DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and right side perspective view of a head phone showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being essentially a mirror image of the same; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view.

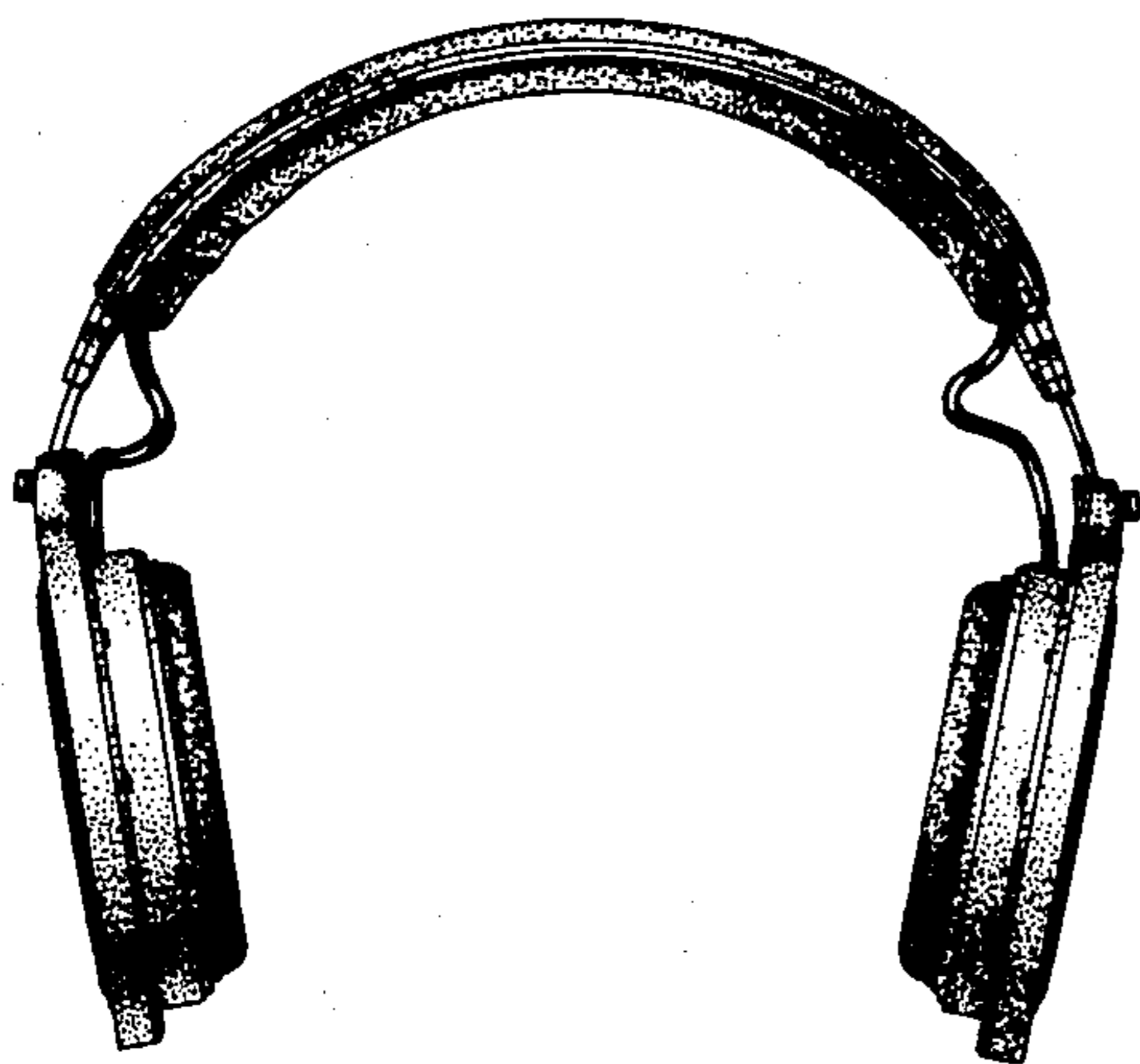
