FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of an ornamental design for a collapsible lamp shade in accordance with the present invention.


FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of an ornamental design in accordance with the present invention;


FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a fourth embodiment of an ornamental design in accordance with the present invention; and
