[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a railroad tie, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a railroad tie showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary perspective view thereof; and  
FIG. 4 is a greatly enlarged sectional view thereof taken along line 4-4 in FIG. 2.
