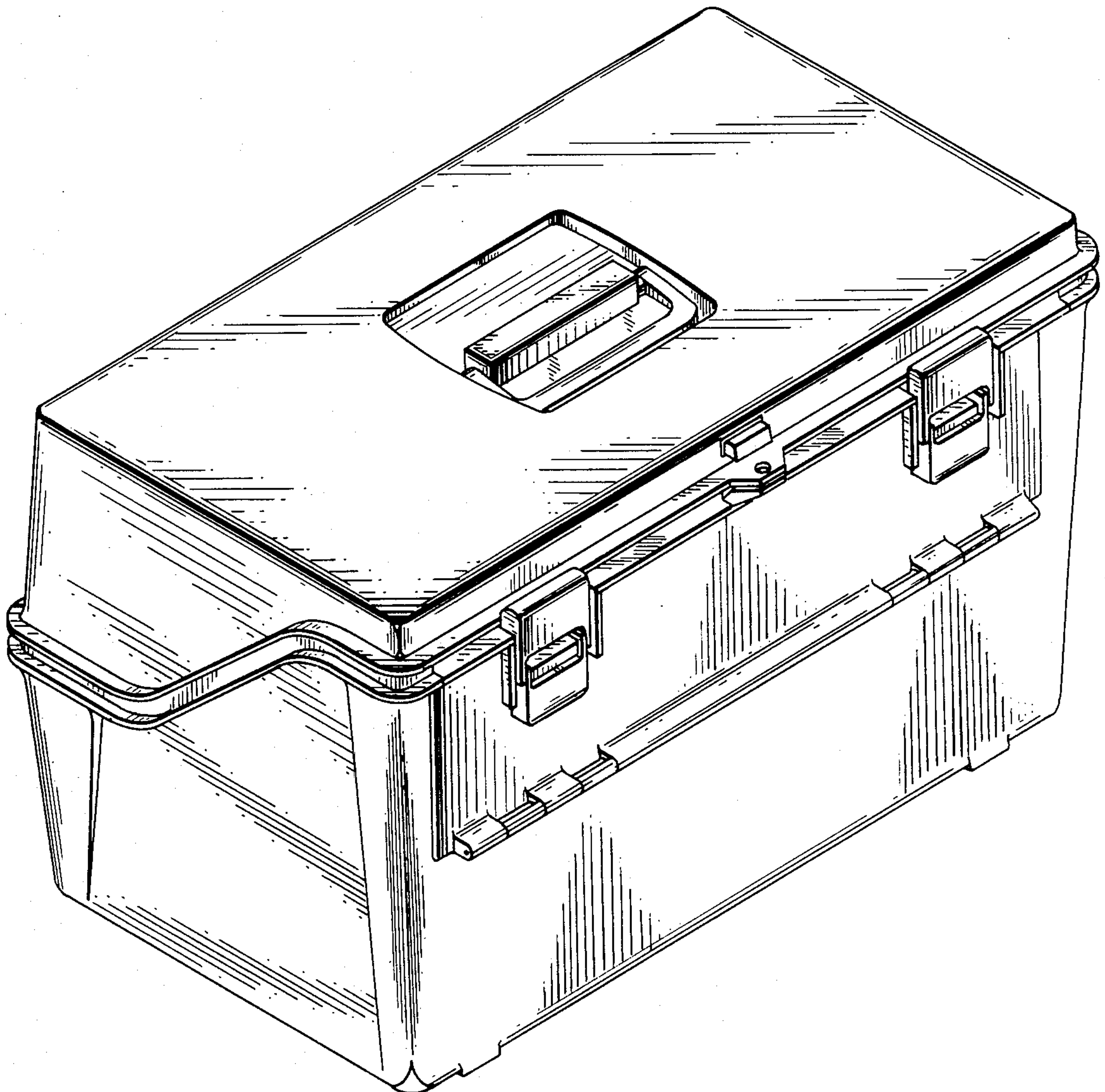

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing box showing my new design, the end opposite that shown being a mirror image thereof; and, FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view. The bottom of the fishing box is plain and unornamented.



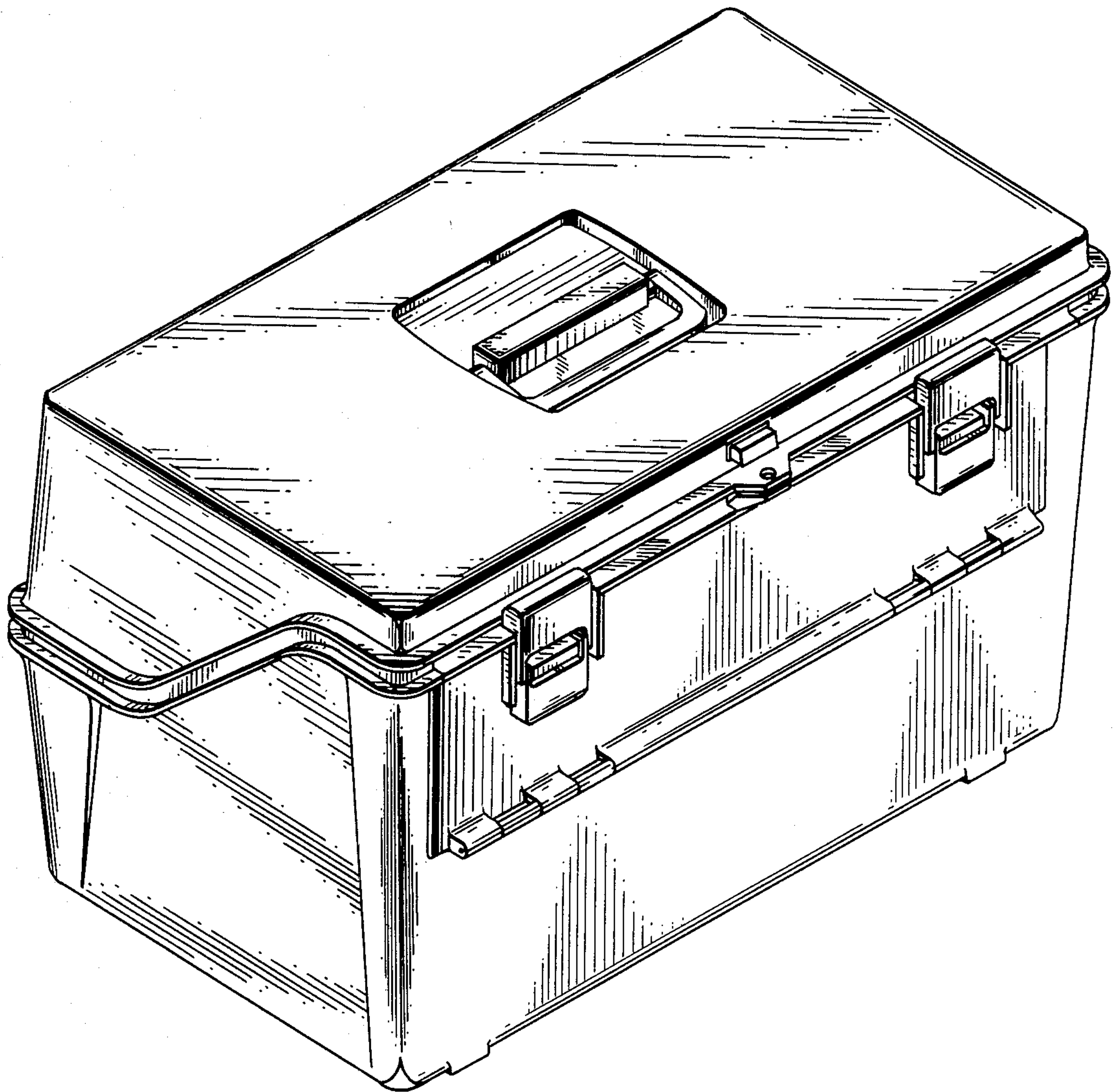

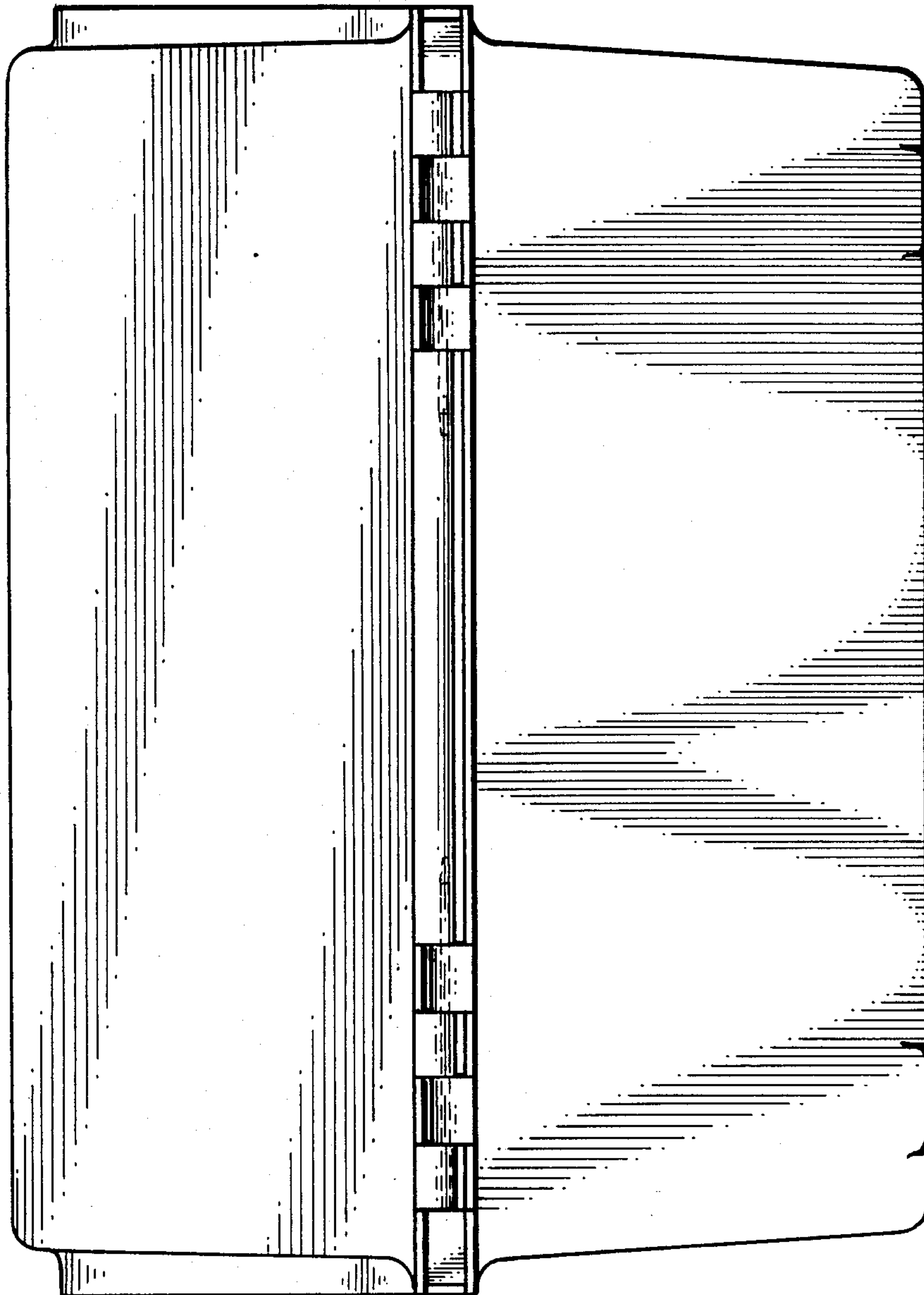
