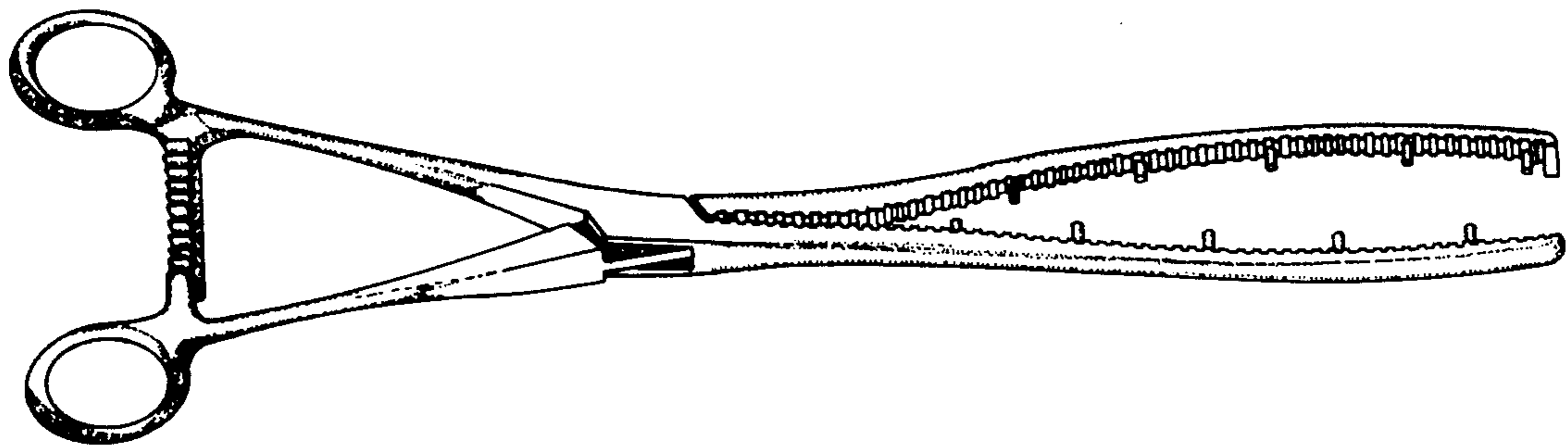
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of the hepatic occlusion clamp, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the hepatic occlusion clamp.
 FIG. 2 is an isometric view of an opposite side of the hepatic occlusion clamp as shown in FIG. 1.
 FIG. 3 is a front elevation of the hepatic occlusion clamp with the jaws partially open.
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the hepatic occlusion clamp.

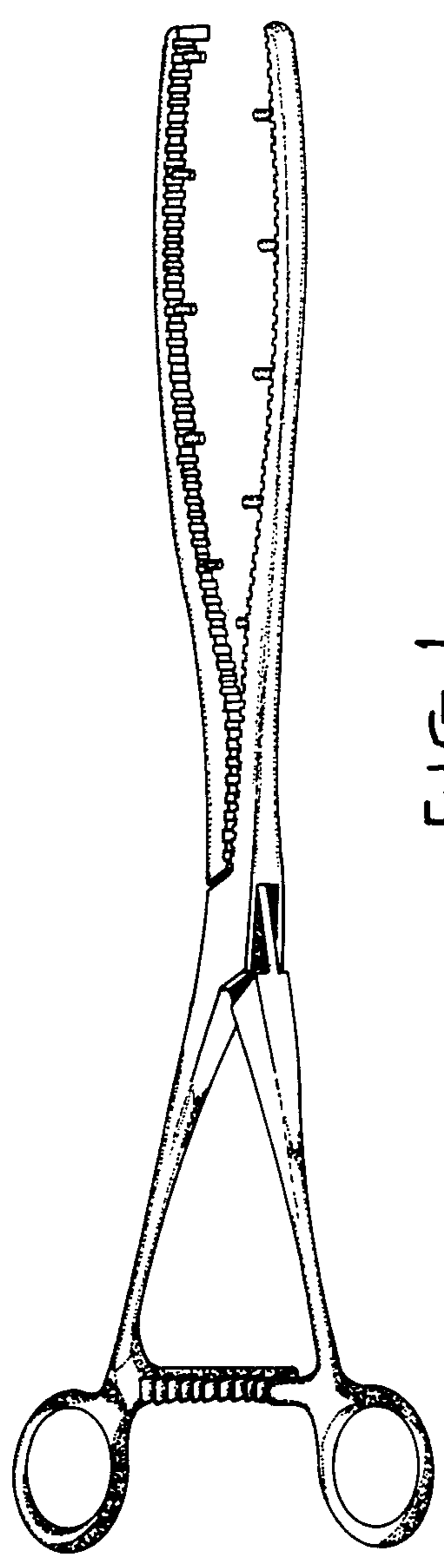

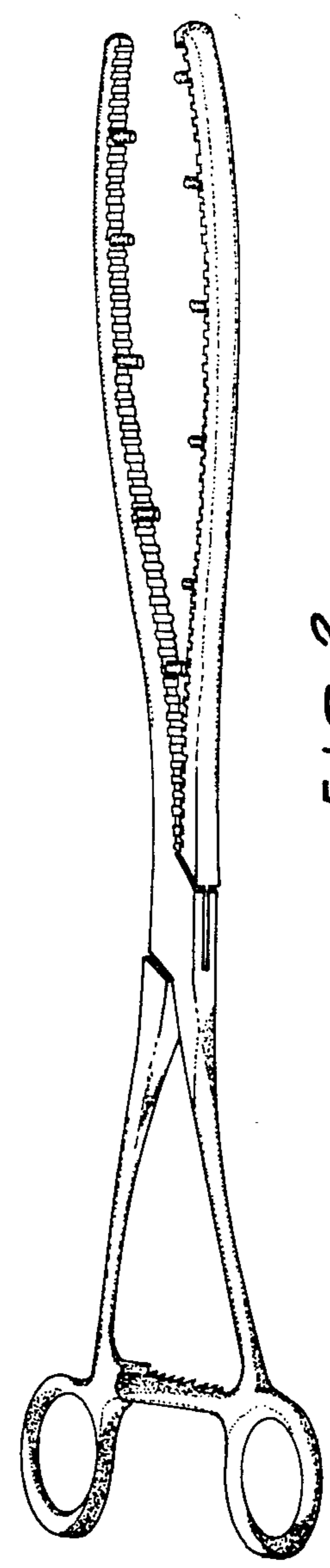

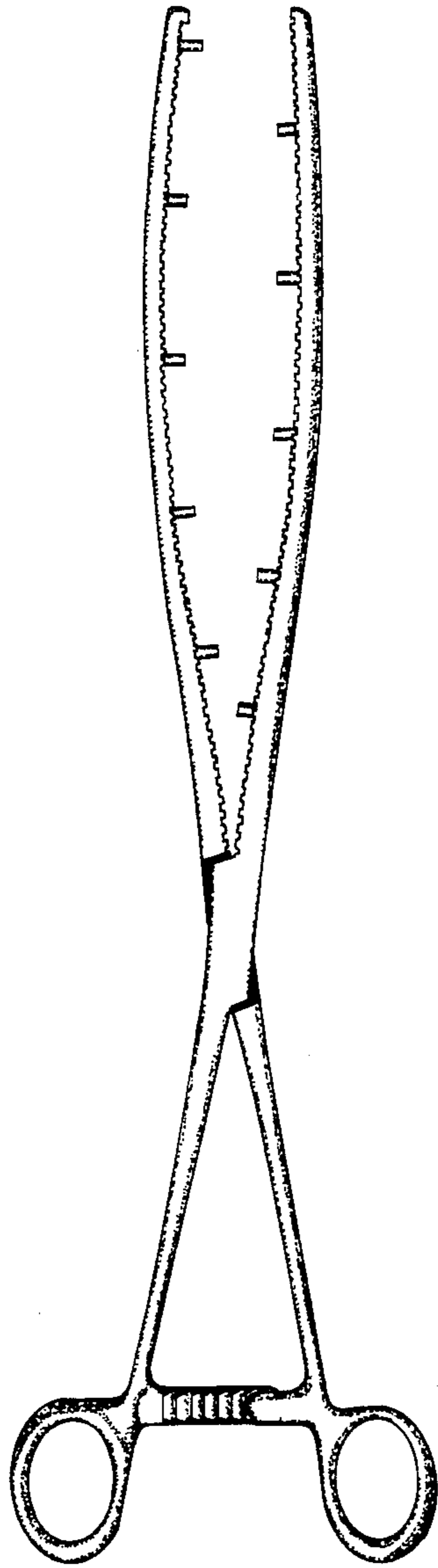
