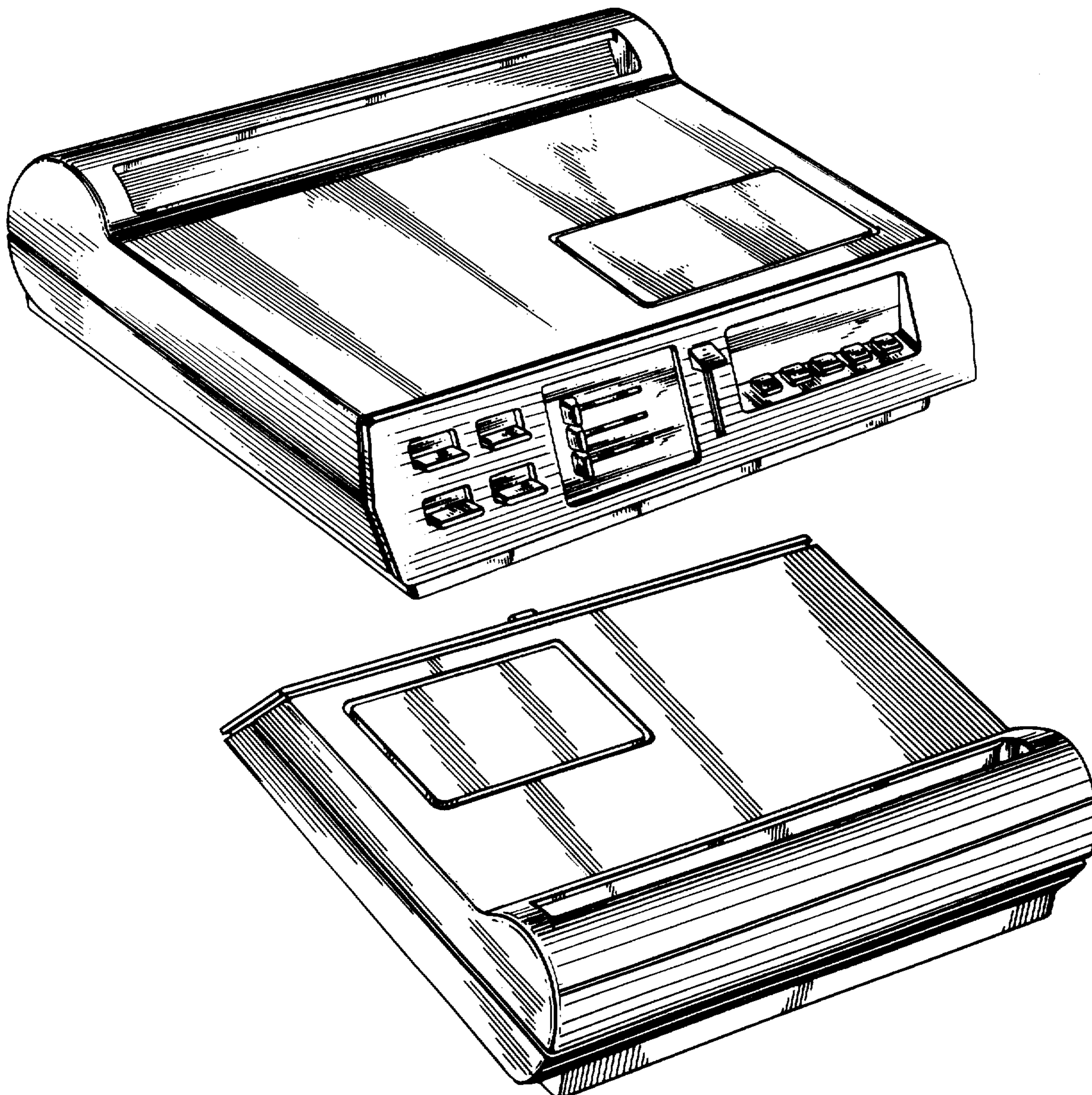

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a dictation machine or similar article, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front end view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.



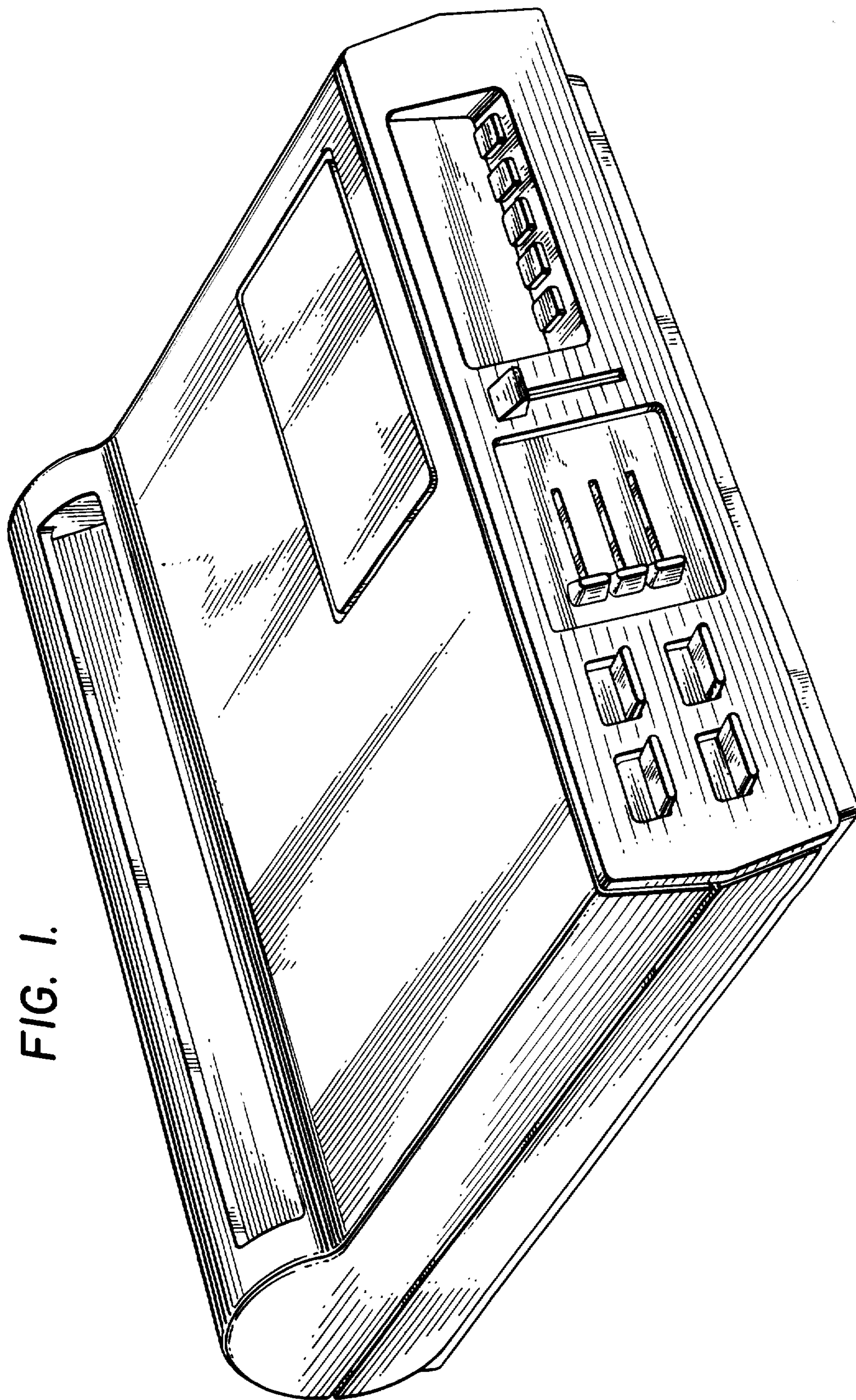

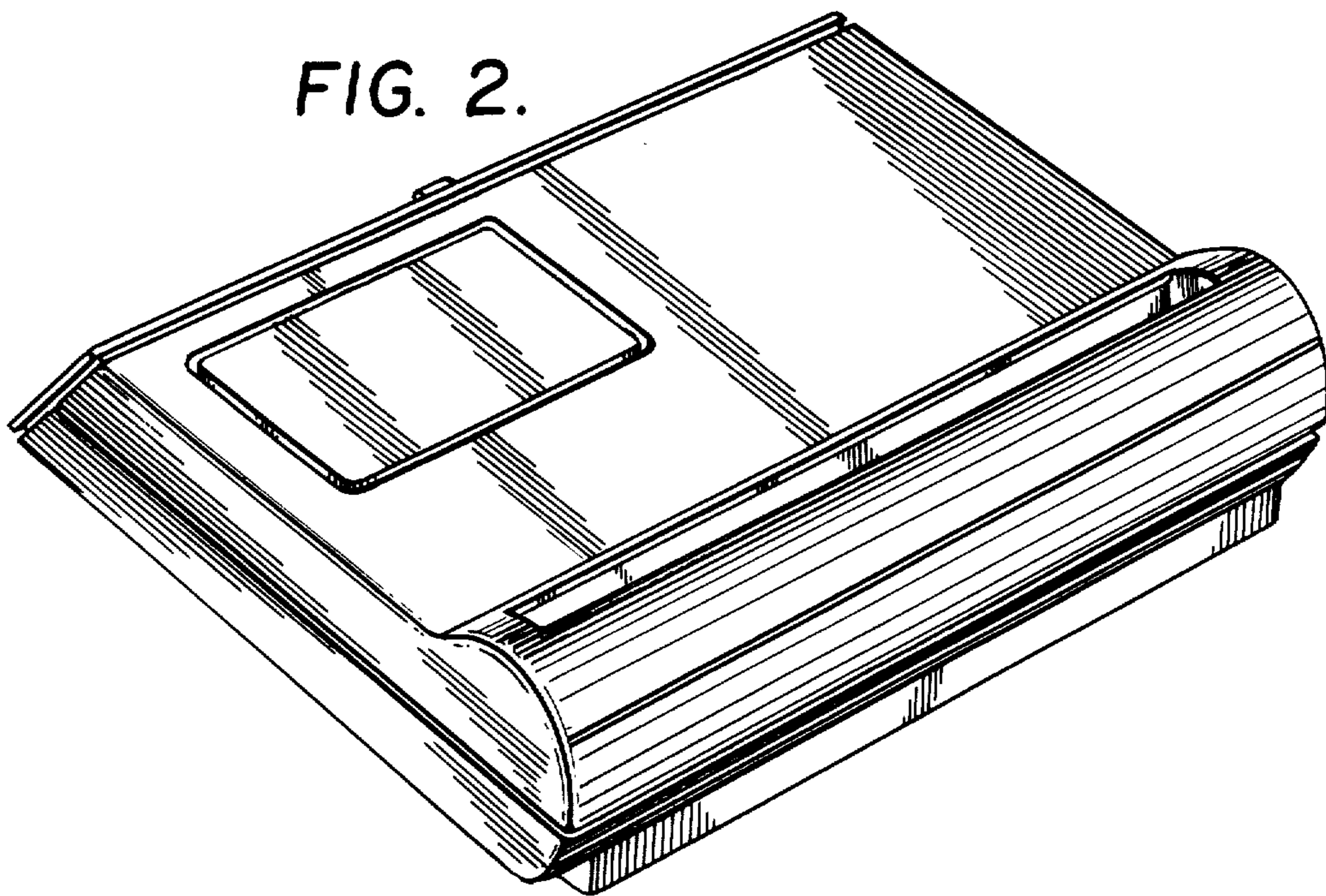

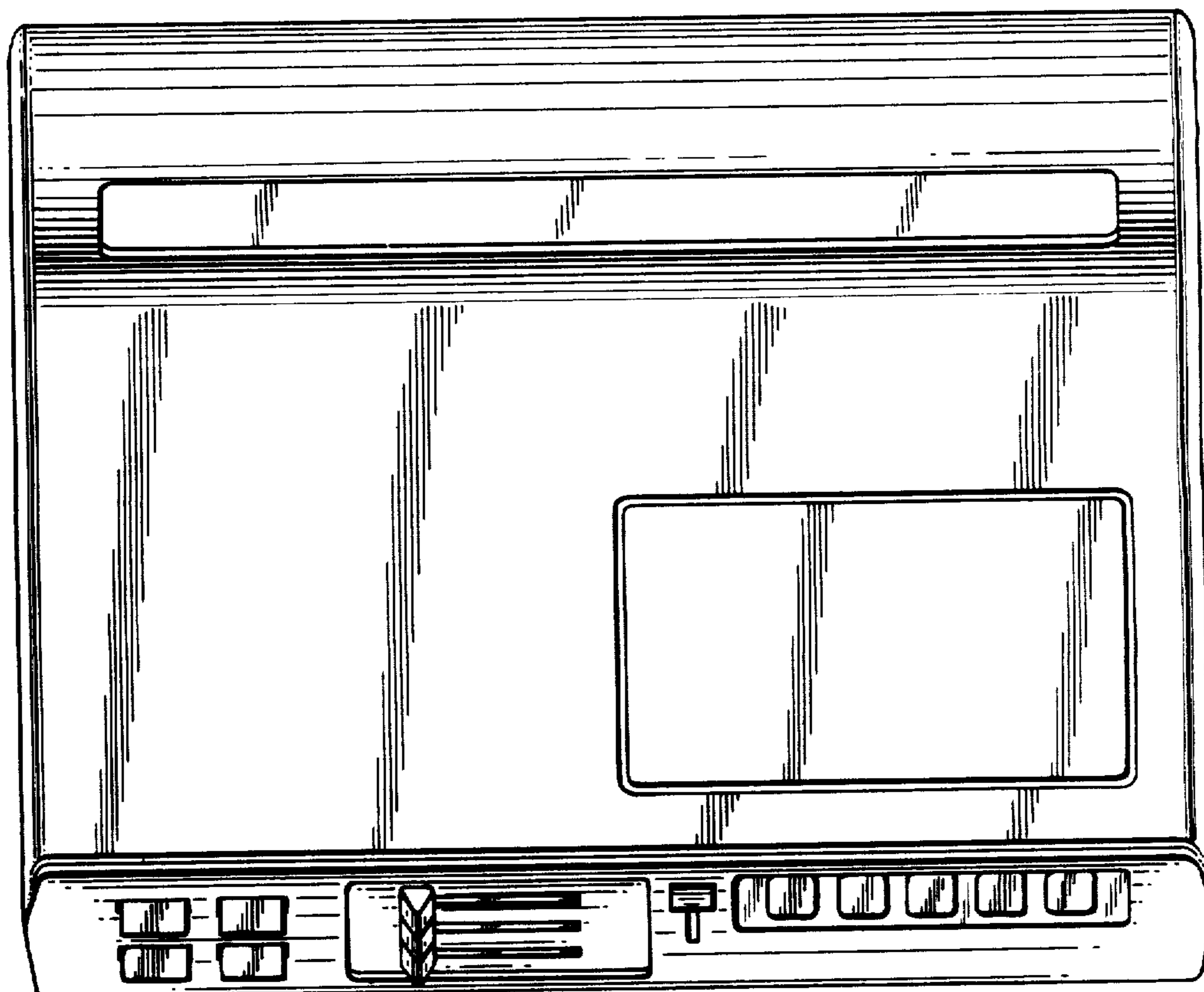

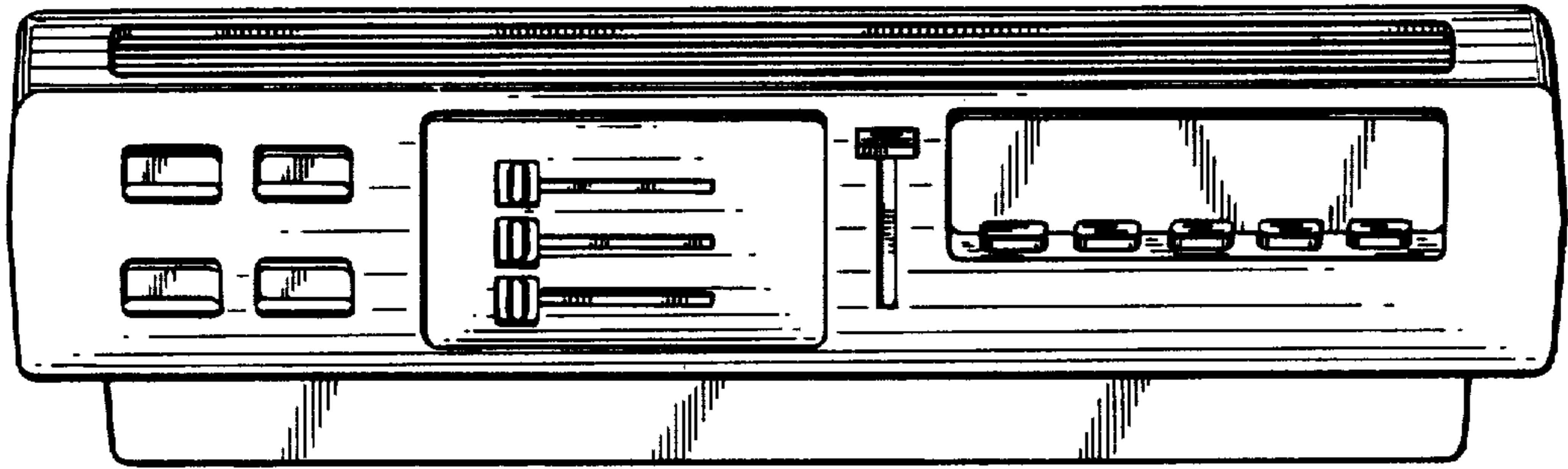

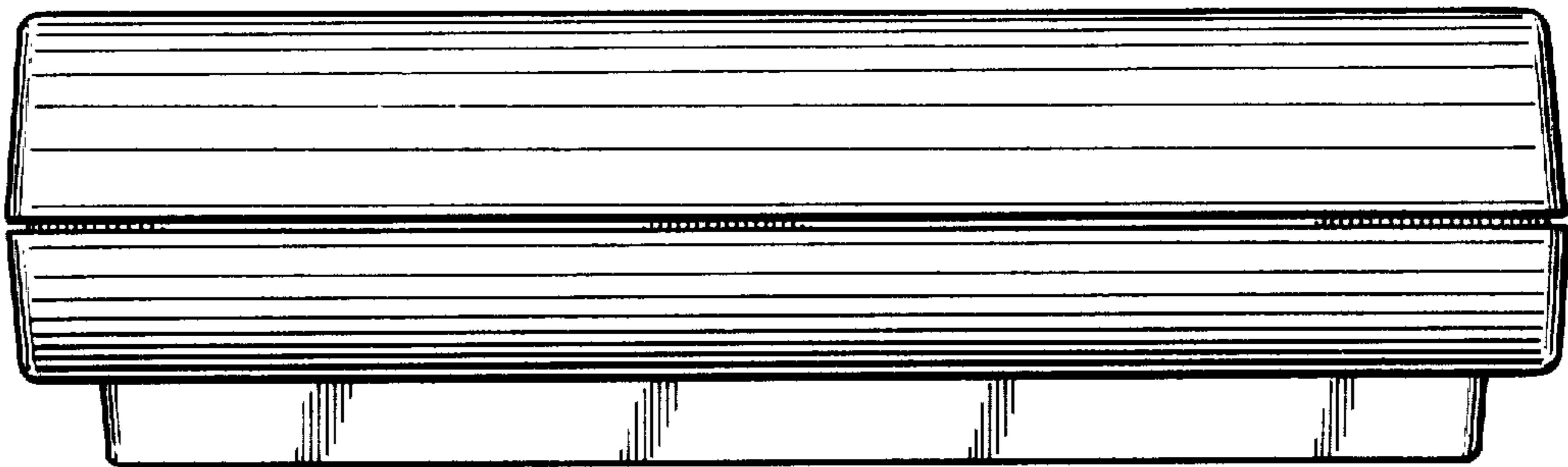

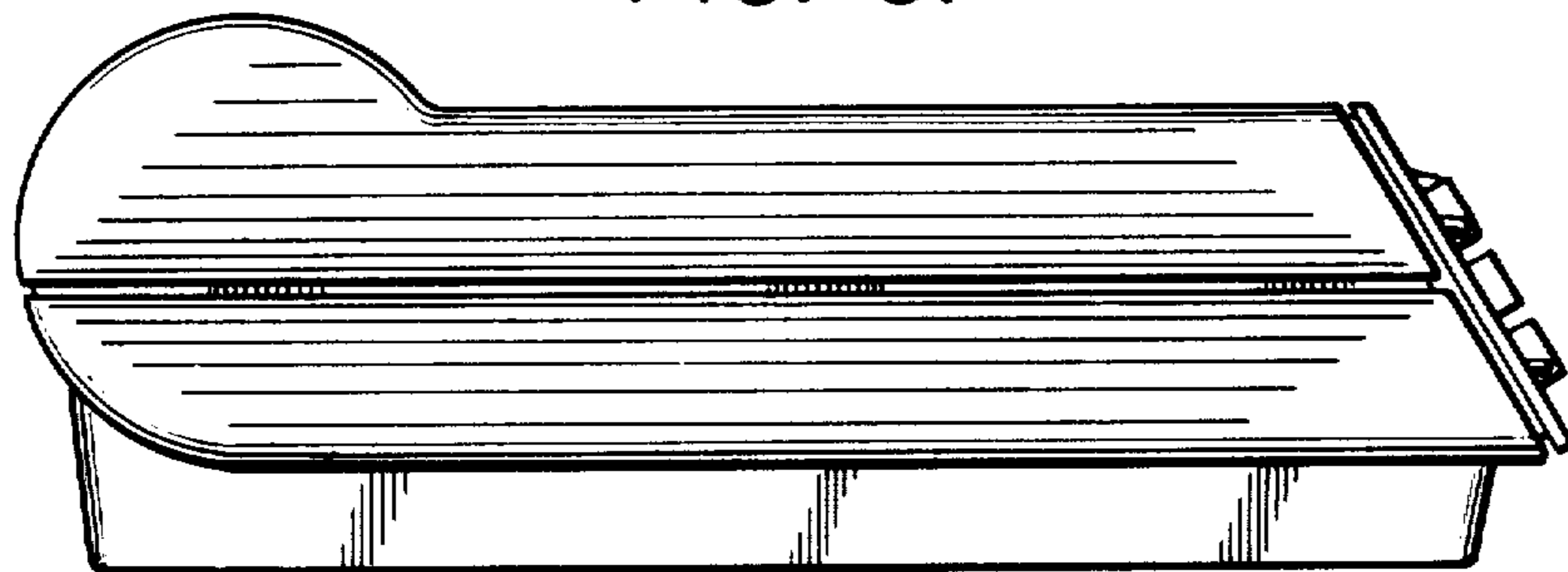
