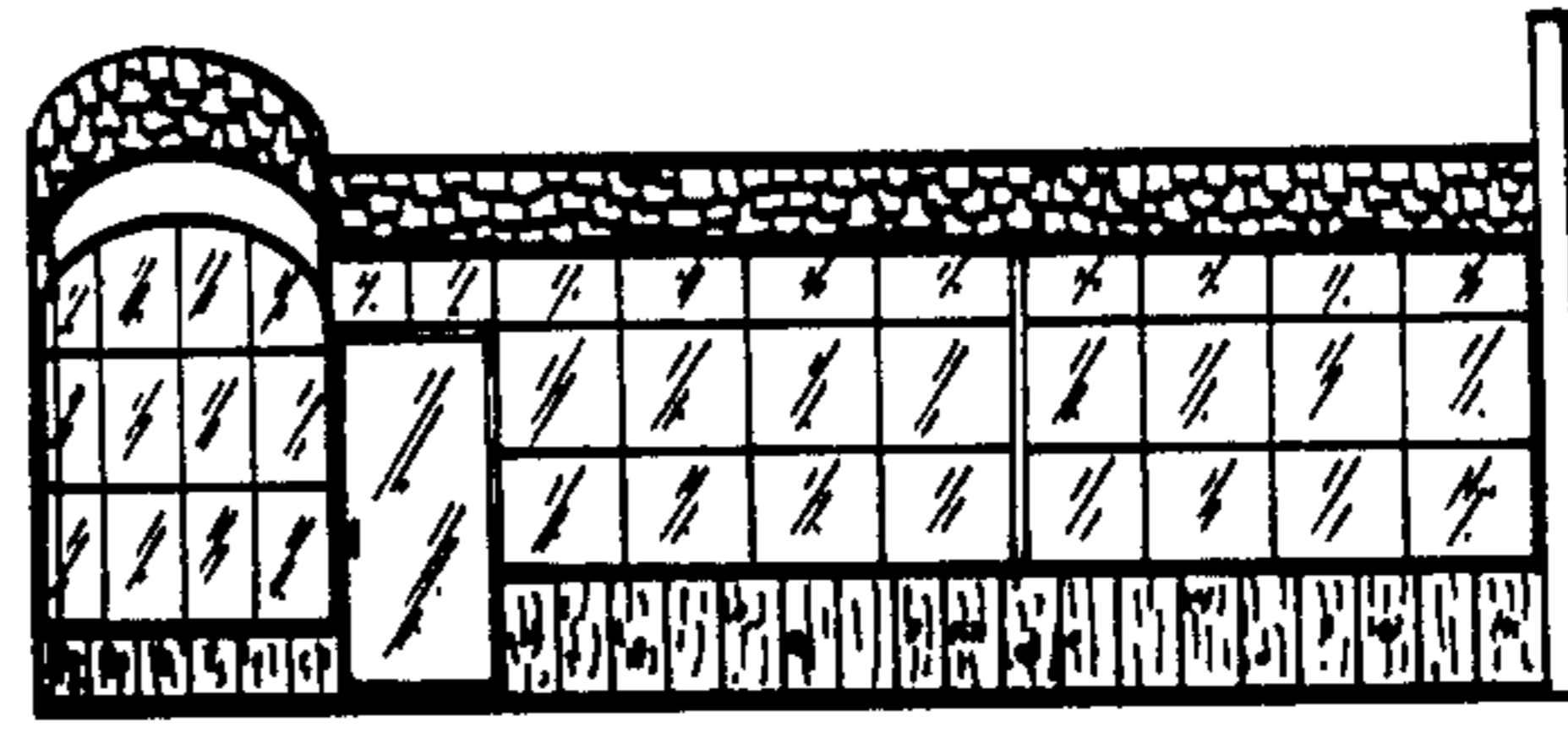

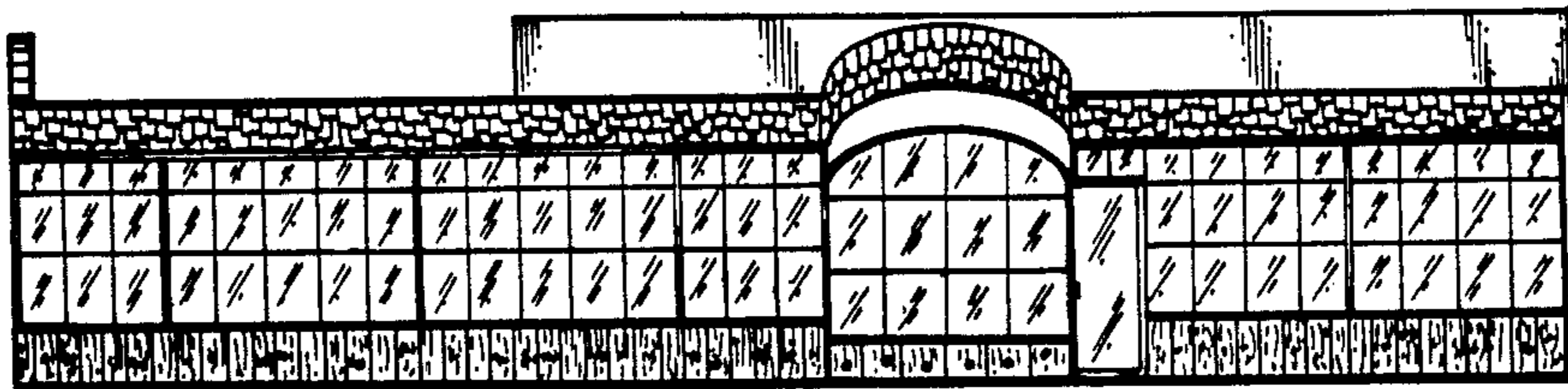

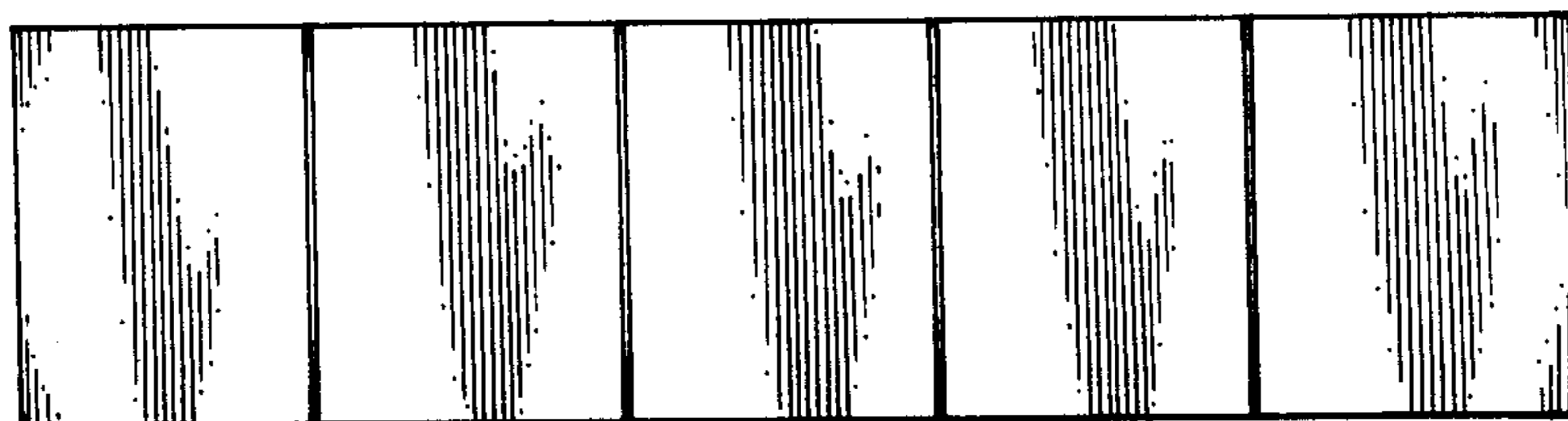
