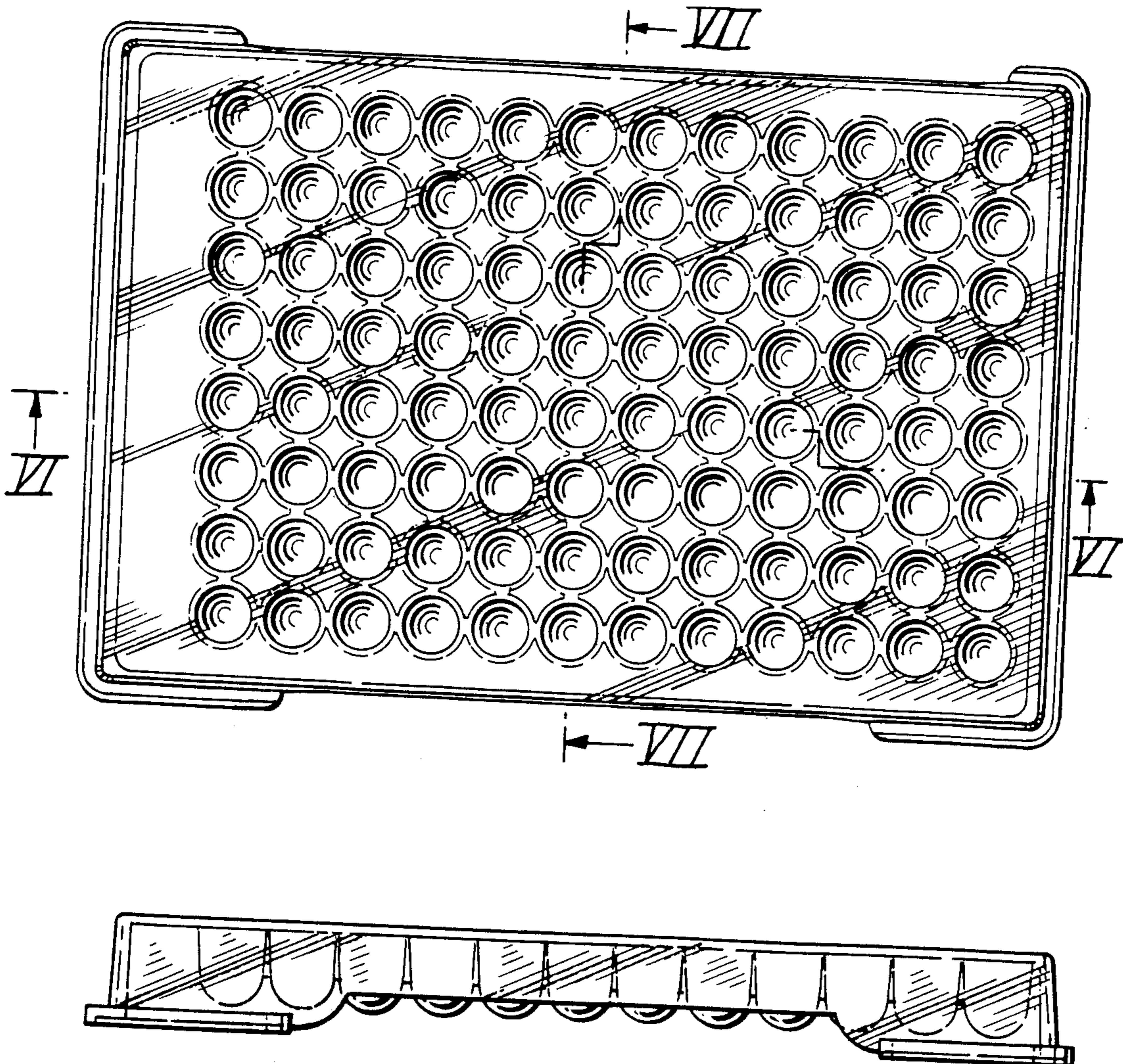

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a tray for biological tests
showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevation thereof;
FIG. 6 is a cross section taken on line VI — VI of FIG.

FIG. 1.



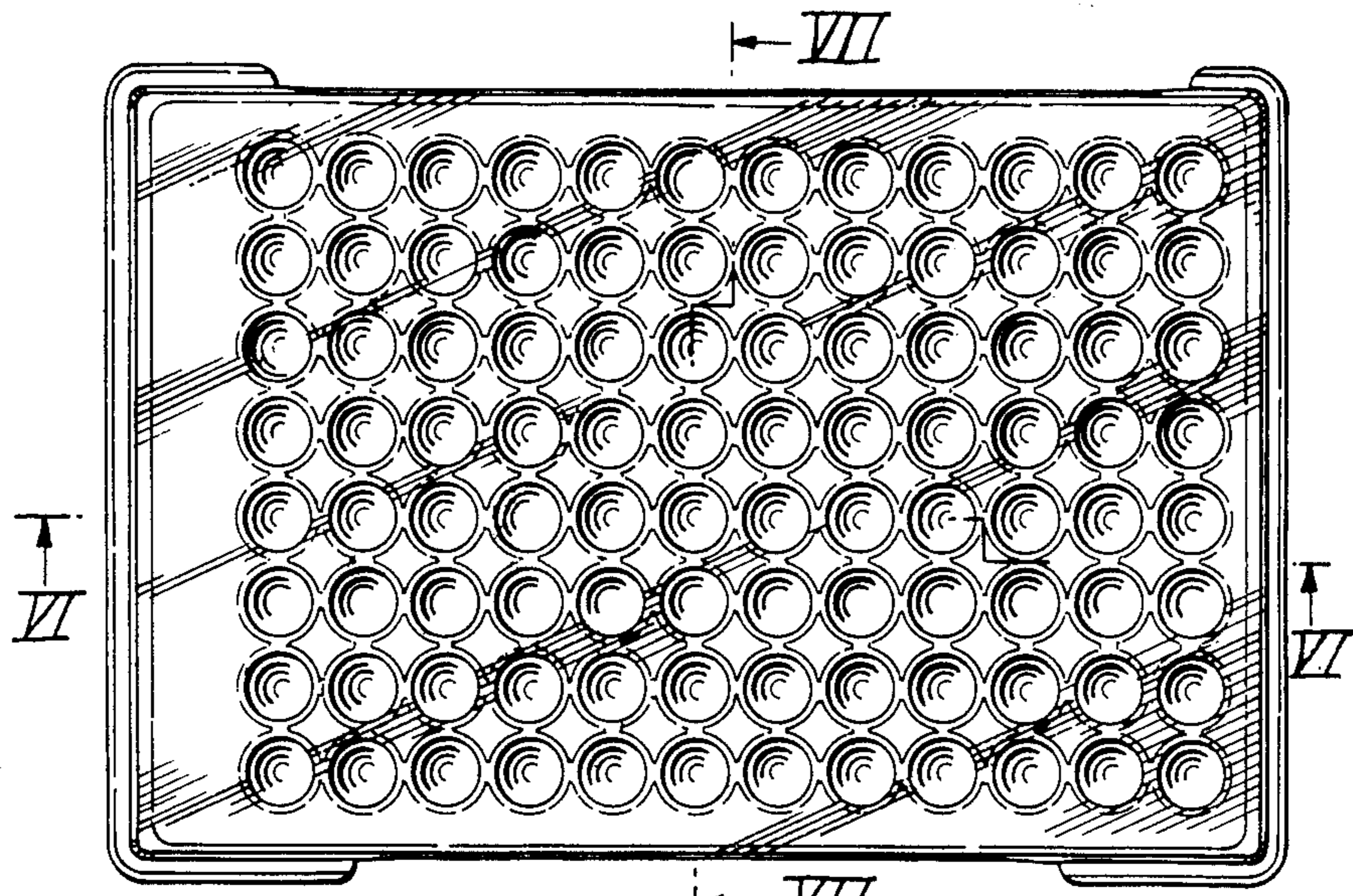

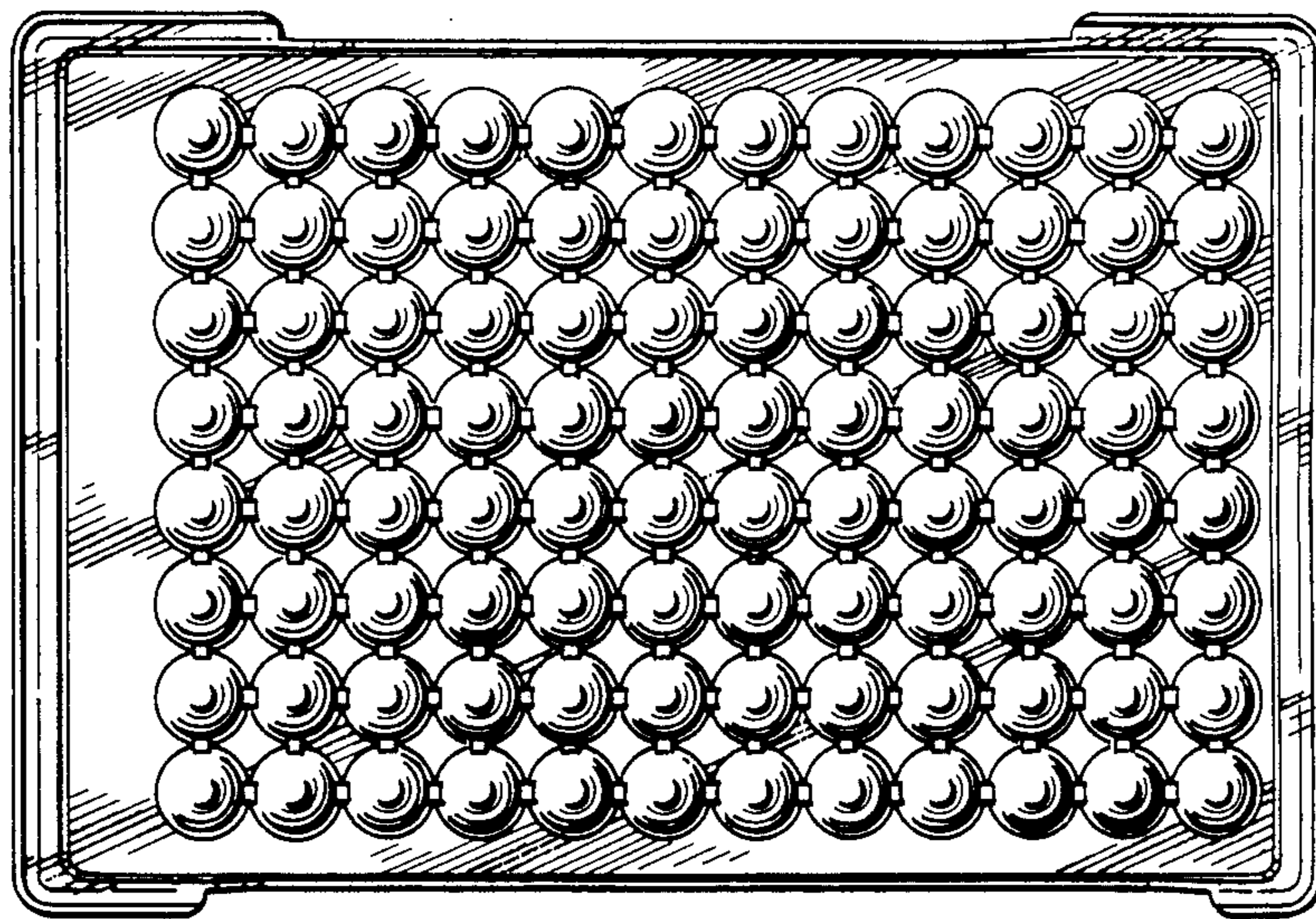

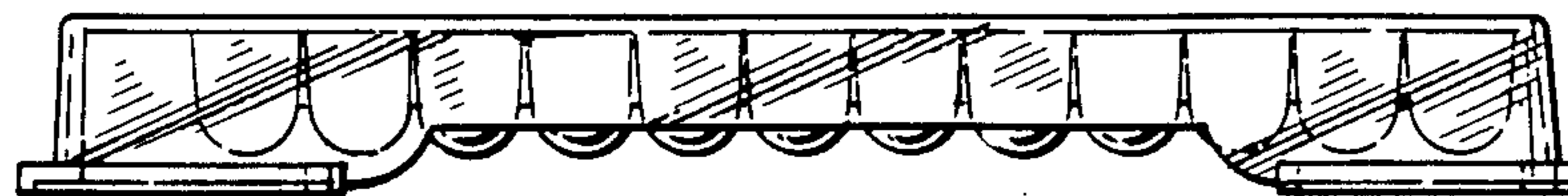

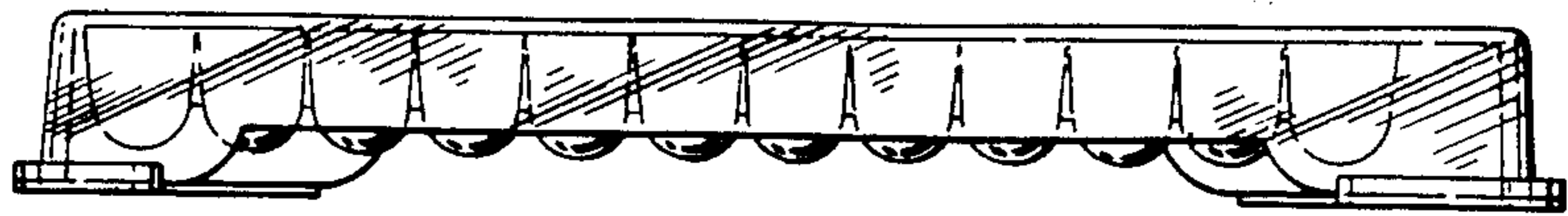

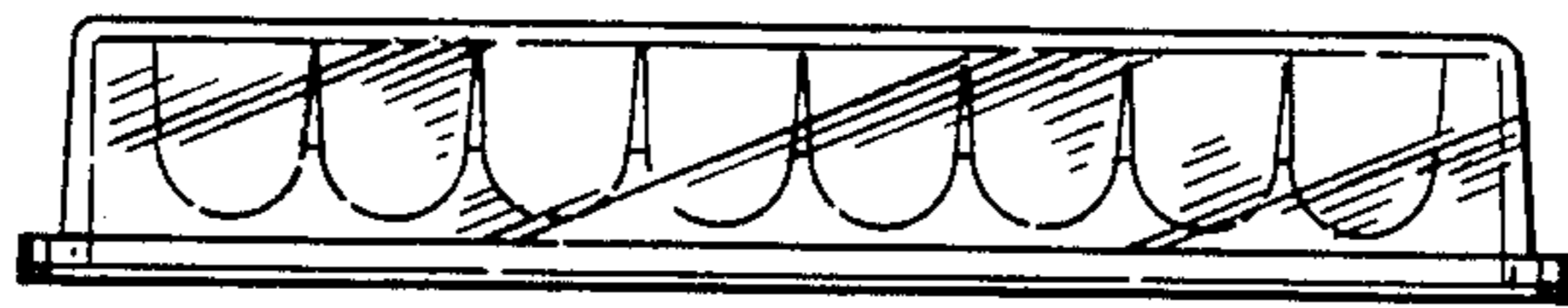

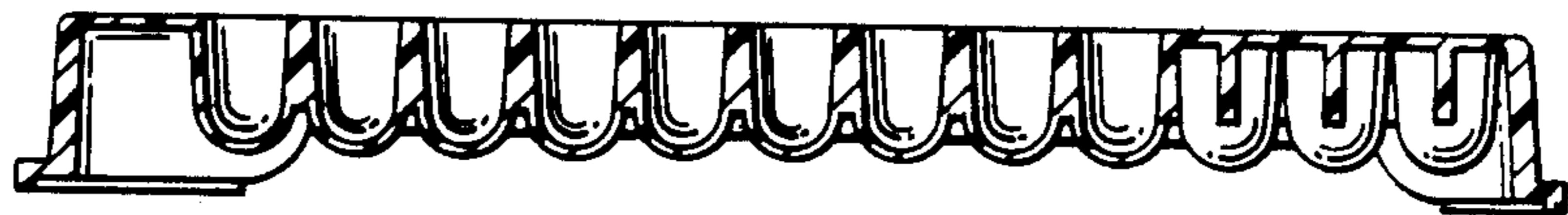
