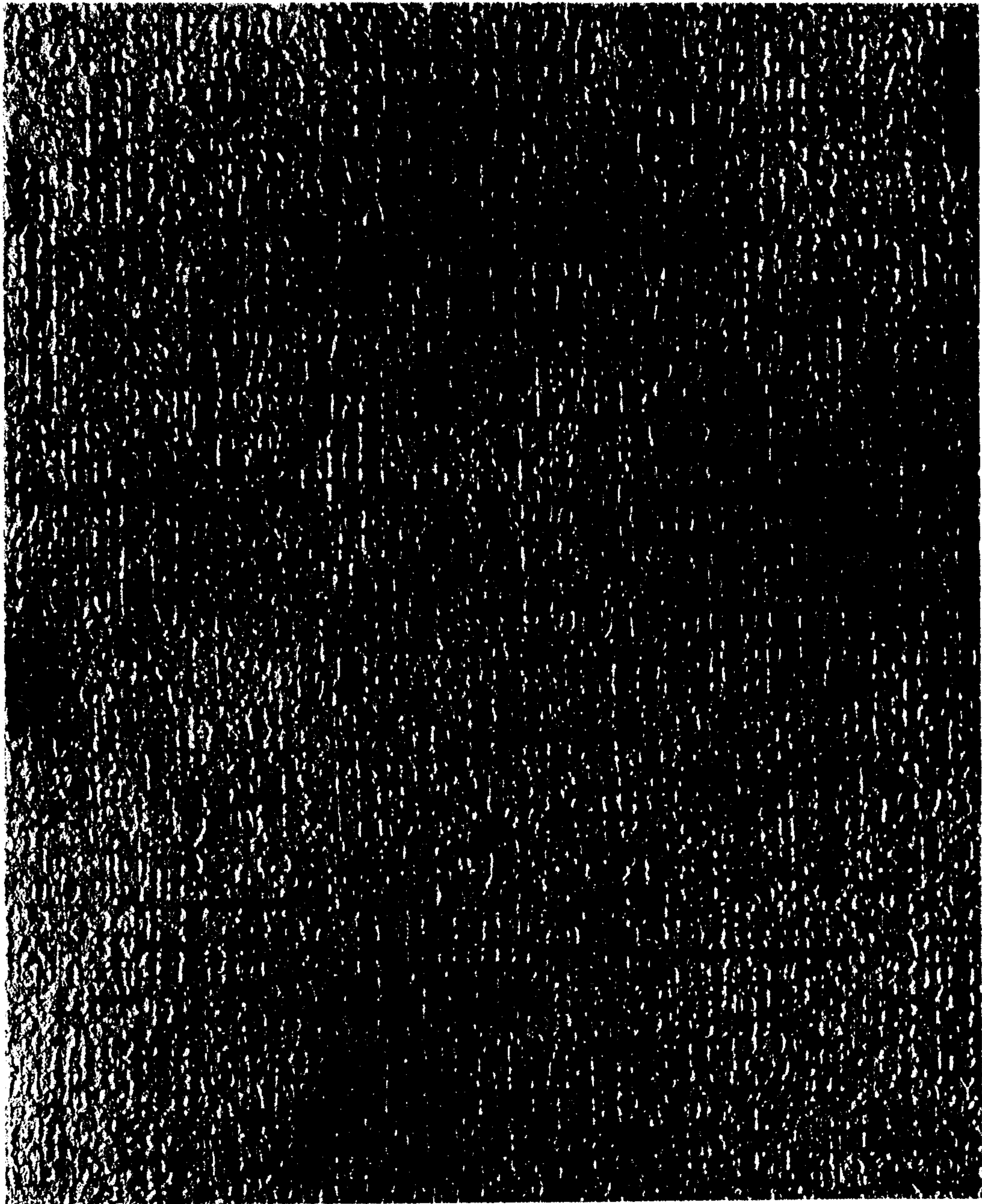
The ornamental design for a ceiling tile, as shown.

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view of a portion of the ceiling tile as shown in FIG. 1.



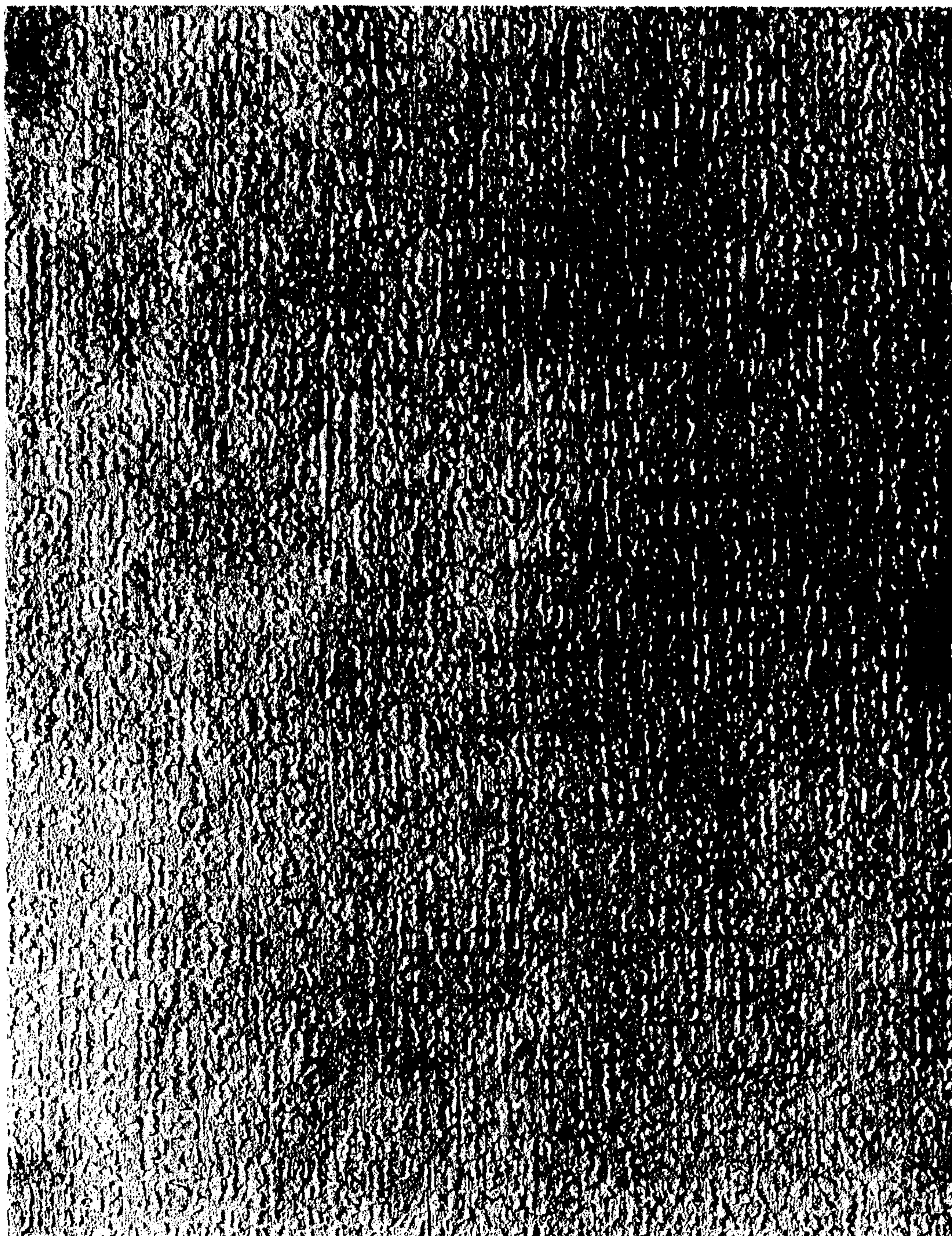

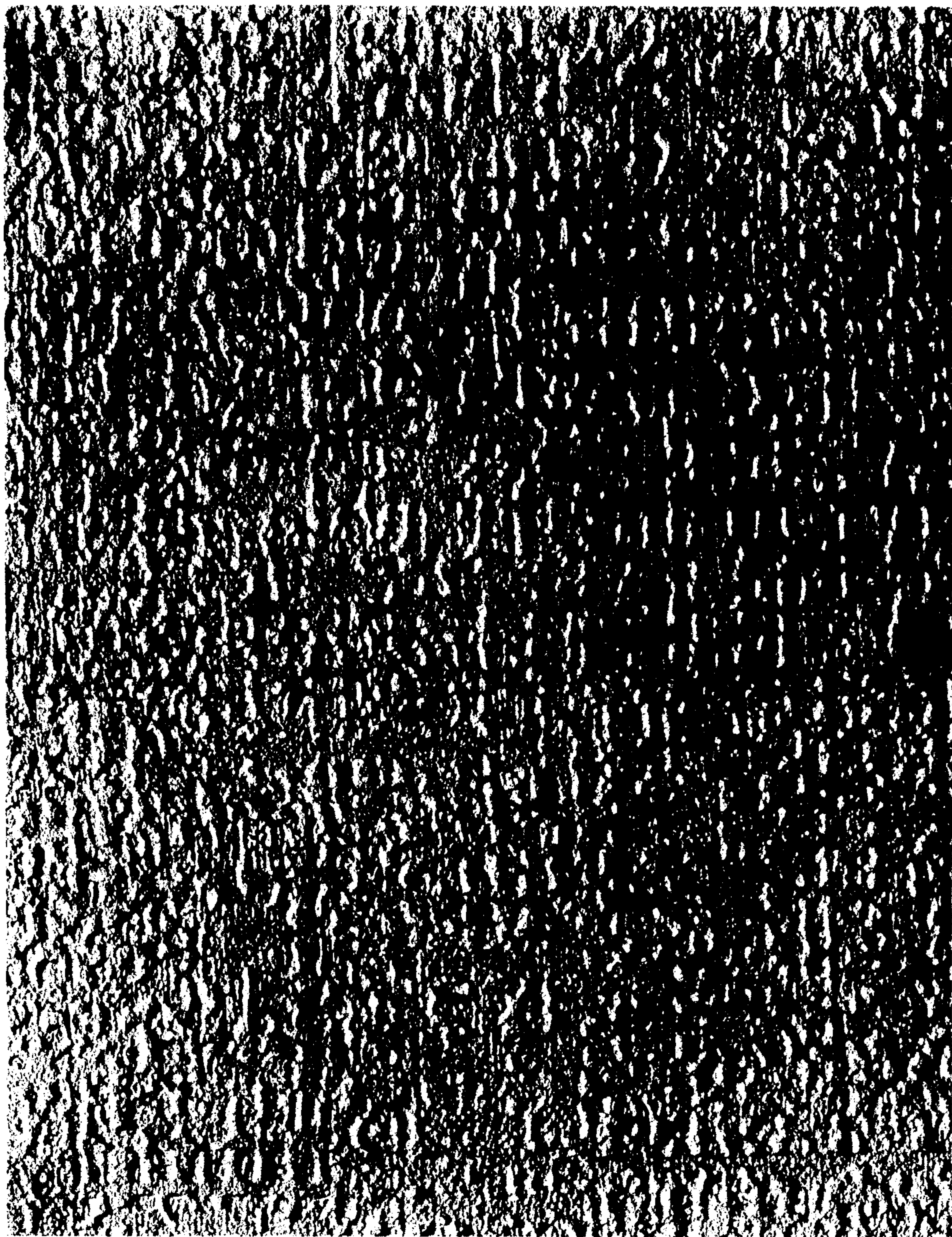
