The ornamental design for a calculator support stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top perspective view of the right side of a calculator support stand, showing my design.
FIG. 2 is a rear, top perspective view of the opposite side thereof.
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the left side of FIG. 2.
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the right side of FIG. 2.
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1.
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2.
