The ornamental design for a diamond ring, substantially as shown and described.

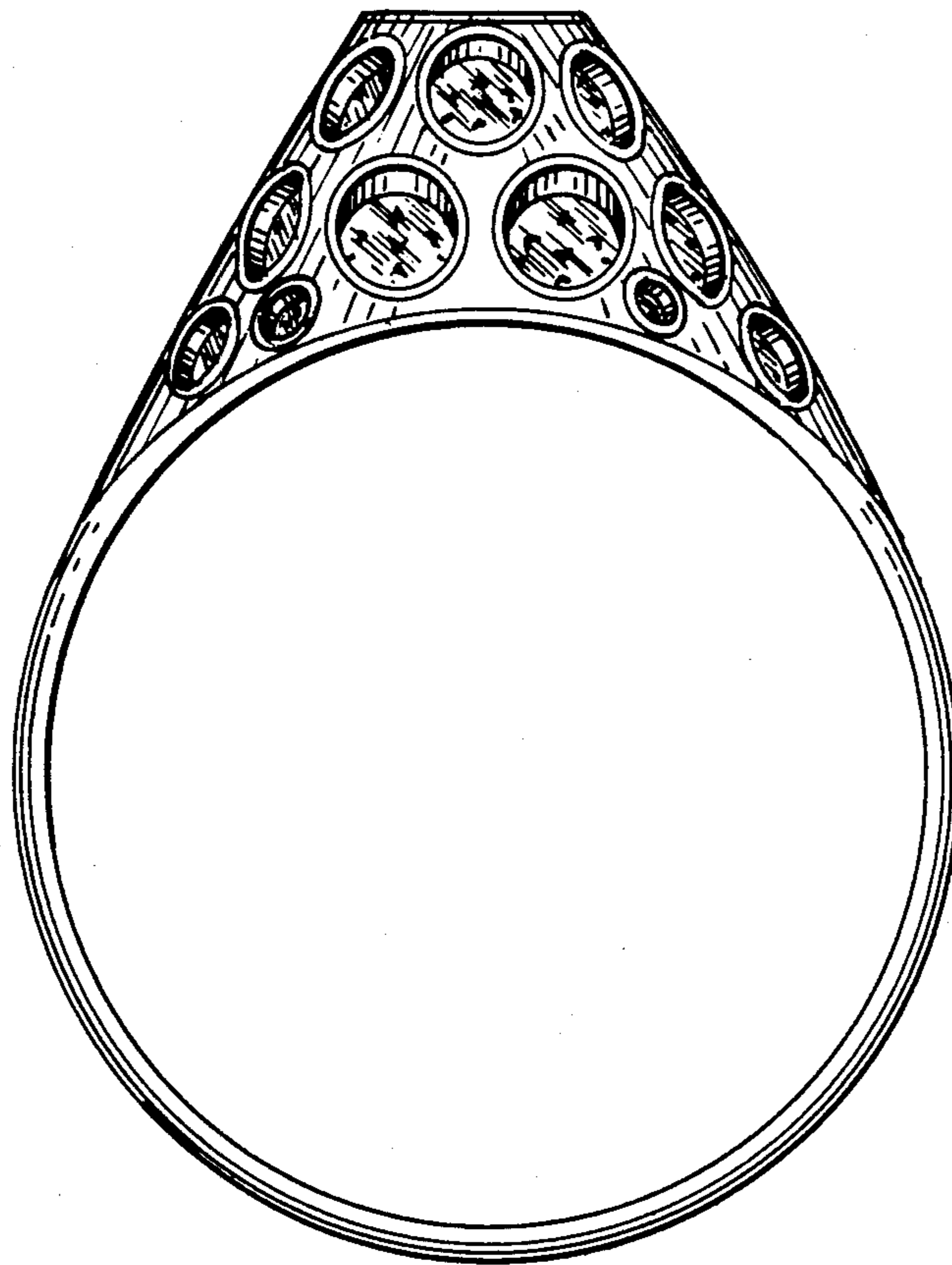
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a diamond ring showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being the same;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



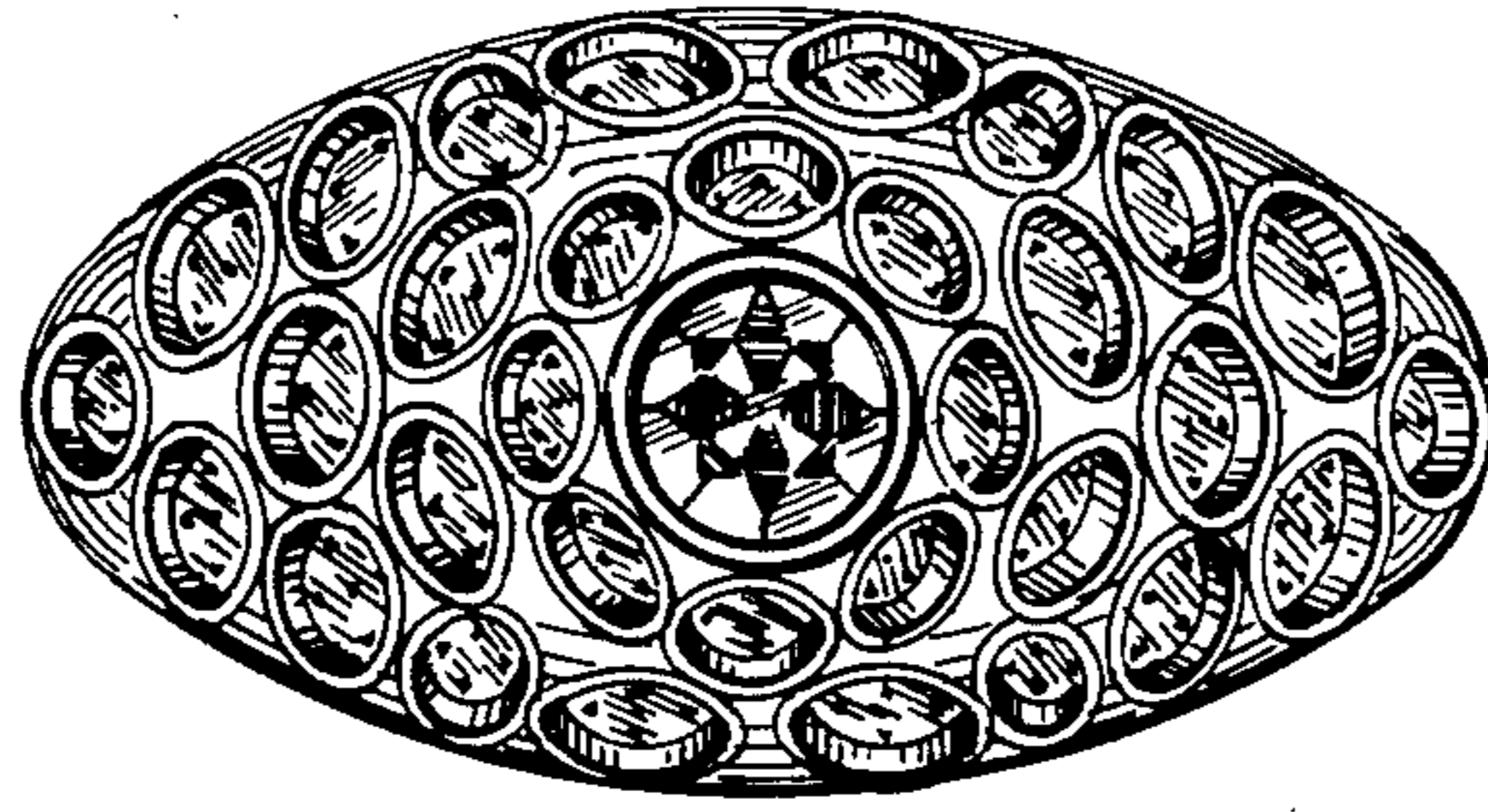

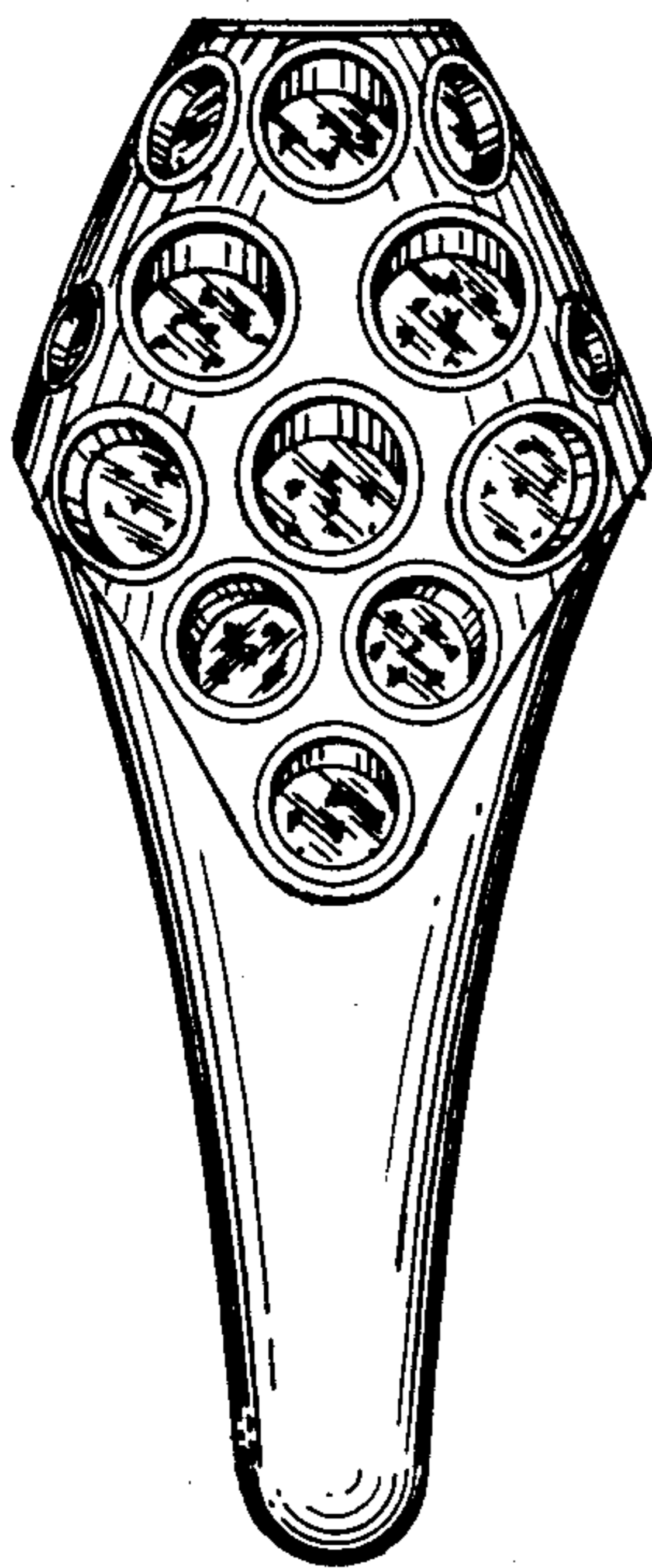

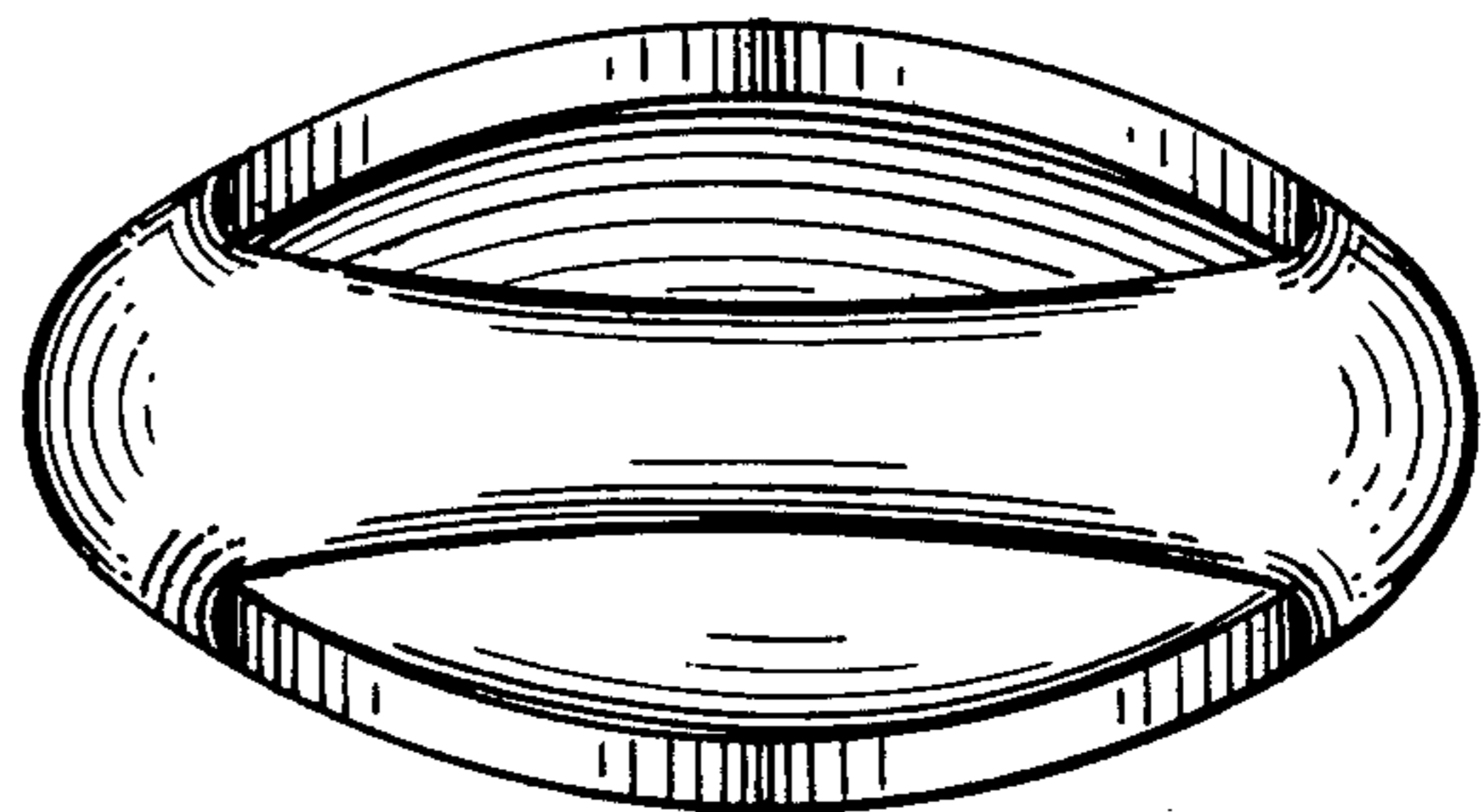
