 FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1.

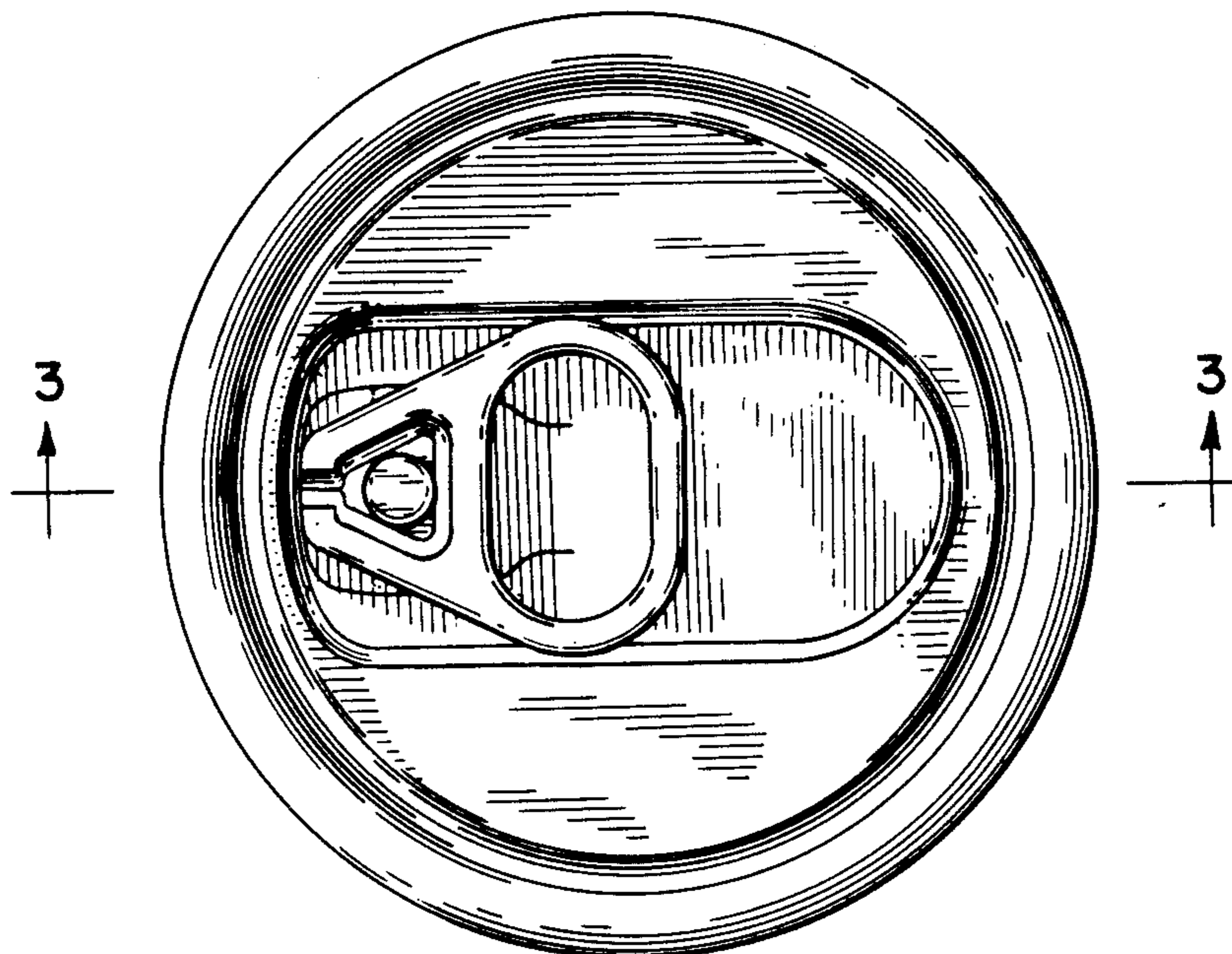

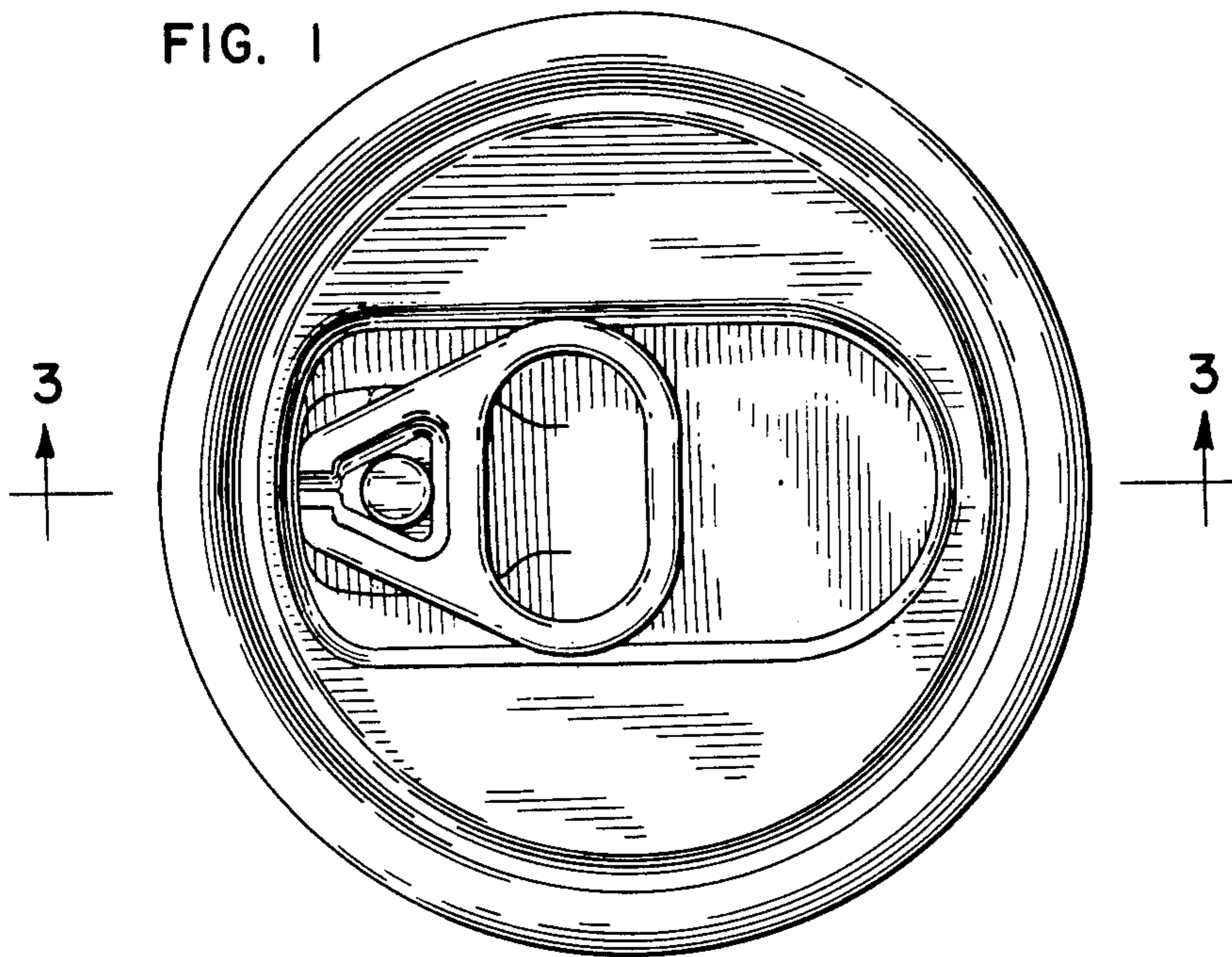

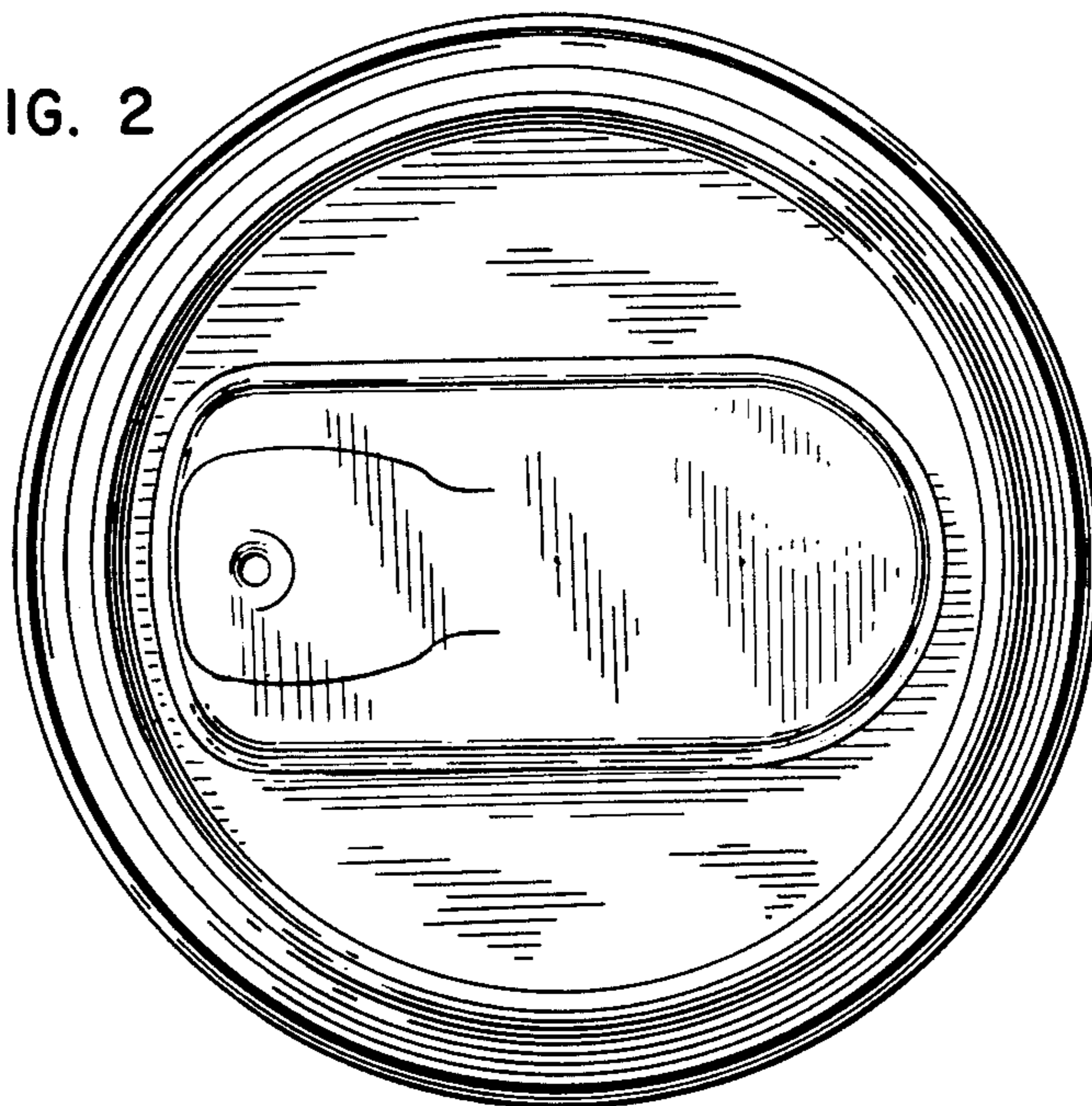
