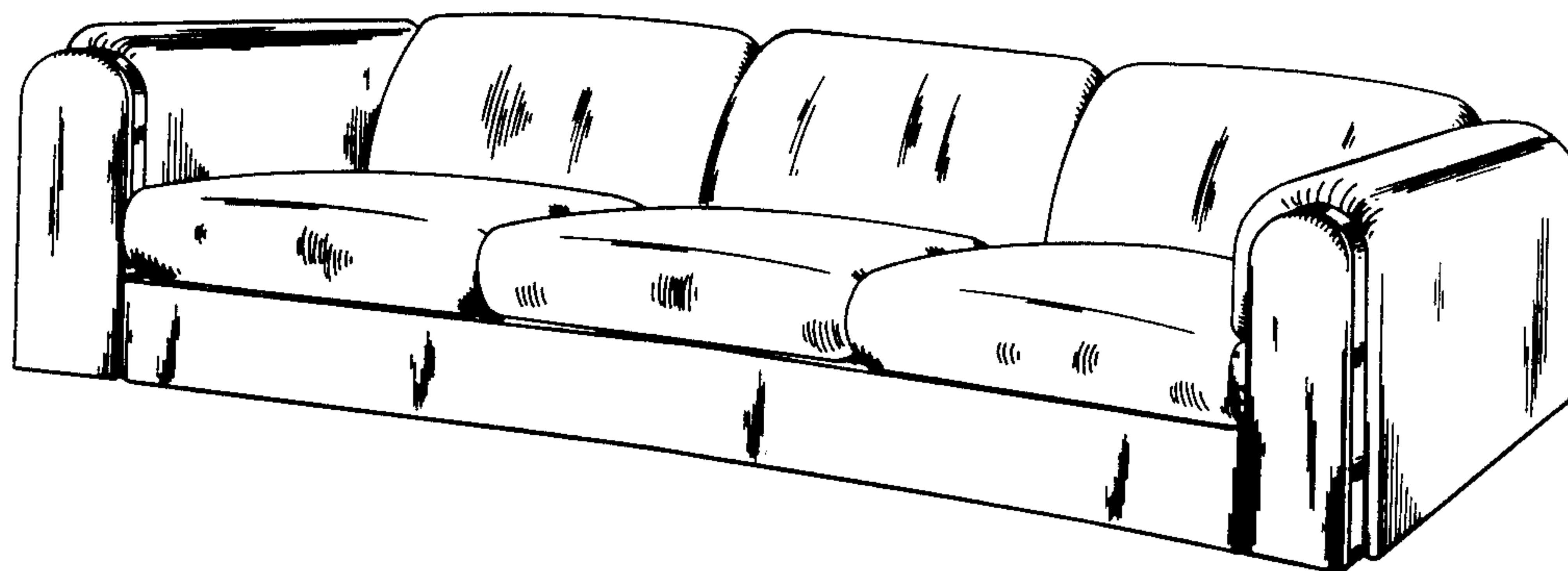

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of the design shown in the form of a loveseat.



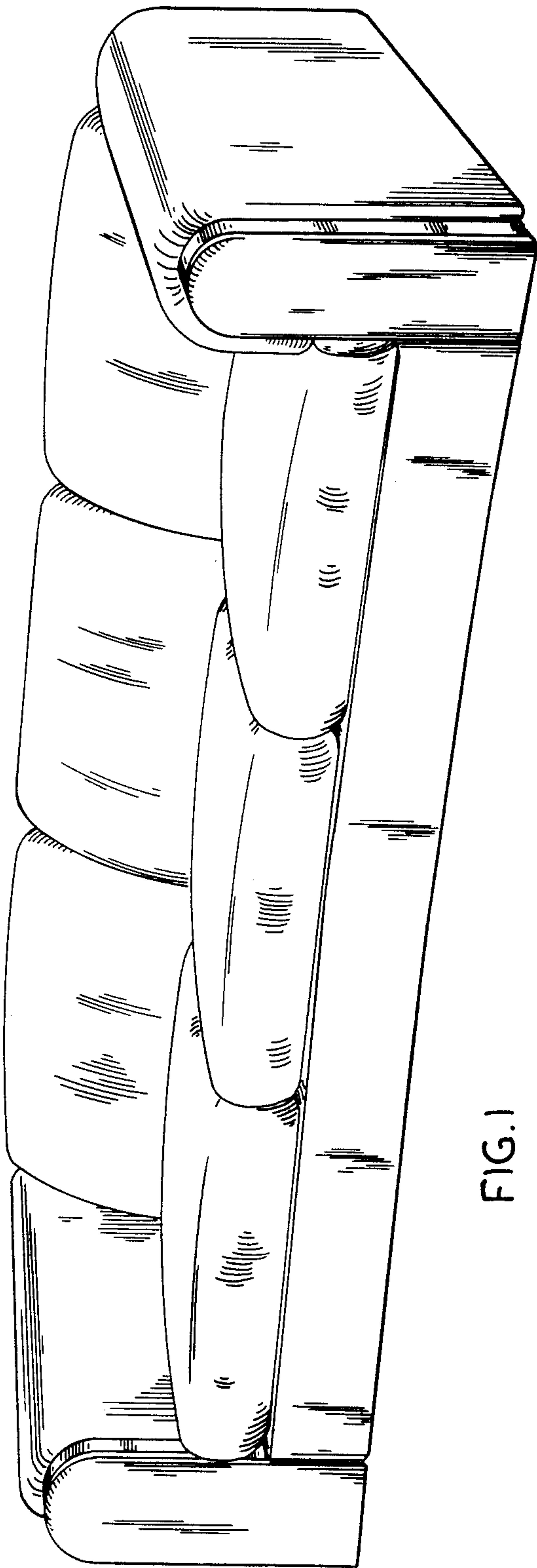

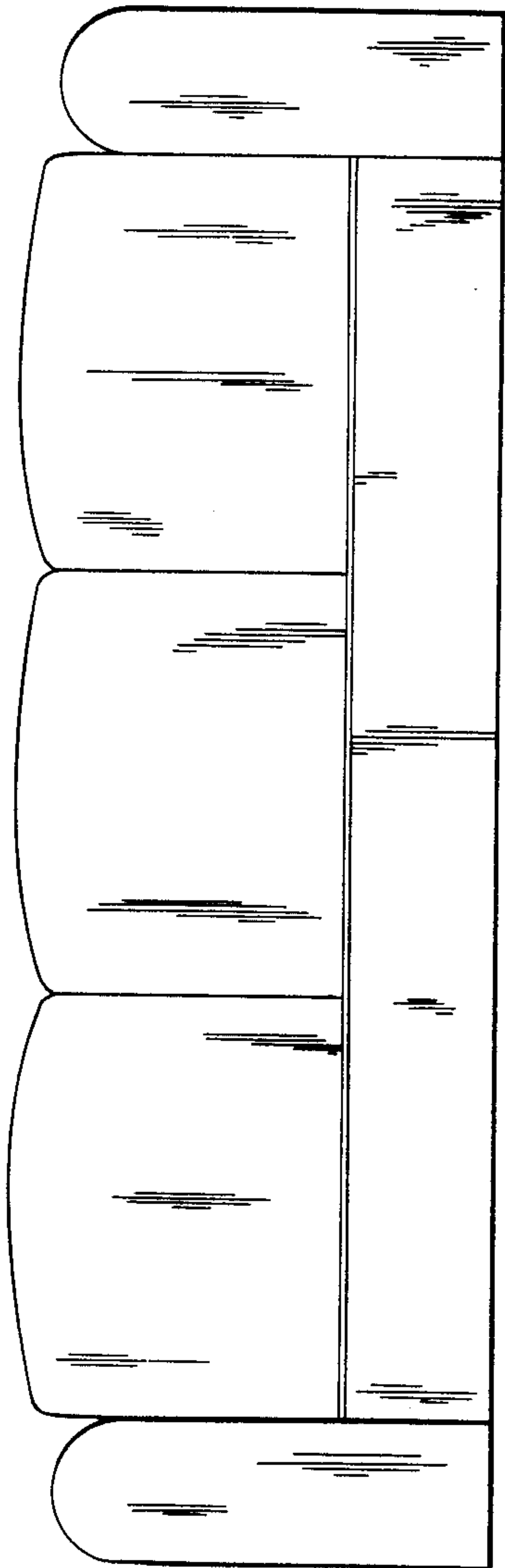

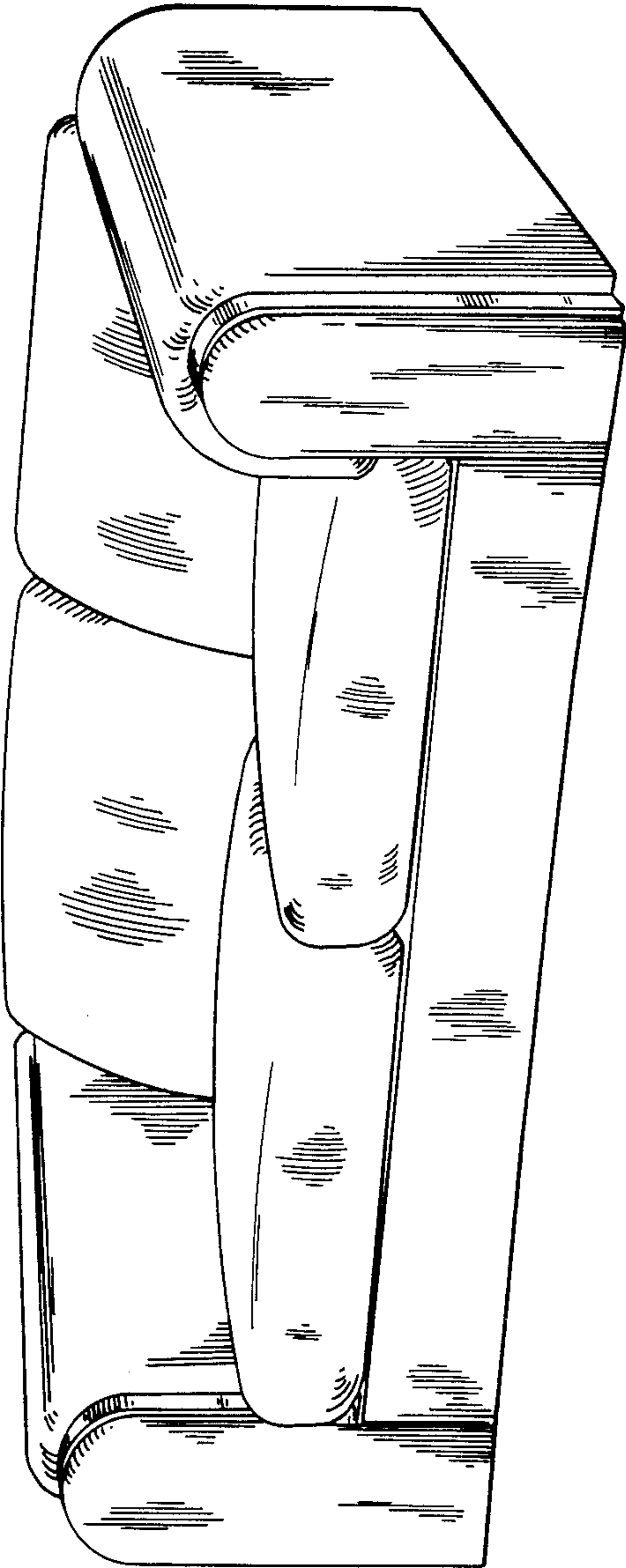
