The ornamental design for a seat, as shown.

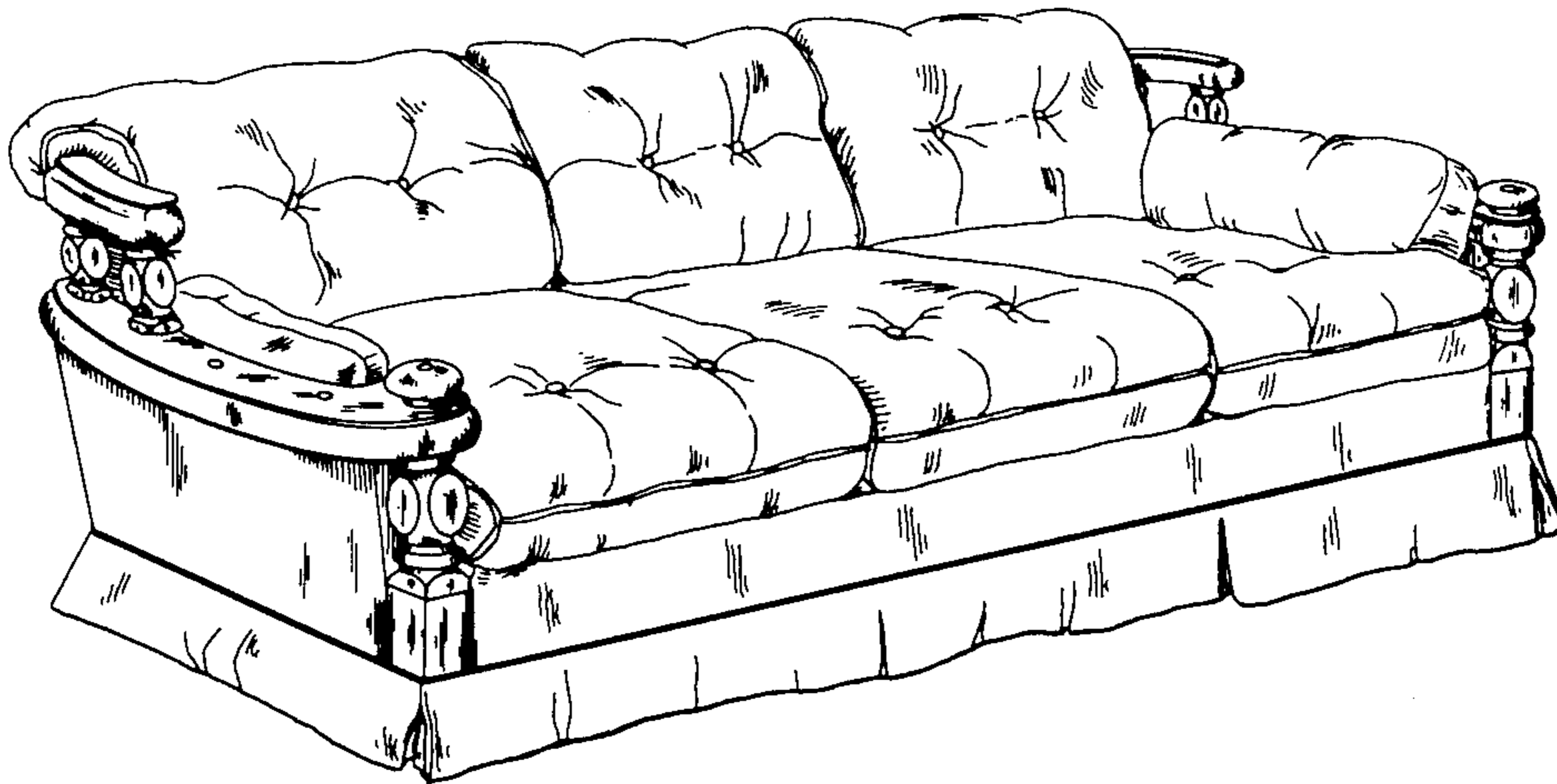
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of the design in the form of an armchair.



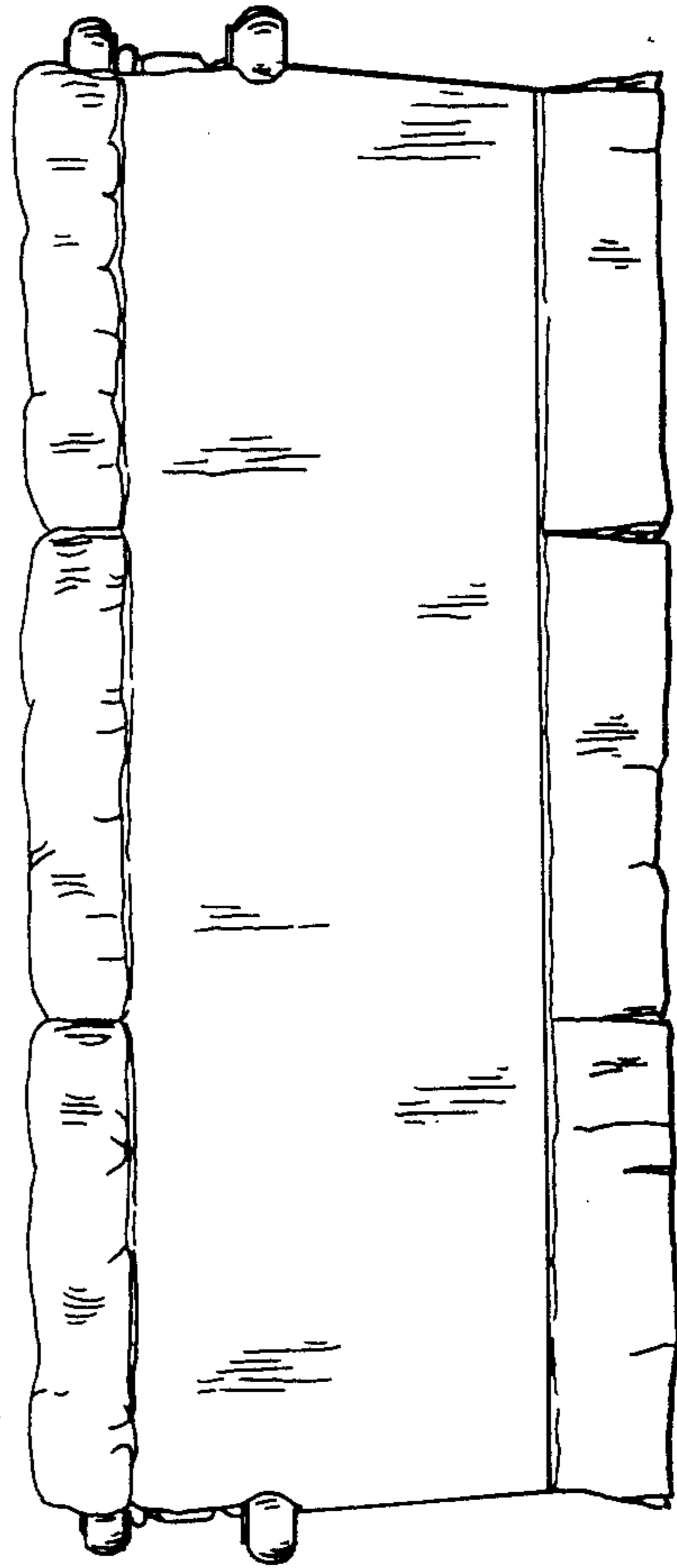

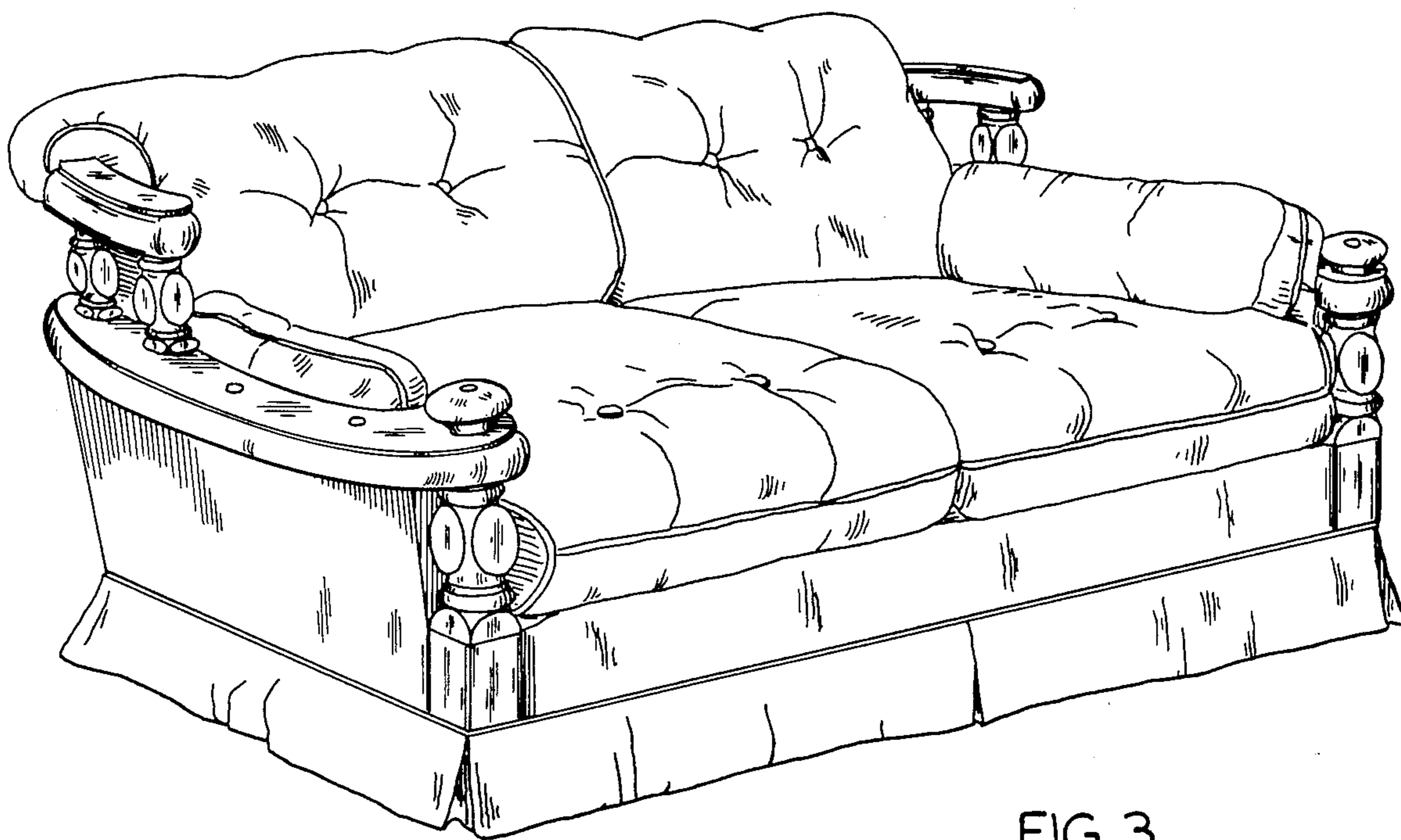

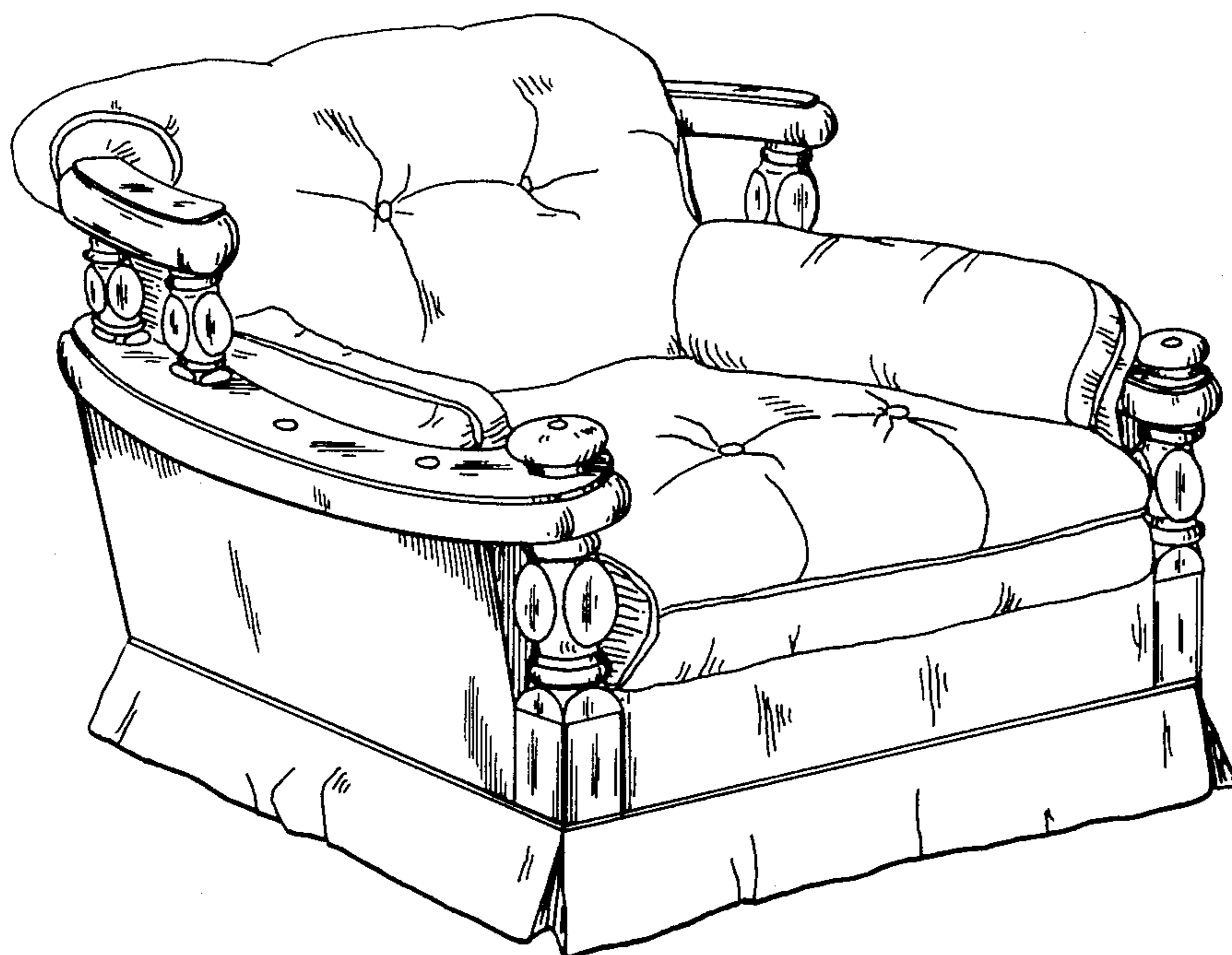
