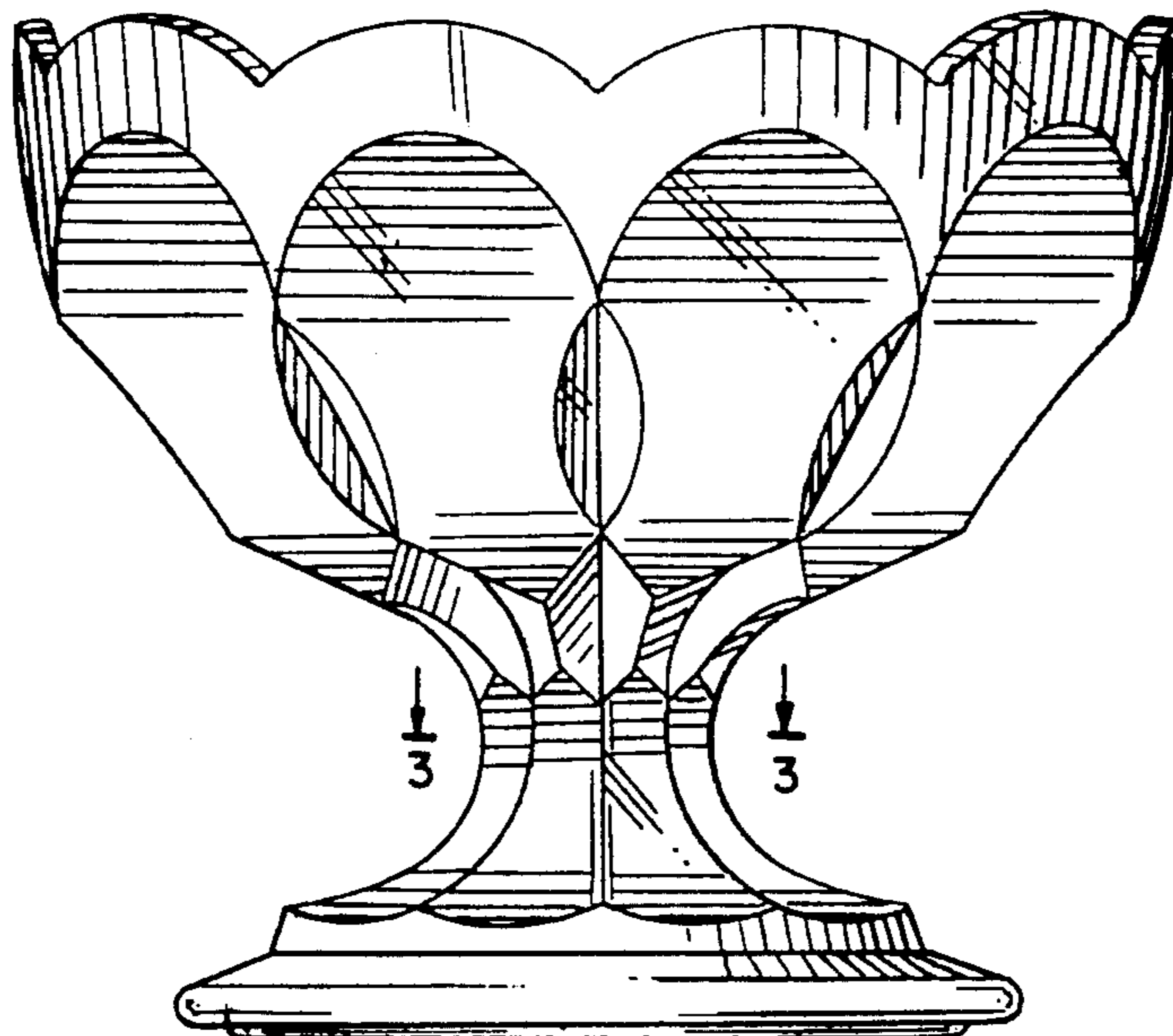

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a compote dish or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a compote dish or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on a reduced scale;
FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken on line 3-3 of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale;
FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 3 on the scale of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



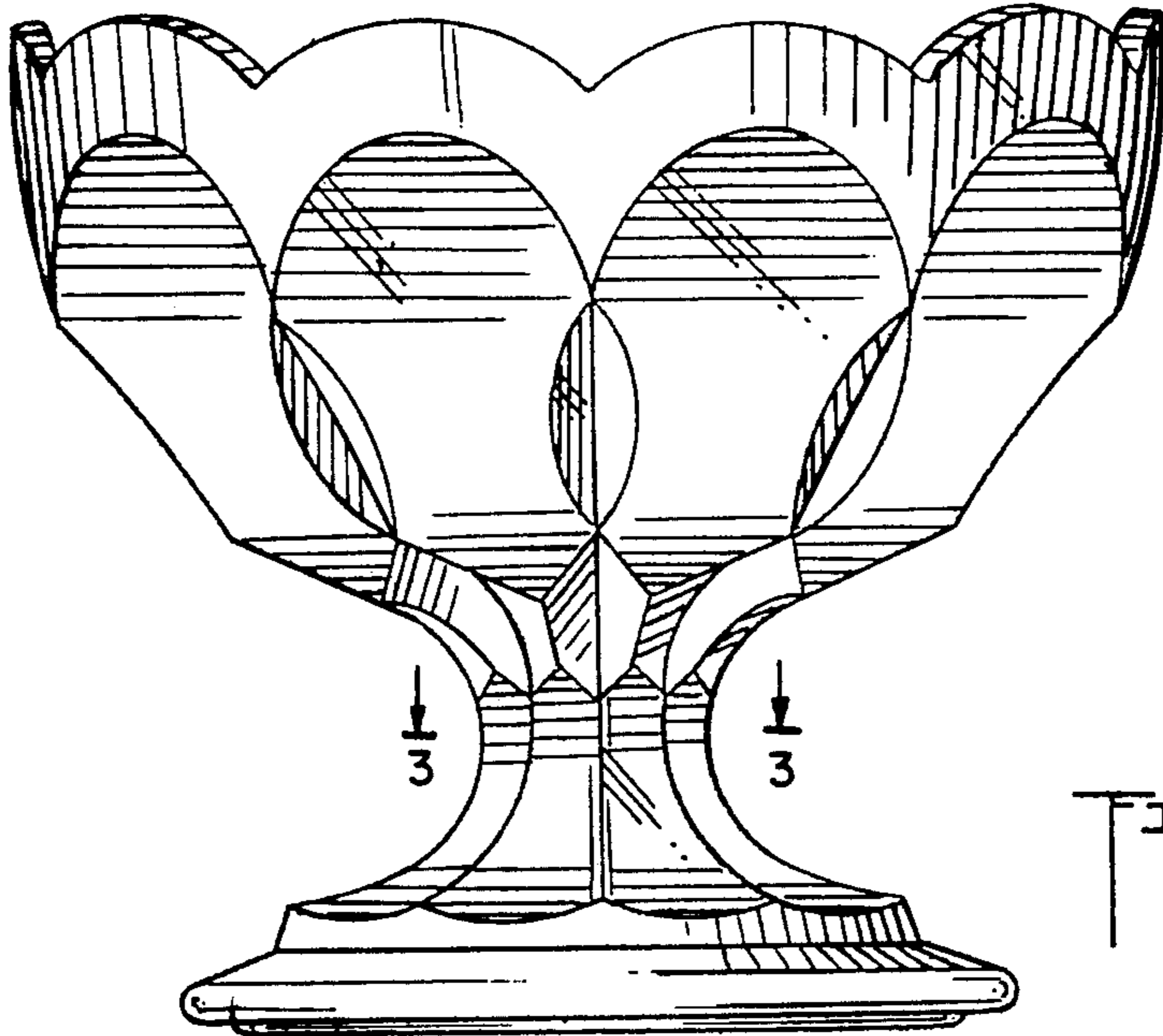

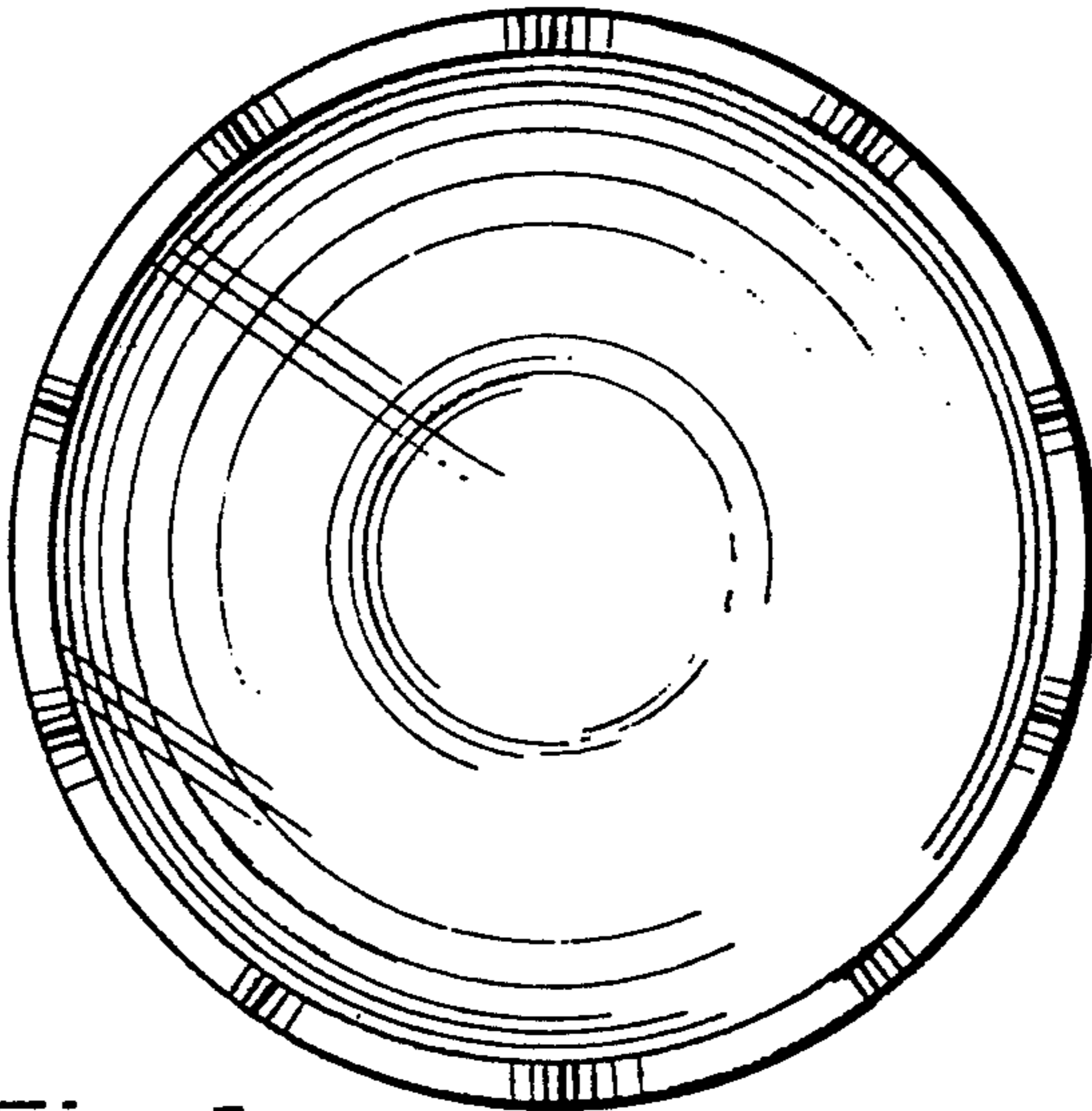

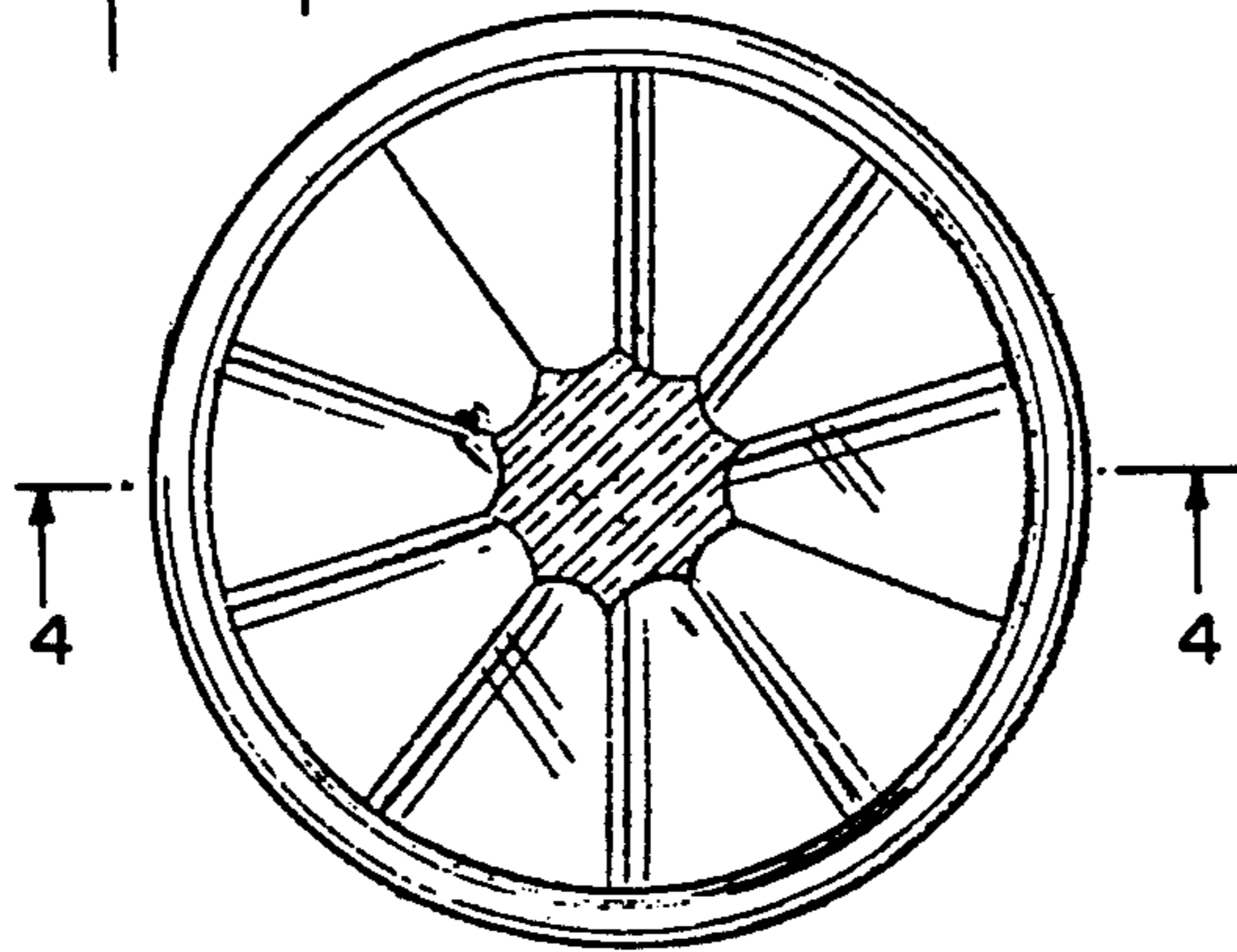

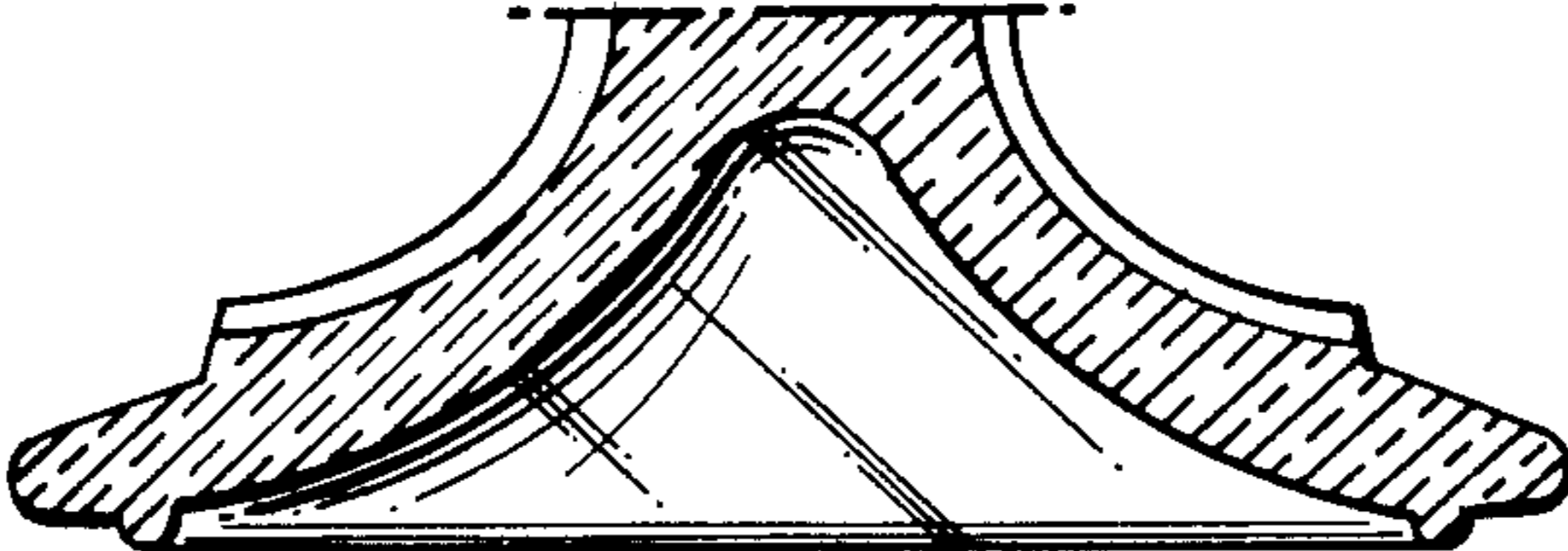
