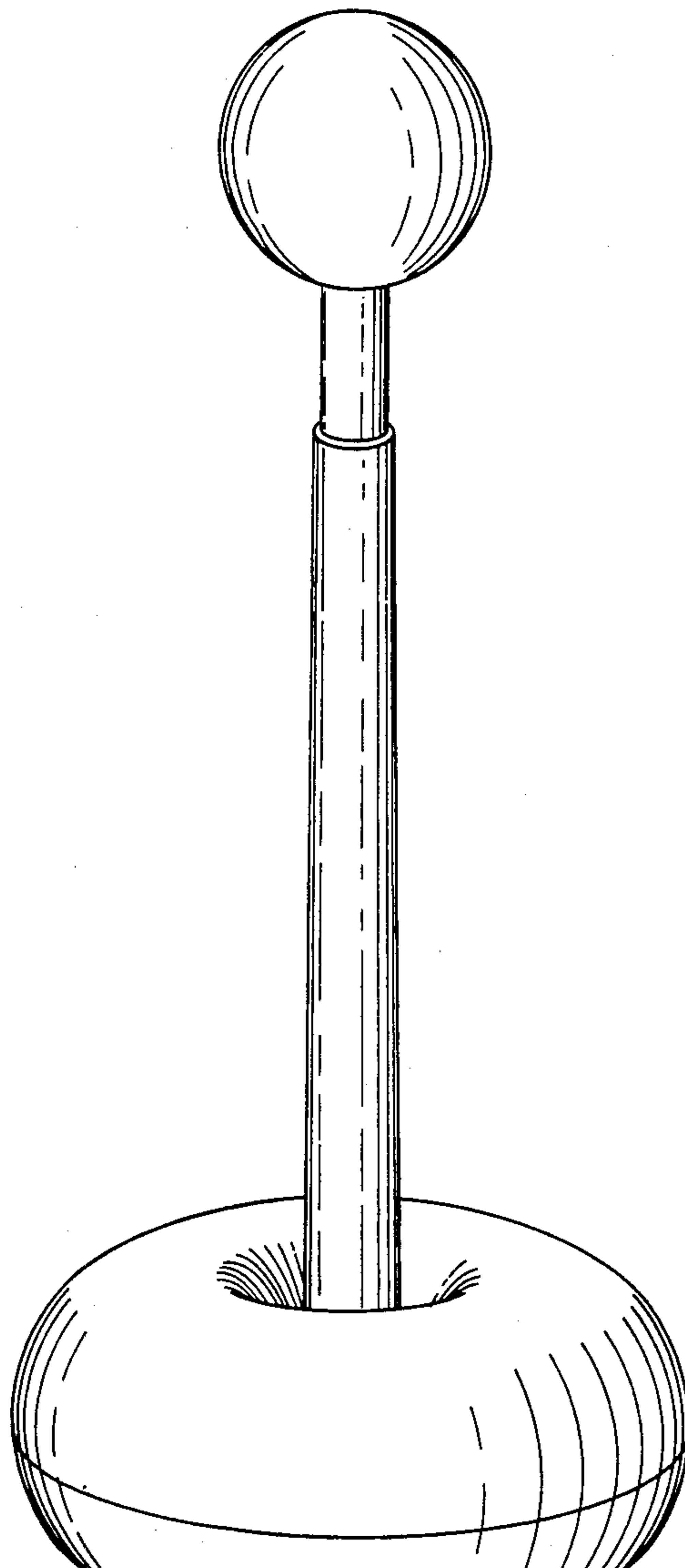
CLAIM

FIG. 3 is an exploded perspective view thereof.



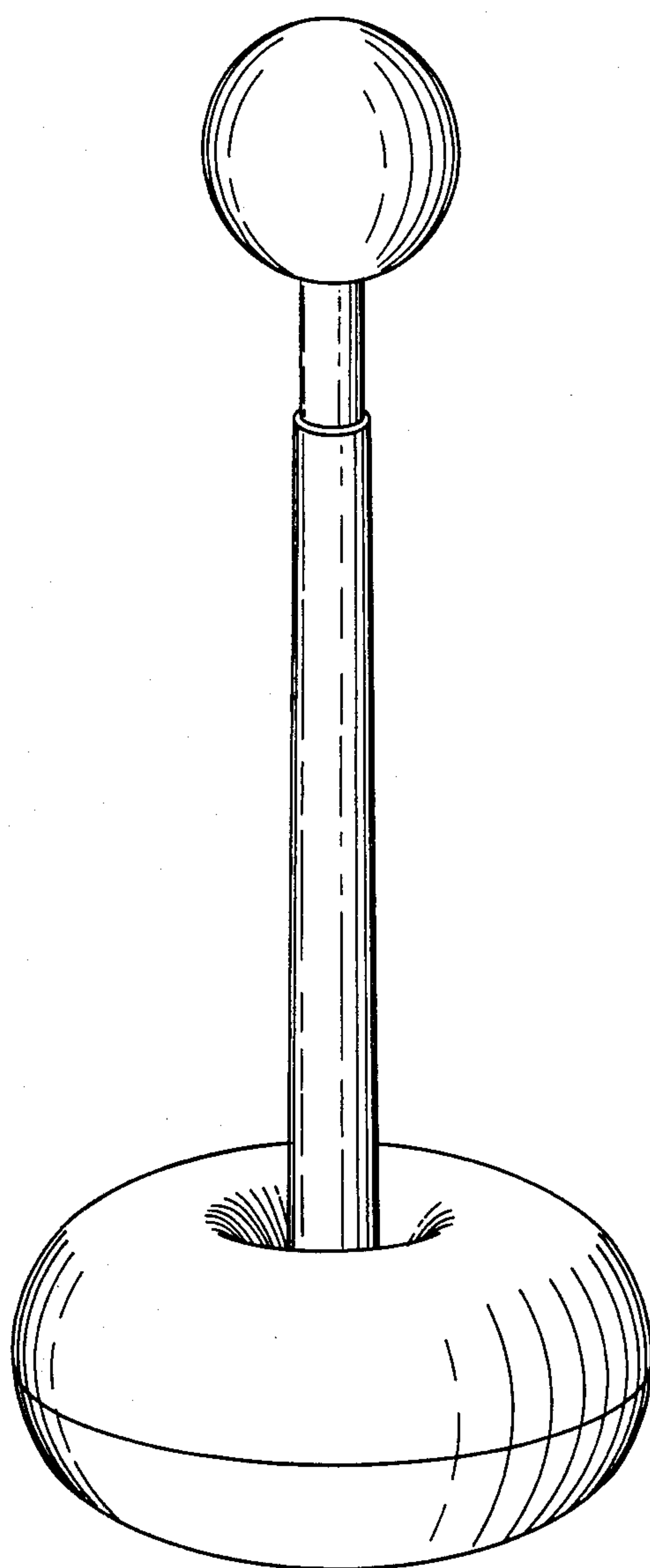

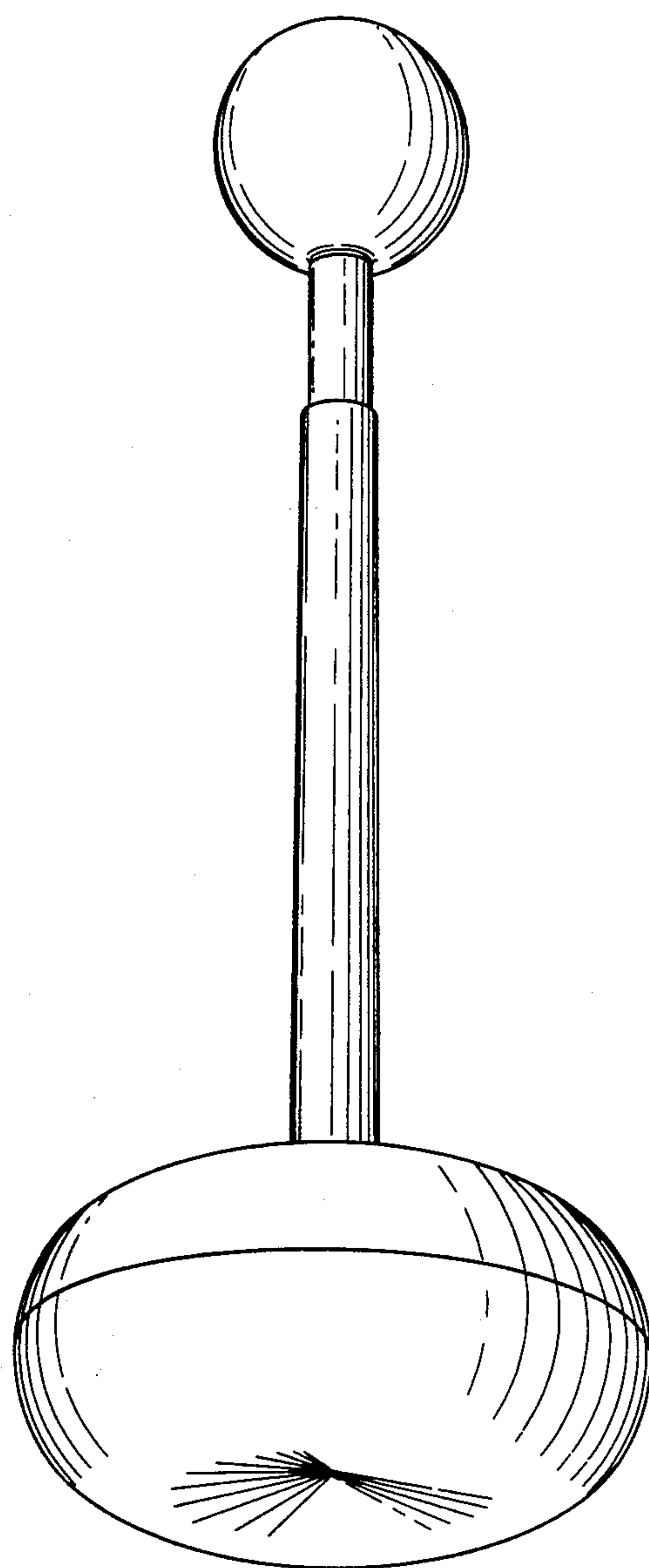

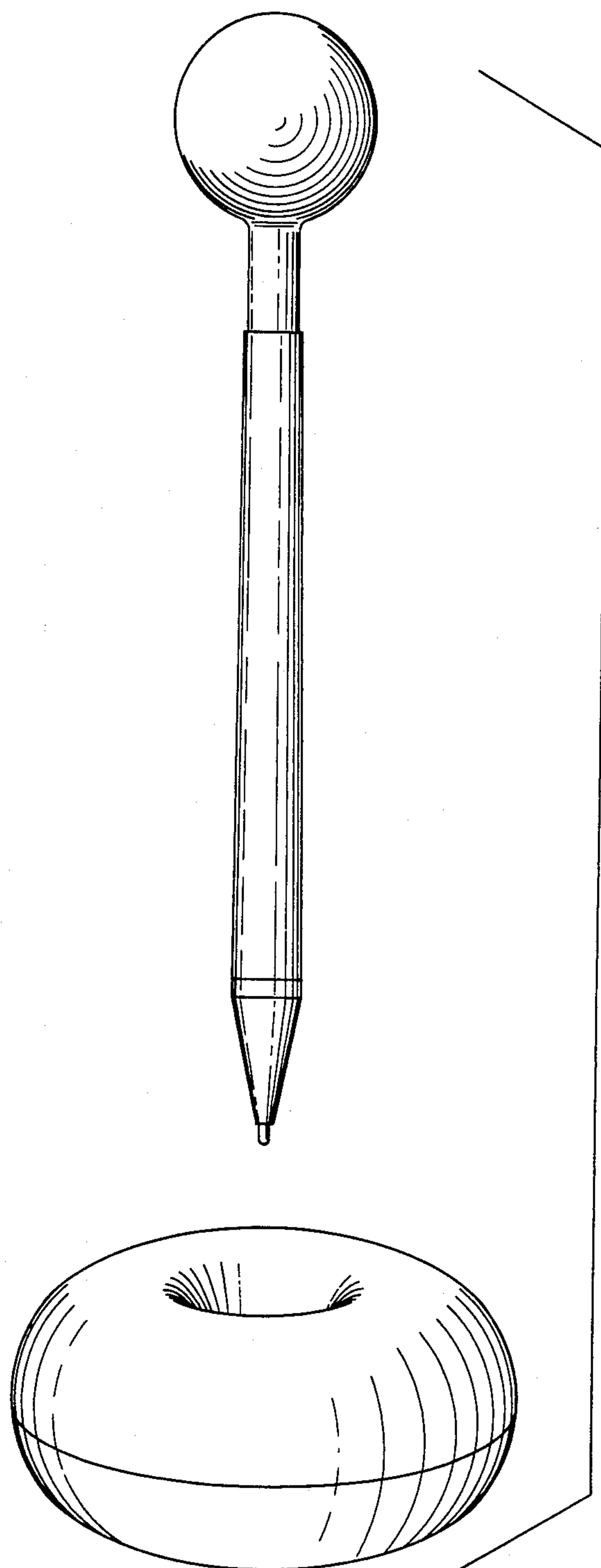
