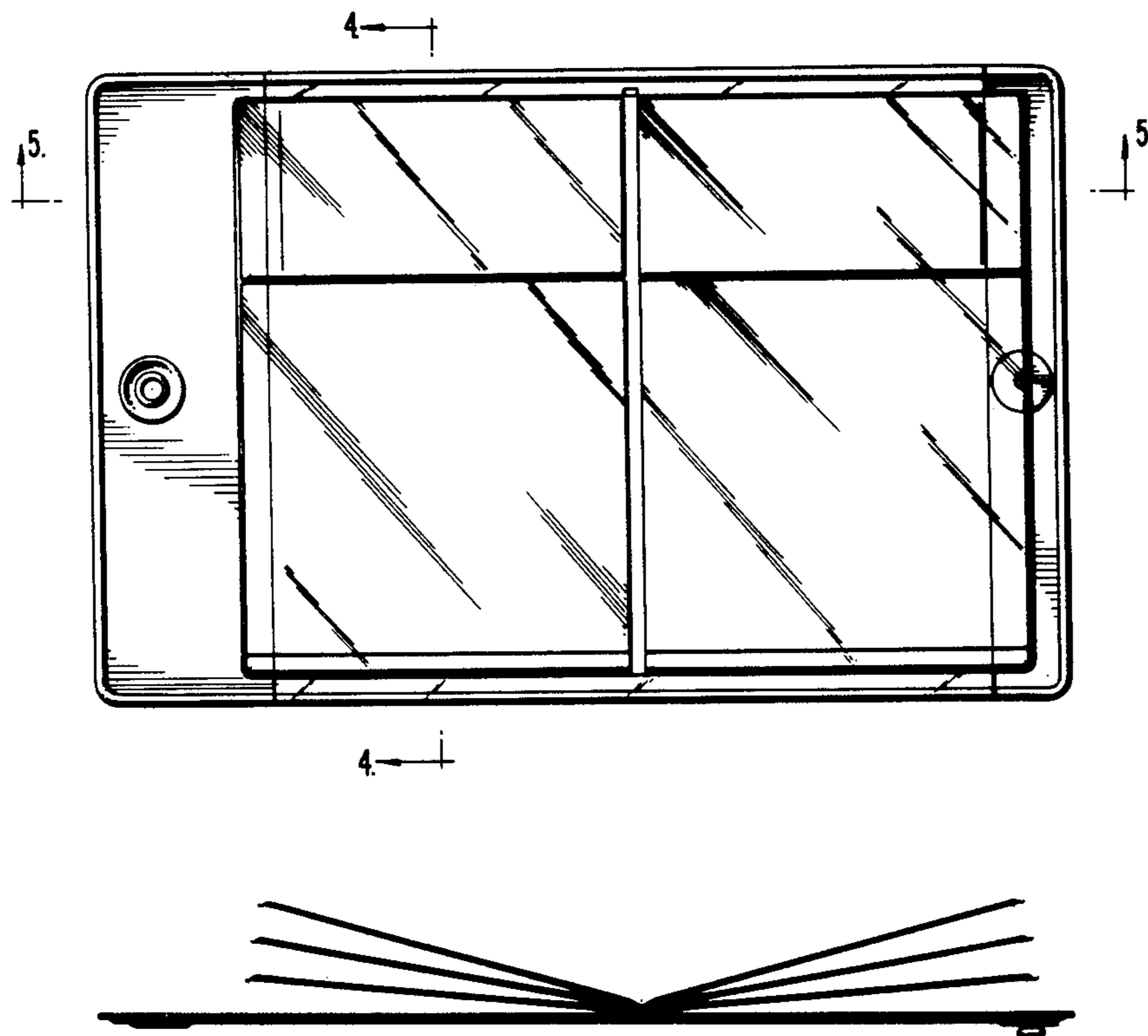

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined medication and instruction card carrier case showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view with the leaves in a slightly raised position; FIG. 4 is an enlarged scale cross-sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1, an intermediate portion being broken out and omitted for ease of illustration; and FIG. 5 is an enlarged scale cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1, intermediate portions being broken out and omitted for ease of illustration.



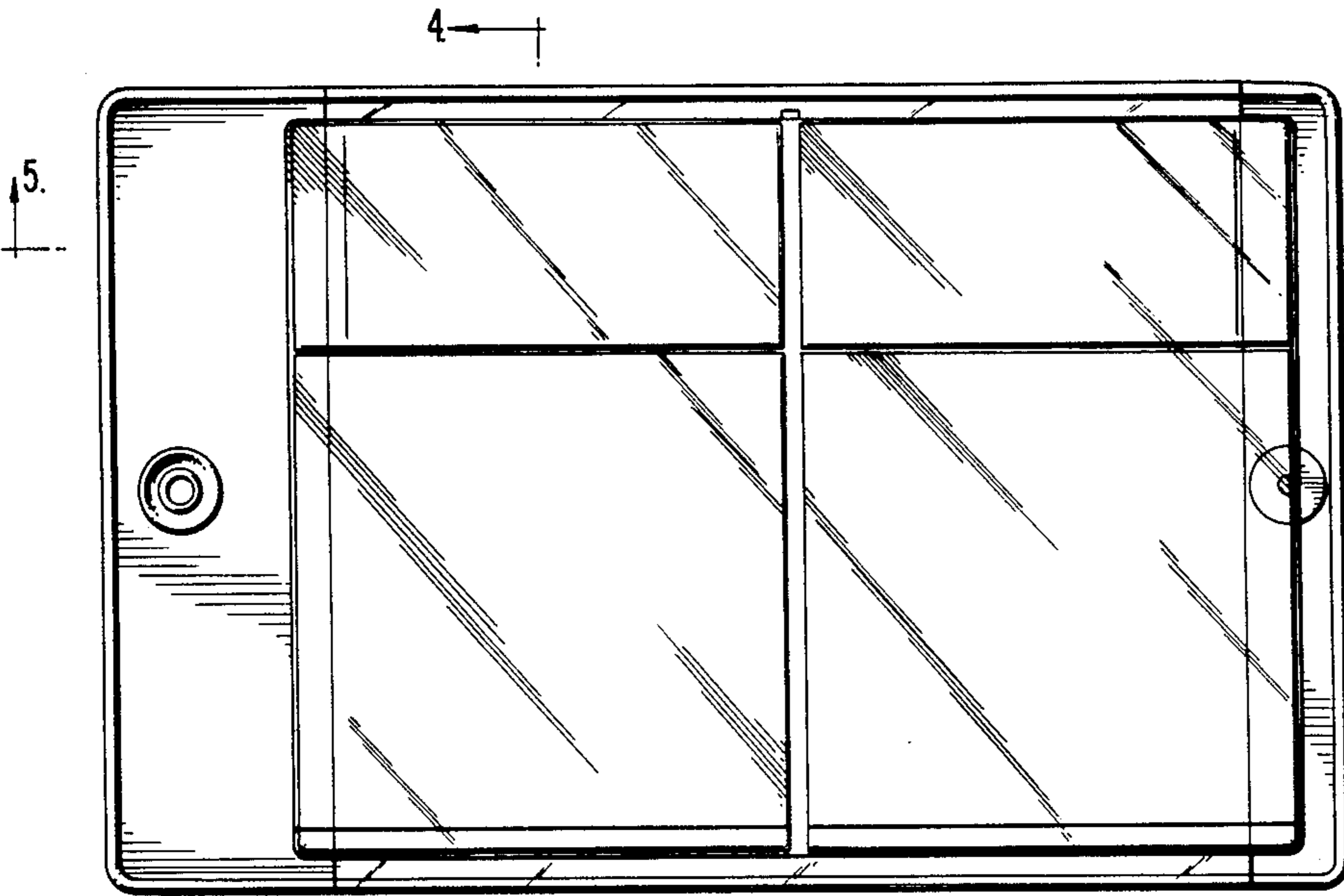

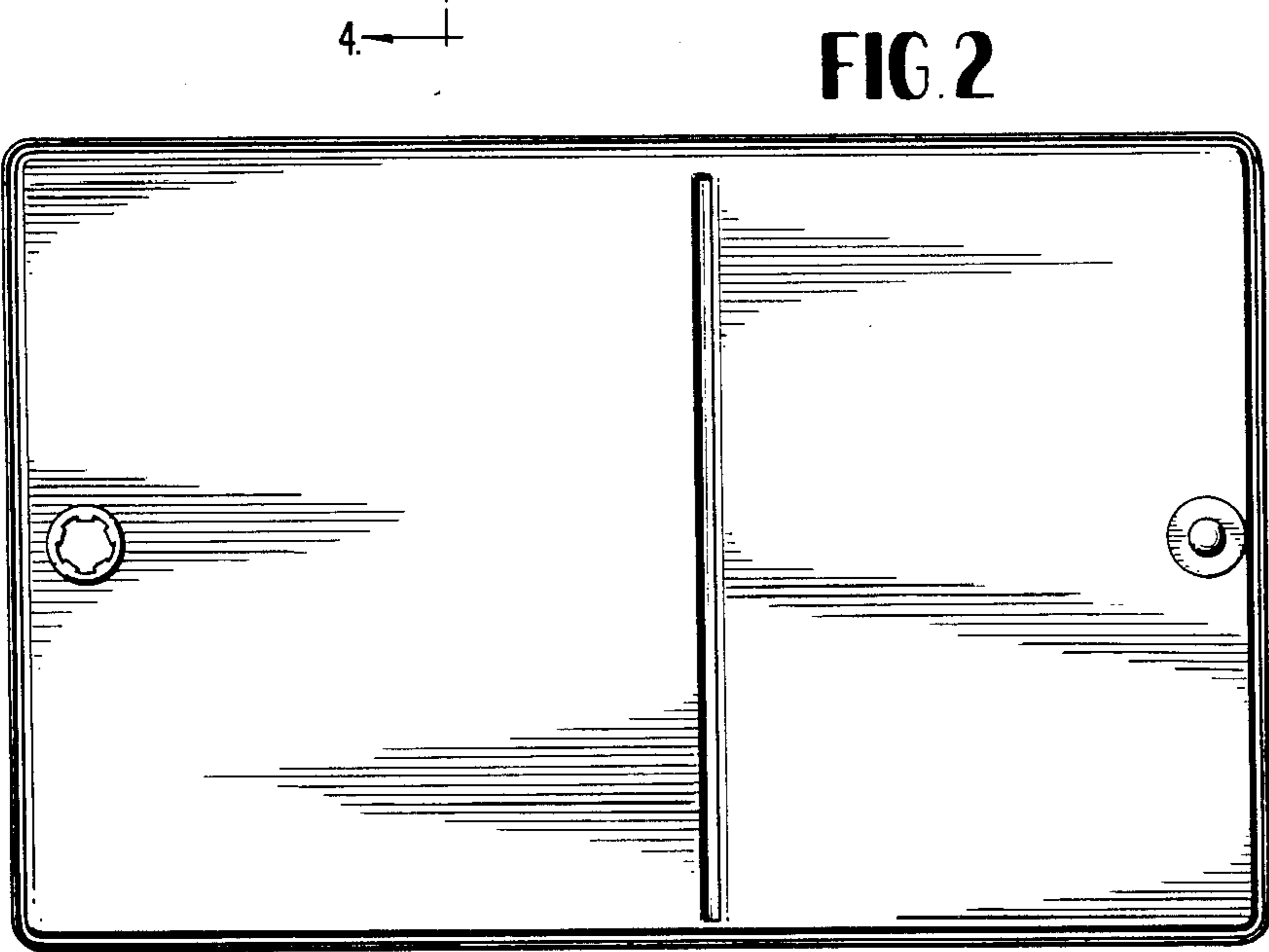
