DESCRIPTION

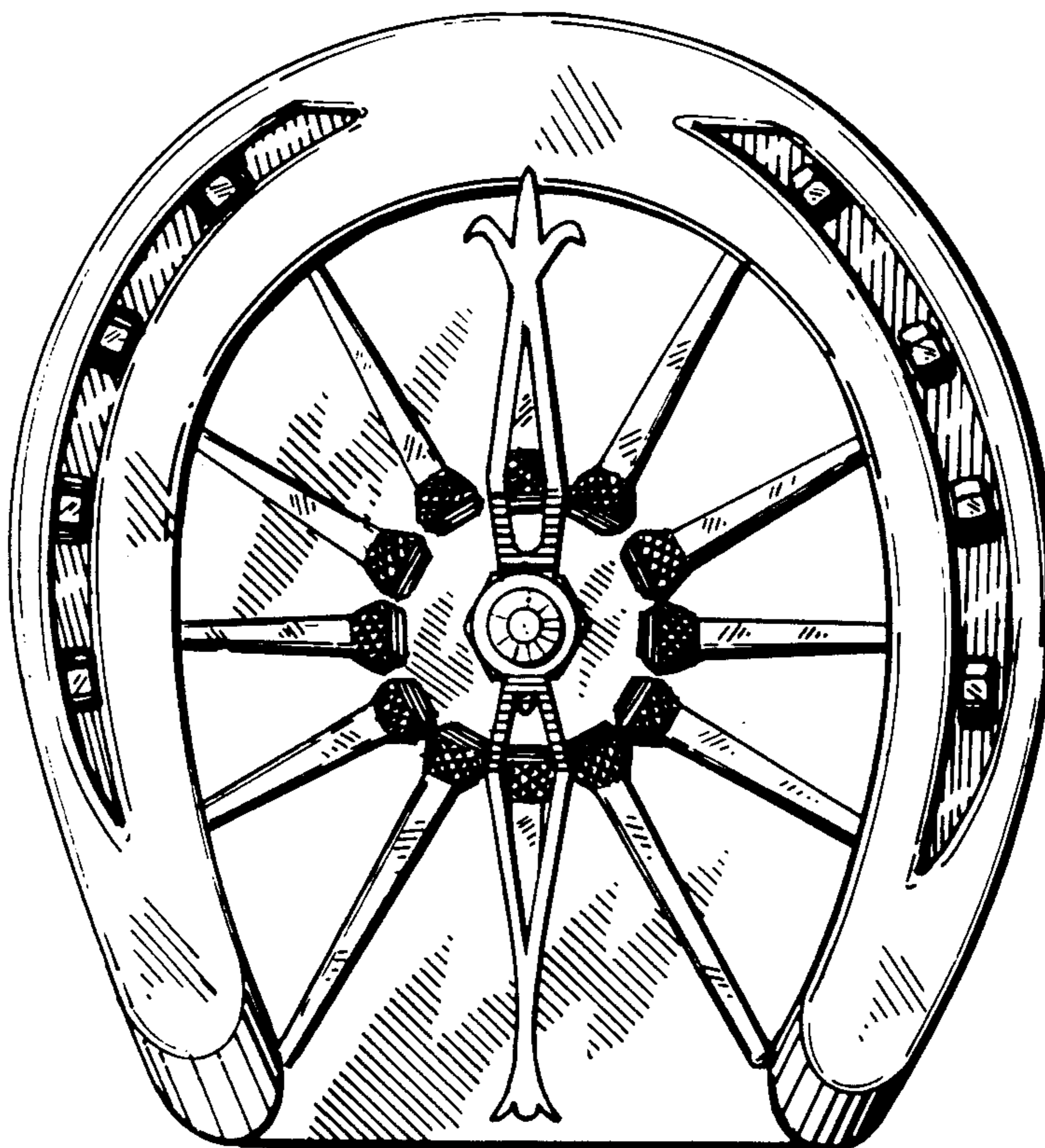
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof the left side being a mirror image thereto.



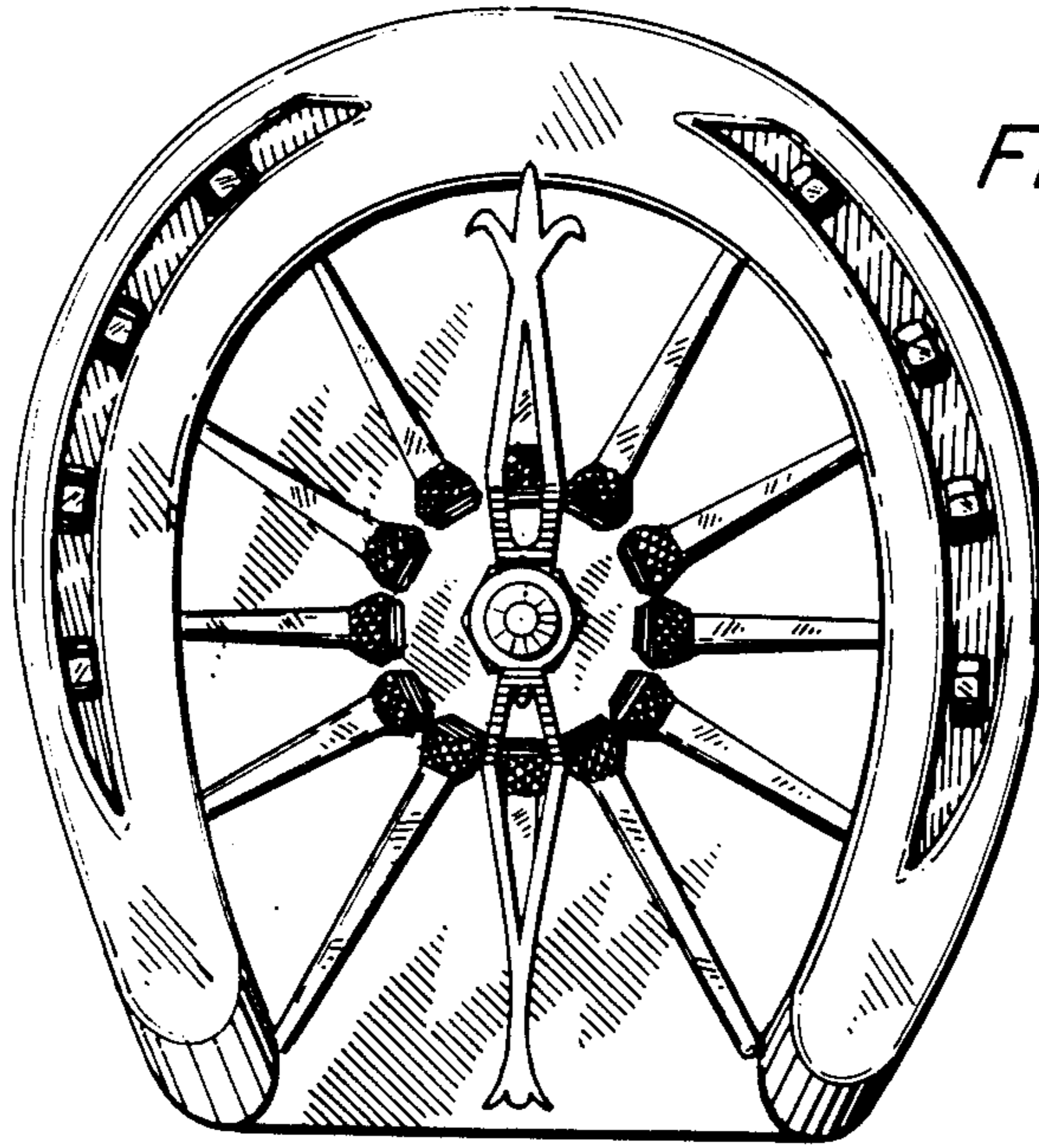

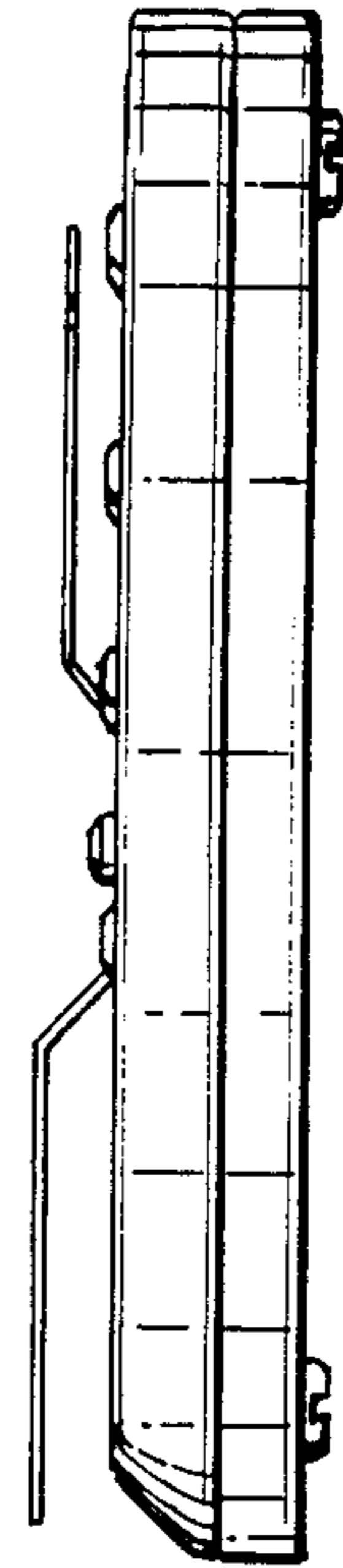

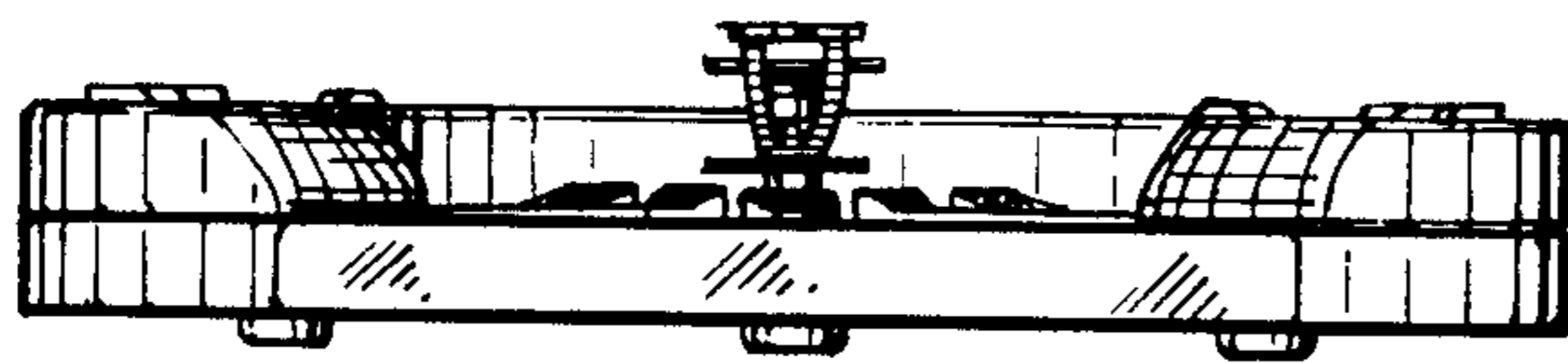

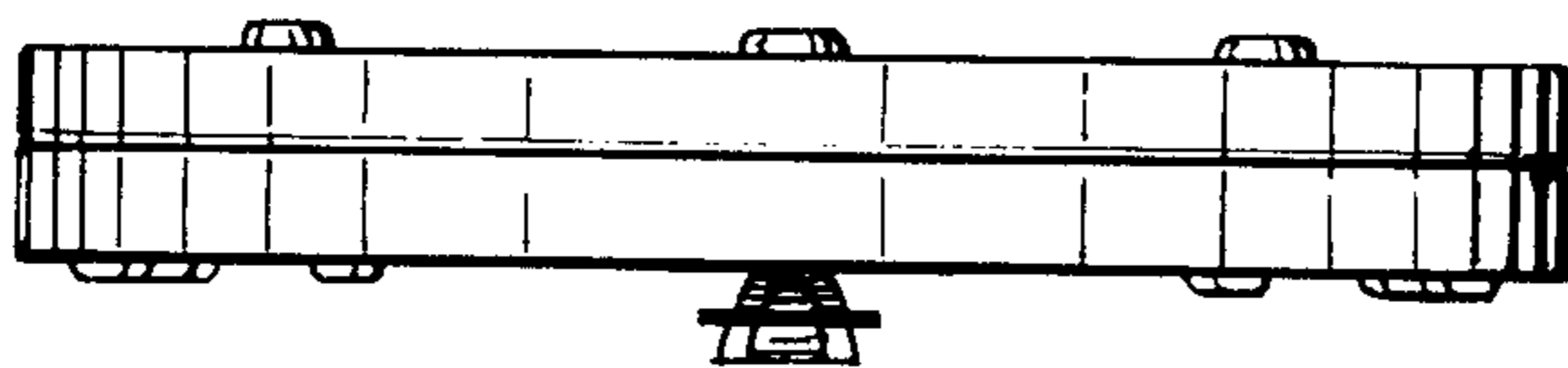

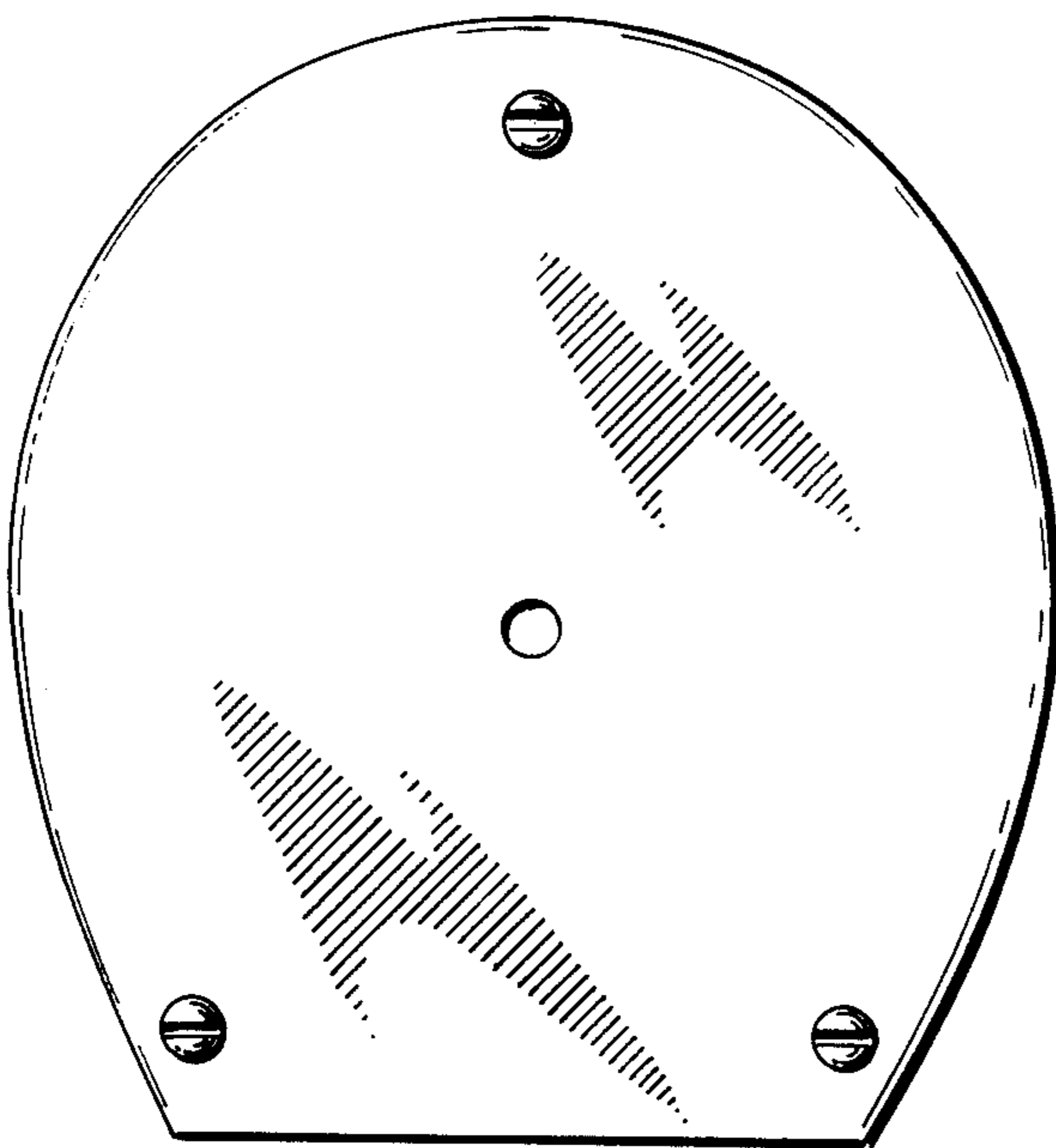
