FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the side not shown of the tower on the left in FIG. 1.

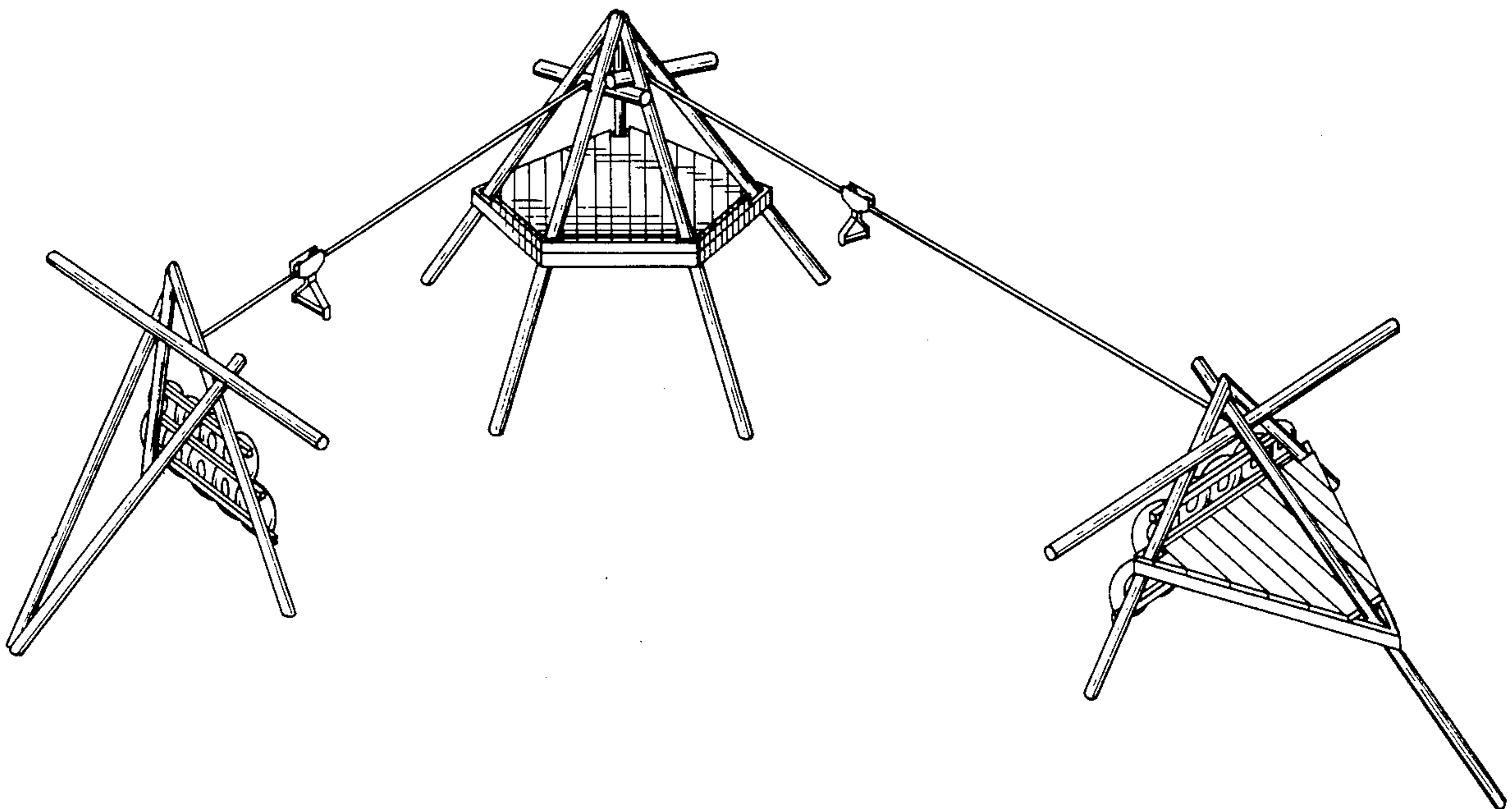

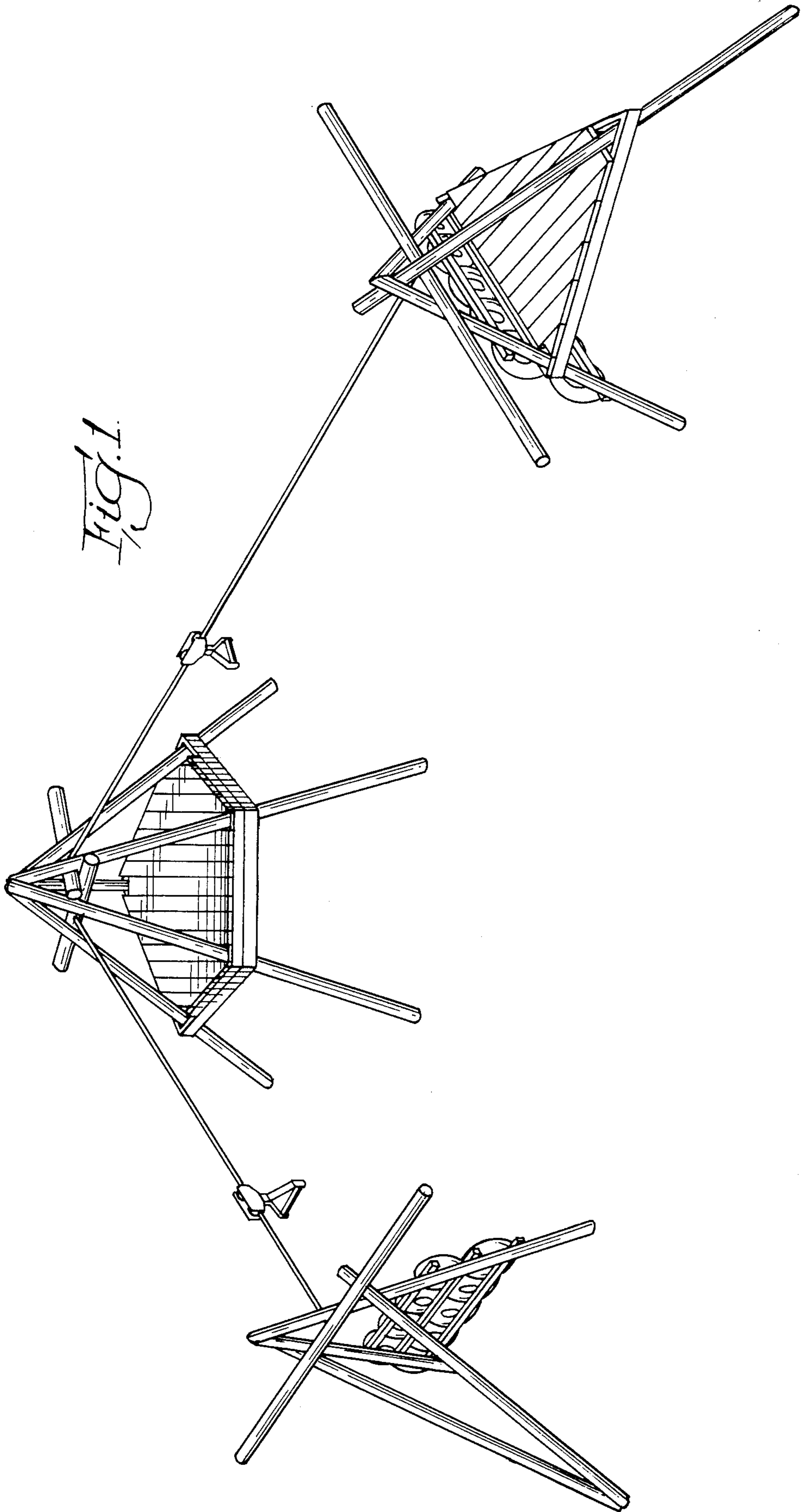

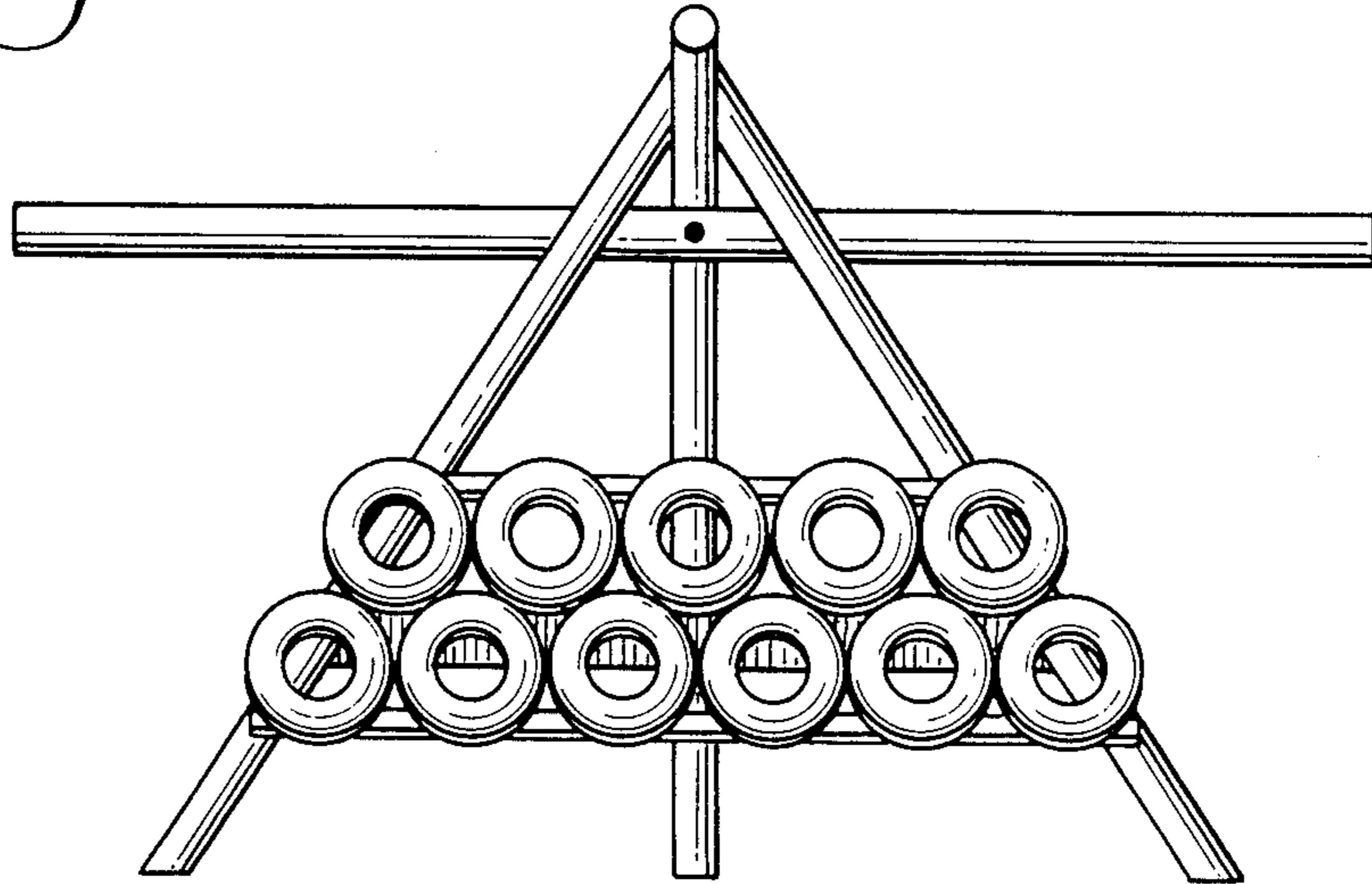
