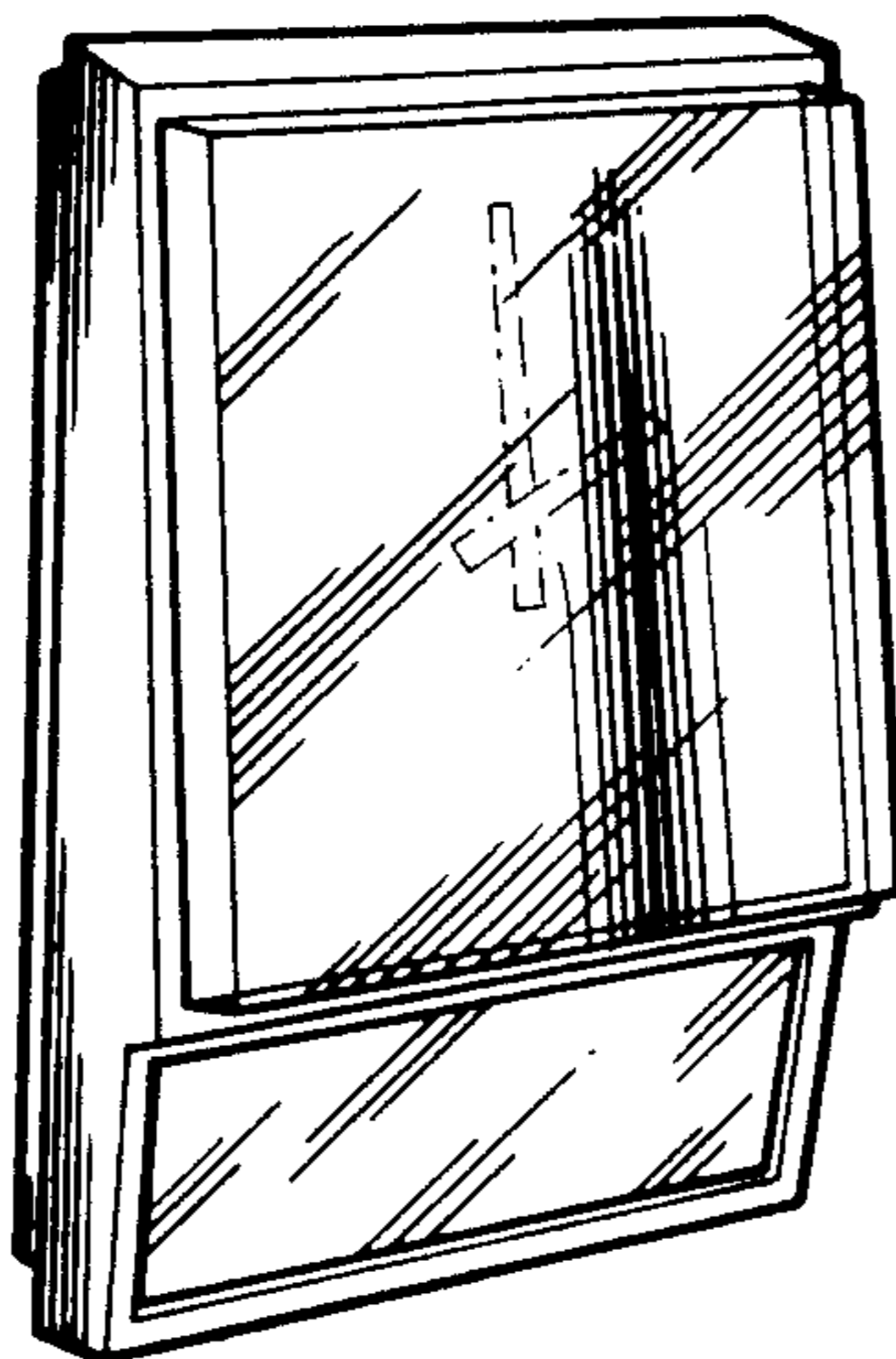
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left perspective view of the combined clock and sign showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is an exploded perspective view thereof from the front and right side;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale; and
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale.

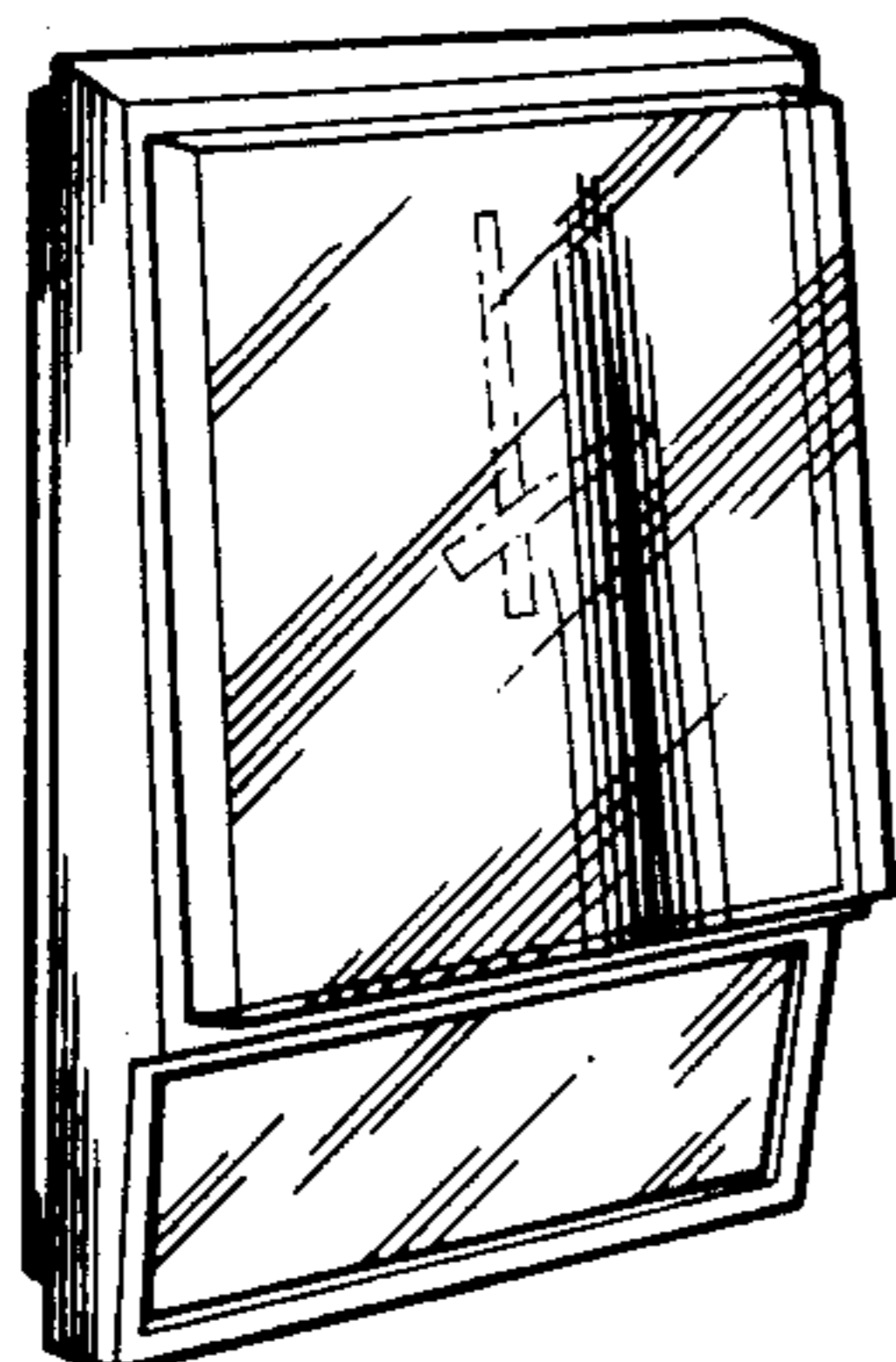

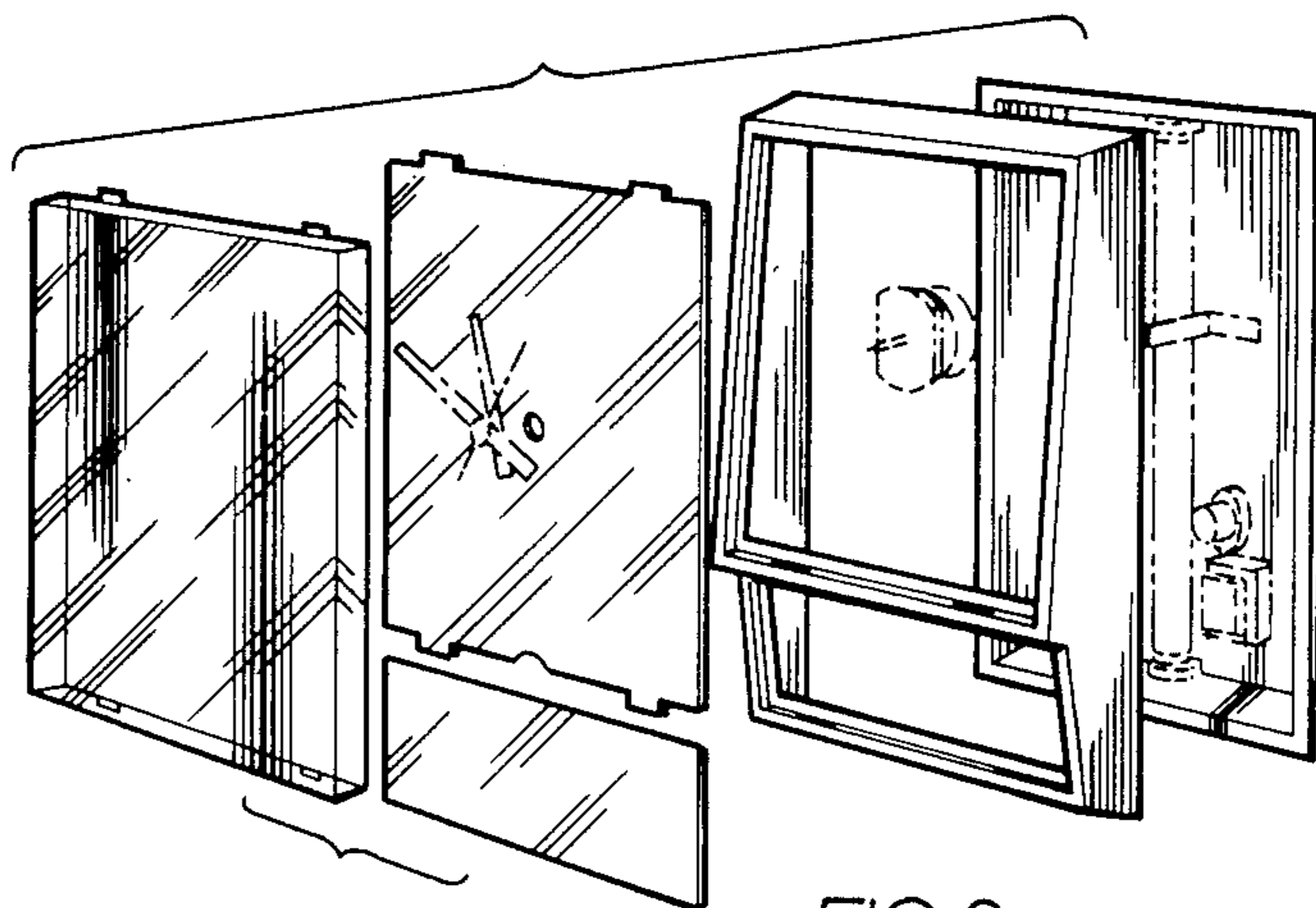

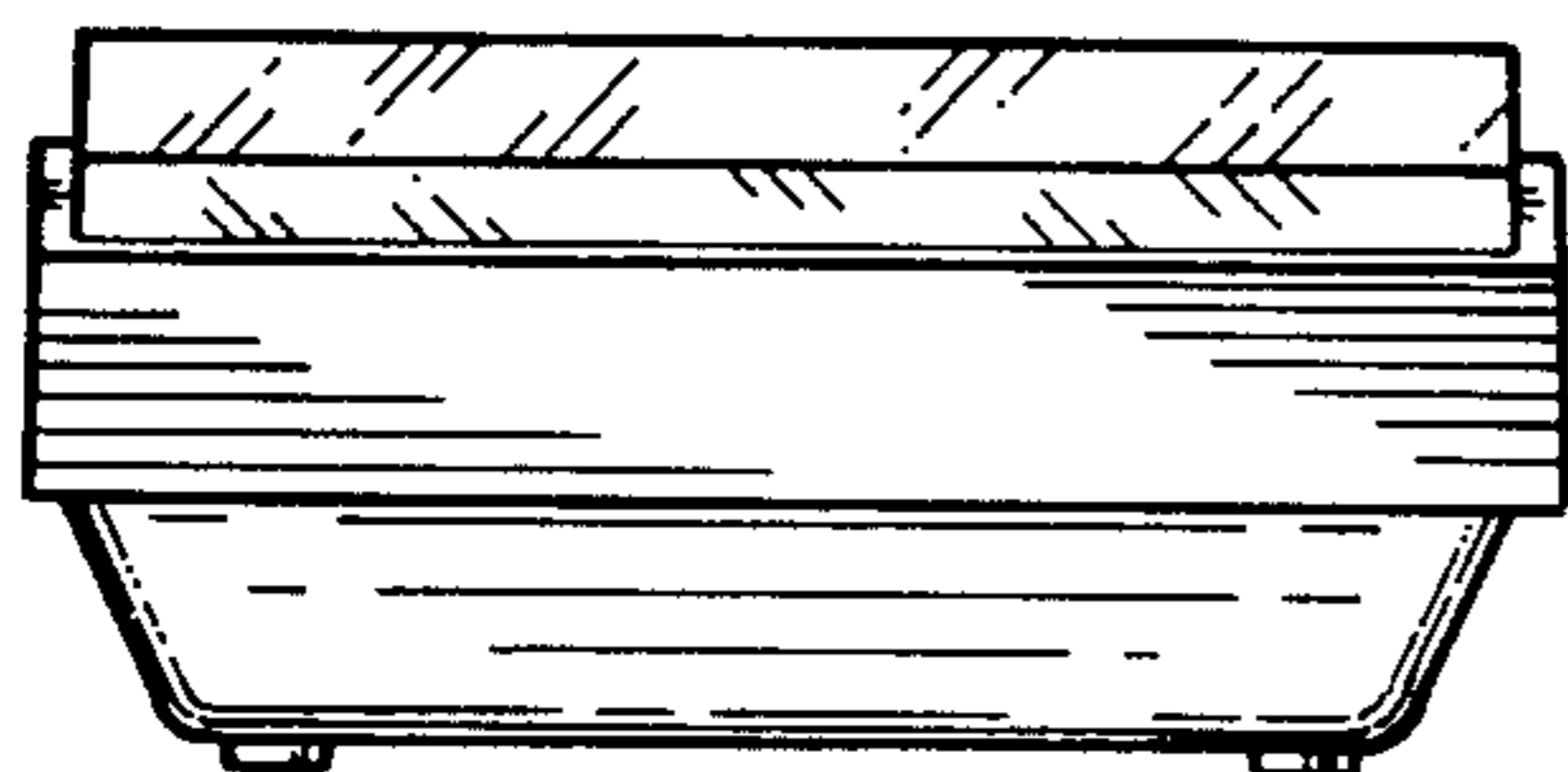

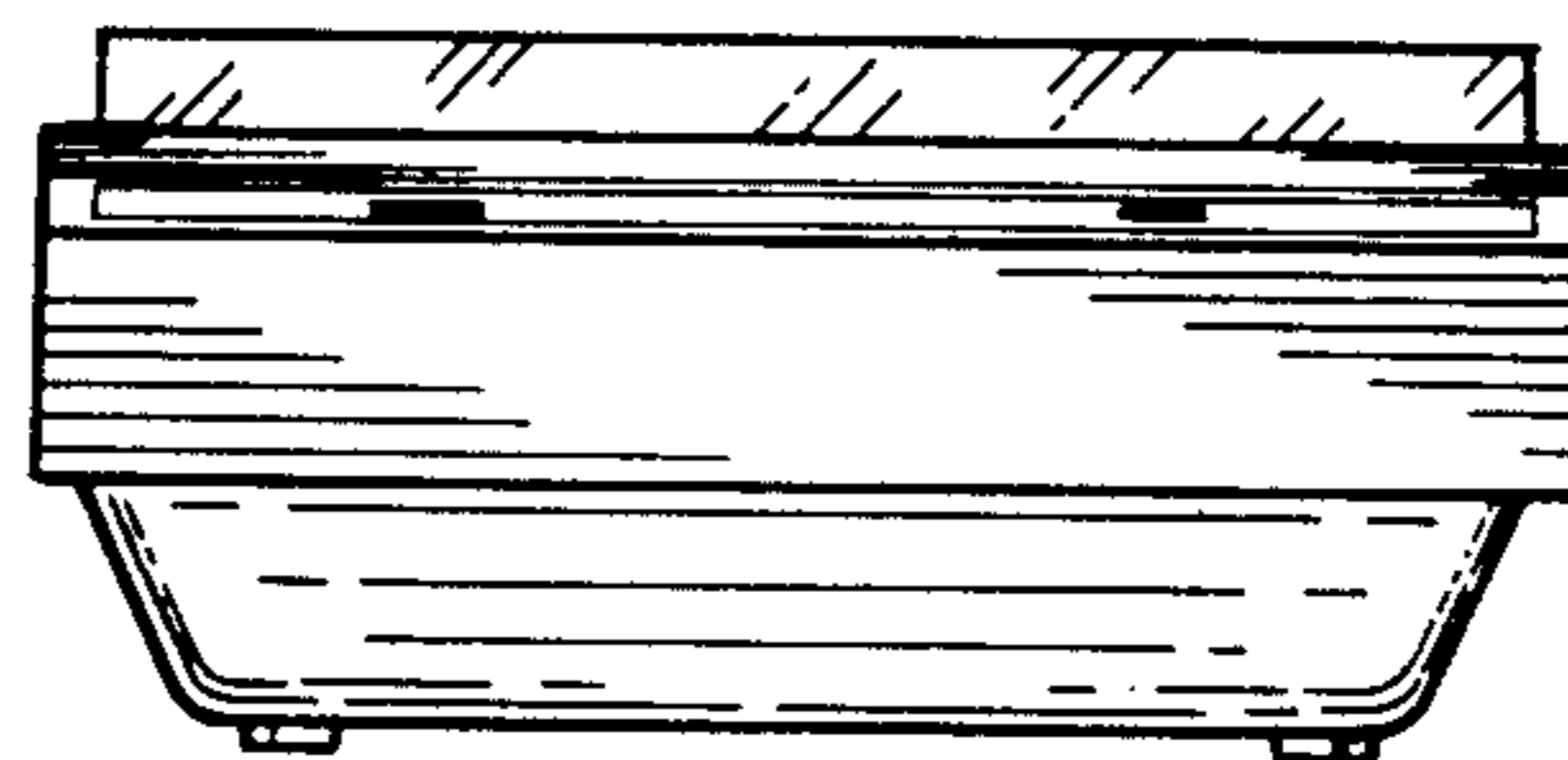

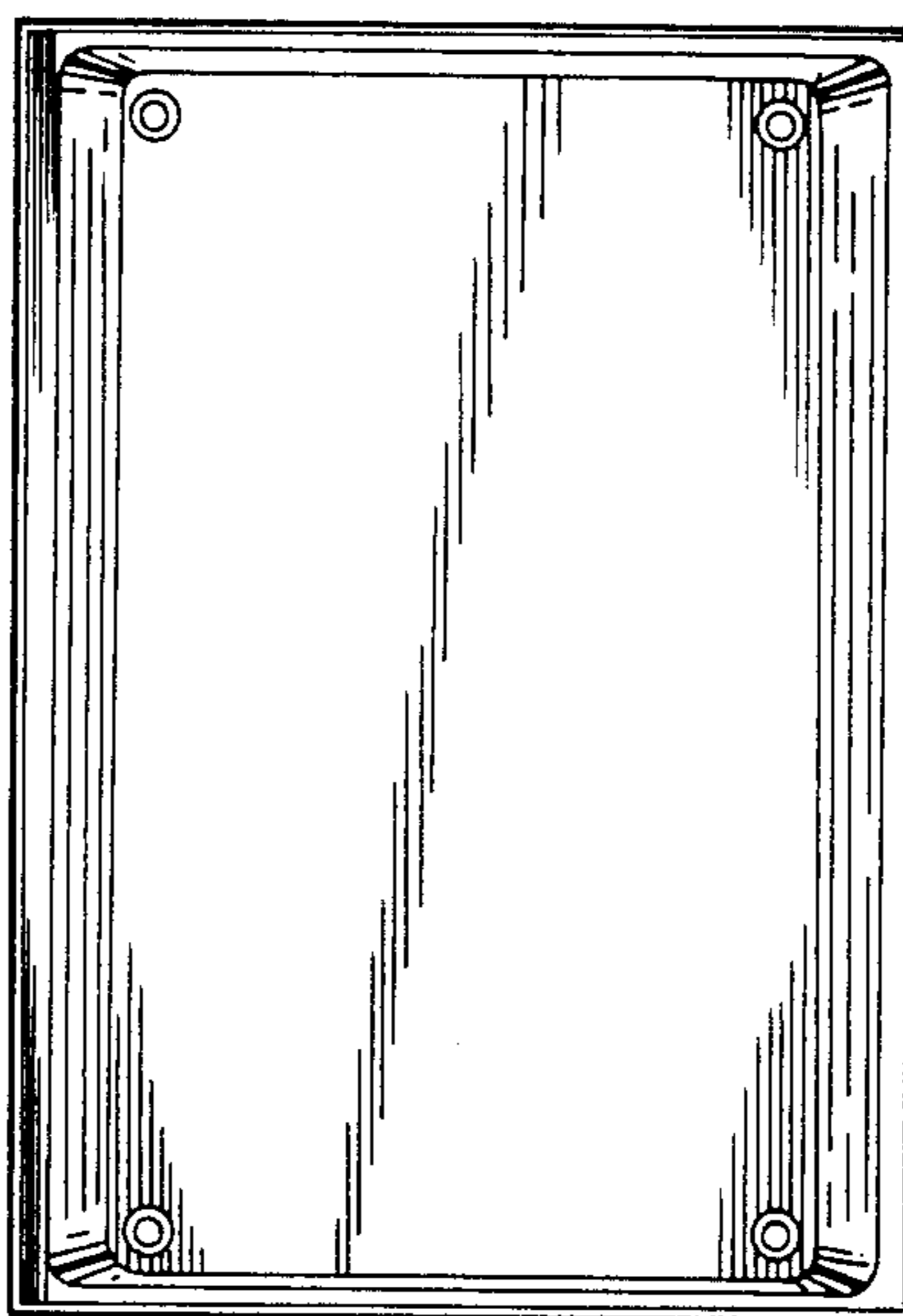
