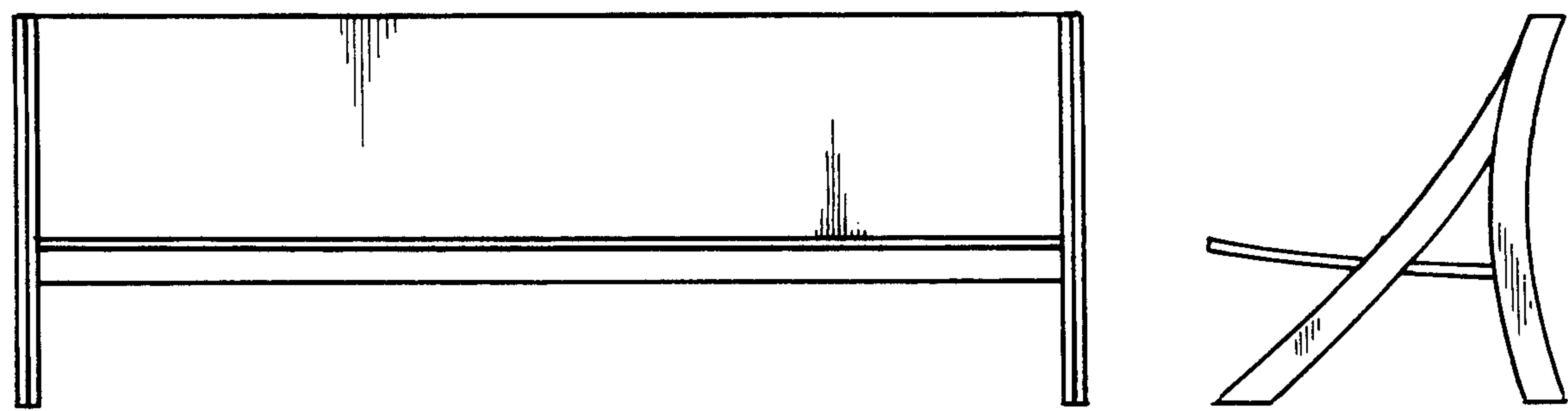

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a couch frame
showing my design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view of one of the two identical
ends;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a modified form of
the couch frame shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is an elevational view of one of the two identical
ends;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof.



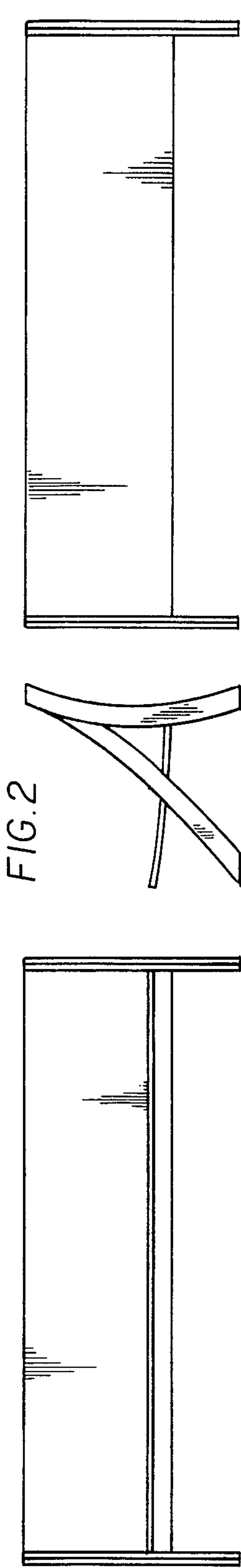

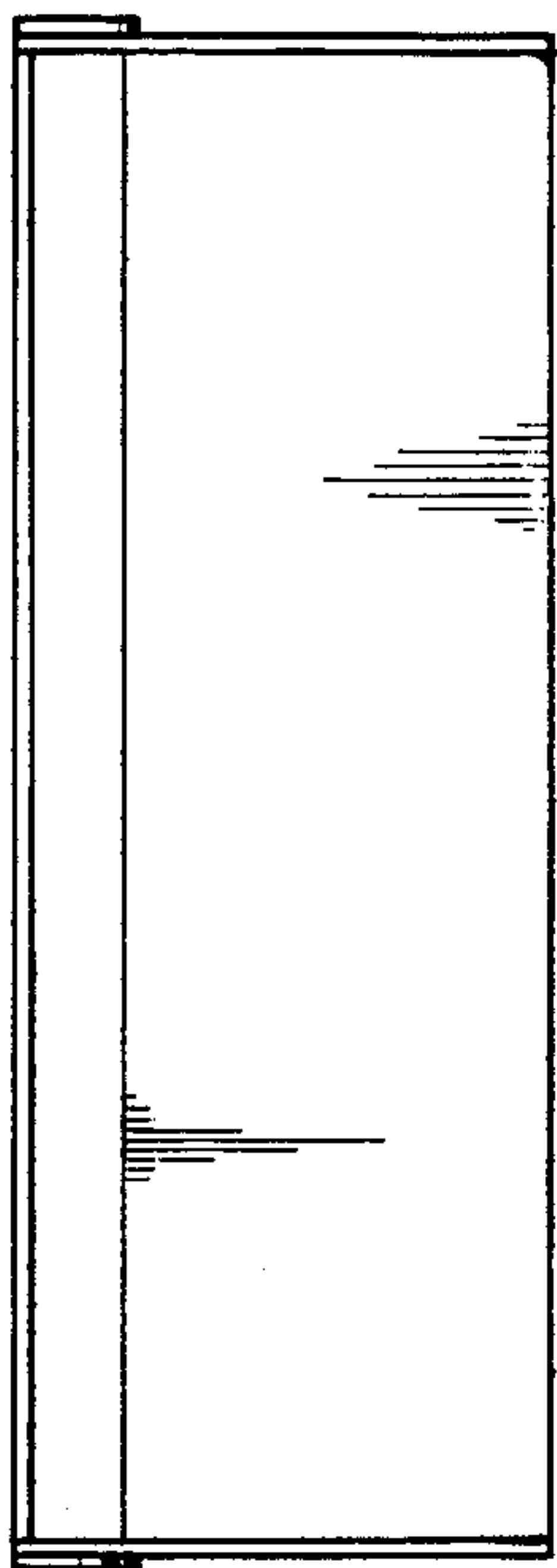

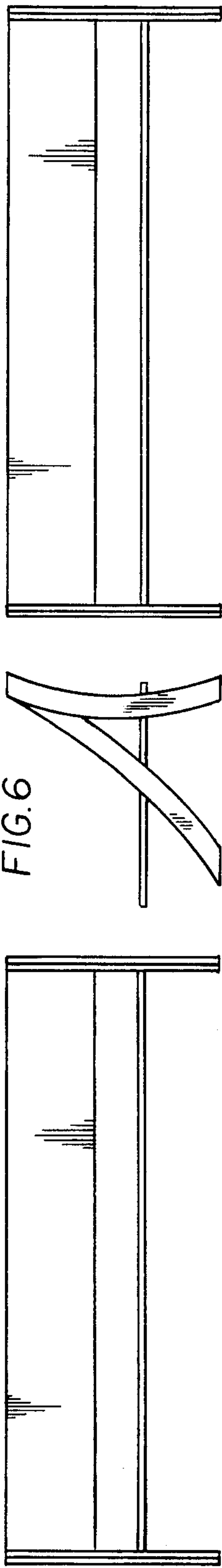

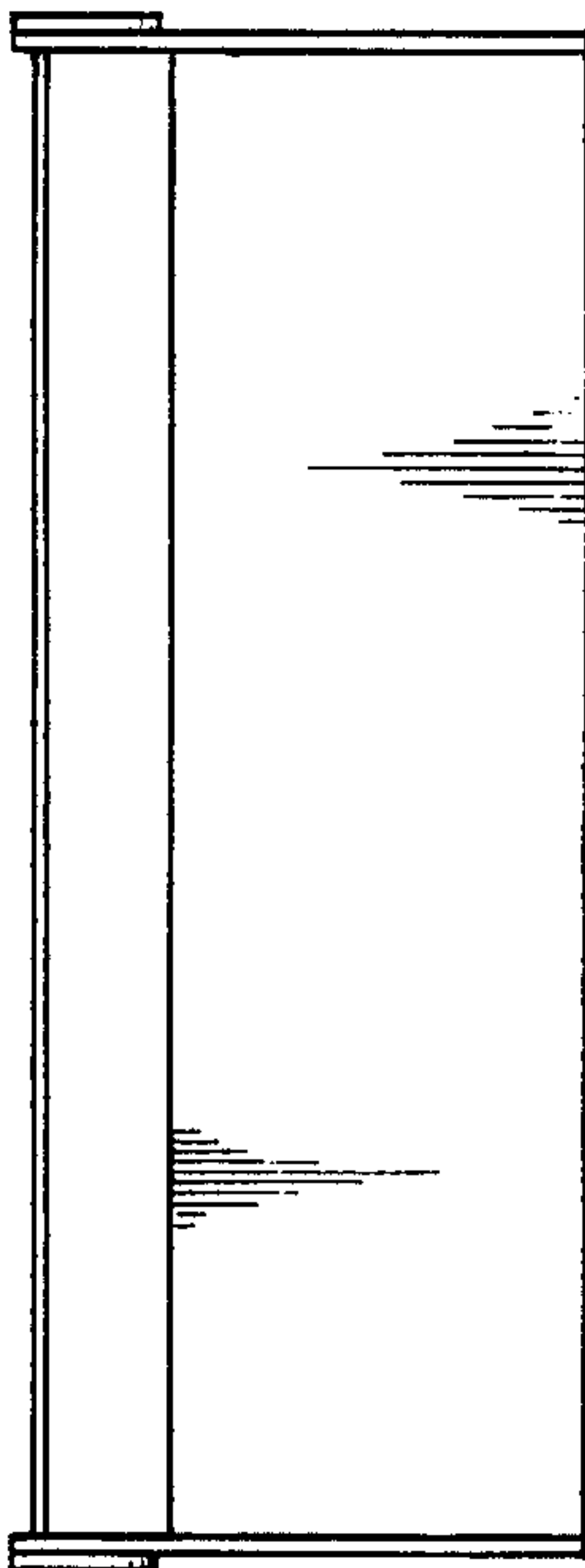
