DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is an opposite end view thereof on an enlarged scale.

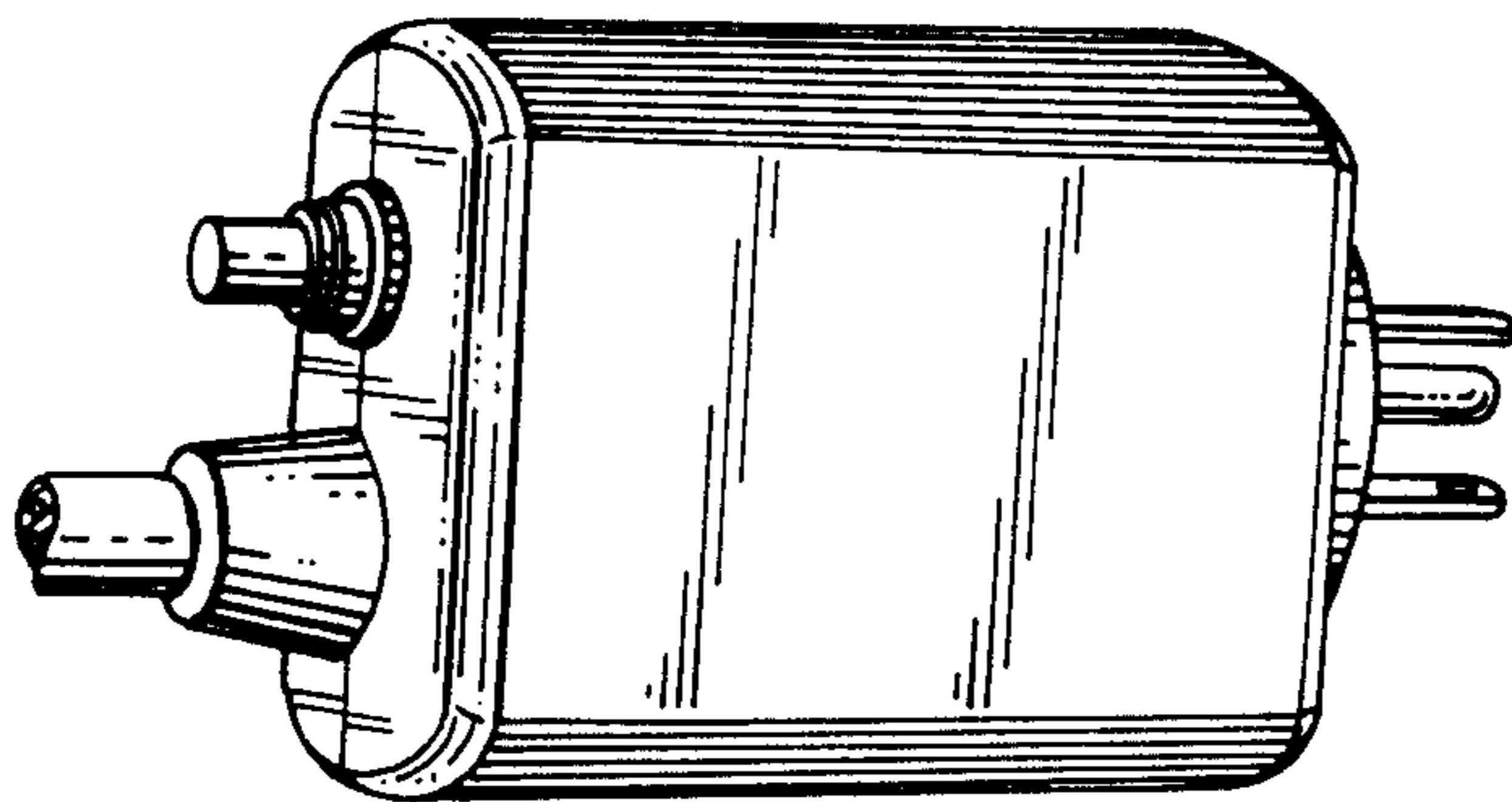

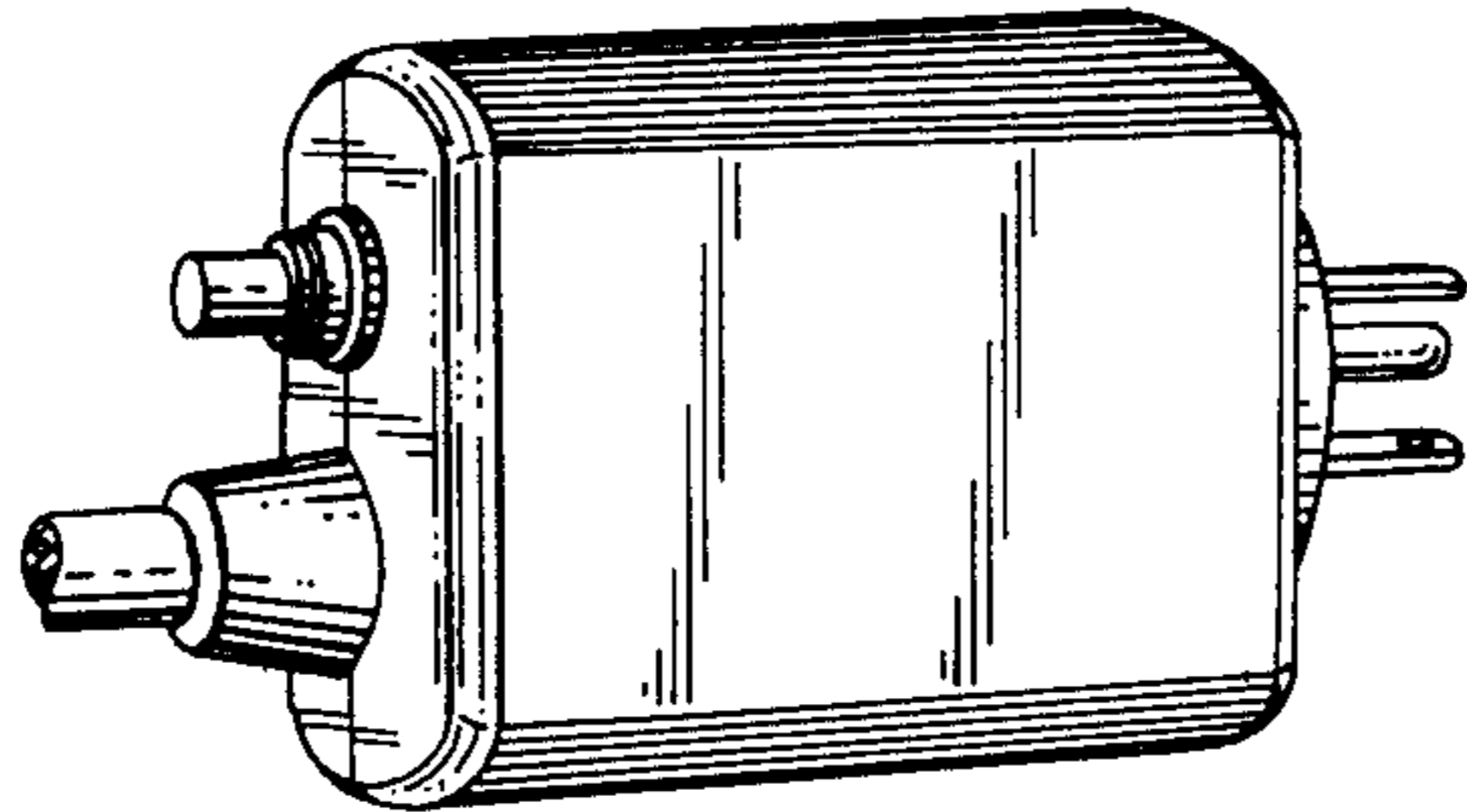

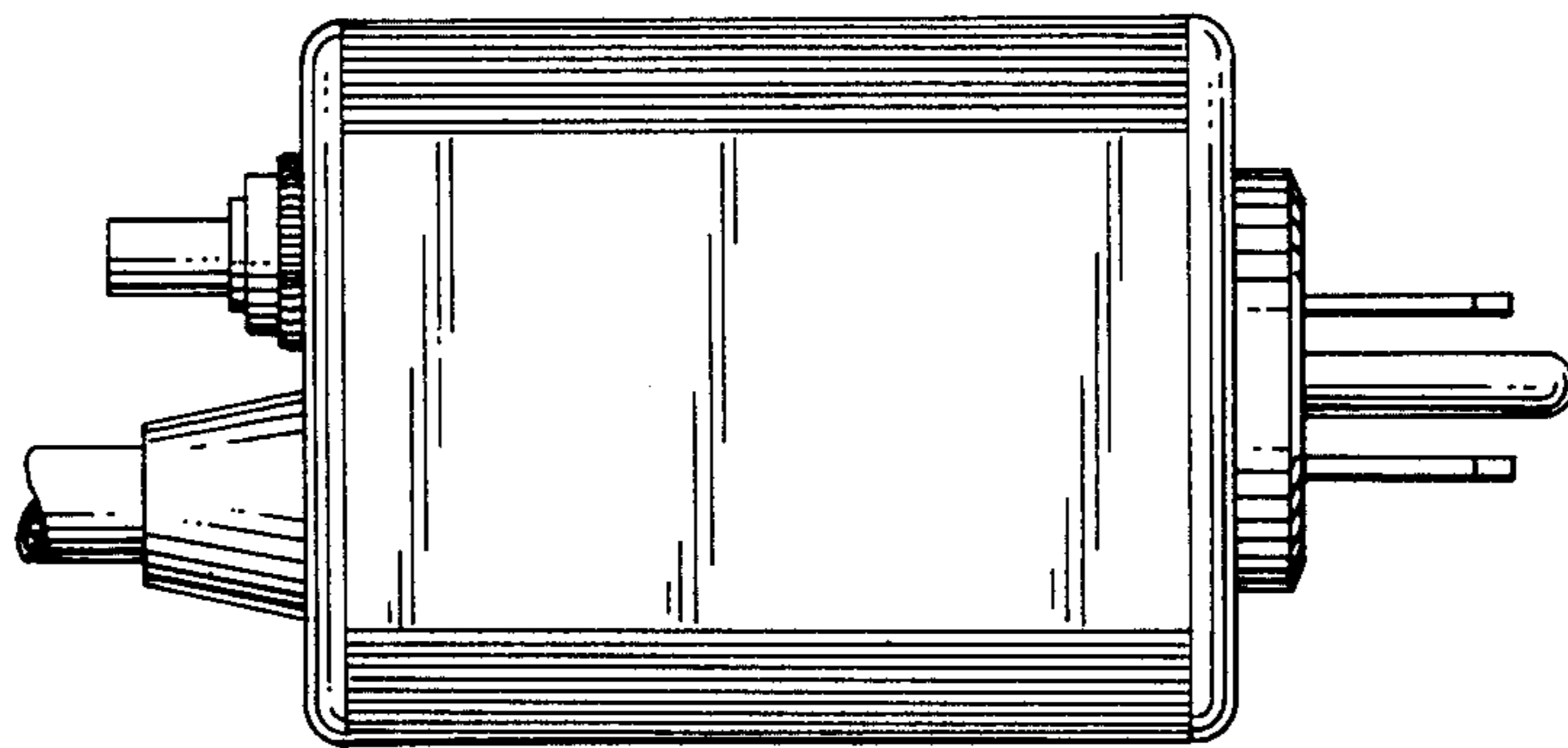

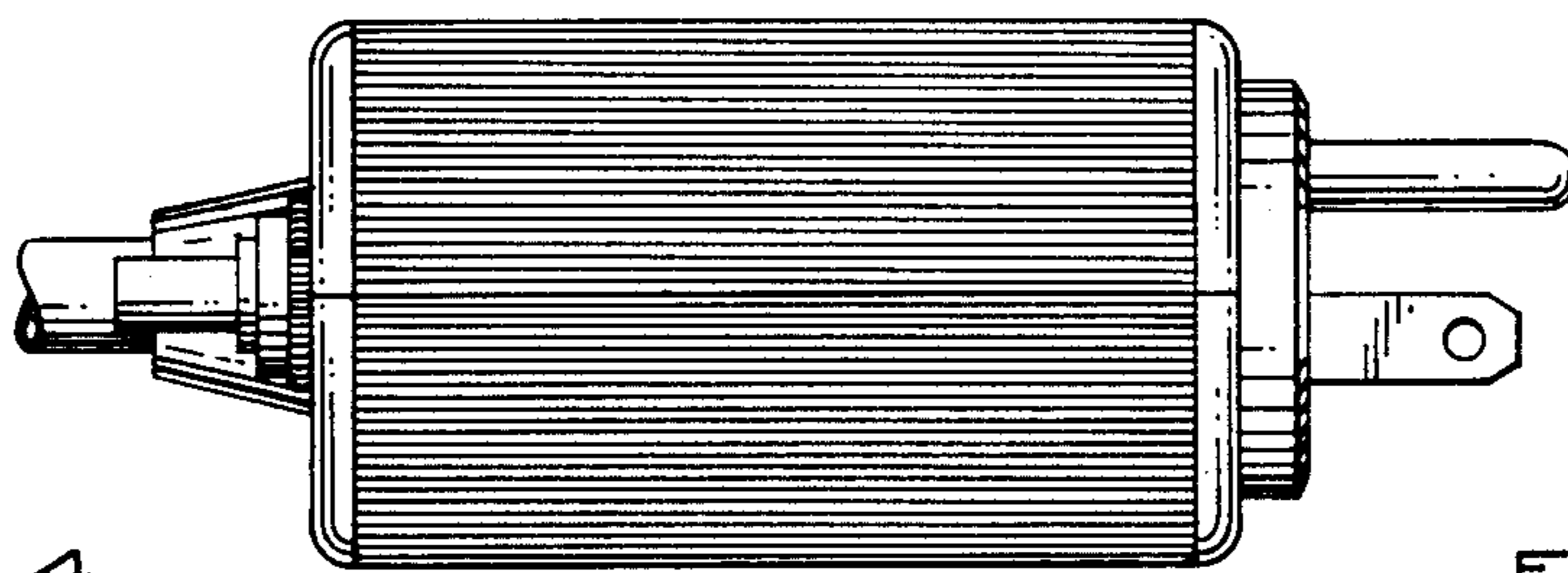

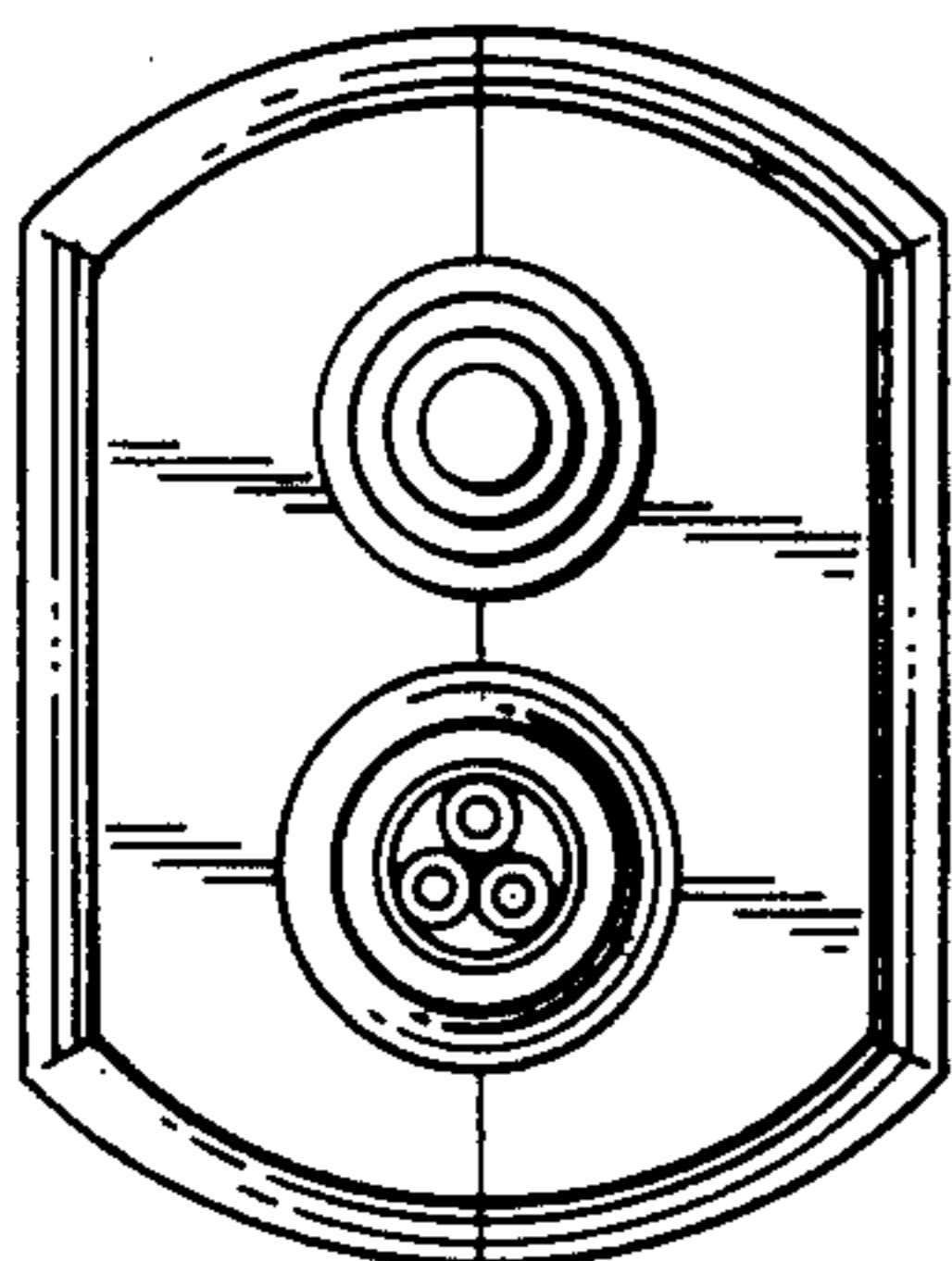
