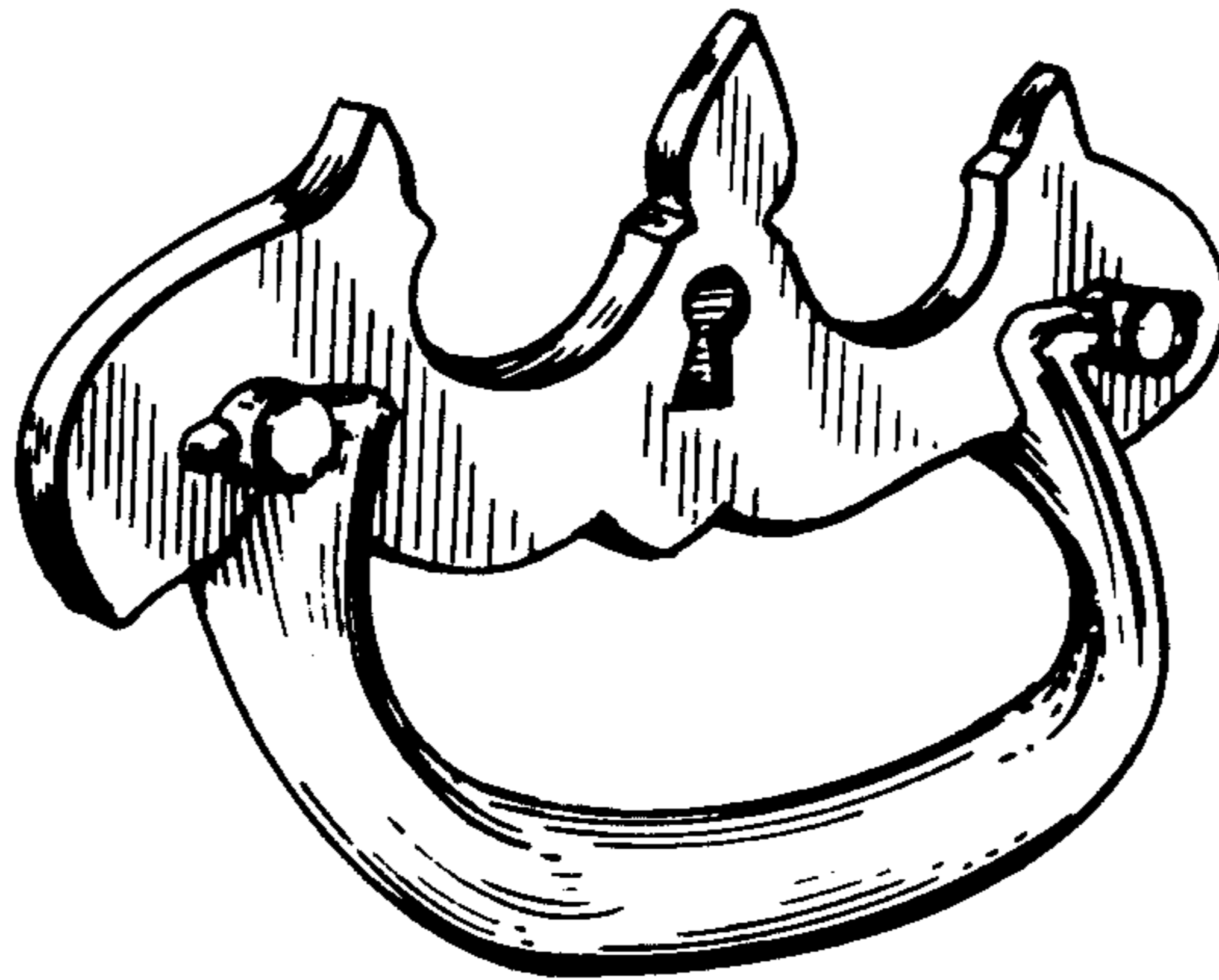

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a drawer pull having bail, substantially as shown.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a drawer pull having bail showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view.



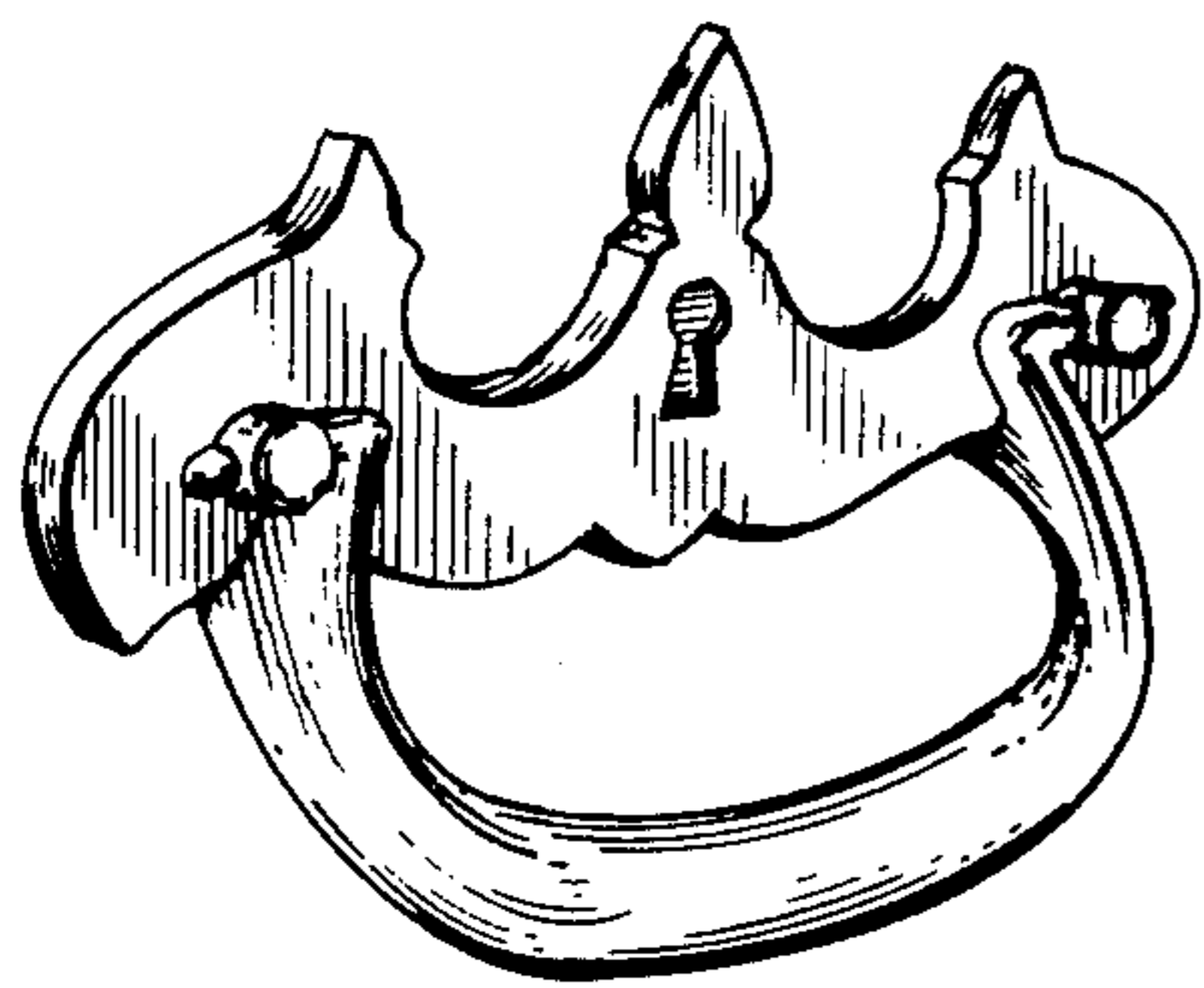

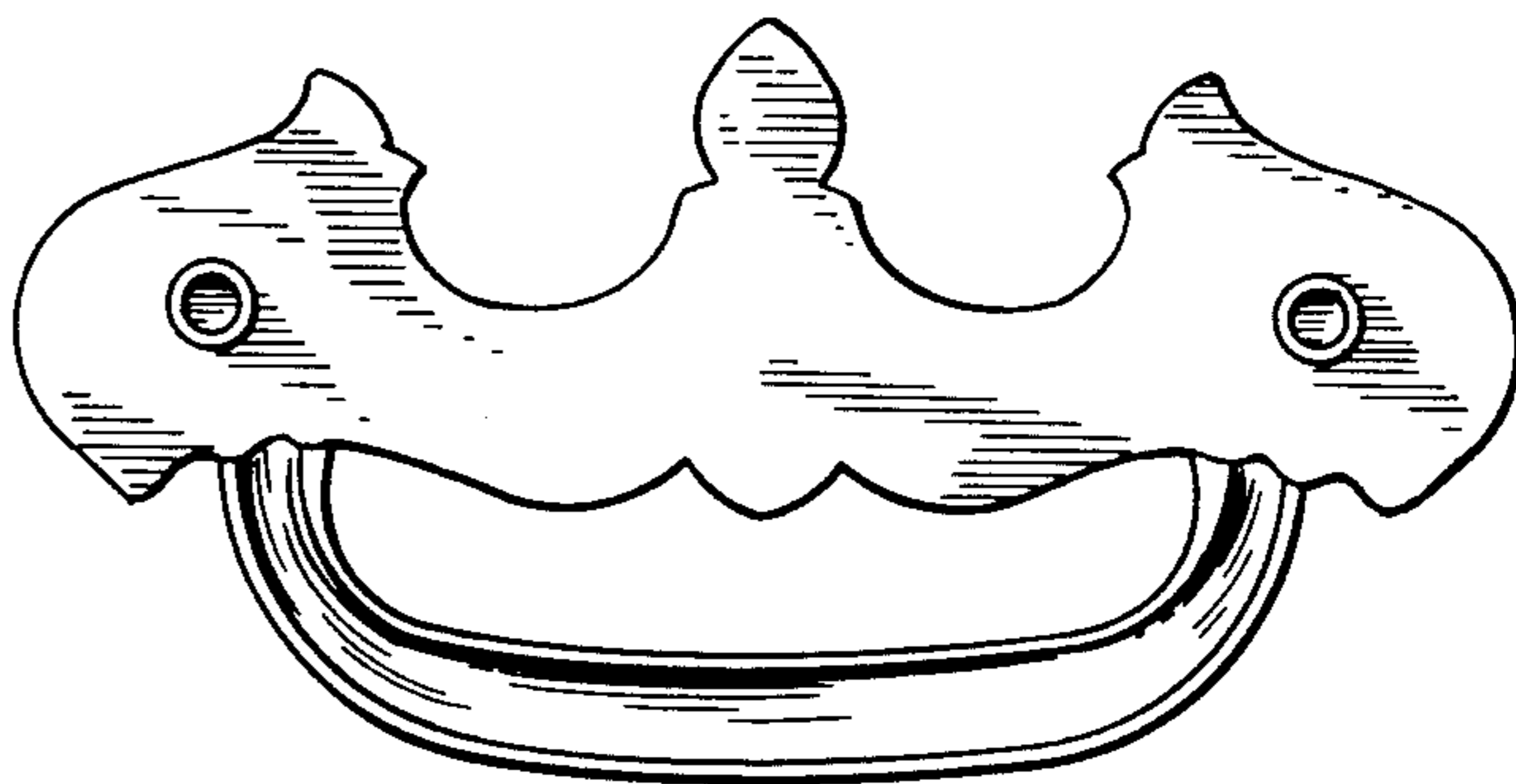

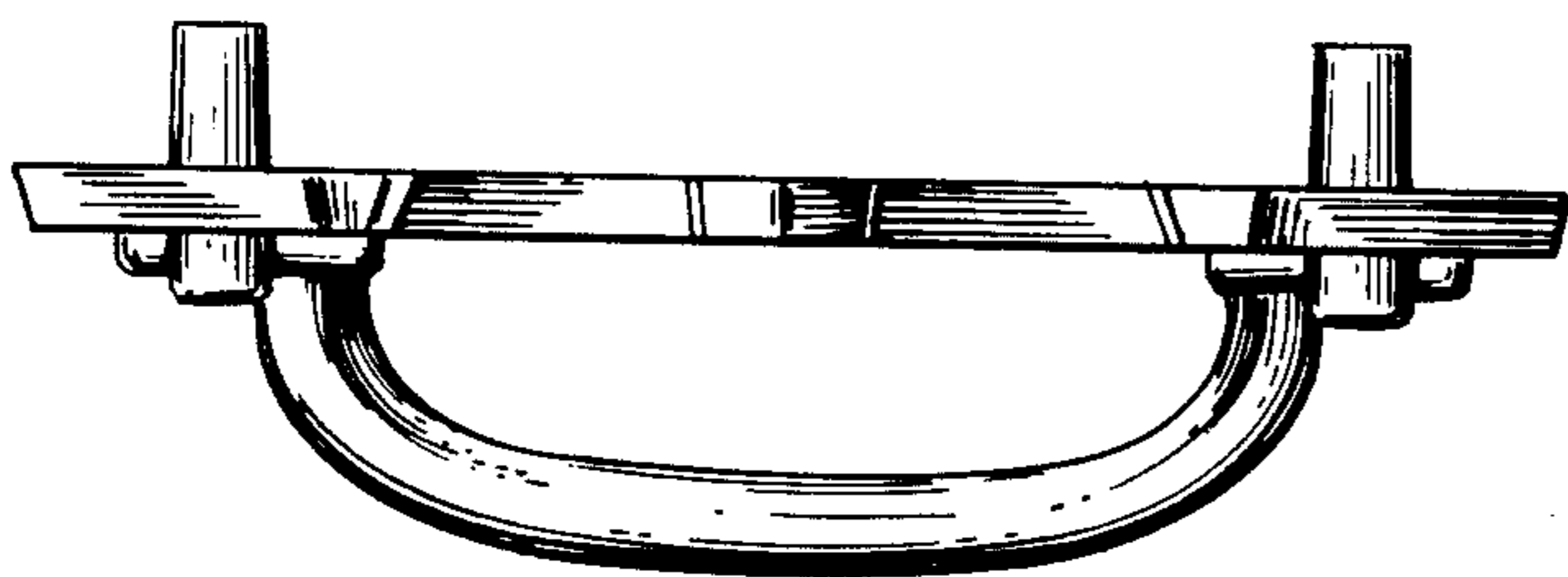

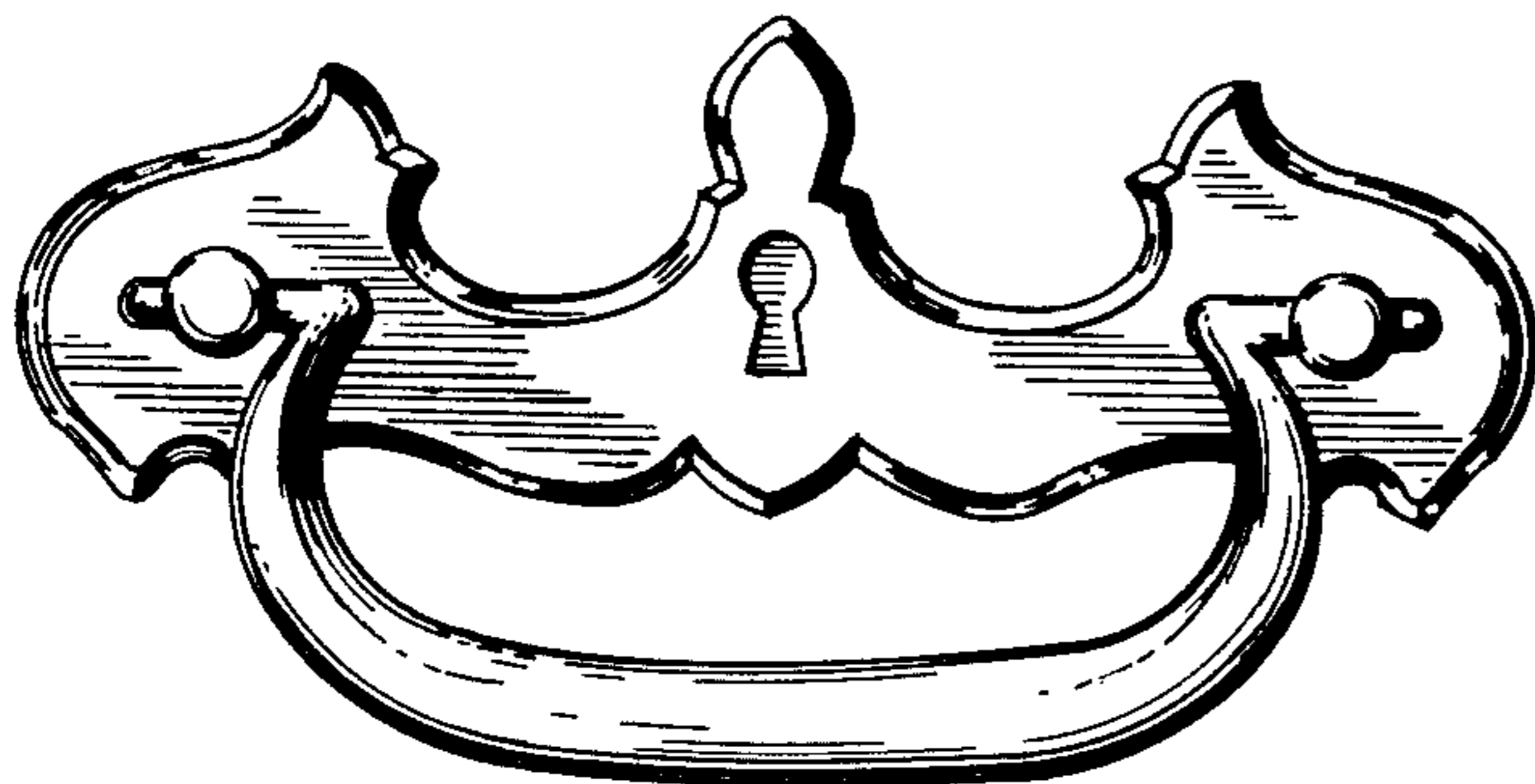

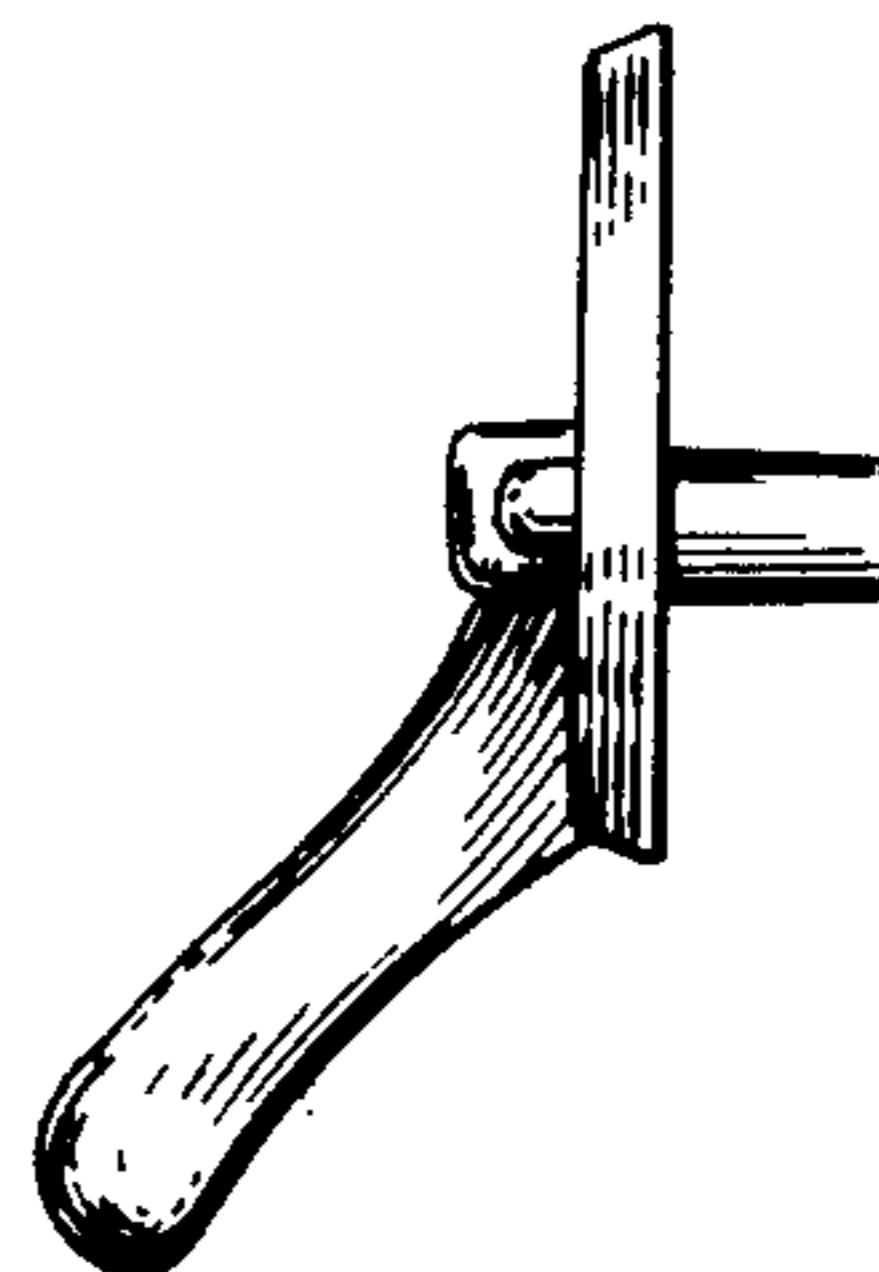

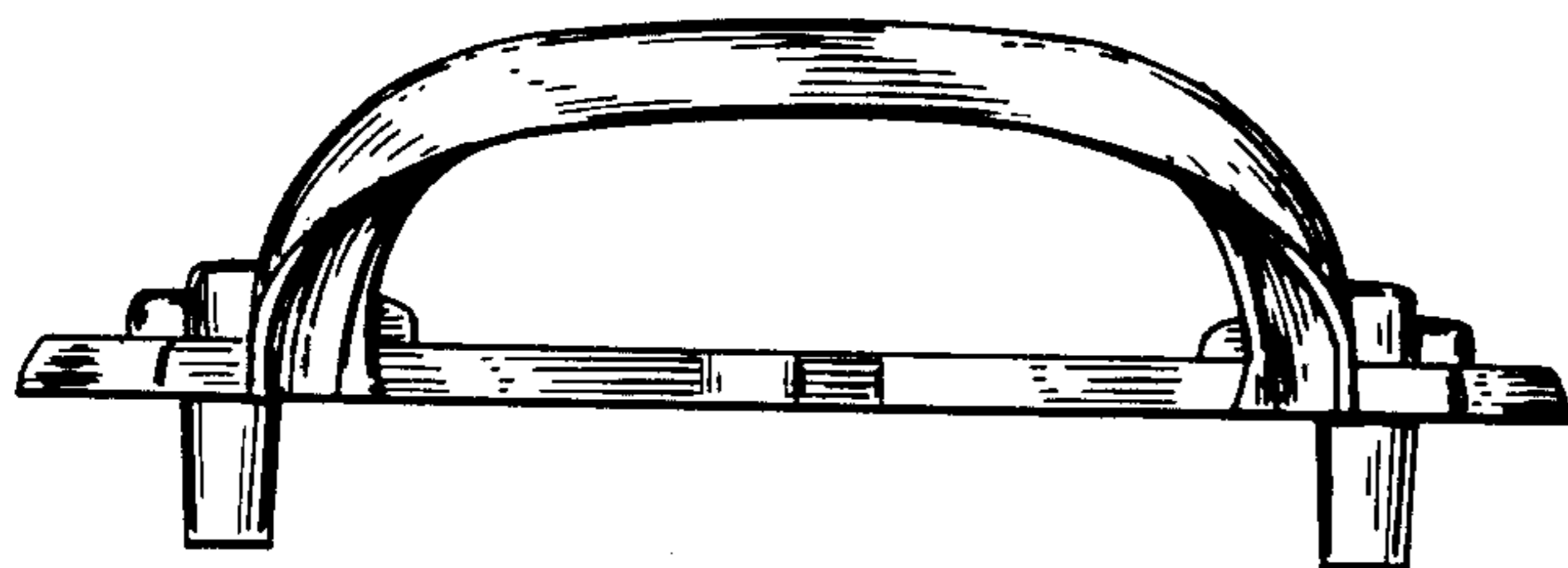
