DESCRIPTION

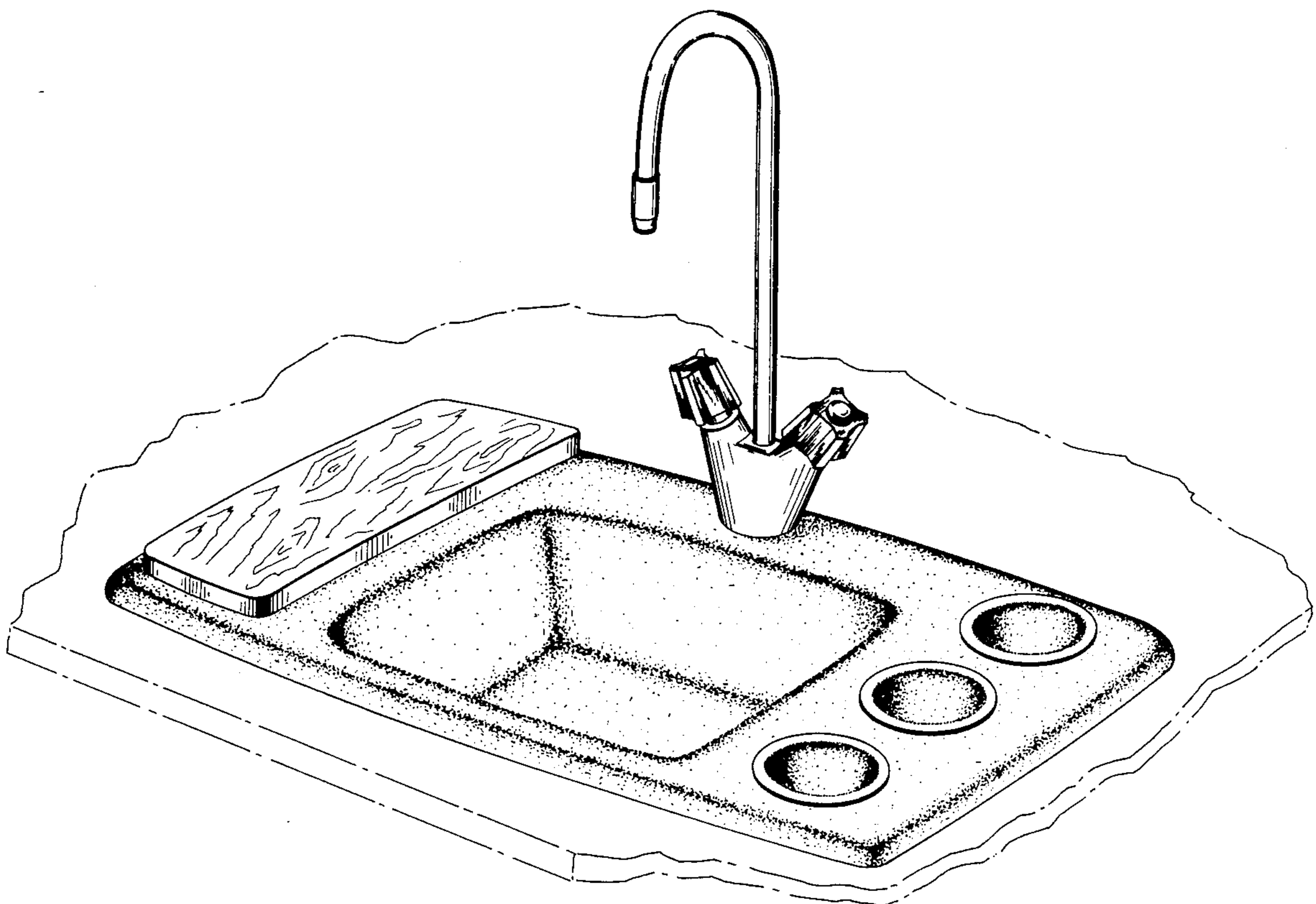
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined sink and faucet showing my new design;

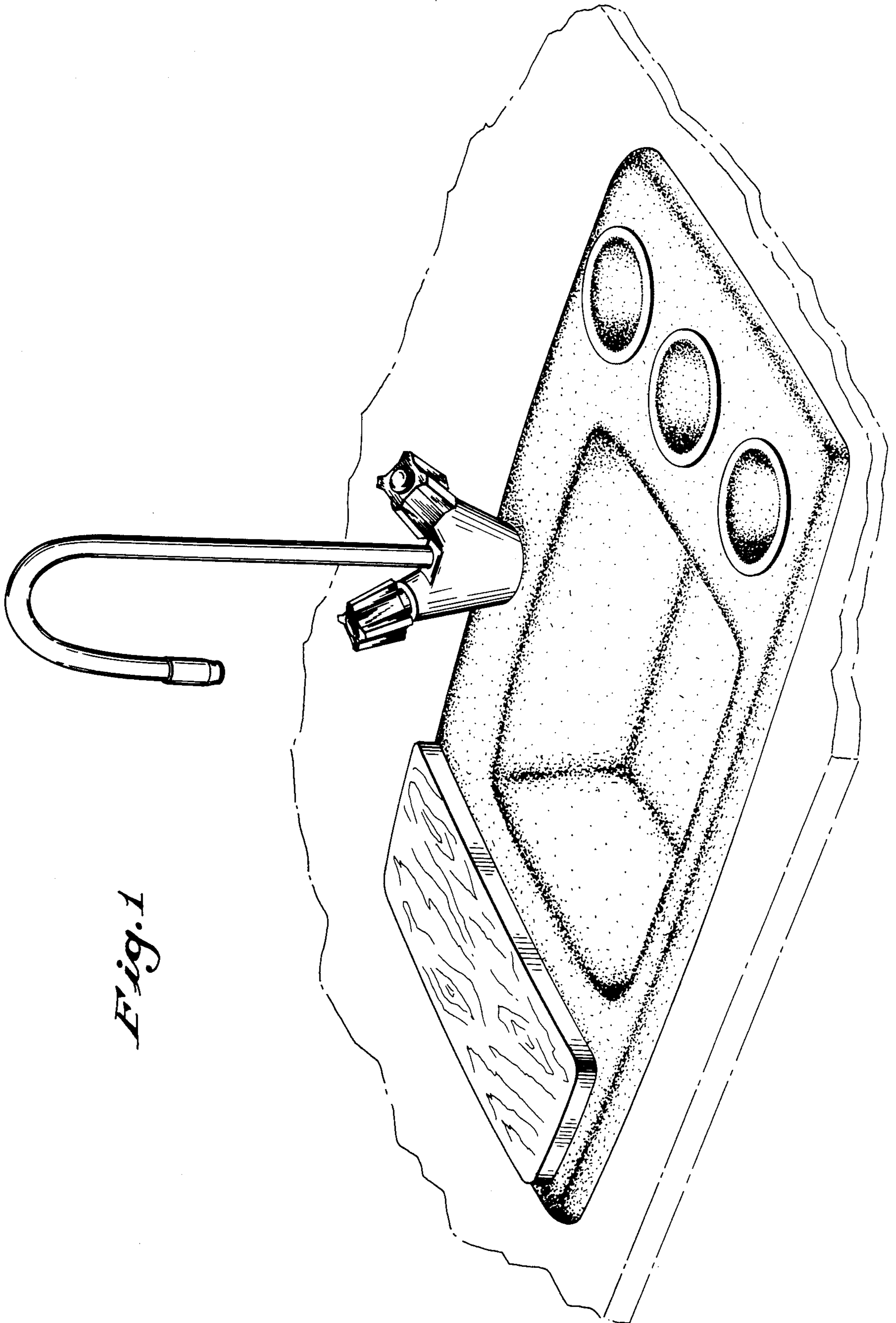
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a cross sectional view taken on line 3-3 of FIG. 2; and

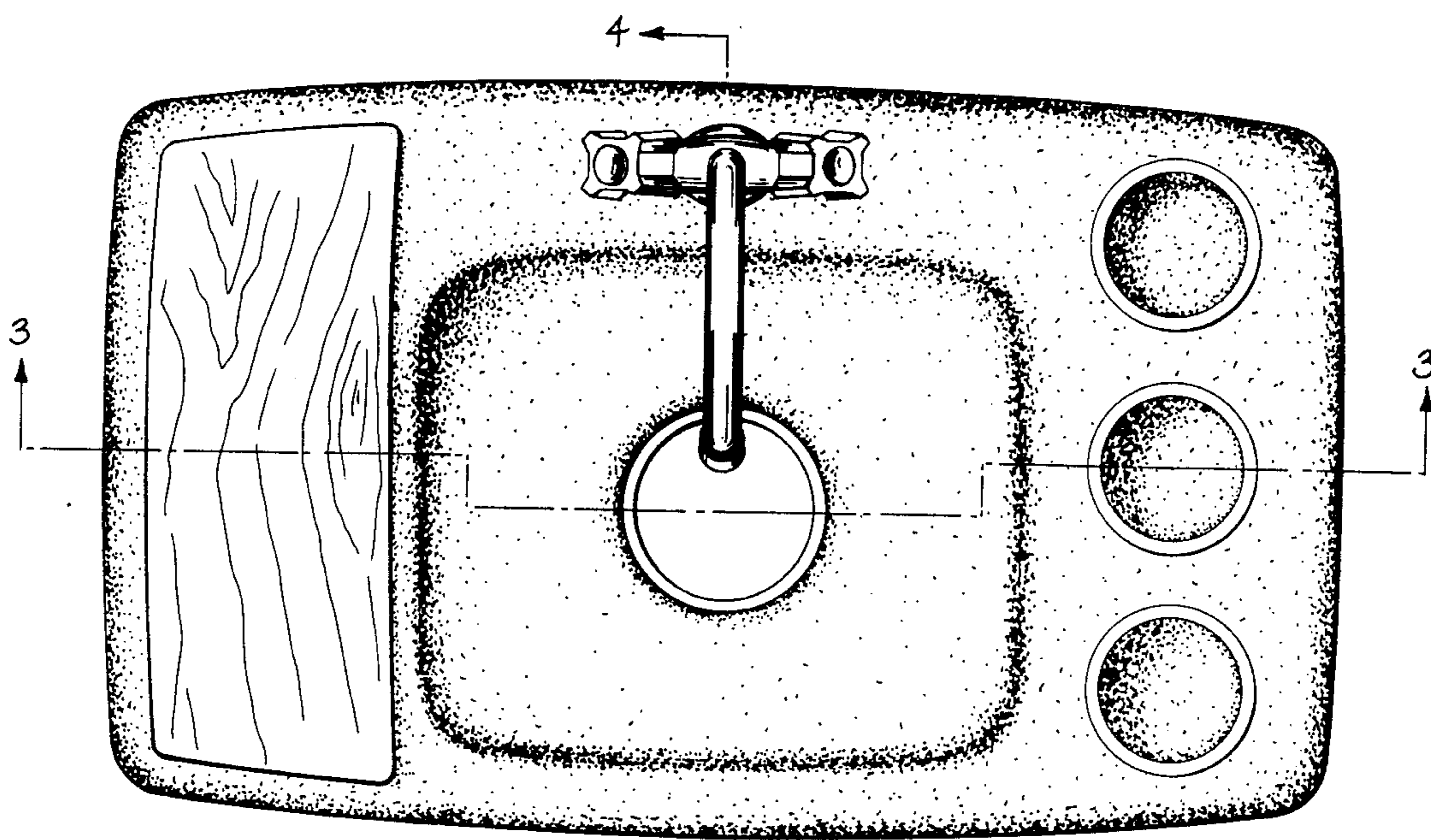
FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 2.

The fragmentary broken line representation of a counter top in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.

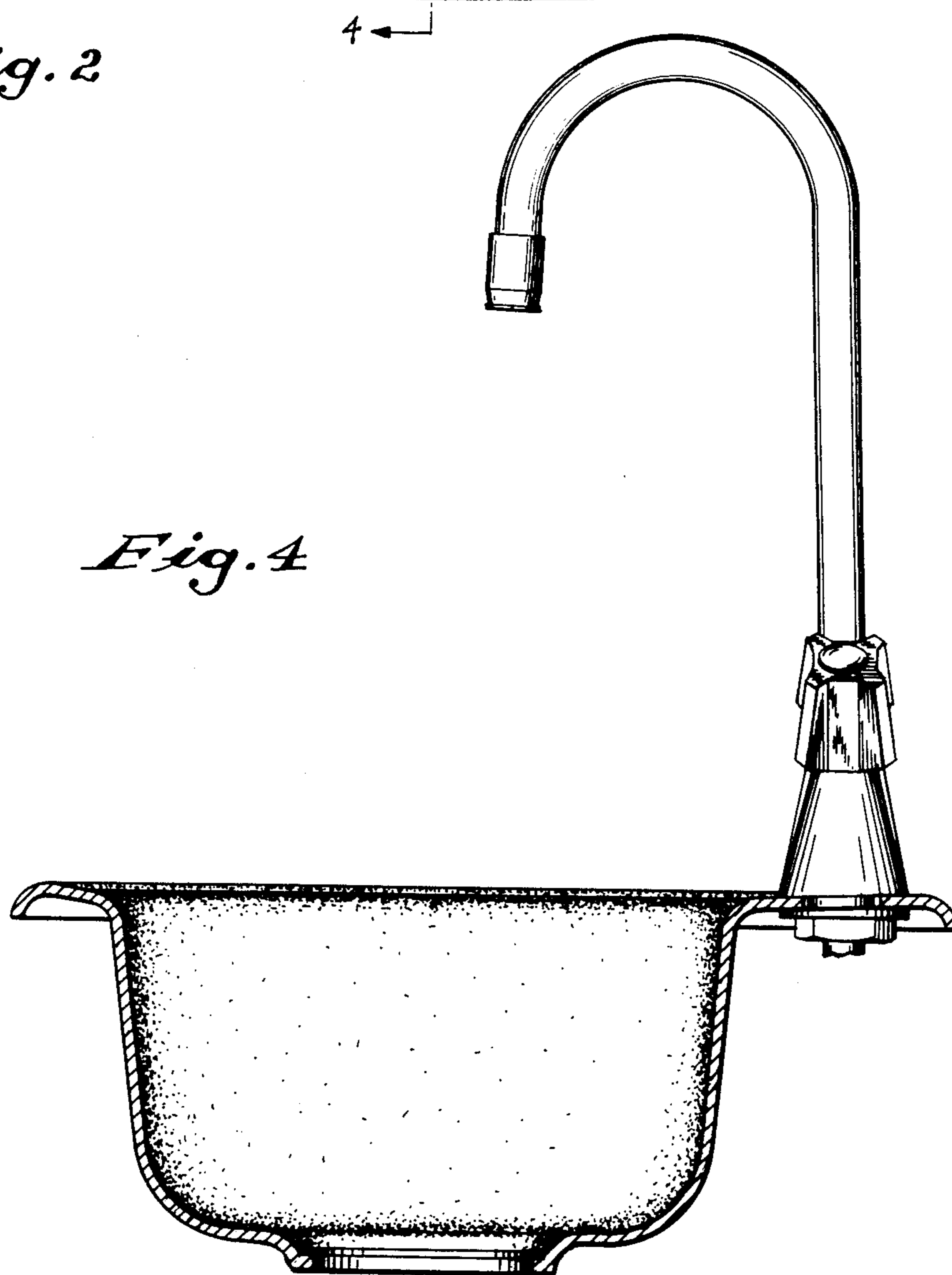




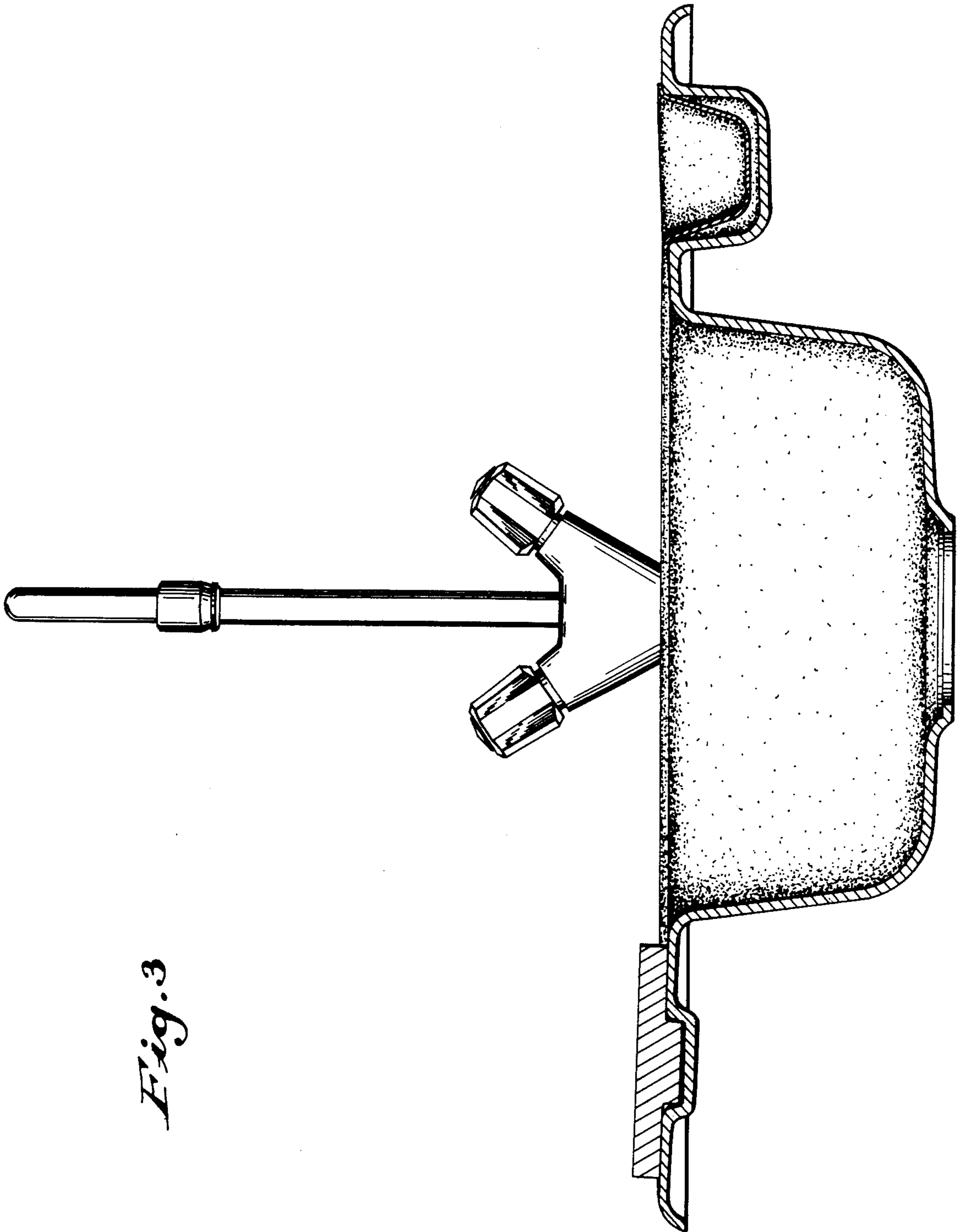
