DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the sun visor showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view.

The sun visor is symmetrical so that any obscured portions on the drawings are the same as visible portions on the opposite side of the visor.

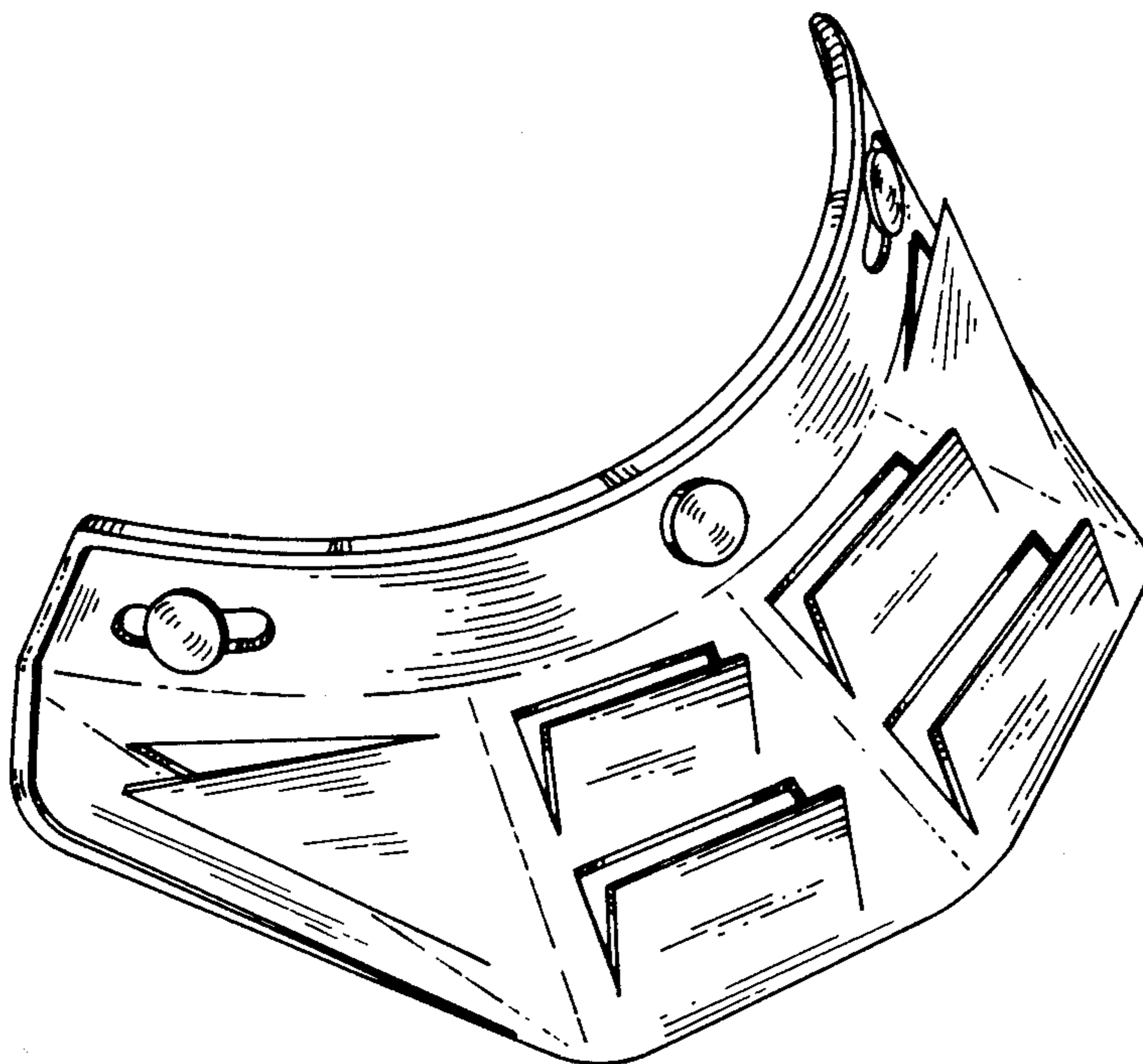

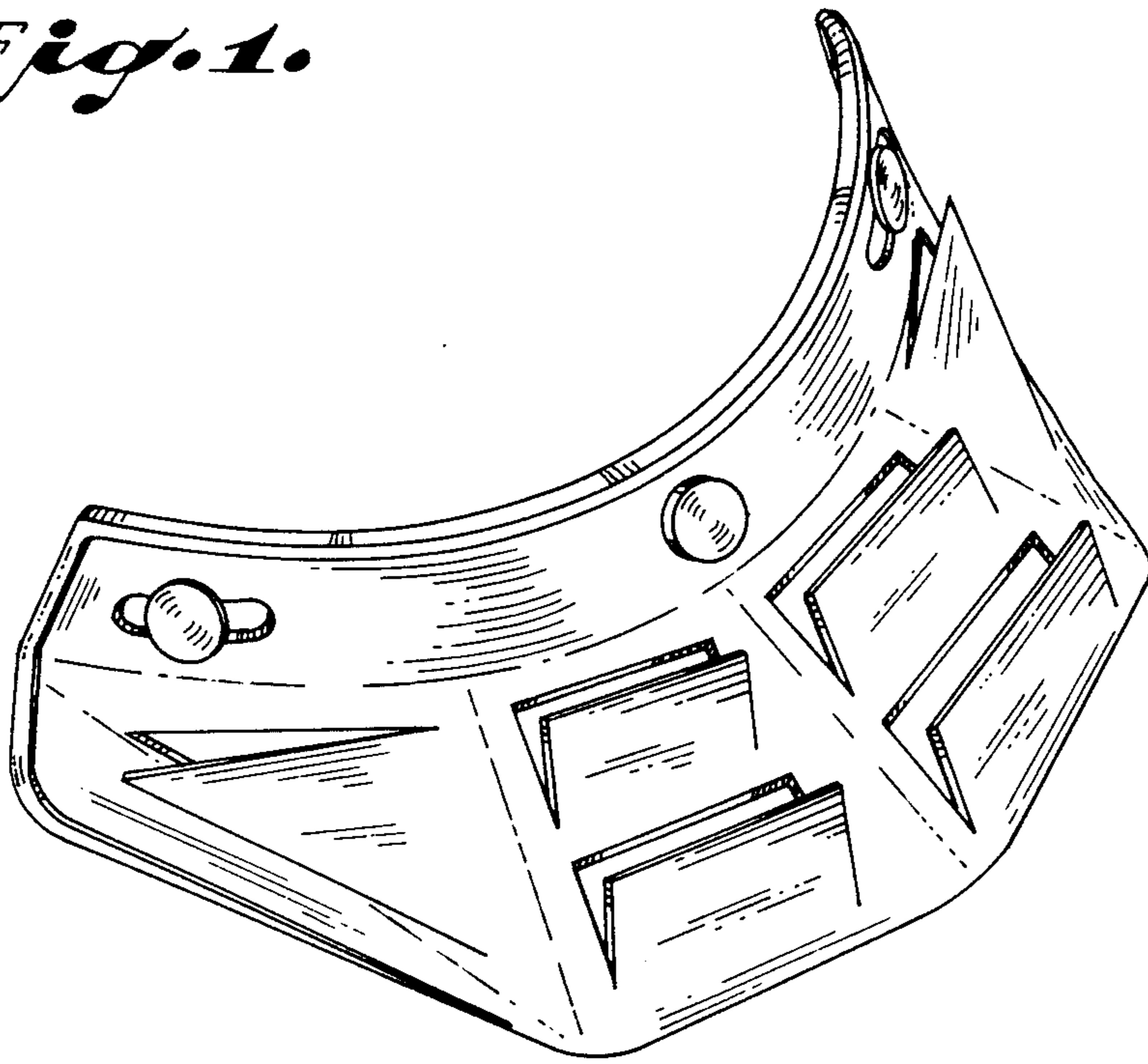
